Spartans Square Off Against Western Carolina Monday in Cullowhee

THE TIPOFF...

The UNCG women's basketball team closes a quick two-game road stint Monday evening, facing off against Western Carolina in Cullowhee. The Spartans look to earn a season series split with the Catamounts after Western captured a 60-49 decision Jan. 17 in Greensboro. The Catamounts have won five straight over the Spartans and lead the all-time series 31-25 - including a 14-9 mark at the Ramsey Regional Activity Center. Both teams will attempt to get back on the winning track as UNCG fell at Appalachian State Saturday and Western Carolina has dropped its last three contests. The last time the Blue and Gold won in Cullowhee was Jan. 3, 2011 when the Spartans topped the Catamounts 56-50.

ABOUT US...

The Blue and Gold enters the game with a 6-18 overall record and 2-11 league mark after losing at Appalachian State Saturday. The Spartans are averaging 63.8 points per game and are allowing opponents to score 73.1 points per contest. The Blue and Gold owns a -0.9 margin on the glass, averaging 39.3 rebounds and giving up 40.2 boards per game. The Spartans are first in the league in offensive rebounding at 15.9 per outing. In terms of shooting, UNCG is firing at a 36.5 percent clip from the field, 31.5 percent from beyond the arc and 63.6 percent from the free throw line. Sophomore guard Lucy Mason and senior forward Janae' Stevenson lead the team in scoring average at 12.3 points per game while Stevenson paces the Spartans in rebounding average at 8.1 boards per contest. The Blue and Gold uses its bench liberally as nine players have appeared in 22 or more games.

ABOUT THEM...

Western Carolina is 11-14 overall and 5-9 in Southern Conference action after suffering a 65-61 setback against Elon Saturday. The Catamounts are averaging 59.2 points per game while giving up 61.1 per contest. WCU also pulls down 37.6 rebounds per contest while allowing 40.8 - a rebounding margin of -3.2. The Catamounts are shooting 37.2 percent from the field, 31.2 percent from deep and 61.6 percent at the free throw line. Rena Wakama is the top offensive force for Western, averaging 10.3 points per game, while Shauna Terry leads the squad in rebounding average at 5.0 boards per outing. WCU ranks third in the league in scoring defense and has held the Spartans under 50 points the last six meetings.

Wendy Palmer (Virginia, '96) is in her third season at the helm of the UNCG women's basketball program. Under her tutelage, the team doubled their win total in 2012-13 and won a game in the conference tournament for the first time since 2010. Palmer also mentored guard Lucy Mason to Southern Conference Freshman of the Year accolades. She arrived in Greensboro after a two-year stint as an assistant coach at her alma mater Virginia. While on the Cavalier staff, Palmer helped recruit and sign a class ranked in the top 15 nationally by ESPN HoopGurlz and coached All-American and national Defensive Player of the Year Monica Wright. During Palmer's tenure on the sidelines, Virginia made one NCAA appearance and a WNIT quarterfinals appearance. Palmer was an assistant for two years at Kentucky prior to returning to Virginia. There, she coached All-American Victoria Dunlap, who was taken 11th in a recent WNBA Draft. While still playing professionally, Palmer began her coaching career at Virginia Commonwealth. In her two years there, Palmer coached 2006 Colonial Athletic Association Rookie of the Year Quanitra Hollingsworth and Krystal Vaughn, who both went on to play professionally in the WNBA and in Europe. Palmer enjoyed outstanding playing careers on both the professional and amateur levels. A WNBA All-Star for the Detroit Shock in 2000, Palmer was also the WNBA's Co-Most Improved Player with the Connecticut Sun in 2004. She was selected in the 1997 Elite Draft by the Utah Starzz in preparation for the WNBA's inaugural year of competition and was a second-team All-WNBA selection that season. Palmer also played for the Orlando Miracle, San Antonio Silver Stars and Seattle Storm in her WNBA career. The Shock's Community Relations Player Representative from 1999-2001, Palmer was the recipient of the Black Legends of Professional Basketball John Isaacs Service Award. Palmer also played professionally in Spain, Brazil, Hungary, Turkey, Italy and Russia, earning another all-star bid in Italy. On the collegiate level, Palmer was a two-time Kodak All-American and Atlantic Coast Conference Player of the Year for the Cavaliers, earning those honors in 1995 and 1996. A three-time All-ACC selection, she is still the Cavs' career rebounding leader and is fourth on Virginia's all-time scoring list. Palmer was the first woman in school history and just the second player overall to record 1,000 career points and 1,000 career rebounds at Virginia. Cavalier legend Ralph Sampson was the other.

