Smith will also be making his sixth start of the season. In his last time out, he went 8.0 innings of two-hit baseball, allowing one run.

Friday - UNCG | Bryce Hensley (LHP, 3-0, 3.76 ERA, 26.1 IP, 20 K's) vs. Georgetown | Simon Mathews (RHP, 2-2, 34.2 IP, 24 K's)

Notes: Hensley will get the ball on Saturday for the sixth weekend in a row. The redshirt sophomore only managed 1.0+ innings in his last weekend start. Hensley made his first-ever relief appearance on Tuesday, going 1.1 innings against NC A&T. Mathews has logged the most innings on the bump for the Hoyas. In his last time out, Mathews worked 7.0 shutout innings against Princeton, striking out two hitters.

Saturday - UNCG | Matt Frisbee (RHP, 1-2, 7.50 ERA, 18.0 IP, 10 K's) vs. Georgetown | Kevin Superko (RHP, 0-3, 6.75 ERA, 24.0 IP, 14 K's)

Notes: Frisbee earned his first collegiate win last weekend, going 5.0 innings, striking out a career-high seven hitters against Marist on Mar. 20th. Superko rounds out the Georgetown pitching rotation. The sophomore threw 6.0 innings, allowing four runs in his last time out against Princeton. Superko surrendered only five hits in the contest.

A Little History -- Georgetown

The Spartans and Hoyas have met a total of three times on the baseball diamond. UNCG holds a 3-0 advantage, having swept the only previous series, played in 2014. During that series, UNCG used 7-1, 14-3 and 10-9 victories to earn the sweep. UNCG only has three players on their current roster that participated in that series. Jake Kusz made an appearance off the bench, singling in his lone at bat of the series. L.J. Kalawaia started one game, and went 2-for-5 with a triple, scored a run and picked up one RBI. Dillon Stewart also appeared in the series, starting two games and appearing all three. Stewart picked up an RBI hit in his seven at-bats.

Scouting the Hoyas

Georgetown enters the weekend with an 11-10 record but have lost three of their last four. The Hoyas fell in three of four games to Princeton at home, before defeating George Washington 3-2 in Arlington, Va. in their midweek game. Georgetown has been a bit streaky as of late, winning five in a row, including sweeping Penn, taking a midweek from Yale and taking the first game of the Princeton series. Georgetown's offense scored 13 runs in a victory over Florida Atlantic, in Bacon Raton, Fla.

The Hoya offense has been led by Michael DeRenzi. The sophomore outfielder has hit for a .351 average, five RBI and has scored 11 runs. Jake Kuzbel has been the primary run producer for Georgetown. Kuzbel has hit for a .256 average in his 20 starts. He has driven in the most runs on the team, plating 16 to go with his five doubles and one more run. Joseph Bialkowski and Ryan Weisenberg lead the team with two home runs apiece. Bialkowski has driven in 12 runs on the year while scoring nine. Chase Bushor has continued to produce in the Hoya lineup as well. Bushor has hit for a .329 average in 19 games. He has also driven in 10 runs and scored five while tying Kuzbel and DeRenzi for the team-lead with five doubles on the year. The Hoyas have a .259 team batting average with 17 players getting at least one at bat, with no starter having played in every game this year.

Georgetown is set to send a trio of righties to the hill. Matt Smith will get the ball on Friday. Smith has started five games this season, going 27.1 innings and striking out 20 hitters. Smith was a 2015 All-Big East First team. Threw two complete games last season, and in his last time out went 8.0 innings, allowing just two hits and one run to the Princeton Tigers. Simon Mathews has been a dominant starter through five games this year. Mathews has earned a 1.82 ERA and a 2-2 record while working in a team-high 34.2 innings. Mathews has also struck out 24 hitters, best on the Hoyas staff. Kevin Superko rounds out the starting rotation. Superko has also made five starts and has throwing in 24.0 innings this season allowing

18 earned runs. Tim Davis has logged the most appearances out of the bullpen making 10 appearances. He has logged 13.0 innings, allowing 11 hits, seven runs and struck out 16 hitters. David Ellingson has earned five saves on the season. Ellingson has made seven total appearances, going 1-0 in his 7.2 innings. Ellingson has surrendered only two earned runs while holding opponents to a .115 average against. As a staff, Georgetown has earned a 4.04 ERA through 21 games.

