Tuesday - UNCG | Jake Lewis (LHP, 4-0, 4.81 ERA, 43.0 IP, 34 K's) vs. Wake Forest | Aaron Fossas (RHP, 0-0, 5.79 ERA, 4.2 IP, 4 K's)

Notes: Lewis is set to make his fifth start of the season on Tuesday evening. The freshman has started in three other midweek games, as well as the first game of a doubleheader in the Coastal Carolina Invitational. In his last outing, Lewis went a career-high 4.2 innings, allowing six hits and two earned runs against the Duke Blue Devils. Aaron Fossas will be making his third start of the year, and fifth appearances overall. Fossas has logged 4.2 innings this year, giving up three earned runs in that time. Fossas has also struck out four hitters during his time on the hill.

Wednesday - UNCG | Keaton Haack (RHP, 4-0, 4.58 ERA, 37.1 IP, 24 K's) vs. Wake Forest | Rayne Supple (RHP, 0-0, 7.53 ERA, 14.1 IP, 14 K's)

Notes: Haack will also be making his fifth start this season, all during midweek competitions. Haack has earned a 3.78 ERA in 16.2 innings to go with his 1-1 record. Haack, who was a late scratch from last week's midweek game, hasn't pitched since March 30th against Campbell. Haack went a career-high 5.0 innings, allowing two earned runs and struck out three hitters in a 8-2 victory. Rayne Supple will be making his 12th appearance, and fourth start of the year. Supple has worked in 14.1 innings, and has struck out 14. Supple has given up 13 hits while walking 22 batters to go with his 7.53 ERA.

A Little History -- Wake Forest

The Spartans and Demon Deacons have played 52 times over the 25 year history of Spartan Baseball, with Wake Forest holding a 39-13 advantage in that span. Over the last ten meetings, UNCG has gone 3-7 against Wake Forest, including winning three of the last four games. The last meeting at David F. Couch Ballpark occurred last season, when the Demon Deacons defeated the Spartans 11-7.

Scouting the Demon Deacons

Wake Forest enters the week with a 19-14 overall record prior to their Monday matchup with the NC State Wolfpack. Wake Forest has played several similar competitors as the Spartans, going 8-4 against teams that have played against UNCG this season. The Demon Deacons have lost three of their last four games prior to Monday, including three ACC matchups.

Will Craig leads the Wake Forest offense. The junior third baseman is the reigning ACC player of the year, as well as being named a First Team All-American in five different publications in 2015. Craig is currently hitting for a .471 clip, third highest in the NCAA. Craig doesn't just do it with average, the right-handed hitter has hit nine home runs, and 12 doubles this season, while driving in a team-high 43 runs. Stuart Fairchild and Joey Rodriguez have started every game for Wake Forest. Fairchild currently has a .297 average, with a pair of home runs, a pair of triples to lead the team and is tied with Rodriguez for second on the squad with 10 doubles. Fairchild has also driven in 21 runs and scored 25. Rodriguez has a .244 average in 33 games, with 22 runs scored. Nate Mondou has scored 27 runs for the Demon Deacons, most on the team. Mondou has started 32 games while playing in all 33. While hitting for a .276 average, Mondou has hit five doubles, a triple and one home run while driving in 15 runs.

On the mound, Wake Forest is set to send a pair of right-handers to the hill against the Spartans. Aaron Fossas is projected to start Tuesday. Fossas, a redshirt senior, has made five appearances, while starting two games. In those appearances, Fossas has only worked 4.2 innings and has allowed three runs in the process. Rayne Supple is the projected starter for the matchup in Greensboro on Wednesday. Supple has started three games and made 11 appearances. In his 14.1 innings, supple has allowed 12 earned runs, while walking 22 batters and striking out 14. John McCarren is a reliever that could see time on the hill during the series. McCarren has worked in 15 games, including one start. In 32.0 innings, the righty, has struck out 21 hitters while allowing just 10 earned runs. Chris Farish has worked the most games out of the bullpen, appearing in 20. In 19.2 innings, Farish has earned a 1-1 record and has struck out 27 hitters while holding opponents to a .174 average. Last Time Out

The Spartans enter the matchup with Wake Forest having earned a series win over The Citadel in Charleston, S.C. over the weekend. The Spartans took Friday's game 14-1, before falling in the Saturday matchup, 7-5. UNCG took the rubber match, 7-4, with Matt Frisbee throwing 6.0 innings, striking out six without walking a batter.

SoCon Pitcher of the Month

Chad Sykes has been named SoCon Pitcher of the Month for the month of March. This is the first time the sophomore right-handed pitcher has earned the honor.

UNCG finished March with a league-best 14-5 record. Sykes went 2-1 and recorded a save to go with his 2.20 ERA in 10 appearances during the month. The sophomore right-hander allowed only six hits; one for extra bases and nine walks through 16.1 innings, good for a 0.92 WHIP. Sykes allowed just four earned runs on the month, striking out 17 batters.

Six of Sykes' appearances went at least two innings, starting with a pair of scoreless frames against Coastal Carolina on Mar. 11 to earn his second save of the season. He noted at least one strikeout in each of his last eight appearances and did not allow a hit in his last seven contests. He also posted six straight scoreless outings, earning wins of Marist and Georgetown with two innings of work against each.

