A Little History -- North Carolina A&T

The Spartans and Aggies have met 48 times since 1991. UNCG holds a 41-7 advantage during that time. The Spartans have won eight of the last ten meetings. UNCG dropped the last meeting with the Aggies, a 9-8 ten-inning game held at NewBridge Bank Park, home of the Greensboro Grasshoppers.

Scouting the Aggies

North Carolina A&T enters the midweek game with a 6-19 overall record. Last week, the Aggies finished 2-2 with a win over UNCG at NewBridge Bank Park. A&T took a game against Bethune-Cookman in Daytona Beach, Fla.

The Aggie offense has hit for a .289 average in their 25 games. Ryan Jantsch leads the A&T offense with a .471 average in 13 games. The senior outfielder has connected for seven doubles and two home runs while driving in 15 runs. Jantsch also leads the Aggies with a .725 slugging percentage. Timothy Ravare and Milton Rivera are two regulars that have continued to produce for the Aggies. Ravare, a junior infielder, has amassed a .338 average with a triple and five doubles while scoring 10 runs. Rivera, a sophomore infielder, has a .340 average through his 25 starts. Rivera also leads the Aggies with six home runs on the season, to go with five doubles. Kyle Clary leads the Aggies with 23 RBI on the season. Adan Ordonez has driven in 22 runs this season to go with a .297 average with two home runs, seven doubles and 22 runs scored.

North Carolina A&T has a staff ERA of 8.67 through 215.0 innings of work. The Aggies have given up 207 earned runs so far this year, and have struck out 154. Teams are also batting .316 against the Aggies pitching staff. Danny Garrett is set to get the ball for A&T. The lefty has made 14 appearances this season, including logging 0.1 innings, surrendering two hits, and two earned runs. Matt Stanley has made the second-most appearances for the Aggies, appearing in 12 games. In his 16.2 innings pitched, Stanley has struck out 15 hitters while earning the Aggies lone save of the season.

A Little History -- Campbell

Campbell and UNCG have played nine games over the years, with the Spartans earning a 5-4 advantage in that time. In the first four years of UNCG baseball, the Spartans and Camels faced each other seven times, with UNCG going 5-2 in those games. Scouting the Camels

Campbell is currently 14-11 on the season and have gone 10-6 in Buies Creek. The Camels started the season with its ups and downs, going 7-5 before dropping four-straight games. The first three were in the Campbell Invitational against Davidson, Rhode Island and Indiana State before rattling off six-straight wins. Charleston Southern defeated the Camels in Charleston before Campbell took the final game of the series.

Catcher Matt Parrish leads the Campbell offense. Parrish has played in 21 games this season, and has hit for a team-best .405 average. Parrish also leads the Camels with 26 runs batted in this season. Jimmy Monaghan has provided the pop in the Camel lineup, connecting for three home runs this season to go with a .338 average. Monaghan has driven in 17 RBI this season. Outfielder Ben Calvano leads the Camels with nine stolen bases on the year and has scored 18 runs tied for third on the team. Anthony Lopez has scored the most runs, 26. The senior infielder has hit for a .361 average and has connected for five doubles, three triples and a pair of home runs.

The Camels have used five different starting pitchers during their midweek competitions. Wes Noble has earned a 1-0 record in two starts and six total appearances. Noble has logged 20.0 innings, striking out 24 hitters over that time. Tyson Messer has also logged a pair of starts. Messer has appeared in nine games, working in 14.1 innings in that time. Messer has earned a 7.53 ERA while giving up 16 hits and 12 earned runs. Erik Dowse has made the most appearances for the Camels, earning two saves in the process. Dowse has logged 26.1 innings and has yet to allow an earned run.

Last Time Out

The Spartans are coming off of a three-game sweep of the Georgetown Hoyas at the UNCG Baseball Stadium over the weekend. UNCG has won 18 games in 24 contests, matching the fastest start for a team since 2008.

10's the Magic Number

In 19 of 24 games this season, UNCG has racked up at least 10 hits. During that time, the Spartans have gone 16-3 in games that they have at least 10 hits. When not reaching the 10 hit plateau, UNCG is 2-3. Three times, UNCG has connected for nine hits. The season-low for hits in a game is six in a 6-4 loss to the Army Black Knights in the series finale.

Wantz Wows

Andrew Wantz has been a force out of the bullpen so far this season for the Spartans. The sophomore right-hander has made a team-high 13 appearances through 24 games. Wantz was named to the SoCon All-Freshman team a season ago, and has continued a stellar start to his career. Wantz leads UNCG with 41 punch outs, including striking out seven through three innings against Binghamton on Feb. 27th. As of Mar. 28th, Wantz ranks 45th in the NCAA with a 11.30 strike outs per nine innings pitched ratio. The 41 strikeouts also comes in at 58th most in the NCAA.

