**Friday - UNCG | Hunter Smith (2-0, 3.86 ERA, 23.1 IP, 18 K's) vs. Marist | Sean Keenan (2-1, 2.88 ERA, 25.0 IP, 17 K's)**

Notes: Smith enters having coming off of one of his most dominant starts of his career. Smith shut down Coastal Carolina for 7.0 innings in a 4-2 victory over the Chanticleers on Friday evening in Conway, S.C. Keenan has been in the Friday night role for the Red Foxes this season. The junior made the transition after being a primary bullpen pitcher a year ago.

**Saturday - UNCG | Bryce Hensley (3-0, 1.88 ERA, 24.0 IP, 18 K's) vs. Marist | Charlie Jerla (1-3, 3.38 ERA, 24.0 IP, 18 K's)**

Notes: Hensley enters with four-straight quality starts. In his last time out, the sophomore south paw held Illinois to two runs through six innings of work as UNCG defeated the Illini in 10 innings. Jerla logged an 8.0 inning shut out over Delaware State in her last time out, surrendering one hit and striking out ten hitters.

**Sunday - UNCG | Matt Frisbee (0-2, 8.31 ERA, 13.0 IP, 8 K's) vs. Marist | TBA**

Notes: Frisbee has started the Sunday games in every weekend series this season. Frisbee logged a career-high 5.0 innings against Army two weeks ago and has eight strikeouts on the season.

## A Little History -- Marist

The Spartans and Red Foxes have met six times, all in Greensboro. The Spartans have earned a 5-1 record in the two three-game series'. In the first meetings in 2007, UNCG picked up a three-game sweep over Marist, with a combined score of 24-12. The next meetings between the programs occurred in 2013. UNCG took the opener and the rubber match of the series, with the Red Foxes taking the Saturday matchup. UNCG has scored at least five runs in every victory over Marist.

## Scouting the Red Foxes

Marist enters the weekend with a 5-7 overall record, including going 4-6 on the road. Marist opened the season with a tournament at Davidson, taking one game against Buffalo. The Red Foxes followed that trip with a meeting within the Triad, taking on the High Point Panthers. The Panthers took two of the three games, but Marist was able to take the first game of the series by a 8-6 tally. The Red Foxes followed their trip to High Point with a series at VCU where they fell in all three matchups. Against Delaware State last weekend, Marist earned their first series sweep of the season, taking all three games in Dover.

The Red Fox offense is led by Greg Kocinski. Kocinski, a junior infielder, has started five games and made one appearance off the bench. In that time, he has hit for a team-high .474 average with a pair of doubles. He also leads Marist with seven RBI, and has scored four runs in his limited time. Joey Aiola has been a constant fixture in the Marist lineup, starting in 11 games this season. Aiola has scored eight times and has five extra-base hits, including one of the three Marist home runs. Aiola is tied with two other players with six RBI so far this season. Jack Shirk, and Graham McIntire have also driven in six runs each this season. Shirk has started in five games and has hit for a .294 average in that time. McIntire has started all 12 games, and has picked up one home run to go with his six RBI. Marist currently has a .231 team batting average through the 12 games played.

Marist's starting rotation will feature right-hander Sean Keenan Friday night, Charlie Jerla Saturday and have not announced Sunday's starter yet. On the season, Keenan has a 2-1 record to go with an impressive 2.88 ERA. In 25.0 innings of work, he has struck out 17 hitters and has allowed eight earned runs. Jerla had one of his most dominant starts a week ago. Jerla threw 8.0 innings of one-hit baseball to Delaware State in Dover, in a 15-0 victory. This season, Jerla has earned a 3.38 ERA and is 1-3. In 24.0 innings, he has fanned a team-high 18 hitters. Sunday's starter has yet to be determined. Spencer Bunting, Tony Ramanelli, and Kevin Stewart have all started at least one game, combining for a 2-0 record in four starts. Ryan Thomas has picked up three saves in the five Marist victories. The junior right-hander has allowed only one earned run in 11.0 innings, good for a 0.82 ERA.

## Last Time Out

UNCG defeated the UMES Hawks on Wednesday afternoon at the UNCG Baseball Stadium by an 8-2 mark. The Spartans took a 1-0 lead in the bottom of the first before UMES plated a pair in the top of the fourth inning. UNCG answered back, using a grand slam from Dillon Stewart to give the Spartans the lead for good. UNCG tacked on five runs total in the fourth, and added a pair later in the game to help put it away. Keaton Haack, Jake Lewis, Andrew Wantz, and Chad Sykes held the Hawks to seven hits on the day Wednesday evening.

## 10's the Magic Number

In 12 of 16 games this season, UNCG has racked up at least 10 hits. During that time, the Spartans have gone 11-2 in games that they have at least 10 hits. When not reaching the 10 hit plateau, UNCG is 1-3. Three times, UNCG has connected for nine hits. The season-low for hits in a game is six in a 6-4 loss to the Army Black Knights in the series finale.

## Wantz Wows

Andrew Wantz has been a force out of the bullpen so far this season for the Spartans. The sophomore right-hander has made a team-high 10 appearances through 16 games. Wantz was named to the SoCon All-Freshman team a season ago, and has continued a stellar start to his career. Wantz leads UNCG with 32 punch outs, including striking out seven through three innings against Binghamton on Feb. 27th. As of Mar. 17th, Wantz ranks 34th in the NCAA with a 12.34 strike outs per nine innings pitched ratio. The 32 strikeouts also comes in at 32nd most in the NCAA.