Last Time Out

UNCG suffered a 9-8 ten-inning loss on Tuesday evening to the North Carolina A&T Aggies at NewBridge Bank Park. The Spartans went down early, giving up two runs in the top of the first before taking the lead in the bottom of the frame. The game went back and forth over the next seven innings, with UNCG tying it up in the bottom of the seventh inning. A&T was able to score a run in the top of the 10th inning to take the lead and UNCG was unable to mount another comeback.

10's the Magic Number

In 17 of 21 games this season, UNCG has racked up at least 10 hits. During that time, the Spartans have gone 14-3 in games that they have at least 10 hits. When not reaching the 10 hit plateau, UNCG is 1-3. Three times, UNCG has connected for nine hits. The season-low for hits in a game is six in a 6-4 loss to the Army Black Knights in the series finale.

Wantz Wows

Andrew Wantz has been a force out of the bullpen so far this season for the Spartans. The sophomore right-hander has made a team-high 11 appearances through 20 games. Wantz was named to the SoCon All-Freshman team a season ago, and has continued a stellar start to his career. Wantz leads UNCG with 38 punch outs, including striking out seven through three innings against Binghamton on Feb. 27th. As of Mar. 20th, Wantz ranks 42nd in the NCAA with a 11.66 strike outs per nine innings pitched ratio. The 38 strikeouts also comes in at 34th most in the NCAA.

Start Hot, Stay Hot

Currently, the UNCG offense currently leads the NCAA with a .364 team batting average. Air Force has the next closest average at .353. UNCG leads the NCAA in hits, doubles, doubles per game, slugging percentage and on-base percentage.

UNCG has connected for at least 40 hits in every weekend since the start of the season. UNCG has also knocked out 10 or more hits in 17 of 21 games played so far this season, including going for 20+ in four games. The Spartans have had 20+ hit games 10 times in the 24 year history of the program, prior to this year.

UNCG failed to reach the 10-hit plateau against No. 8 NC State, in the series finale with Army, the last game of the Coastal Carolina Invitational and the midweek game with UMES.

Cesar Trejo, who has taken over as the designated hitter the last five games, leads the Spartans with a .439 average. Trejo has played in 13 games with nine starts. Ben Spitznagel has earned the highest average of those who have played at least 15 games. Spitznagel has a .422 average, with seven extra-base hits, nine RBI and has scored 20 runs. Collin Woody leads the team with five home runs on the season, following a three homer weekend against Marist. Woody homered in all three games of the Marist series and leads the team with 27 RBI.

Tripp Shelton is currently tied for 18th in the NCAA with three triples on the season. Shelton has connected for nine doubles on the season, while only hitting seven doubles in all of 2015 as a freshman. Shelton also hit his first home run of the season against A&T, a two-run blast.

Perfect 10

The Spartans improved their all-time record to 6-0 against Big Ten teams all-time with a pair of victories over Illinois last weekend. UNCG has previously met with Minnesota and Penn State as other Big Ten opponents. The Spartans and Golden Gophers met in Conway, S.C., in another tournament hosted by Coastal Carolina in 2014. UNCG and the Nittany Lions met in 2012 with UNCG sweeping Penn State in a three-game series the second weekend of the season.

Coastal Carolina Invitational

UNCG hit the road for its first road swing of the season on Mar. 9th UNCG opened the 2016 season with eight of 12 games played at the UNCG Baseball Stadium. The Spartans first games outside of North Carolina were in the Coastal Carolina Invitational, where UNCG finished 3-1.

UNCG opened the season with a split series against the High Point Panthers, going 2-1 and taking the game at home. The Spartans have gone 8-1 at home during the early part of the season, with a 2-4 record on the road, including a close loss in Raleigh to No. 8 NC State.