Start Hot, Stay Hot

Currently, the UNCG offense currently leads the NCAA with a .366 team batting average. BYU has the next closest average at .342. UNCG also leads the NCAA in hits, runs, triples, slugging percentage and on-base percentage.

UNCG has connected for at least 40 hits in every weekend since the start of the season. UNCG has also knocked out 10 or more hits in 17 of 21 games played so far this season, including going for 20+ in four games. The Spartans have had 20+ hit games 10 times in the 24 year history of the program, prior to this year.

UNCG failed to reach the 10-hit plateau against No. 8 NC State, in the series finale with Army, the last game of the Coastal Carolina Invitational and the midweek game with UMES.

Cesar Trejo has been in the lineup for the last nine games, earning a .377 average in that time.

Ben Spitznagel has earned the highest average of those who have played at least 15 games. Spitznagel has a .412 average, with eight extra-base hits, nine RBI and has scored 24 runs.

Dillon Stewart leads the Spartans with seven home runs, following a three-homer weekend against Georgetown. Collin Woody has driven in 32 RBI, a team-best. The 32 RBI is 12th-most in the NCAA this season.

The Spartans improved their all-time record to 6-0 against Big Ten teams all-time with a pair of victories over Illinois two weeks ago. UNCG has previously met with Minnesota and Penn State as other Big Ten opponents. The Spartans and Golden Gophers met in Conway, S.C., in another tournament hosted by Coastal Carolina in 2014. UNCG and the Nittany Lions met in 2012 with UNCG sweeping Penn State in a three-game series the second weekend of the season.

Coastal Carolina Invitational

UNCG hit the road for its first road swing of the season on Mar. 9th UNCG opened the 2016 season with eight of 12 games played at the UNCG Baseball Stadium. The Spartans first games outside of North Carolina were in the Coastal Carolina Invitational, where UNCG finished 3-1.

UNCG opened the season with a split series against the High Point Panthers, going 2-1 and taking the game at home. The Spartans have gone 8-1 at home during the early part of the season, with a 2-4 record on the road, including a close loss in Raleigh to No. 8 NC State.

In their first road trip of the year, UNCG went 3-2 with two victories over Illinois and splitting a pair of games with Coastal Carolina. The Spartans also dropped the midweek game at UNCW, an NCAA Regional qualifier a year ago. Illinois was a 2015 Super Regional participant and Coastal Carolina has made the postseason in 12 seasons since 2001.

Home Cooking

UNCG is currently 14-1 in games played at the UNCG Baseball Stadium. The Spartans will play 30 of the 56 regular season games at the UNCG Baseball Stadium. Last season, UNCG only managed 13 wins in front of the home fans.

This season, Kusz has hit for a .304 average, with seven doubles and three home runs. Kusz has allowed just four passed balls this season, while being able to catch seven runners attempting to steal bases. Kusz has yet to make an error this season.

Oh Captain, My Captain

Head Coach Link Jarrett announced the captains of the 2016 UNCG Baseball team prior to the start of the season. L.J. Kalawaia, Collin Woody, Hunter Smith and Jake Kusz have earned the right to be called captain this season. The four receive this honor after a vote conducted of the UNCG baseball team.

"We are very proud and fortunate to have the leadership these four players provide to our program," Jarrett said, "They are all worthy of this honor, and it is a true reflection of their consistency, work ethic, production and character. It is very evident that these guys are so well respected by their peers, and that is something they can reflect on for years to come."

Kalawaia and Woody are each seniors, while Smith and Kusz are juniors. Kalawaia received a redshirt after suffering a preseason injury in 2015. Smith is a redshirt junior, having sat out the 2015 season due to NCAA transfer rules.

Woody and Ruiz earn Preseason SoCon Honors

Senior Collin Woody and Sophomore Devin Ruiz earned Preseason SoCon Second Team honors as announced by the conference office on Feb. 11th. Woody qualified as a third baseman, with Ruiz named as the designated hitter.

Woody competed in 50 games as the everyday third baseman for the Spartans last season. He hit for a .296 average, with 12 doubles and belted ten home runs. The ten long balls are the most of any returning player. Woody also logged time on the mound, pitching in 9.1 innings, earning a 1-0 record and a save in 2015.

Ruiz will be entering his sophomore season in 2016. As a freshman, the Pennsauken, N.J. native hit for a .300 average with nine extra-base hits. Ruiz also knocked in 17 RBI in his 26 starts.

Return to Action

The Spartans return to action on Friday, April 1st at 6:00 p.m. at the UNCG Baseball Stadium for the first of three games against VMI. This is the first SoCon series of the season for the Spartans.
