UNCG Welcomes Furman For Saturday SoCon Clash

THE TIPOFF...

The UNCG women's basketball team returns to Fleming Gymnasium this weekend to close out its home schedule, beginning with a Saturday league clash against Furman. The Blue and Gold will celebrate the 1987-88 team which won the Dixie Intercollegiate Athletic Conference regular season and tournament championships before reaching the NCAA Division III Final Four. The Spartans and Paladins met Jan. 27 in Greenville, S.C., with Furman pulling away late for a 73-64 victory. UNCG leads the series between the schools 22-17, including a 12-4 mark in Greensboro. However, Furman has captured six of the last 10 meetings. Last season, the Spartans downed the Paladins in two of the three encounters.

ABOUT US...

The Blue and Gold enters the game with a 6-19 overall record and 2-12 league mark after falling at Western Carolina Monday. The Spartans are averaging 63.2 points per game and are allowing opponents to score 72.7 points per contest. The Blue and Gold owns a -1.0 margin on the glass, averaging 39.4 rebounds and giving up 40.4 boards per game. The Spartans are second in the league in offensive rebounding at 15.8 per outing. In terms of shooting, UNCG is firing at a 36.4 percent clip from the field, 30.8 percent from beyond the arc and 63.4 percent from the free throw line. Sophomore guard Lucy Mason leads the team in scoring average at 12.4 points per game while senior forward Janae' Stevenson paces the Spartans in rebounding average at 8.2 boards per contest. The Blue and Gold uses its bench liberally as nine players have appeared in 23 or more games.

ABOUT THEM...

Furman is 14-11 overall and 8-6 in Southern Conference action after downing Samford 51-45 Monday at home. The Paladins are averaging 65.9 points per game while giving up 64.7 per contest. Furman also pulls down 39.4 rebounds per contest while allowing 39.5 - a rebounding margin of -0.1. The Paladins are shooting 41.6 percent from the field, 32.0 percent from deep and 69.8 percent at the free throw line. Holli Wilkins, who tallied a game-high 16 points against Samford, tops Furman and ranks five in the SoCon in scoring (14.6 ppg) and is followed by Brittany Hodges (13.6 ppg). The Paladins lead the league in field goal percentage defense (38.9 percent). Furman heads into Saturday's contest tied with Elon for third place in the league standings, one game behind second place Davidson.

Wendy Palmer (Virginia, '96) is in her third season at the helm of the UNCG women's basketball program. Under her tutelage, the team doubled their win total in 2012-13 and won a game in the conference tournament for the first time since 2010. Palmer also mentored guard Lucy Mason to Southern Conference Freshman of the Year accolades. She arrived in Greensboro after a two-year stint as an assistant coach at her alma mater Virginia. While on the Cavalier staff, Palmer helped recruit and sign a class ranked in the top 15 nationally by ESPN HoopGurlz and coached All-American and national Defensive Player of the Year Monica Wright. During Palmer's tenure on the sidelines, Virginia made one NCAA appearance and a WNIT quarterfinals appearance. Palmer was an assistant for two years at Kentucky prior to returning to Virginia. There, she coached All-American Victoria Dunlap, who was taken 11th in a recent WNBA Draft. While still playing professionally, Palmer began her coaching career at Virginia Commonwealth. In her two years there, Palmer coached 2006 Colonial Athletic Association Rookie of the Year Quanitra Hollingsworth and Krystal Vaughn, who both went on to play professionally in the WNBA and in Europe. Palmer enjoyed outstanding playing careers on both the professional and amateur levels. A WNBA All-Star for the Detroit Shock in 2000, Palmer was also the WNBA's Co-Most Improved Player with the Connecticut Sun in 2004. She was selected in the 1997 Elite Draft by the Utah Starzz in preparation for the WNBA's inaugural year of competition and was a second-team All-WNBA selection that season. Palmer also played for the Orlando Miracle, San Antonio Silver Stars and Seattle Storm in her WNBA career. The Shock's Community Relations Player Representative from 1999-2001, Palmer was the recipient of the Black Legends of Professional Basketball John Isaacs Service Award. Palmer also played professionally in Spain, Brazil, Hungary, Turkey, Italy and Russia, earning another all-star bid in Italy. On the collegiate level, Palmer was a two-time Kodak All-American and Atlantic Coast Conference Player of the Year for the Cavaliers, earning those honors in 1995 and 1996. A three-time All-ACC selection, she is still the Cavs' career rebounding leader and is fourth on Virginia's all-time scoring list. Palmer was the first woman in school history and just the second player overall to record 1,000 career points and 1,000 career rebounds at Virginia. Cavalier legend Ralph Sampson was the other.

