Notes: Smith has been the Friday night starter for the Spartans all season. Threw a complete game against Marist as UNCG has won every one of Smith's starts. Eagle has started five games with eight total appearances on the year. In his last time out, Eagle logged a short outing against The Citadel, going 2.2 innings allowing five earned runs and striking out one hitter.

Saturday - UNCG | Bryce Hensley (3-0, 3.90 ERA, 32.1 IP, 21 K's) vs. VMI | Brandon Barbery (LHP, 3-2, 4.24 ERA, 34.0 IP, 17 K's)

Notes: Hensley has earned quality starts in five of six starts this season, going 6.0 innings, with three or less earned runs in those starts. Barbery has started six games with eight total appearances. In his last time out, Barbery shut out The Citadel through eight innings, allowing just three hits.

Sunday - UNCG | Matt Frisbee (1-2, 5.62 ERA, 24.0 IP, 17 K's) vs. VMI | Josh Winder (RHP, 3-2, 3.40 ERA, 39.2 IP, 37 K's)

Notes: Frisbee earned his first collegiate win over Marist and has gone at least 5.0 innings in his last two starts. Winder enters as the only starter who has started in all of his outings. The six starts is the most for VMI. In his last outing with The Citadel, Winder picked up the loss, throwing six innings, giving up four earned runs.

A Little History -- VMI

The Spartans and Keydets have met 29 times with UNCG holding a 19-10 advantage in that time. This is the first time the Keydets have played in Greensboro since 2001. VMI and UNCG didn't play for 12 years prior to last year's meeting in Lexington, Va.

Scouting the Keydets

VMI enters the weekend with a 15-14 overall record. The Keydets have played some familiar faces for the Spartans, playing Georgetown once, then series' with Binghamton and UMES. VMI owns a 6-1 record to similar opponents, having defeated Georgetown once in a tournament at Wake Forest, the taking two of three games with Binghamton and sweeping UMES in Lexington.

VMI has had three players hit above the .300 mark, while posting a .275 team average. The Keydet offense has shown plenty of pop this year, totaling 42 home runs. Peyton Maddox leads VMI with eight long balls on the year, with Matt Pita and Collin Fleischer nipping at his heels, hitting seven apiece. The 42 home runs is the most for one squad in the NCAA, with Maddox's eight ranking 12th. VMI ranks in the top ten in doubles, home runs per game, and slugging percentage. David Geary leads the VMI offense with a .351 average. The senior third baseman has a team-high 13 doubles, four triples and 31 runs scored. Geary has also driven in 24 runs and stolen five bases. Pita has a .330 average through 29 games. Pita leads the Keydets with a .642 slugging percentage after hitting eight doubles, two triples and the seven homers. Fleischer has a .311 average in his 29 starts, connecting for seven home runs and nine doubles. VMI has nine players who have started at least 25 games this season.

The VMI pitching staff has a 5.61 ERA in 251.2 innings of work. The Keydets will use the same rotation as they did in their SoCon opening series with The Citadel. Matthew Eagle will get the ball on Friday night. Eagle has earned a 5-1 record with a 3.60 ERA in 35.0 innings of work. Eagle has struck out one hitter per every inning picked, while giving up a team-high five home runs. Brandon Barbery is set to start Saturday. Barbery has earned six starts this season, working in 34.0 innings. Barbery has earned a 4.24 ERA with a 3-2 record in his eight appearances. Josh Winder, VMI's most consistent starter, will go on Sunday. Winder has worked in six games, starting all six. Winder has earned a 3-2 record with a 3.40 ERA in a team-high 39.2 innings. Winder also leads the team with 37 strikeouts this year. On the back end, Taylor Edens has earned five saves for the Keydets. Edens has worked in 14 games, logging 22.2 innings and has struck out 20 hitters. Kyle Staats has earned the most calls out of the VMI 'pen, making 15 appearances. Staats has earned a 5.40 ERA in 11.2 innings, striking out 12 to

Last Time Out

The Spartans enter the conference season sporting a 20-6 record, recording wins the two previous midweek games. UNCG defeated North Carolina A&T, 6-2 on Tuesday, before traveling to Buies Creek, N.C. and beating the Camels 8-2.

Early Success

2016 UNCG baseball has had one of the best starts in program history with a 20-6 record heading into SoCon play. The 20 wins prior to the conference season is the most-ever for a UNCG squad, and the .769 winning percentage is the highest winning percentage entering conference play since 2003, when the Spartans were 12-0 entering conference.

Already this season, UNCG has earned three series sweeps, while winning five total series. Opening weekend UNCG took two of three from High Point and in the third weekend of the season, the Spartans took two of three from Army. Those sweeps and series wins don't take into account the Coastal Carolina Invitational in which UNCG defeated Illinois twice, while splitting a pair of games with the host Chanticleers. With six nonconference games remaining, UNCG has a chance to earn the school-record for nonconference wins in a season with the record being set 1997, with 23 nonconference wins.

10's the Magic Number

In 19 of 26 games this season, UNCG has racked up at least 10 hits. During that time, the Spartans have gone 16-3 in games that they have at least 10 hits. When not reaching the 10 hit plateau, UNCG is 4-3. Five times UNCG has connected for nine hits. The season-low for hits in a game is six in a 6-4 loss to the Army Black Knights in the series finale.

Sensational Sykes

Chad Sykes earned the role of closer prior to the start of the season. In 2016, he has worked in 13 games this year, throwing in 20.0 innings. During his time on the hill, Sykes has earned a 2.70 ERA and has held opponents to a .109 average against him. Sykes has struck out 22 hitters on the year, including recording at least one strike out in his last eight outings.