## Start Hot, Stay Hot

Currently, the UNCG offense currently leads the NCAA with a .351 team batting average. BYU has the next closes average at .348. UNCG leads the NCAA in doubles, doubles per game as wells as being in the top ten in slugging percentage, and fifth in on-base percentage.

UNCG has connected for at least 40 hits in every weekend since the start of the season. UNCG has also knocked out 10 or more hits in 12 of 16 games played so far this season, including going for 20+ in three games.

UNCG failed to reach the 10-hit plateau against No. 8 NC State, in the series finale with Army, the last game of the Coastal Carolina Invitational and the midweek game with UMES. Ben Spitznagel leads the Spartans with a .400 average in 17 games played. He has taken over the lead-off spot of the order after the week of the season. The junior has mixed in six extra-base hits to go with five bunt hits. Spitznagel is also tied with L.J. Kalawaia for the team lead with six steals on the season. Kalawaia has shown a knack for getting on-base, posting a .500 on-base percentage in 15 starts to go with his .381 average.

Shelton is currently tied for 21st in the NCAA with eight doubles on the season. Shelton only hit seven doubles in all of 2015 as he as surpassed his extra-base hit total from the year before in his sophomore season.

## Perfect 10

The Spartans improved their all-time record to 6-0 against Big Ten teams all-time with a pair of victories over Illinois last weekend. UNCG has previously met with Minnesota and Penn State as other Big Ten opponents. The Spartans and Golden Gophers met in Conway, S.C., in another tournament hosted by Coastal Carolina in 2014. UNCG and the Nittany Lions met in 2012 with UNCG sweeping Penn State in a three-game series the second weekend of the season.

## Home Cooking

UNCG hit the road for its first road swing of the season on Mar. 9th UNCG opened the 2016 season with eight of 12 games played at the UNCG Baseball Stadium. The Spartans first games outside of North Carolina were in the Coastal Carolina Invitational, where UNCG finished 3-1.

UNCG opened the season with a split series against the High Point Panthers, going 2-1 and taking the game at home. The Spartans have gone 8-1 at home during the early part of the season, with a 2-4 record on the road, including a close loss in Raleigh to No. 8 NC State.

In their first road trip of the year, UNCG went 3-2 with two victories over Illinois and splitting a pair of games with Coastal Carolina. The Spartans also dropped the midweek game at UNCW, an NCAA Regional qualifier a year ago. Illinois was a 2015 Super Regional participant and Coastal Carolina has made the postseason in 12 seasons since 2001.

Overall, UNCG will play 30 of its schedule 56 games at the UNCG Baseball Stadium, and an additional 12 will be in the state of North Carolina.

## Greensboro's New Arrivals

There's 18 players who donned the navy and gold for the first time on opening weekend. The Spartans welcome in a class of 11 freshman, two sophomores and five juniors to Greensboro. On opening weekend, 12 first-year players made their debuts.

UNCG used an all-new to UNCG weekend rotation so far this season. Hunter Smith has been the Friday night starter, with Bryce Hensley working Saturday's and Matt Frisbee taking the ball on Sundays. Jake Lewis, Easton Welch, Zach Kuchmaner, and Ben Kerner all made appearances on opening weekend, their first appearances as Spartans.

Hensley has tossed a quality start (6.0 IP, less than three earned runs) in all of his starts, earning three wins in the process. Smith had his longest outing of the season against Coastal Carolina (Mar. 13th). Smith went 7.0+ innings, striking out six in the victory. Frisbee has also earned three starts, going a career-high 5.0 innings against Army, Mar. 6th.

UNCG had four position players make their debuts on opening day. Michael Goss and Ben Spitznagel started on the right side of the infield, with Dillon Stewart earning the starting nod as the designated hitter. Freshmen Andrew Moritz was also the opening day centerfielder. Goss and Spitznagel hit above .450 in the first weekend, with Stewart adding the power, belting two home runs in three games. Moritz served as a table-setter, hitting in the ninth spot of the lineup for games one and two, and then hitting in the leadoff spot of the final game against High Point.

Cesar Trejo and JoJo Underwood also made their first appearances for UNCG. Trejo made the most of his first at-bat, hitting a double down the right field line in the second game with High Point and eventually scoring. Underwood came in as a defensive replacement in the second game against High Point, as well as catching the final two innings in the series finale. Trejo has now earned three starts as the designated hitter, and has a .429 average with three extra-base hits.

Kalawaia and Woody are each seniors, while Smith and Kusz are juniors. Kalawaia received a redshirt after suffering a preseason injury in 2015. Smith is a redshirt junior, having sat out the 2015 season due to NCAA transfer rules.

## Woody and Ruiz earn Preseason SoCon Honors

Senior Collin Woody and Sophomore Devin Ruiz earned Preseason SoCon Second Team honors as announced by the conference office on Feb. 11th. Woody qualified as a third baseman, with Ruiz named as the designated hitter.

Woody competed in 50 games as the everyday third baseman for the Spartans last season. He hit for a .296 average, with 12 doubles and belted ten home runs. The ten long balls are the most of any returning player. Woody also logged time on the mound, pitching in 9.1 innings, earning a 1-0 record and a save in 2015.

Ruiz will be entering his sophomore season in 2016. As a freshman, the Pennsauken, N.J. native hit for a .300 average with nine extra-base hits. Ruiz also knocked in 17 RBI in his 26 starts.
