Spartans Returns Home Saturday For SoCon Clash Against Davidson

THE TIPOFF...

The UNCG women's basketball team returns home following a three-game road stint to host Davidson Saturday at Fleming Gymnasium. The Blue and Gold has lost seven straight and 13 of 14 and will look to salvage a season series split with the Wildcats after Davidson handed the Spartans a 78-59 setback Jan. 13 at Belk Arena. In last season's meeting between the teams at Fleming Gymnasium, the Wildcats escaped with a 59-56 overtime victory after Sophia Aleksandravicius' layup with 39 seconds left in regulation sent the game into the extra session. Davidson leads the all-time series 28-20 and has won the last seven consecutive meetings. UNCG is 13-8 against the Wildcats in Greensboro.

ABOUT US...

The Blue and Gold enters the game with a 5-16 overall record and 1-9 league mark after falling to Elon 80-57 last Saturday at Alumni Gym. The Phoenix shot over 50 percent in each half and forced 24 UNCG turnovers. The Spartans are averaging 63.9 points per game and are allowing opponents to score 73.3 points per contest. The Blue and Gold owns a -0.9 margin on the glass, averaging 39.0 rebounds and giving up 39.9 boards per game. The Spartans are second in the league in offensive rebounding at 15.8 per outing. In terms of shooting, UNCG is firing at a 35.6 percent clip from the field, 31.8 percent from beyond the arc and 66.3 percent from the free throw line. Sophomore guard Lucy Mason leads the team in scoring average at 12.3 points per game while senior forward Janae' Stevenson paces the Spartans in rebounding average at 7.9 boards per contest. The Blue and Gold uses its bench liberally as nine players have appeared in 19 or more games.

ABOUT THEM...

Davidson is 11-11 overall and 8-3 in Southern Conference action after downing Samford 78-56 Monday at home. The Wildcats are averaging 69.5 points per game while giving up 72.3 per contest. Davidson also pulls down 35.2 rebounds per contest while allowing 42.0 - a rebounding margin of -6.8. The Wildcats are shooting 41.6 percent from the field, 35.7 percent from deep and 71.7 percent at the free throw line. Laura Murray is the top offensive force for Davidson, averaging 19.2 points per game, while Dakota Dukes leads in the squad in rebounding average at 7.9 boards per outing. Murray and Hannah Early have combined to make 88 three-point field goals in 218 attempts.

Wendy Palmer (Virginia, '96) is in her third season at the helm of the UNCG women's basketball program. Under her tutelage, the team doubled their win total in 2012-13 and won a game in the conference tournament for the first time since 2010. Palmer also mentored guard Lucy Mason to Southern Conference Freshman of the Year accolades. She arrived in Greensboro after a two-year stint as an assistant coach at her alma mater Virginia. While on the Cavalier staff, Palmer helped recruit and sign a class ranked in the top 15 nationally by ESPN HoopGurlz and coached All-American and national Defensive Player of the Year Monica Wright. During Palmer's tenure on the sidelines, Virginia made one NCAA appearance and a WNIT quarterfinals appearance. Palmer was an assistant for two years at Kentucky prior to returning to Virginia. There, she coached All-American Victoria Dunlap, who was taken 11th in a recent WNBA Draft. While still playing professionally, Palmer began her coaching career at Virginia Commonwealth. In her two years there, Palmer coached 2006 Colonial Athletic Association Rookie of the Year Quanitra Hollingsworth and Krystal Vaughn, who both went on to play professionally in the WNBA and in Europe. Palmer enjoyed outstanding playing careers on both the professional and amateur levels. A WNBA All-Star for the Detroit Shock in 2000, Palmer was also the WNBA's Co-Most Improved Player with the Connecticut Sun in 2004. She was selected in the 1997 Elite Draft by the Utah Starzz in preparation for the WNBA's inaugural year of competition and was a second-team All-WNBA selection that season. Palmer also played for the Orlando Miracle, San Antonio Silver Stars and Seattle Storm in her WNBA career. The Shock's Community Relations Player Representative from 1999-2001, Palmer was the recipient of the Black Legends of Professional Basketball John Isaacs Service Award. Palmer also played professionally in Spain, Brazil, Hungary, Turkey, Italy and Russia, earning another all-star bid in Italy. On the collegiate level, Palmer was a two-time Kodak All-American and Atlantic Coast Conference Player of the Year for the Cavaliers, earning those honors in 1995 and 1996. A three-time All-ACC selection, she is still the Cavs' career rebounding leader and is fourth on Virginia's all-time scoring list. Palmer was the first woman in school history and just the second player overall to record 1,000 career points and 1,000 career rebounds at Virginia. Cavalier legend Ralph Sampson was the other.