Wantz Wows

Andrew Wantz has been a force out of the bullpen so far this season for the Spartans. The sophomore right-hander has made a team-high 14 appearances through 26 games. Wantz was named to the SoCon All-Freshman team a season ago, and has continued a stellar start to his career. Wantz leads UNCG with 47 punch outs, including striking out seven through three innings against Binghamton on Feb. 27th. As of Mar. 28th, Wantz ranks 45th in the NCAA with a 11.54 strike outs per nine innings pitched ratio. The 47 strikeouts also comes in at 24th most in the NCAA.

Start Hot, Stay Hot

Currently, the UNCG offense currently leads the NCAA with a .357 team batting average. Air Force has the next closest average at .343. UNCG also leads the NCAA in hits, runs, triples, and on-base percentage. The Spartans are second in the nation in scoring, doubles, doubles per game, triples, and slugging

has also knocked out 10 or more hits in 19 of 26 games played so far this season, including going for 20+ in four games. The Spartans have had 20+ hit games 10 times in the 24 year history of the program, prior to this year.

UNCG failed to reach the 10-hit plateau against No. 8 NC State, in the series finale with Army, the last game of the Coastal Carolina Invitational, and the last three midweek games.

L.J. Kalawaia owns the Spartans' best batting average at .429. Kalawaia has started 24 games, going for extra bases seven times, including a pair of home runs. Kalawaia also sports a team-best .525 on-base percentage, good for 19th in the country in that category. Kalawaia has stolen 14 bases this season, also a team-best.

Dillon Stewart leads the Spartans with seven home runs, following a three-homer weekend against Georgetown. Collin Woody has driven in 35 RBI, a team-best. The 35 RBI is 14th-most in the NCAA this season.

Perfect 10

The Spartans improved their all-time record to 6-0 against Big Ten teams with a pair of victories over Illinois two weeks ago. UNCG has previously met with Minnesota and Penn State as other Big Ten opponents. The Spartans and Golden Gophers met in Conway, S.C., in another tournament hosted by Coastal Carolina in 2014. UNCG and the Nittany Lions met in 2012 with UNCG sweeping Penn State in a three-game series the second weekend of the season.

Coastal Carolina Invitational

UNCG hit the road for its first road swing of the season on Mar. 9th UNCG opened the 2016 season with eight of 12 games played at the UNCG Baseball Stadium. The Spartans first games outside of North Carolina were in the Coastal Carolina Invitational, where UNCG finished 3-1.

UNCG opened the season with a split series against the High Point Panthers, going 2-1 and taking the game at home. The Spartans have gone 8-1 at home during the early part of the season, with a 2-4 record on the road, including a close loss in Raleigh to No. 8 NC State.

In their first road trip of the year, UNCG went 3-2 with two victories over Illinois and splitting a pair of games with Coastal Carolina. The Spartans also dropped the midweek game at UNCW, an NCAA Regional qualifier a year ago. Illinois was a 2015 Super Regional participant and Coastal Carolina has made the postseason in 12 seasons since 2001.

Home Cooking

UNCG is currently 15-1 in games played at the UNCG Baseball Stadium. The Spartans will play 30 of the 56 regular season games at the UNCG Baseball Stadium. Last season, UNCG only managed 13 wins in front of the home fans.

Johnny Bench Watch List

UNCG catcher Jake Kusz was named to the Johnny Bench Award Watch List earlier this season. The Greater Wichita Area Sports Commission announced the official watch list on March 8th. The watch list will be narrowed down on May 18th before the final vote occurs during the College World Series. 75 players were named to the list, four of which play for SoCon teams.

This season, Kusz has hit for a .280 average, with seven doubles and three home runs. Kusz has allowed just four passed balls this season, while being able to catch eight runners attempting to steal bases. Kusz has yet to made only one error this season, and has a team-best .995 fielding percentage for players with over 100 chances.

Oh Captain, My Captain

Head Coach Link Jarrett announced the captains of the 2016 UNCG Baseball team prior to the start of the season. L.J. Kalawaia, Collin Woody, Hunter Smith and Jake Kusz have earned the right to be called captain this season. The four receive this honor after a vote conducted of the UNCG baseball team.

"We are very proud and fortunate to have the leadership these four players provide to our program," Jarrett said, "They are all worthy of this honor, and it is a true reflection of their consistency, work ethic, production and character. It is very evident that these guys are so well respected by their peers, and that is something they can reflect on for years to come."

Kalawaia and Woody are each seniors, while Smith and Kusz are juniors. Kalawaia received a redshirt after suffering a preseason injury in 2015. Smith is a redshirt junior, having sat out the 2015 season due to NCAA transfer rules.

Woody and Ruiz earn Preseason SoCon Honors

Senior Collin Woody and Sophomore Devin Ruiz earned Preseason SoCon Second Team honors as announced by the conference office on Feb. 11th. Woody qualified as a third baseman, with Ruiz named as the designated hitter.

Woody competed in 50 games as the everyday third baseman for the Spartans last season. He hit for a .296 average, with 12 doubles and belted ten home runs. The ten long balls are the most of any returning player. Woody also logged time on the mound, pitching in 9.1 innings, earning a 1-0 record and a save in 2015.

Ruiz will be entering his sophomore season in 2016. As a freshman, the Pennsauken, N.J. native hit for a .300 average with nine extra-base hits. Ruiz also knocked in 17 RBI in his 26 starts.

Return to Action

The Spartans return to action on Tuesday, April 5th as they travel to Durham, N.C. for a midweek matchup with Duke at Jack Coombs Field.
