UNCG Travels To Appalachian State For Final Scheduled Meeting

THE TIPOFF...

With just six games left in the 2013-14 regular season, the UNCG women's basketball team heads to the Holmes Convocation Center in Boone Saturday for the second of two meetings with Appalachian State. The Mountaineers won the first game in the season series by a 75-56 count Jan. 19 at Fleming Gymnasium. In their most recent contest, the Spartans snapped an eight-game losing skid with a 76-65 victory over Georgia Southern. As a result, guard Bailey Williams was named the Southern Conference Freshman of the Week. Appalachian State has won nine straight over UNCG and leads the series 18-9 in Boone. The contest is the final scheduled meeting between the schools as the Mountaineers will join the Sun Belt Conference next season.

ABOUT US...

The Blue and Gold enters the game with a 6-17 overall record and 2-10 league mark after rolling past Georgia Southern Monday at Fleming Gymnasium. The Spartans are averaging 63.6 points per game and are allowing opponents to score 73.0 points per contest. The Blue and Gold owns a -0.6 margin on the glass, averaging 39.5 rebounds and giving up 40.1 boards per game. The Spartans are first in the league in offensive rebounding at 16.0 per outing. In terms of shooting, UNCG is firing at a 36.2 percent clip from the field, 31.3 percent from beyond the arc and 64.0 percent from the free throw line. Sophomore guard Lucy Mason leads the team in scoring average at 12.5 points per game while senior forward Janae' Stevenson paces the Spartans in rebounding average at 7.9 boards per contest. The Blue and Gold uses its bench liberally as nine players have appeared in 21 or more games.

ABOUT THEM...

Appalachian State is 9-14 overall and 6-7 in Southern Conference action after suffering a 55-47 setback at Samford Monday. The Mountaineers are averaging 61.9 points per game while giving up 65.3 per contest. ASU also pulls down 40.3 rebounds per contest while allowing 34.3 - a rebounding margin of +6.0. The Mountaineers are shooting 41.1 percent from the field, 29.0 percent from deep and 64.8 percent at the free throw line. Maryah Sydnor is the top offensive force for Appalachian, averaging 19.5 points per game, while also leading the squad in rebounding average at 8.8 boards per outing. ASU is also a good offensive rebounding team, ranking second behind UNCG in the league at 15.8 per game.

Wendy Palmer (Virginia, '96) is in her third season at the helm of the UNCG women's basketball program. Under her tutelage, the team doubled their win total in 2012-13 and won a game in the conference tournament for the first time since 2010. Palmer also mentored guard Lucy Mason to Southern Conference Freshman of the Year accolades. She arrived in Greensboro after a two-year stint as an assistant coach at her alma mater Virginia. While on the Cavalier staff, Palmer helped recruit and sign a class ranked in the top 15 nationally by ESPN HoopGurlz and coached All-American and national Defensive Player of the Year Monica Wright. During Palmer's tenure on the sidelines, Virginia made one NCAA appearance and a WNIT quarterfinals appearance. Palmer was an assistant for two years at Kentucky prior to returning to Virginia. There, she coached All-American Victoria Dunlap, who was taken 11th in a recent WNBA Draft. While still playing professionally, Palmer began her coaching career at Virginia Commonwealth. In her two years there, Palmer coached 2006 Colonial Athletic Association Rookie of the Year Quanitra Hollingsworth and Krystal Vaughn, who both went on to play professionally in the WNBA and in Europe. Palmer enjoyed outstanding playing careers on both the professional and amateur levels. A WNBA All-Star for the Detroit Shock in 2000, Palmer was also the WNBA's Co-Most Improved Player with the Connecticut Sun in 2004. She was selected in the 1997 Elite Draft by the Utah Starzz in preparation for the WNBA's inaugural year of competition and was a second-team All-WNBA selection that season. Palmer also played for the Orlando Miracle, San Antonio Silver Stars and Seattle Storm in her WNBA career. The Shock's Community Relations Player Representative from 1999-2001, Palmer was the recipient of the Black Legends of Professional Basketball John Isaacs Service Award. Palmer also played professionally in Spain, Brazil, Hungary, Turkey, Italy and Russia, earning another all-star bid in Italy. On the collegiate level, Palmer was a two-time Kodak All-American and Atlantic Coast Conference Player of the Year for the Cavaliers, earning those honors in 1995 and 1996. A three-time All-ACC selection, she is still the Cavs' career rebounding leader and is fourth on Virginia's all-time scoring list. Palmer was the first woman in school history and just the second player overall to record 1,000 career points and 1,000 career rebounds at Virginia. Cavalier legend Ralph Sampson was the other.