LAST TIME OUT FOR THE SPARTANS

Elon 80, UNCG 57

February 1, 2014 @ Elon, N.C. (Alumni Gym)

ELON, N.C. – UNCG senior forward Janae' Stevenson became the 23rd player in program history to score 1,000 career points Saturday as the Spartans dropped an 80-57 Southern Conference game at Alumni Gym. Stevenson finished the game with 16 points and 14 rebounds – her seventh double-double of the campaign. She was the lone UNCG player to reach double figures in scoring and rebounding though freshman guard Bailey Williams ended the contest with nine points and tied her career high with seven assists. Zora Stephenson paced four Phoenix players in double figures offensively with a game-high 18 points. Elon shot 50 percent in both halves to end up with 53.8 efficiency from the field. The Phoenix hit 35 of 65 attempts from the field, a total which included eight three-point field goal conversions. The Blue and Gold shot 34.8 percent and drained 23 of 66 shots. UNCG could also manage just a 33.3 percent performance at the free throw line, missing 16 of 24 attempts. The Spartans were plagued by 24 turnovers leading to 29 Elon points. The Blue and Gold won the rebounding battle by a 47-38 margin and picked up 28 offensive rebounds. The teams traded layups to start the game before the Phoenix netted six of the next eight points to build an 8-4 lead at 17:17. Williams hit a triple to cut the advantage to one, but Elon took advantage of a lack of transition defense by UNCG to score some easy fastbreak layups and forge ahead 16-7 with 14:53 left in the half. A pair of free throws by Stevenson helped the Spartans reduce their deficit to five at 16-11 with 13:38 on the clock, but a 9-0 run capped by a Sam Coffey triple left the Phoenix with a 25-11 cushion at 9:53. Elon would not let the lead slip under 10 the rest of the stanza as Elon took a 40-24 edge into the break. Stevenson had a monster half for UNCG, scoring 12 points and pulling down 10 rebounds – nine on the offensive end. Jessica Farmer paced the Phoenix with 10 points in the period. Elon converted 19 of its 33 attempts from the field to shoot 57.6 percent while limiting the Spartans to just 27.8 percent (10-of-36). The Blue and Gold out-rebounded its hosts 26-18 and tallied 18 offensive boards. UNCG attempted to keep pace with the Phoenix as the second half commenced, but Zora Stephenson caught fire from beyond the arc and hit three-consecutive triples to stretch the Elon advantage to 51-33 with 14:34 to play. A layup by Jenifer Rhodes extended the cushion to 55-35 at the 13:04 mark and the Phoenix would lead by as much as 32 points before settling for the 23-point win.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE MACHINE...

Stevenson's recent career-best streak of six-straight double-doubles is a school record. She now has 18 career double-doubles, surpassing Julie Moore for third on the program chart. The school record for career double-doubles is held by Melinda Goodson who tallied 24 from 1997-2000.

WELCOME TO THE SIXTIES...

The Spartan offense has improved each year over head coach Wendy Palmer's tenure. UNCG averaged just 49.6 points per game in her first season before scoring 57.2 per outing last year. This campaign has the Blue and Gold scoring at an average of 62.9 points a game.

PLAYING FROM BEHIND...

UNCG has battled back from a double-digit deficit on a couple of occasions to win this season. The Spartans were down 12 in the second half at Norfolk State and 13 in the first half against High Point but emerged victorious both times.

CASHING IN ON THE FREEBIES...

A bright spot for UNCG in the season opener at Florida State was its performance at the free throw line. The Spartans were 14-for-18 at the stripe led by a pair of freshman in Jade Scaife and Shanese Harris who combined to make 11 of 12 attempts. UNCG is shooting 66.3 percent at the charity stripe this season

USUALLY GOOD FOR THREE...

UNCG has nailed at least one three-point field goal in 225 of its last 227 games and 24 straight. The Spartans owned a streak of 155-straight contests with a triple until they went 0-6 at Wofford Dec. 17, 2011.

SOCON FRESHMAN OF THE YEAR...

Freshman guard Lucy Mason was selected the 2013 Southern Conference Freshman of the Year by the league's media members. She is the first Spartan to earn league freshman of the year accolades since Kristen Boone was recognized during the 2004-05 campaign and the first to garner a spot on the all-freshman team since teammate Janae' Stevenson in 2010-11. Mason paced the Spartans this season in scoring at 12.5 points per game and three-point field goals made with 35 while also averaging in double figures in SoCon play at 10.4 points per contest. She started every game for UNCG in 2012-13 and was the highest scoring rookie in the league by a full six points in all games and by three points in league contests.

STUFFED...

