NC A&T has used a multitude of midweeks starters. B Smith has worked in two midweeks, with four other pitchers earning starts. In Smith's last mideek start against Appalachian State, Smith went 6.0 innings, and gave up nine hits and five runs as NC A&T fell to the Mountaineers 7-6 at War Memorial Stadium.

#### A Little History -- North Carolina A&T

The Spartans and Aggies have met 47 times since 1991. UNCG holds a 41-6 advantage during that time. The Spartans have won eight of the last ten meetings, with four of these games being played at the NewBridge Bank Park, home of the Greensboro Grasshoppers. The tradition of playing one game at NewBridge Bank Park started in 2006, a year after the park opened. UNCG has gone 7-1 in games played at the neutral site, with Head Coach Link Jarrett going 2-0 in his three seasons at the helm.

#### Scouting the Aggies

North Carolina A&T enters the midweek game with a 4-17 overall record. The Aggies have dropped six-straight, and 10 of their last 11. Over the last four games, North Carolina A&T has allowed an average of 13.5 runs per game, during that time.

The Aggie offense has hit for a .278 average in their 21 games. Ryan Jantsch leads the A&T offense with a .459 average in ten games. The senior outfielder has connected for five doubles and two home runs while driving in 12 runs. Jantsch also leads the Aggies with a .757 slugging percentage. Timothy Ravare and Milton Rivera are two regulars that have continued to produce for the Aggies. Ravare, a junior infielder has amassed a .338 average with a triple and five doubles while scoring 10 runs. Rivera, a sophomore infielder, has a .325 average through his 21 starts. Rivera also leads the Aggies with five home runs on the season, to go with three doubles. Kyle Clary, Keenan Herring, Adan Ordonez are all tied for the team-lead in RBI. The trio have driven in 15 runs each, with Herring connecting for two home runs during the season.

North Carolina A&T has a staff ERA of 8.95 through 182.0 innings of work. The Aggies have given up 181 earned runs so far this year, and have struck out 136. Teams are also batting .316 against the Aggies pitching staff. There have been five starters during NC A&T's midweek games. KJ McCalister is 0-1 in six appearances, with one start. B Smith has started two midweek games this season, going 0-2 in his six appearances. Smith has an 11.74 ERA in 15.1 innings and has struck out eight hitters. Danny Garrett leads the Aggies in appearances, making 12 through 21 games. Garrett has made one start and has earned an 8.85 ERA in 20.1 innings and is second on the team with 22 strikeouts on the season. Matt Stanley has the lowest ERA of all the Aggie pitchers, earning a 5.52 mark in his 14.2 innings of work. Stanley has recorded an 0-2 record and has allowed nine earned runs while on the bump.

team-high six home runs, and has driven in 27 RBI on the season, including eight over the three games. Over every weekend series this season, UNCG has connected for 40+ hits, including a 53 hit weekend against Marist.

#### 10's the Magic Number

In 16 of 20 games this season, UNCG has racked up at least 10 hits. During that time, the Spartans have gone 14-2 in games that they have at least 10 hits. When not reaching the 10 hit plateau, UNCG is 1-3. Three times, UNCG has connected for nine hits. The season-low for hits in a game is six in a 6-4 loss to the Army Black Knights in the series finale.

#### **Wantz Wows**

Andrew Wantz has been a force out of the bullpen so far this season for the Spartans. The sophomore right-hander has made a team-high 11 appearances through 20 games. Wantz was named to the SoCon All-Freshman team a season ago, and has continued a stellar start to his career. Wantz leads UNCG with 38 punch outs, including striking out seven through three innings against Binghamton on Feb. 27th. As of Mar. 20th, Wantz ranks 42nd in the NCAA with a 11.66 strike outs per nine innings pitched ratio. The 38 strikeouts also comes in at 34th most in the NCAA.

#### **Start Hot, Stay Hot**

Currently, the UNCG offense currently leads the NCAA with a .370 team batting average. Air Force has the next closest average at .353. UNCG leads the NCAA in doubles, doubles per game as wells as being in the top ten in slugging percentage, and fifth in on-base percentage.

