Friday - Hunter Smith (0-0, 1.93 ERA, 4.2 IP) vs. Mike Bunal (0-1, 13.50 ERA, 3.1 IP)

Notes: In Smith's first UNCG start, he fanned three hitters and allowed five hits with one walk. In Bunal's first start, the righty went 3.1 innings allowing seven runs, five earned to Houston Baptist while striking out one hitter.

Saturday - Bryce Hensley (1-0, 1.50 ERA, 6.0 ERA) vs. Rob Hardy (0-0, 5.40 ERA, 5.0 IP)

Notes: Bryce Hensley noted the first quality start of the season for the UNCG pitching staff, going 6.0 innings, allowing only one earned run while striking out five hitters. Rob Hardy started the Saturday matchup with Houston Baptist. Hardy threw 5.0 innings, giving up five hits and three earned runs while striking out a team-high three.

Sunday - Matt Frisbee (0-1, 32.40 ERA, 1.2 IP) vs. Jake Cryts (0-0, 5.04 ERA)

Notes: Frisbee showed potential in his first start, with a smooth first inning of action. Frisbee retired the side in order in his first inning, earning the benefit of a caught stealing. Cryts threw the most innings of any starter, going 5.1 in the finale on Sunday. He gave up three runs on four hits and fanned one hitter.

A Little History -- Binghamton

The Spartans and Bearcats have never met on the baseball diamond. Binghamton has been a Division I institution since the 2002 season. Since that time, Binghamton has earned three bids to an NCAA Regional (2009, 2013, 2014). The Bearcats have posted an overall record of 740-923-9 all time, with the first season being played in 1948. Binghamton has followed a similar path as UNCG, going from a Division III institution to a Division I school, competing in the American East Conference.

Scouting the Bearcats

The Bearcats come to Greensboro after having faced Houston Baptist the previous weekend. Houston Baptist, a 2015 NCAA Regional Participant, took three of four games from the Bearcats during the weekend. Binghamton has made the NCAA tournament in three of the last seven seasons, and returns seven position players and two players from its weekend rotation in 2015.

Pat Britt leads the charge for the Bearcat offense. The sophomore outfielder has hit for a team-high .545 average through three games. Britt has gone 6-for-11 during three games, with a triple and an RBI while scoring two runs. Darian Herncane leads the Bearcats with five RBI on the young season. Herncane, another outfielder, has gone 3-for-12 in his three starts, while scoring a run to go with his RBI. He and Reed Gamache hit home runs during opening weekend. Gamache has started all four games and has hit for a .313 average, going 5-for-16. Gamache is tied for second on the team with four RBI. Brendon Skidmore has also brought in four runs for Binghamton. Skidmore, a junior infielder has a .235 average in his four starts, managing a hit per start in 17 at bats, while leading the team with two doubles.

Binghamton will send the same starters to the mound over the weekend that worked in the first weekend of the season. Mike Bunal will face off with UNCG's Smith on Friday night. In Bunal's last appearance, the righty went 3.1 innings and allowed nine hits, seven runs; five earned, and struck out one hitter. Bunal worked as the Saturday starter in 2015, earning a 3.96 ERA in 50.0 innings of work. On Saturday, Rob Hardy will get the call against UNCG's Hensley. Hardy also threw against the Huskies on opening day in the second game of a double header. Hardy was relieved after five innings of work in his first start. He gave up five hits and allowed three runs, all earned while only allowing one free pass and striking out three hitters. Hardy worked as the Sunday starter in 2015, earning a 5.02 ERA in 57.1 innings, the second-most on the team. Jake Cryts will get the ball in the series finale against UNCG's Frisbee. Cryts logged a team-high 5.1 innings, allowing four hits and three runs in as the Bearcats suffered a 4-3 loss in the third game of the series.

Last 10 vs. Binghamton

This weekend will be the first time the Spartans and the Bearcats will meet on the baseball diamond.

Last Time Out

UNCG earned a 7-3 victory over the Elon Phoenix at the UNCG Baseball Stadium on Tuesday evening. The Spartans fell behind early, giving up three runs in the first two innings, but mounted a come back. UNCG benefitted from some Elon miscues en route to a six run third inning giving the Spartans lead and eventually the game. UNCG added an insurance run in the bottom of the seventh inning. UNCG used six pitcher to hold the Phoenix down. Andrew Wantz threw 2.1 innings striking out six hitters while not giving up a hit. Tripp Shelton finished the evening 2-for-4 with two doubles, two runs scored and an RBI as he led the offensive effort.