LAST TIME OUT FOR THE SPARTANS

Western Carolina 63, UNCG 51

CULLOWHEE, N.C. – The UNCG women's basketball team could not overcome Western Carolina on its home floor Monday evening as the Catamounts downed the Spartans 63-51 in a Southern Conference game inside the Ramsey Regional Activity Center. WCU completed the season sweep of the Blue and Gold, having downed the Spartans 60-49 Jan. 17 in Greensboro. Both squads shot the ball under 40 percent in the contest from the floor with Western Carolina finishing at 35.7 percent (25 of 70) and UNCG turning in a 34 percent performance (18 of 53). The Catamounts also held a slight advantage on the glass, picking up 44 rebounds as compared to 42 for the Spartans. The Blue and Gold turned the ball over 14 times in the second half, ending up with 18 overall while Western finished with just 12. Senior forward Janae' Stevenson filled up the stat sheet to the tune of 10 rebounds, nine points and a blocked shot. The block gives her the program's career record of 122 – surpassing Rebecca Vivrette. Sophomore guard Lucy Mason paced the offense with 13 points to go along with three assists while freshman forward Jade Scaife contributed eight points and a career-best 11 rebounds. Western Carolina seized control right out of the gate, scoring 10 of the first 12 points to lead 10-2 at the 16:10 mark. A layup by freshman guard Shanese Harris (Chesapeake, Va./Western Branch) cut the deficit to 12-5 with 14:02 left in the first half before the Catamounts answered with a 9-5 run over the next three minutes to push in front 21-10. The home side would extend its cushion all the way to 15 points, rolling ahead 32-17 at 5:38 on a jumper by Alexis Carter. However, just as in Saturday's game at Appalachian State, the Spartans rallied and held the Catamounts scoreless for the remainder of the stanza. Meanwhile, Stevenson went to work down low and earned multiple trips to the foul line. All told, she would score six of the final 11 UNCG points in the half as the Blue and Gold closed on an 11-0 run to pull within 32-28 at the break. Mason paced the Spartans in the first 20 minutes with eight points and two assists while Stevenson corralled five rebounds. Erika Joseph contributed six points and 10 rebounds for Western Carolina, which shot 36.8 percent (14 of 38) from the field and held UNCG to 31 percent (9 of 29). The Catamounts also held the upper hand in the rebounding column 24-21 – including 11 offensive boards. The teams combined for just nine turnovers. Any momentum UNCG possessed disappeared as the second stanza began as Western Carolina scored the first four points to push its lead back to eight points. A layup by Mason drew the Spartans within 38-34 with 15:25 to play, but the Catamounts clamped down and extended their cushion to 51-40 at 9:44 off of a layup by Wakama. UNCG would not threaten down the stretch and Western salted the game away at the free throw line.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE MACHINE...

Stevenson's recent career-best streak of six-straight double-doubles is a school record. She now has 19 career double-doubles, surpassing Julie Moore for third on the program chart. The school record for career double-doubles is held by Melinda Goodson who tallied 24 from 1997-2000.

WELCOME TO THE SIXTIES...

The Spartan offense has improved each year over head coach Wendy Palmer's tenure. UNCG averaged just 49.6 points per game in her first season before scoring 57.2 per outing last year. This campaign has the Blue and Gold scoring at an average of 63.2 points a game.

PLAYING FROM BEHIND...

UNCG has battled back from a double-digit deficit on a couple of occasions to win this season. The Spartans were down 12 in the second half at Norfolk State and 13 in the first half against High Point but emerged victorious both times. In the game with Davidson, the Wildcats led by 17 in the second half but had to fend off the Spartans in overtime.

USUALLY GOOD FOR THREE...

UNCG has nailed at least one three-point field goal in 229 of its last 231 games and 28 straight. The Spartans owned a streak of 155-straight contests with a triple until they went 0-6 at Wofford Dec. 17, 2011.

SOCON FRESHMAN OF THE YEAR...

Freshman guard Lucy Mason was selected the 2013 Southern Conference Freshman of the Year by the league's media members. She is the first Spartan to earn league freshman of the year accolades since Kristen Boone was recognized during the 2004-05 campaign and the first to garner a spot on the all-freshman team since teammate Janae' Stevenson in 2010-11. Mason paced the Spartans this season in scoring at 12.5 points per game and three-point field goals made with 35 while also averaging in double figures in SoCon play at 10.4 points per contest. She started every game for UNCG in 2012-13 and was the highest scoring rookie in the league by a full six points in all games and by three points in league contests.

STUFFED...

Stevenson made a rapid move up the UNCG career blocked shots list. As a freshman, she swatted 36 shots, the fourth-most in a single season in school history. She did two better with 38 blocked shots her sophomore campaign. With 122 to her credit, she is now the program's all-time leader in swats.

