Notes: Haack starts his third midweek game of the season, and will be making his fifth appearance of the season. Haack has worked in 8.2 innings, allowed six runs; five earned and struck out nine while holding opponents to a .229 average against.

#### A Little History -- UMES

The Spartans and Hawks have only played once in UNCG's history. UNCG defeated UMES 16-5 in the previous meeting in 2014. The Spartans garnered 19 hits in the contest, with 13 RBI. UNCG had six players with multiple hits in the game, with five picking up multiple RBI.

#### **Scouting the Hawks**

UMES travels to UNCG for the first time since the 2014 season. UMES made the trip to Greensboro on March 19th and were defeated 16-5 by the Spartans. The Hawks enter the midweek matchup after playing at VMI the weekend before and taking on Duke on Tuesday. UMES is currently 4-11, and was swept by VMI the weekend before. UMES got the season started on the right foot, taking two of three from Fairleigh Dickinson. UMES then dropped five of the next six, taking one from Saint Peter's. After taking one of four games with Eastern Kentucky, the Hawks have lost four-straight prior to the midweek games with Duke and the Spartans.

The Hawk offense is led by Jessey Valdez. Valdez has started in 13 of 15 games, and has hit for a .360 average. The redshirt sophomore has connected for five doubles, a home run and currently leads UMES with 13 RBI. Mike Escanilla has been another consistent contributor to the Hawks offense. Escanilla has started all 15 games and has a .333 average in that span. He has hit the only triple of the season, driven in nine runs and scored 10 runs of his own. Dallas Culotta and Skylar Murray are tied for the team lead with a pair of home runs each. Culotta has started seven games and is also tied for second on the team with five doubles. Murray has started seven games as well and has four hits, two of which are home runs.

On the mound, UMES has used a combination of 13 pitchers who have all thrown in at least four innings. Jason Marquez has made three appearances, with one start in his 9.0 innings pitched. Marquez has picked up a win while earning a 4.00 ERA. Tom Summers has also made four appearances to go with one start. In his 6.1 innings, he has allowed five runs; three of which were earned. As a staff, UMES has a 10.26 ERA and is allowing opposing teams to hit for a .367 average.

#### **Last Time Out**

UNCG is coming off of a 3-1 weekend with two games against Illinois and Coastal Carolina each. The Spartans won a doubleheader with both teams on Friday, using 21 hits to earn a 20-9 victory over the Illini. UNCG then defeated Coastal Carolina 4-2 in the nightcap. The Navy and Gold came back the next day and picked up a 5-4 victory over Illinois in ten innings. UNCG dropped the final game of the weekend, 7-4 to Coastal Carolina and are now 11-5 on the season.

#### 10's the Magic Number

In 12 of 15 games this season, UNCG has racked up at least 10 hits. During that time, the Spartans have gone 11-2 in games that they have at least 10 hits. When not reaching the 10 hit plateau, UNCG is 0-3. Twice UNCG has had nine hits and the season-low for hits in a game is six in a 6-4 loss to the Army Black Knights.

#### Wantz Wows

Andrew Wantz has been a force out of the bullpen so far this season for the Spartans. The sophomore right-hander has made a team-high nine appearances through 15 games. Wantz

was named to the SoCon All-Freshman team a season ago, and has continued a stellar start to his career. Wantz leads UNCG with 31 punch outs, including striking out seven through three innings against Binghamton on Feb. 27th. As of Mar. 15th, Wantz ranks tied at 28th in the NCAA with a 12.49 strike outs per nine innings pitched ratio. The 36 strikeouts also comes in at 36th most in the NCAA.

#### Start Hot, Stay Hot

Currently, the UNCG offense currently leads the NCAA with a .353 team batting average. BYU has the next closes average at .351. UNCG leads the NCAA in doubles, doubles per game as wells as being in the top ten in slugging percentage.

UNCG has connected for at least 40 hits in every weekend since the start of the season. UNCG has also knocked out 10 or more hits in 12 of 15 games played so far this season, including going for 20+ in three games.

UNCG has continued to produce at the plate. The Spartans have hit for double-digit hits in 12 of 15 games to start this season. UNCG failed to reach the 10-hit plateau against No. 8 NC State, in the series finale with Army and in the last game of the Coastal Carolina Invitational. L.J. Kalawaia leads the Spartans with a .400 average in 14 games played. Kalawaia has 24 hits on the season with 11 RBI. Collin Woody and Tripp Shelton are tied for the team-lead with 27 hits.