Stevenson is rapidly moving her way up the UNCG career blocked shots list. As a freshman, she swatted 36 shots, the fourth-most in a single season in school history. She did two better with 38 blocked shots her sophomore campaign. With 117 to her credit now, she is second in program career history. Should she maintain her current pace, Stevenson should be able to surpass UNCG's career record of 121 by Rebecca Viverette (1994-98) by the time her days in a Spartan uniform are over.

JUST FINE IN FLEMING...

UNCG has been historically successful in Fleming Gym, posting a 202-100 (.669) mark at the venue. In 23 years, UNCG has had just five losing seasons in the facility. The playing surface was christened Lynne Agee Court in honor of the former UNCG coach, who retired in March 2011 after 30 years at the helm. The court was officially dedicated at halftime of UNCG's Dec. 3, 2011 contest against Samford.

ROCKY ROAD...

The Blue and Gold has had a tough go of it away from home the last five years, compiling an 19-60 record away from Fleming Gymnasium.

WHAT'S BACK FOR THE BLUE AND GOLD...

UNCG may have a number of new faces joining the program this season, but the Spartans also return a large amount of their production - losing just one starter from the 2012-13 squad. Below is a more in-depth look.

SOUTHERN CONFERENCE: THE 17TH SEASON...

UNCG is in its 17th season as a basketball member of the Southern Conference. Starting in 1997, the Spartans became eligible to compete for the league title after making their transition to Division I status as a member of the Big South Conference. UNCG owns two regular season championships (1998-99 and 2001-02) and one tournament title (1998) which led to the program's only NCAA Tournament appearance. The Blue and Gold also qualified for the WNIT at the conclusion of the 2001-02 campaign. Below is a closer look at UNCG's history in the league.

2014 SOUTHERN CONFERENCE CHAMPIONSHIP...

The 2014 edition of the Southern Conference Women's Basketball Championship is scheduled for March 7-10 in Asheville, N.C. All 10 conference squads will compete in the event, with the winner taking the league's automatic bid to the 2014 NCAA Tournament. Last season, No. 1 seed Chattanooga swept through the event to win its 14th SoCon title. The Mocs, seeded 11th in the NCAA Tournament, fell to No. 6 seed Nebraska 73-59 in the national event's first round.

1,000 ACHIEVED...

For her efforts at the Fordham Holiday Classic, Stevenson was named to the all-tournament team. She averaged 13.0 points and 5.5 rebounds in games against Fordham and Tulsa while making 12 of 20 shots from the field (.600).

OVERTIME NOT THE RIGHT TIME...

With the overtime loss at Wofford, the Spartans have lost five of their last seven overtime contests dating back to the 2008-09 season.

NEW SPARTANS...

UNCG head coach Wendy Palmer welcomes four new members to the Spartan women's basketball family next season. Below is a look at the new faces joining the program next year:

Keli Foster, Guard, 5-7, Hampton, Va. (Bethel)

Foster averaged 10.4 points, 3.4 rebounds, 4.9 assists and 4.1 steals per game her junior campaign at Bethel High School, earning first-team all-district accolades. She currently serves as a team captain for the Bruins and scored a career-high 24 points in an upset win over powerhouse Hampton High School in January of last season. Foster also excels in the classroom as a member of her school's honor roll and is a participant in the student athletic training program. She plays her AAU basketball for the Boo Williams Norfolk Xpress coached by Morris Smith.

Skye Jefferson, Forward/Center, 6-2, Richmond, Va. (Cosby)

Jefferson was the starting center last season for a state championship contending Cosby High School team under head coach Rachel Mead. She helped lead the Titans to a 26-2 overall record and racked up second-team all-district honors. Jefferson is a member of the Boo Williams Richmond AAU program coached by Max Coats and Mike Davis.

Jayda Luckie, Guard, 5-9, Norfolk, Va. (Maury)

Luckie averaged 12.7 points per game at Maury High School last season under head coach Jermaine Woods and earned first-team all-district recognition. She helped the Commodores to a 21-6 record as a junior and is a teammate of fellow signee Keli Foster on the Boo Williams Norfolk Xpress AAU program coached by Morris Smith. One of her most memorable moments last season occurred against Mount Vernon when she scored 13 points and hit a buzzer-beating layup at the end of double overtime to give Maury a 79-77 victory.

Alison Whitman, Center/Forward, 6-3, Madison, W.Va. (Scott)

Whitman is an impact post player who earned third-team all-state, first-team all-district and first-team all-conference honors last season under head coach John Porter at Scott High School. As a sophomore, Whitman helped the Skyhawks to a 25-4 overall record, 8-1 league ledger and a No. 9 ranking in the state. Scott has finished as the state runner up the past two years. Whitman is also a member of the West Virginia Thunder AAU program coached by Scott Johnson.