In their first road trip of the year, UNCG went 3-2 with two victories over Illinois and splitting a pair of games with Coastal Carolina. The Spartans also dropped the midweek game at UNCW, an NCAA Regional qualifier a year ago. Illinois was a 2015 Super Regional participant and Coastal Carolina has made the postseason in 12 seasons since 2001.

Overall, UNCG will play 30 of its schedule 56 games at the UNCG Baseball Stadium, and an additional 12 will be in the state of North Carolina.

Home Cooking

UNCG is currently 11-1 in games played at the UNCG Baseball Stadium. The Spartans will play 30 of the 56 regular season games at the UNCG Baseball Stadium.

Greensboro's New Arrivals

There's 18 players who donned the navy and gold for the first time on opening weekend. The Spartans welcome in a class of 11 freshman, two sophomores and five juniors to Greensboro. On opening weekend, 12 first-year players made their debuts.

UNCG has used an all-new to UNCG weekend rotation so far this season. Hunter Smith has been the Friday night starter, with Bryce Hensley working Saturday's and Matt Frisbee taking the ball on Sundays. Jake Lewis, Easton Welch, Zach Kuchmaner, and Ben Kerner all made appearances on opening weekend, their first appearances as Spartans.

Hensley has tossed a quality start (6.0 IP, less than three earned runs) in all but of his starts, earning three wins in the process. Smith threw a complete game against Marist on Mar. 18th as UNCG won 16-3 in the opener. Frisbee has also earned three starts, going a career-high 5.0 innings against Army on Mar. 6th, and Marist on Mar. 20th.

UNCG had four position players make their debuts on opening day. Michael Goss and Ben Spitznagel started on the right side of the infield, with Dillon Stewart earning the starting nod as the designated hitter. Freshmen Andrew Moritz was also the opening day centerfielder.

Goss and Spitznagel hit above .450 in the first weekend, with Stewart adding the power, belting two home runs in three games. Moritz served as a table-setter, hitting in the ninth spot of the lineup for games one and two, and then hitting in the leadoff spot of the final game against High Point.

Cesar Trejo and JoJo Underwood also made their first appearances for UNCG. Trejo made the most of his first at-bat, hitting a double down the right field line in the second game with High Point and eventually scoring. Underwood came in as a defensive replacement in the second game against High Point, as well as catching the final two innings in the series finale. Trejo has now earned three starts as the designated hitter, and has a .429 average with three extra-base hits.

Oh Captain, My Captain

Head Coach Link Jarrett announced the captains of the 2016 UNCG Baseball team prior to the start of the season. L.J. Kalawaia, Collin Woody, Hunter Smith and Jake Kusz have earned the right to be called captain this season. The four receive this honor after a vote conducted of the UNCG baseball team.

"We are very proud and fortunate to have the leadership these four players provide to our program," Jarrett said, "They are all worthy of this honor, and it is a true reflection of their consistency, work ethic, production and character. It is very evident that these guys are so well respected by their peers, and that is something they can reflect on for years to come."

Kalawaia and Woody are each seniors, while Smith and Kusz are juniors. Kalawaia received a redshirt after suffering a preseason injury in 2015. Smith is a redshirt junior, having sat out the 2015 season due to NCAA transfer rules.

Woody and Ruiz earn Preseason SoCon Honors

Senior Collin Woody and Sophomore Devin Ruiz earned Preseason SoCon Second Team honors as announced by the conference office on Feb. 11th. Woody qualified as a third baseman, with Ruiz named as the designated hitter.

Woody competed in 50 games as the everyday third baseman for the Spartans last season. He hit for a .296 average, with 12 doubles and belted ten home runs. The ten long balls are the most of any returning player. Woody also logged time on the mound, pitching in 9.1 innings, earning a 1-0 record and a save in 2015.

Ruiz will be entering his sophomore season in 2016. As a freshman, the Pennsauken, N.J. native hit for a .300 average with nine extra-base hits. Ruiz also knocked in 17 RBI in his 26 starts.