JUST FINE IN FLEMING...

UNCG has been historically successful in Fleming Gym, posting a 203-101 (.668) mark at the venue. In 23 years, UNCG has had just five losing seasons in the facility. The playing surface was christened Lynne Agee Court in honor of the former UNCG coach, who retired in March 2011 after 30 years at the helm. The court was officially dedicated at halftime of UNCG's Dec. 3, 2011 contest against Samford.

ROCKY ROAD...

The Blue and Gold has had a tough go of it away from home the last five years, compiling an 19-61 record away from Fleming Gymnasium.

WHAT'S BACK FOR THE BLUE AND GOLD...

UNCG may have a number of new faces joining the program this season, but the Spartans also return a large amount of their production - losing just one starter from the 2012-13 squad. Below is a more in-depth look.

UNCG is in its 17th season as a basketball member of the Southern Conference. Starting in 1997, the Spartans became eligible to compete for the league title after making their transition to Division I status as a member

of the Big South Conference. UNCG owns two regular season championships (1998-99 and 2001-02) and one tournament title (1998) which led to the program's only NCAA Tournament appearance. 2014 SOUTHERN CONFERENCE CHAMPIONSHIP...

The 2014 edition of the Southern Conference Women's Basketball Championship is scheduled for March 7-10 in Asheville, N.C. All 10 conference squads will compete in the event, with the winner taking the league's automatic bid to the 2014 NCAA Tournament. Last season, No. 1 seed Chattanooga swept through the event to win its 14th SoCon title. The Mocs, seeded 11th in the NCAA Tournament, fell to No. 6 seed Nebraska 73-59 in the national event's first round.

The Spartans put five players in double figures offensively in the win over Triad rival High Point, marking the first time that had happened for UNCG since Nov. 24, 2008 - also against the Panthers.

ALL-TOURNAMENT...

For her efforts at the Fordham Holiday Classic, Stevenson was named to the all-tournament team. She averaged 13.0 points and 5.5 rebounds in games against Fordham and Tulsa while making 12 of 20 shots from the field (.600).

OVERTIME NOT THE RIGHT TIME...

With two overtime losses this season, the Spartans have dropped six of their

last eight overtime contests dating back to the 2008-09 season.

ASSISTANCE PROVIDED...

Freshman guard Bailey Williams is coming into her own at the point guard position, leading the team with 93 assists for an average of 3.7 per game. She dropped a career-best eight dimes at Appalachian State with seven of them in the first half alone. UNCG is one of the better teams in the league when it comes to assists, ranking fifth with an average of 12.3 per contest.

NEW SPARTANS...

UNCG head coach Wendy Palmer welcomes four new members to the Spartan women's basketball family next season. Below is a look at the new faces joining the program next year:

Keli Foster, Guard, 5-7, Hampton, Va. (Bethel)

Foster averaged 10.4 points, 3.4 rebounds, 4.9 assists and 4.1 steals per game her junior campaign at Bethel High School, earning first-team all-district accolades. She currently serves as a team captain for the Bruins and scored a career-high 24 points in an upset win over powerhouse Hampton High School in January of last season. Foster also excels in the classroom as a member of her school's honor roll and is a participant in the student athletic training program. She plays her AAU basketball for the Boo Williams Norfolk Xpress coached by Morris Smith.

Skye Jefferson, Forward/Center, 6-2, Richmond, Va. (Cosby)

Jefferson was the starting center last season for a state championship contending Cosby High School team under head coach Rachel Mead. She helped lead the Titans to a 26-2 overall record and racked up second-team all-district honors. Jefferson is a member of the Boo Williams Richmond AAU program coached by Max Coats and Mike Davis.

Jayda Luckie, Guard, 5-9, Norfolk, Va. (Maury)

Luckie averaged 12.7 points per game at Maury High School last season under head coach Jermaine Woods and earned first-team all-district recognition. She helped the Commodores to a 21-6 record as a junior and is a teammate of fellow signee Keli Foster on the Boo Williams Norfolk Xpress AAU program coached by Morris Smith. One of her most memorable moments last season occurred against Mount Vernon when she scored 13 points and hit a buzzer-beating layup at the end of double overtime to give Maury a 79-77 victory.

Alison Whitman, Center/Forward, 6-3, Madison, W.Va. (Scott)

Whitman is an impact post player who earned third-team all-state, first-team all-district and first-team all-conference honors last season under head coach John Porter at Scott High School. As a sophomore, Whitman helped the Skyhawks to a 25-4 overall record, 8-1 league ledger and a No. 9 ranking in the state. Scott has finished as the state runner up the past two years. Whitman is also a member of the West Virginia Thunder AAU program coached by Scott Johnson.