Shelton is currently tied for 14th in the NCAA with eight doubles on the season. Shelton only hit seven doubles in all of 2015 as he as surpassed his extra-base hit total from the year before in his sophomore season.

#### Perfect 10

The Spartans improved their record to 6-0 against Big Ten teams all-time with a pair of victories over Illinois last weekend. UNCG has previously met with Minnesota and Penn State as other Big Ten opponents. The Spartans and Golden Gophers met in Conway, S.C., in another tournament hosted by Coastal Carolina in 2014. UNCG and the Nittany Lions met in 2012 with UNCG sweeping Penn State in a three-game series the second weekend of the season.

#### Home Cooking

UNCG hit the road for its first road swing of the season on Mar. 9th UNCG opened the 2016 season with eight of 12 games played at the UNCG Baseball Stadium. The Spartans first games outside of North Carolina were in the Coastal Carolina Invitational, where UNCG finished 3-1.

UNCG opened the season with a split series against the High Point Panthers, going 2-1 and taking the game at home. The Spartans have gone 7-1 at home during the early part of the season, with a 2-4 record on the road, including a close loss in Raleigh to No. 8 NC State.

In their first road trip of the year, UNCG went 3-2 with two victories over Illinois and splitting a pair of games with Coastal Carolina. The Spartans also dropped the midweek game at UNCW, an NCAA Regional qualifier a year ago. Illinois was a 2015 Super Regional participant and Coastal Carolina has made the postseason in 12 seasons since 2001.

#### **Greensboro's New Arrivals**

There's 18 players who donned the navy and gold for the first time on opening weekend. The Spartans welcome in a class of 11 freshman, two sophomores and five juniors to Greensboro. On opening weekend, 12 first-year players made their debuts.

UNCG used an all-new to UNCG weekend rotation so far this season. Hunter Smith has been the Friday night starter, with Bryce Hensley working Saturday's and Matt Frisbee taking the ball on Sundays. Jake Lewis, Easton Welch, Zach Kuchmaner, and Ben Kerner all made appearances throughout opening weekend, as their first appearances as Spartans.

Hensley has tossed a quality start (6.0 IP, less than three earned runs) in all of his starts, earning three wins in the process. Smith had his longest outing of the season against Army (Mar. 4). Smith went 7.0 innings, striking out seven in his first victory. Frisbee has also earned three starts, going a career-high 5.0 innings against Army, Mar. 6th.

UNCG had four position players make their debuts on opening day. Michael Goss and Ben Spitznagel started on the right side of the infield, with Dillon Stewart earning the starting nod as the designated hitter. Freshmen Andrew Moritz was also the opening day centerfielder. Goss and Spitznagel hit above .450 in the first weekend, with Stewart adding the power, belting two home runs in three games. Moritz served as a table-setter, hitting in the ninth spot of the lineup for games one and two, and then hitting in the leadoff spot of the final game against High Point.

Cesar Trejo and JoJo Underwood also made their first appearances for UNCG. Trejo made the most of his first at-bat, hitting a double down the right field line in the second game with High Point and eventually scoring. Underwood came in as a defensive replacement in the second game against High Point, as well as catching the final two innings in the series finale. Trejo has now earned three starts as the designated hitter, and has a .429 average with three extra-base hits.

The Spartans will need these new faces to continue to contribute after seeing their top four position players and top four pitchers from the 2015 season depart.

#### Oh Captain, My Captain

Head Coach Link Jarrett announced the captains of the 2016 UNCG Baseball team prior to the start of the season. L.J. Kalawaia, Collin Woody, Hunter Smith and Jake Kusz have earned the right to be called captain this season. The four receive this honor after a vote conducted of the UNCG baseball team.

"We are very proud and fortunate to have the leadership these four players provide to our program." Jarrett said, "They are all worthy of this honor, and it is a true reflection of their consistency, work ethic, production and character. It is very evident that these guys are so well respected by their peers, and that is something they can reflect on for years to come."

Kalawaia and Woody are each seniors, while Smith and Kusz are juniors. Kalawaia received a redshirt after suffering a preseason injury in 2015. Smith is a redshirt junior, having sat out the 2015 season due to NCAA transfer rules.

#### Woody and Ruiz earn Preseason SoCon Honors

Senior Collin Woody and Sophomore Devin Ruiz earned Preseason SoCon Second Team honors as announced by the conference office on Feb. 11th. Woody qualified as a third baseman, with Ruiz named as the designated hitter.