LAST TIME OUT FOR THE SPARTANS

Appalachian State 76, UNCG 67

February 15, 2014 @ Boone, N.C. (Holmes Convocation Center)

BOONE, N.C. – The UNCG women's basketball team rallied from a 16-point first half deficit to take the lead in the second stanza Saturday at Appalachian State, but the Mountaineers had just enough to grind out a 76-67 Southern Conference victory at the Holmes Convocation Center. Senior forward Janae' Stevenson was the only player in the game to record a double-double – her eighth of the season – as she scored 21 points and pulled down 13 rebounds. Freshman forward Jade Scaife also netted double figures offensively with 10 points while freshman guard Bailey Williams set a career high in assists with eight helpers. Additionally, freshman guard Shanese Harris contributed 10 points and five rebounds in 31 minutes played. Maryah Sydnor paced ASU with 22 points and eight rebounds. Appalachian State out-shot UNCG 46 percent to 43 percent, hitting 32 of 69 from the field while holding the Spartans to 27 of 63 overall. The Mountaineers also held the upper hand in rebounding, 43-36, and the top two offensive rebounding teams in the SoCon combined for 30 offensive boards. The squads played pretty evenly down low as the Mountaineers ended up with a slight 42-38 advantage in the paint, but ASU received 34 points from its bench to aid its cause. The Blue and Gold dished out 18 assists as a team with Williams and sophomore guard Lucy Mason teaming up for 15 of the dimes. The Spartans started off the game well, scoring six of the first eight points to take a four-point advantage with 2:06 gone. However, the Mountaineers settled down and went on a 10-4 run to lead 12-8 at 15:13. A layup by Sydnor stretched the home team's cushion out to 18-10, but a jumper by junior guard Jarae Savage sliced the deficit to 22-16 with 10:02 remaining in the half. Appalachian State looked to run away with the game in the first half, going ahead 35-19 at 5:07 after an offensive rebound and putback by Amber Doniere. UNCG would not quit though, using a 9-2 run over the final minutes of the period to cut its deficit to 37-28 at the break. Stevenson led the Spartans with 10 points in the first 20 minutes while Sydnor paced all scorers with 12. The Mountaineers held a 24-20 advantage on the glass and 24-16 in the paint. Appalachian State shot 46 percent (18 of 39) in the stanza while limiting UNCG to 35 percent (11 of 31). UNCG came out on fire in the second half, coming all the way back to knot the score at 42 at 15:28 on a triple by Harris. Keke Cooper put her team back in front 52-48 thanks to a jumper down low. However, Scaife continued a strong start to the second period as her layup with 8:15 remaining gave the Blue and Gold the lead at 55-54. Appalachian State would deliver the knockout blow, however, going on a 14-2 run over the next several minutes to put the game away. Farrah Wood was key for the Mountaineers during the stretch as she hit a trio of three-point field goals. UNCG would get no closer than eight the rest of the way.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE MACHINE...

Stevenson's recent career-best streak of six-straight double-doubles is a school record. She now has 19 career double-doubles, surpassing Julie Moore for third on the program chart. The school record for career double-doubles is held by Melinda Goodson who tallied 24 from 1997-2000.

WELCOME TO THE SIXTIES...

The Spartan offense has improved each year over head coach Wendy Palmer's tenure. UNCG averaged just 49.6 points per game in her first season before scoring 57.2 per outing last year. This campaign has the Blue and Gold scoring at an average of 63.8 points a game.

PLAYING FROM BEHIND...

UNCG has battled back from a double-digit deficit on a couple of occasions to win this season. The Spartans were down 12 in the second half at Norfolk State and 13 in the first half against High Point but emerged victorious both times. In Saturday's game with Davidson, the Wildcats led by 17 in the second half but had to fend off the Spartans in overtime.

USUALLY GOOD FOR THREE...

UNCG has nailed at least one three-point field goal in 228 of its last 230 games and 27 straight. The Spartans owned a streak of 155-straight contests with a triple until they went 0-6 at Wofford Dec. 17, 2011.

SOCON FRESHMAN OF THE YEAR...

Freshman guard Lucy Mason was selected the 2013 Southern Conference Freshman of the Year by the league's media members. She is the first Spartan to earn league freshman of the year accolades since Kristen Boone was recognized during the 2004-05 campaign and the first to garner a spot on the all-freshman team since teammate Janae' Stevenson in 2010-11. Mason paced the Spartans this season in scoring at 12.5 points per game and three-point field goals made with 35 while also averaging in double figures in SoCon play at 10.4 points per contest. She started every game for UNCG in 2012-13 and was the highest scoring rookie in the league by a full six points in all games and by three points in league contests.

STUFFED...

Stevenson is rapidly moving her way up the UNCG career blocked shots list. As a freshman, she swatted 36 shots, the fourth-most in a single season in school history. She did two better with 38 blocked shots her sophomore campaign. With 121 to her credit now, she is tied for first in program career history with Rebecca Vivrette.