LAST TIME OUT FOR THE SPARTANS

UNCG 76, Georgia Southern 65

February 10, 2014 @ Greensboro, N.C. (Fleming Gymnasium)

GREENSBORO, N.C. – The UNCG women's basketball team jumped all over Georgia Southern to start Monday night's Southern Conference contest at Fleming Gymnasium and never surrendered the lead as the Spartans recorded a 76-65 victory. The win snapped an eight-game losing streak overall and a four-game skid to the Eagles. UNCG shot the ball well in the contest, finishing with a season second-best 51.7 percent efficiency in knocking down 30 of 58 attempts from the field, while also limiting Georgia Southern to 38.2 percent overall (26 of 68). The Spartans did most of their damage down low, out-scoring the Eagles 40-36 in the paint. The Blue and Gold also got out in transition, recording 21 fast-break points. Despite hitting just 12 of 31 attempts from the free throw line, UNCG made up for it with its performance from the field. Georgia Southern owned the final rebounding advantage to the tune of 45-40. Freshman guard Shanese Harris netted a career high offensively for the second-straight game, pouring in 15 points as one of four Spartans to tally double figures. Sophomore guard Lucy Mason paced the team with 18 points while freshman guard Bailey Williams and senior forward Janae' Stevenson chipped in with 12 each. Stevenson also pulled down a team-high eight rebounds – a total which included three offensive boards. For the Eagles, Anna Claire Knight led the way with 22 points and nine rebounds. The Blue and Gold recorded an assist on more than half of its made baskets, racking up a season second-best 18 helpers of which Mason and Williams tallied five each. UNCG also forced 17 GSU turnovers, scoring 20 points off those miscues, while committing just 13 as a team. Mason provided the game's first points via a fast-break layup at the 18:51 mark and would score the first seven points for the Spartans. UNCG held a 10-2 advantage after a Williams triple with 16:29 on the clock and would keep the clamps down on defense, extending the lead to 23-6 when Harris put in a layup at 9:47. The home side would not let the cushion slide under double figures for much of the remainder of the period. However, with the Blue and Gold leading 37-22 after a Harris three-pointer with 2:06 to play, the Eagles closed the stanza on an 8-0 run to slice their deficit to 37-30 heading into the break. Knight led all scorers with 11 points in the first 20 minutes while Harris netted nine for UNCG. The Spartans were on fire from the field in the half, hitting 15 of 26 to shoot 57.7 percent. In terms of the rebounding battle, Georgia Southern posted 11 offensive boards as a part of a 23-15 advantage. UNCG came out with purpose in the second half, netting eight of the first 10 points to lead 45-32 at the 18:14 mark. The Eagles were able to cut into the advantage as the second half wore on, going on a 7-0 run that was capped by a Knight jumper to leave the score at 45-39 with 13:58 to play. Williams would put a stop to the run at the 12:30 mark, hitting a three to push the Spartan lead back to nine. Georgia Southern put forth another rally, this time pulling all the way to within 51-47 after two free throws by Knight with 8:51 remaining. The Blue and Gold absorbed the run successfully though and scored the next six to push ahead 57-47 and force a timeout from the visitor bench at the 7:18 mark. A jumper by Mason saw the Spartans lead by as much as 13 at 64-51 with 5:42 to play in the contest, but UNCG had to survive one last Georgia Southern rally. Angel McGown would hit a three-point field goal at 3:16 to pull the Eagles within five, 66-61. However, that was as close as GSU would come the rest of the way as the Spartans out-scored their guests 10-4 in the final minutes to seal the victory.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE MACHINE...

Stevenson's recent career-best streak of six-straight double-doubles is a school record. She now has 18 career double-doubles, surpassing Julie Moore for third on the program chart. The school record for career double-doubles is held by Melinda Goodson who tallied 24 from 1997-2000.

WELCOME TO THE SIXTIES...

The Spartan offense has improved each year over head coach Wendy Palmer's tenure. UNCG averaged just 49.6 points per game in her first season before scoring 57.2 per outing last year. This campaign has the Blue and Gold scoring at an average of 63.6 points a game.

PLAYING FROM BEHIND...

UNCG has battled back from a double-digit deficit on a couple of occasions to win this season. The Spartans were down 12 in the second half at Norfolk State and 13 in the first half against High Point but emerged victorious both times. In Saturday's game with Davidson, the Wildcats led by 17 in the second half but had to fend off the Spartans in overtime.

USUALLY GOOD FOR THREE...

UNCG has nailed at least one three-point field goal in 227 of its last 229 games and 26 straight. The Spartans owned a streak of 155-straight contests with a triple until they went 0-6 at Wofford Dec. 17, 2011.

SOCON FRESHMAN OF THE YEAR...

Freshman guard Lucy Mason was selected the 2013 Southern Conference Freshman of the Year by the league's media members. She is the first Spartan to earn league freshman of the year accolades since Kristen Boone was recognized during the 2004-05 campaign and the first to garner a spot on the all-freshman team since teammate Janae' Stevenson in 2010-11. Mason paced the Spartans this season in scoring at 12.5 points per game and three-point field goals made with 35 while also averaging in double figures in SoCon play at 10.4 points per contest. She started every game for UNCG in 2012-13 and was the highest scoring rookie in the league by a full six points in all games and by three points in league contests.

STUFFED...