Home Cooking

UNCG opens the 2016 season with eight of 12 games at the UNCG Baseball Stadium and won't leave the state of North Carolina until Mar. 11th. The Spartans opened with a split three-game series with the High Point Panthers, going 1-2 and 1-0 at home. UNCG next welcomes Elon and Binghamton to the UNCG Baseball Stadium. UNCG next takes on N.C. State in Raleigh before hosting Army for a three-game set. The Spartans then start a mini-road swing, playing five games in four days away from home. UNCG takes on the UNCW Seahawks on Mar. 9th before participating in a tournament at Coastal Carolina. The Spartans will take on the Chanticleers twice as well as the Illinois Fighting Illini, an NCAA Super-Regional participant in 2015, for the first time in school history. Overall, UNCG will play 30 of its schedule 56 games at the UNCG Baseball Stadium, and an additional 12 will be in the state of North Carolina.

Start Hot, Stay Hot

UNCG pounded out a total of 43 hits in three games on opening weekend, highlighted by a season-high 17 in a 13-5 victory over High Point in the UNCG Baseball Stadium home opener. The 43 hits are the second most for the first three games of the season since 2003 when UNCG knocked out 60 hits to open the season. The next closest total for opening weekend was 40, set in 2012.

Greensboro's New Arrivals

There's 18 players who will be donning the navy and gold for the first time this weekend. The Spartans welcome in a class of 11 freshman, two sophomores and five juniors to Greensboro. On opening weekend, 12 first-year players made their debuts.

On the mound, Matt Frisbee started the Sunday contest, with Bryce Hensley taking the ball on Saturday. Jake Lewis, Easton Welch, Zach Kuchmaner, and Ben Kerner all made appearances through out the weekend. Hensley earned a win in his first start, throwing 6.0 innings, allowing just one run.

UNCG had four position players make their debuts on opening day. Michael Goss and Ben Spitznagel started on the right side of the infield, with Dillon Stewart earning the starting nod as the designated hitter. Freshmen Andrew Moritz was also the opening day centerfielder. Goss and Spitznagel hit above .450 in the first weekend, with Stewart adding the power, belting two home runs in three games. Moritz served as a table-setter, hitting in the ninth spot of the lineup for games one and two, and then hitting in the leadoff spot of the final game against High Point.

Cesar Trejo and JoJo Underwood also made their first appearances for UNCG. Trejo made the most of his first at-bat, hitting a double down the right field line in the second game with High Point and eventually scoring. Underwood came in as a defensive replacement in the second game against High Point, as well as catching the final two innings in the series finale. The Spartans will need these new faces to continue to contribute after seeing their top four position players and top four pitchers from the 2015 season depart.

opening day. Hunter Smith got the ball on opening day, with Bryce Hensley getting it for the home opener Saturday. Freshman Matt Frisbee took the hill on Sunday at High Point for his first collegiate start.

Smith joins the Spartans after a two-year stint at Gardner-Webb. Smith sat out the 2015 season due to NCAA transfer rules. He started 13 games on the bump Gardner-Webb, and compiled a 4-2 overall record. He logged 58 innings while in Boiling Springs, N.C. and struck out 19 hitters in his sophomore campaign. In his debut, Smith threw 4.2 innings, allowing five hits, two runs, one earned and striking out three hitters.

Hensley comes to UNCG by way of Catawba Valley CC. At Catawba Valley, Hensley tied a team-high seven wins in his 73.1 innings of work. He racked up 74 strike outs while having posted a 2.95 ERA. Hensley has shown that he can go the distance as well, tossing four complete games at Catawba, including a no-hitter over New River CC. In his first start, Hensley tossed a quality start, going 6.0 innings, allowing one run on five hits and leads the Spartans with five strike outs.

Frisbee is a big right-hander out of Enka, N.C. He was an All-American Honorable Mention, and earned All-Atlantic Region honors from Perfect game. Frisbee had some difficulty that is expected from a freshman making his debut. He suffered the loss in the finale with High Point, but was able to earn his first collegiate strike out during the game.

Debuts a Dozen

UNCG had a dozen players make their UNCG debuts on opening weekend. Six pitchers saw their first action with the Spartans. The starting rotation were all newcomers, with Ben Kerner, Easton Welch and Jake Lewis making appearances out of the bullpen. Lewis made two appearances, throwing a total of 3.1 innings, allowing two hits and striking out four hitters. Easton Welch pitched an inning in the second game with High Point, surrendering three hits but picking up two strike outs. Kerner also threw an inning, earning his first NCAA strike out in the process.