UNCG has connected for at least 40 hits in every weekend since the start of the season. UNCG has also knocked out 10 or more hits in 16 of 20 games played so far this season, including going for 20+ in four games. The Spartans have had 20+ hit games 10 times in the 24 year history of the program, prior to this year.

UNCG failed to reach the 10-hit plateau against No. 8 NC State, in the series finale with Army, the last game of the Coastal Carolina Invitational and the midweek game with UMES. Cesar Trejo, who has taken over as the designated hitter the last four games, leads the Spartans with a .486 average. Trejo has played in 12 games with eight starts. Ben Spitznagel has earned the highest average of those who have played at least 15 games. Spitznagel has a .429 average, wtih seven extra-base hits, eight RBI and has scored 19 runs. Collin Woody leads the team with five home runs on the season, following a three homer weekend against Marist. Woody has homered in three-straight games, while leading the Spartans with 27 RBI on the season.

Tripp Shelton is currently tied for 18th in the NCAA with three triples on the season. Shelton has connected for eight doubles on the season, and only hit seven doubles in all of 2015. He as surpassed his extra-base hit total from the year before in his sophomore season.

#### **Coastal Carolina Invitational**

UNCG hit the road for its first road swing of the season on Mar. 9th UNCG opened the 2016 season with eight of 12 games played at the UNCG Baseball Stadium. The Spartans first games outside of North Carolina were in the Coastal Carolina Invitational, where UNCG finished 3-1.

UNCG opened the season with a split series against the High Point Panthers, going 2-1 and taking the game at home. The Spartans have gone 8-1 at home during the early part of the season, with a 2-4 record on the road, including a close loss in Raleigh to No. 8 NC State.

In their first road trip of the year, UNCG went 3-2 with two victories over Illinois and splitting a pair of games with Coastal Carolina. The Spartans also dropped the midweek game at UNCW, an NCAA Regional qualifier a year ago. Illinois was a 2015 Super Regional participant and Coastal Carolina has made the postseason in 12 seasons since 2001.

Overall, UNCG will play 30 of its schedule 56 games at the UNCG Baseball Stadium, and an additional 12 will be in the state of North Carolina.

#### **Home Cooking**

UNCG is currently 11-1 in games played at the UNCG Baseball Stadium. The Spartans will play 30 of the 56 regular season games at the UNCG Baseball Stadium.

#### **Greensboro's New Arrivals**

There's 18 players who donned the navy and gold for the first time on opening weekend. The Spartans welcome in a class of 11 freshman, two sophomores and five juniors to Greensboro. On opening weekend, 12 first-year players made their debuts.

UNCG has used an all-new to UNCG weekend rotation so far this season. Hunter Smith has been the Friday night starter, with Bryce Hensley working Saturday's and Matt Frisbee taking the ball on Sundays. Jake Lewis, Easton Welch, Zach Kuchmaner, and Ben Kerner all made appearances on opening weekend, their first appearances as Spartans.

Hensley has tossed a quality start (6.0 IP, less than three earned runs) in all but of his starts, earning three wins in the process. Smith threw a complete game against Marist on Mar. 18th as UNCG won 16-3 in the opener. Frisbee has also earned three starts, going a career-high 5.0 innings against Army on Mar. 6th, and Marist on Mar. 20th.

UNCG had four position players make their debuts on opening day. Michael Goss and Ben Spitznagel started on the right side of the infield, with Dillon Stewart earning the starting nod as the designated hitter. Freshmen Andrew Moritz was also the opening day centerfielder. Goss and Spitznagel hit above .450 in the first weekend, with Stewart adding the power, belting two home runs in three games. Moritz served as a table-setter, hitting in the ninth spot of the lineup for games one and two, and then hitting in the leadoff spot of the final game against High Point.

Cesar Trejo and JoJo Underwood also made their first appearances for UNCG. Trejo made the most of his first at-bat, hitting a double down the right field line in the second game with High Point and eventually scoring. Underwood came in as a defensive replacement in the second game against High Point, as well as catching the final two innings in the series finale. Trejo has now earned three starts as the designated hitter, and has a .429 average with three extra-base hits