Overall, Sykes has worked in 15 games, throwing in 24.0 innings. During his time on the hill, Sykes has earned a 2.25 ERA and has held opponents to a .103 average against him. Sykes has struck out 28 hitters on the year.

Pitcher of the Week

Andrew Wantz earned a multitude of honors for yephis performance the week of Mar. 28th-Apr. 3rd. Wantz was named SoCon Pitcher of the Week, National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association Pitcher of the Week and was one of Collegiate Baseball's seven national Players of the Week.

Wantz finished the weekend 2-0 with a 1.00 ERA in nine innings over three appearances on the week. Striking out 17 batters. Wantz opened the week starting against North Carolina A&T, striking out six and earning the win.

Wantz worked in 2.1 innings out of the bullpen in Friday's win over VMI, allowing just one hit and getting six of his seven outs via the strikeout. UNCG took game one, 10-4 over the Keydets. In the series finale against VMI, the sophomore logged 2.2 innings, allowing two walks and striking out five batters. Wantz entered with the bases loaded and no outs in the fifth and shut VMI down, striking out the side and keep an inherited runner from scoring and picking up the win.

Wantz leads UNCG with 58 punch outs and is now 12th in the NCAA with a 12.53 strikeouts per nine innings pitched, and is 13th in the nation on total strikeouts.

2016 UNCG baseball has had one of the best starts in program history with a 20-6 record heading into SoCon play. The 20 wins prior to the conference season is the most-ever for a UNCG squad, and the .769 winning percentage is the highest winning percentage entering conference play since 2003, when the Spartans were 12-0 entering conference.

Already this season, UNCG has earned four series sweeps, while winning seven total series. Opening weekend UNCG took two of three from High Point and in the third weekend of the season, the Spartans took two of three from Army. Those sweeps and series wins don't take into account the Coastal Carolina Invitational in which UNCG defeated Illinois twice, while splitting a pair of games with the host Chanticleers. With five nonconference games remaining, UNCG has a chance to earn the school-record for nonconference wins in a season with the record being set 1997, with 23 nonconference wins.

10's the Magic Number

In 24 of 33 games this season, UNCG has racked up at least 10 hits. During that time, the Spartans have gone 21-3 in games that they have at least 10 hits. When not reaching the 10 hit plateau, UNCG is 4-5. six times UNCG has connected for nine hits. The season-low for hits in a game is six, a 6-4 loss to the Army Black Knights in the only home loss of the season.

Start Hot, Stay Hot

Currently, the UNCG offense currently leads the NCAA with a .355 team batting average. Air Force has the next closest average at .343. UNCG also leads the NCAA in hits, runs, slugging, and on-base percentage. The Spartans are second in the nation in scoring, doubles and sacrifice flies.

UNCG has connected for at least 40 hits in every weekend since the start of the season. UNCG has also knocked out 10 or more hits in 24 of 33 games played so far this season, including going for 20+ in four games. The Spartans have had 20+ hit games 10 times in the 24 year history of the program, prior to this year.

Freshman Andrew Mortiz leads the Spartans with a .408 average. The Charlotte, N.C. native has started every game in centerfield, and leads UNCG with six triples. His 17 extra-base hits is second only to Dillon Stewart, who currently leads the team with nine home runs.

Collin Woody leads the Spartans with 40 RBI this year. UNCG has four players who have driven in at least 30 runs, and a total of six players with at least 29 RBI this year.

UNCG has nine players hitting above the .300 plateau who have played in at least 21 games this season.

season, with a 2-4 record on the road, including a close loss in Raleigh to No. 8 NC State.

In their first road trip of the year, UNCG went 3-2 with two victories over Illinois and splitting a pair of games with Coastal Carolina. The Spartans also dropped the midweek game at UNCW, an NCAA Regional qualifier a year ago. Illinois was a 2015 Super Regional participant and Coastal Carolina has made the postseason in 12 seasons since 2001.

Home Cooking

UNCG is currently 18-1 in games played at the UNCG Baseball Stadium. The Spartans will play 30 of the 56 regular season games at the UNCG Baseball Stadium. Last season, UNCG only managed 13 wins in front of the home fans.

Johnny Bench Watch List

UNCG catcher Jake Kusz was named to the Johnny Bench Award Watch List earlier this season. The Greater Wichita Area Sports Commission announced the official watch list on March 8th. The watch list will be narrowed down on May 18th before the final vote occurs during the College World Series. 75 players were named to the list, four of which play for SoCon teams.

This season, Kusz has hit for a .274 average, with nine doubles and four home runs. Kusz has allowed just five passed balls this season, while being able to catch eight runners attempting to steal bases. Kusz has made only one error this season, and has a team-best .997 fielding percentage for players with over 100 chances.

Oh Captain, My Captain

Head Coach Link Jarrett announced the captains of the 2016 UNCG Baseball team prior to the start of the season. L.J. Kalawaia, Collin Woody, Hunter Smith and Jake Kusz have earned the right to be called captain this season. The four receive this honor after a vote conducted of the UNCG baseball team.

Kalawaia and Woody are each seniors, while Smith and Kusz are juniors. Kalawaia received a redshirt after suffering a preseason injury in 2015. Smith is a redshirt junior, having sat out the 2015 season due to NCAA transfer rules.