JUST FINE IN FLEMING...

UNCG has been historically successful in Fleming Gym, posting a 203-101 (.668) mark at the venue. In 23 years, UNCG has had just five losing seasons in the facility. The playing surface was christened Lynne Agee Court in honor of the former UNCG coach, who retired in March 2011 after 30 years at the helm. The court was officially dedicated at halftime of UNCG's Dec. 3, 2011 contest against Samford.

ROCKY ROAD...

The Blue and Gold has had a tough go of it away from home the last five years, compiling an 19-60 record away from Fleming Gymnasium.

WHAT'S BACK FOR THE BLUE AND GOLD...

UNCG may have a number of new faces joining the program this season, but the Spartans also return a large amount of their production - losing just one starter from the 2012-13 squad. Below is a more in-depth look.

SOUTHERN CONFERENCE: THE 17TH SEASON...

UNCG is in its 17th season as a basketball member of the Southern Conference. Starting in 1997, the Spartans became eligible to compete for the league title after making their transition to Division I status as a member

of the Big South Conference. UNCG owns two regular season championships (1998-99 and 2001-02) and one tournament title (1998) which led to the program's only NCAA Tournament appearance. 2014 SOUTHERN CONFERENCE CHAMPIONSHIP...

The 2014 edition of the Southern Conference Women's Basketball Championship is scheduled for March 7-10 in Asheville, N.C. All 10 conference squads will compete in the event, with the winner taking the league's automatic bid to the 2014 NCAA Tournament. Last season, No. 1 seed Chattanooga swept through the event to win its 14th SoCon title. The Mocs, seeded 11th in the NCAA Tournament, fell to No. 6 seed Nebraska 73-59 in the national event's first round.

1,000 ACHIEVED...

The Spartans put five players in double figures offensively in the win over Triad rival High Point, marking the first time that had happened for UNCG since Nov. 24, 2008 - also against the Panthers.

ALL-TOURNAMENT...

For her efforts at the Fordham Holiday Classic, Stevenson was named to the all-tournament team. She averaged 13.0 points and 5.5 rebounds in games against Fordham and Tulsa while making 12 of 20 shots from the field (.600).

OVERTIME NOT THE RIGHT TIME...

With two overtime losses this season, the Spartans have dropped six of their

last eight overtime contests dating back to the 2008-09 season.

ASSISTANCE PROVIDED...

Freshman guard Bailey Williams is coming into her own at the point guard position, leading the team with 89 assists for an average of 3.7 per game. She dropped a career-best eight dimes at Appalachian State with seven of them in the first half alone. UNCG is one of the better teams in the league when it comes to assists, ranking fifth with an average of 12.4 per contest.

NEW SPARTANS...

UNCG head coach Wendy Palmer welcomes four new members to the Spartan women's basketball family next season. Below is a look at the new faces joining the program next year:

Keli Foster, Guard, 5-7, Hampton, Va. (Bethel)

Foster averaged 10.4 points, 3.4 rebounds, 4.9 assists and 4.1 steals per game her junior campaign at Bethel High School, earning first-team all-district accolades. She currently serves as a team captain for the Bruins and scored a career-high 24 points in an upset win over powerhouse Hampton High School in January of last season. Foster also excels in the classroom as a member of her school's honor roll and is a participant in the student athletic training program. She plays her AAU basketball for the Boo Williams Norfolk Xpress coached by Morris Smith.

Skye Jefferson, Forward/Center, 6-2, Richmond, Va. (Cosby)

Jefferson was the starting center last season for a state championship contending Cosby High School team under head coach Rachel Mead. She helped lead the Titans to a 26-2 overall record and racked up second-team all-district honors. Jefferson is a member of the Boo Williams Richmond AAU program coached by Max Coats and Mike Davis.

Jayda Luckie, Guard, 5-9, Norfolk, Va. (Maury)

Luckie averaged 12.7 points per game at Maury High School last season under head coach Jermaine Woods and earned first-team all-district recognition. She helped the Commodores to a 21-6 record as a junior and is a teammate of fellow signee Keli Foster on the Boo Williams Norfolk Xpress AAU program coached by Morris Smith. One of her most memorable moments last season occurred against Mount Vernon when she scored 13 points and hit a buzzer-beating layup at the end of double overtime to give Maury a 79-77 victory.

Alison Whitman, Center/Forward, 6-3, Madison, W.Va. (Scott)

Whitman is an impact post player who earned third-team all-state, first-team all-district and first-team all-conference honors last season under head coach John Porter at Scott High School. As a sophomore, Whitman helped the Skyhawks to a 25-4 overall record, 8-1 league ledger and a No. 9 ranking in the state. Scott has finished as the state runner up the past two years. Whitman is also a member of the West Virginia Thunder AAU program coached by Scott Johnson.