Stevenson is rapidly moving her way up the UNCG career blocked shots list. As a freshman, she swatted 36 shots, the fourth-most in a single season in school history. She did two better with 38 blocked shots her sophomore campaign. With 119 to her credit now, she is second in program career history. Should she maintain her current pace, Stevenson should be able to surpass UNCG's career record of 121 by Rebecca Viverette (1994-98) by the time her days in a Spartan uniform are over.

JUST FINE IN FLEMING...

UNCG has been historically successful in Fleming Gym, posting a 203-101 (.668) mark at the venue. In 23 years, UNCG has had just five losing seasons in the facility. The playing surface was christened Lynne Agee Court in honor of the former UNCG coach, who retired in March 2011 after 30 years at the helm. The court was officially dedicated at halftime of UNCG's Dec. 3, 2011 contest against Samford.

ROCKY ROAD...

The Blue and Gold has had a tough go of it away from home the last five years, compiling an 19-60 record away from Fleming Gymnasium.

WHAT'S BACK FOR THE BLUE AND GOLD...

UNCG may have a number of new faces joining the program this season, but the Spartans also return a large amount of their production - losing just one starter from the 2012-13 squad. Below is a more in-depth look.

UNCG is in its 17th season as a basketball member of the Southern

Conference. Starting in 1997, the Spartans became eligible to compete for the league title after making their transition to Division I status as a member of the Big South Conference. UNCG owns two regular season championships (1998-99 and 2001-02) and one tournament title (1998) which led to the program's only NCAA Tournament appearance. The Blue and Gold also qualified for the WNIT at the conclusion of the 2001-02 campaign. Below is a closer look at UNCG's history in the league.

2014 SOUTHERN CONFERENCE CHAMPIONSHIP...

The 2014 edition of the Southern Conference Women's Basketball Championship is scheduled for March 7-10 in Asheville, N.C. All 10 conference squads will compete in the event, with the winner taking the league's automatic bid to the 2014 NCAA Tournament. Last season, No. 1 seed Chattanooga swept through the event to win its 14th SoCon title. The Mocs, seeded 11th in the NCAA Tournament, fell to No. 6 seed Nebraska 73-59 in the national event's first round.

1,000 ACHIEVED...

Stevenson entered the new campaign within reach of becoming the 23rd player in program history to score 1,000 career points. She reached the milestone with a 16-point performance at Elon. Here is a look at all the 1,000-point scorers in UNCG women's basketball history:

DOUBLING UP...

The Spartans put five players in double figures offensively in the win over Triad rival High Point, marking the first time that had happened for UNCG since Nov. 24, 2008 - also against the Panthers.

ALL-TOURNAMENT...

For her efforts at the Fordham Holiday Classic, Stevenson was named to the all-tournament team. She averaged 13.0 points and 5.5 rebounds in games against Fordham and Tulsa while making 12 of 20 shots from the field (.600).

OVERTIME NOT THE RIGHT TIME...

With two overtime losses this season, the Spartans have dropped six of their last eight overtime contests dating back to the 2008-09 season.

NEW SPARTANS...

UNCG head coach Wendy Palmer welcomes four new members to the Spartan women's basketball family next season. Below is a look at the new faces joining the program next year:

Keli Foster, Guard, 5-7, Hampton, Va. (Bethel)

Foster averaged 10.4 points, 3.4 rebounds, 4.9 assists and 4.1 steals per game her junior campaign at Bethel High School, earning first-team all-district accolades. She currently serves as a team captain for the Bruins and scored a career-high 24 points in an upset win over powerhouse Hampton High School in January of last season. Foster also excels in the classroom as a member of her school's honor roll and is a participant in the student athletic training program. She plays her AAU basketball for the Boo Williams Norfolk Xpress coached by Morris Smith.

Skye Jefferson, Forward/Center, 6-2, Richmond, Va. (Cosby)

Jefferson was the starting center last season for a state championship contending Cosby High School team under head coach Rachel Mead. She helped lead the Titans to a 26-2 overall record and racked up second-team all-district honors. Jefferson is a member of the Boo Williams Richmond AAU program coached by Max Coats and Mike Davis.

Jayda Luckie, Guard, 5-9, Norfolk, Va. (Maury)

Luckie averaged 12.7 points per game at Maury High School last season under head coach Jermaine Woods and earned first-team all-district recognition. She helped the Commodores to a 21-6 record as a junior and is a teammate of fellow signee Keli Foster on the Boo Williams Norfolk Xpress AAU program coached by Morris Smith. One of her most memorable moments last season occurred against Mount Vernon when she scored 13 points and hit a buzzer-beating layup at the end of double overtime to give Maury a 79-77 victory.

Alison Whitman, Center/Forward, 6-3, Madison, W.Va. (Scott)

Whitman is an impact post player who earned third-team all-state, first-team all-district and first-team all-conference honors last season under head coach John Porter at Scott High School. As a sophomore, Whitman helped the Skyhawks to a 25-4 overall record, 8-1 league ledger and a No. 9 ranking in the state. Scott has finished as the state runner up the past two years. Whitman is also a member of the West Virginia Thunder AAU program coached by Scott Johnson.