Michael Goss, Dillon Stewart, Andrew Moritz and Ben Spitznagel all saw their names on the UNCG lineup card for the first time on opening weekend. Goss was hit in the third-spot in the lineup and did plenty of damage, knocking six hits, five RBI, a double and his first home run to go with a .462 average. Stewart also had some highlight reel material, hitting for a .385 average, with two home runs and almost a third when he hit a double off the top two feet of the wall to left center field in the finale with High Point. Spitznagel hit for a team-best .545 average while starting at second base. Moritz started all three games, and hit in the lead off spot once. He hit for a .308 average with a double. Cesar Trejo and JoJo Underwood also made their debuts, Trejo hit a double down the right field line in his first at bat, while Underwood came in as a defensive replacement in the final inning in the second game with High Point.

Oh Captain, My Captain

Head Coach Link Jarrett has announced the captains for his 2016 baseball team. L.J. Kalawaia, Collin Woody, Hunter Smith and Jake Kusz have earned the right to be called captain. The four receive this honor after a vote conducted of the UNCG baseball team.

"We are very proud and fortunate to have the leadership these four players provide to our program," Jarrett said, "They are all worthy of this honor, and it is a true reflection of their consistency, work ethic, production and character. It is very evident that these guys are so well respected by their peers, and that is something they can reflect on for years to come."

Kalawaia and Woody are each seniors, while Smith and Kusz are juniors. Kalawaia received a redshirt after suffering a preseason injury in 2015. Smith is a redshirt junior, having sat out the 2015 season due to NCAA transfer rules.

SoCon Preseason

The Spartans were picked to finish fifth in the Southern Conference's preseason poll. Samford and Mercer split the polls, with Samford taking the coaches poll by one point, and Mercer earning the preseason honor in the media poll. The Bears and the Bulldogs finished one and two, respectively in 2015, with Mercer earning a nod to the NCAA tournament to compete in the Tallahassee Regional.

In the coaches poll, Samford and Mercer tied with four first-place votes, with Samford earning one more point to be the favorite. Wofford and Western Carolina were picked third and fourth, the Spartans were at fifth, two points behind the Catamounts. Furman was picked sixth, The Citadel and ETSU tied for seventh and rounding out the coaches poll was VMI.

For the media poll, Mercer and Samford each took home seven first place votes. The Bears totaled 119 points, two more than the Bulldogs. Wofford and Western Carolina were again third and fourth, with UNCG picked fifth and Furman sixth. VMI took the seventh spot, with The Citadel and ETSU picked for eighth and ninth, respectively.

Woody and Ruiz earn Preseason SoCon Honors

Senior Collin Woody and Sophomore Devin Ruiz earned Preseason SoCon Second Team honors as announced by the conference office on Feb. 11th. Woody qualified as a third baseman, with Ruiz named as the designated hitter.

Woody competed in 50 games as the everyday third baseman for the Spartans last season. He hit for a .296 average, with 12 doubles and belted ten home runs. The ten long balls are the most of any returning player. Woody also logged time on the mound, pitching in 9.1 innings, earning a 1-0 record and a save in 2015.

Ruiz will be entering his sophomore season in 2016. As a freshman, the Pennsauken, N.J. native hit for a .300 average with nine extra-base hits. Ruiz also knocked in 17 RBI in his 26 starts.

SoCon All Freshman

Andrew Wantz will begin his sophomore season, hoping to improve upon an excellent freshman campaign. Wantz appeared in 15 games, starting ten of those. Wantz earned a 5-3 record in 51.2 innings and struck out 36 hitters. For his efforts, Wantz was named to the SoCon All-Freshman team.

Braves Select Clark in the 5th Round

Ryan Clark, the former UNCG Friday night starter, was selected by the Atlanta Braves in the fifth round of the MLB Draft last June. Clark logged a team-high 15 starts in 2015 for the Spartans, going 7-6 in those starts. He also threw in 95.1 innings and earned a 4.06 ERA while striking out 94 hitters. The 94 K's are the fourth-most in a single season at UNCG. Clark appeared in 13 games for the Danville Braves of the Appalachian League where he went 6-1 with a 3.08 ERA. Clark joins former Spartan Max Povse with the Atlanta Braves organization. Povse was a third-round pick in the 2014 draft. Povse saw time with in Danville as a rookie before moving up to the A level with the Rome Braves. In Rome, he started 12 games and earned a 4-2 record to go with a sparkling 2.56 ERA. He then made the transition to the A+ Carolina Mudcats of the Carolina League.

The Spartans return to action on Tuesday, Mar. 1st as they travel to Raleigh, N.C. to face off with the No. 18/19 NC State Wolfpack at Doak Field at Dail Park at 4:00 p.m.
