Probable Rotation

Friday - UNCG | Hunter Smith (RHP, 5-0, 4.14 ERA, 50.0 IP, 42 K's) vs. Furman | Will Gaddis (RHP, 5-2, 3.52 ERA, 53.2 IP, 51 K's)

Notes: Smith will be working in his ninth Friday night start of the year. Smith has earned a 5-0 record and the Spartans have yet to lose a game with Smith starts on the hill. The redshirt junior has earned one complete game this season. In his last outing against The Citadel, Smith went 7.0 innings, allowing one unearned run, and struck out eight hitters. Gaddis enters having started eight games this season. The sophomore from Brentwood, Tenn., was named a second team All-Southern Conference selection in the coaches poll. He was placed on the All-Freshman team a year ago, working as the Saturday starter for the Paladins. In his last outing, Gaddis worked 8.0 innings against West Virginia, allowing seven hits, and two earned runs while striking out four.

Saturday - UNCG | Bryce Hensley (LHP, 4-1, 5.44 ERA, 41.1 IP, 29 K's) vs. Furman | Harry Norman (LHP, 1-2, 3.55 ERA, 38.0 IP, 19 K's)

Notes: Hensley will be starting his ninth game of the season on Saturday. Hensley has logged five quality starts this season, including striking out a career-high eight hitters. Against The Citadel, Hensley worked 4.0 innings, allowing seven runs, six earned and striking out five hitters. Norman has started in four games this year, as he has recently moved into the starting rotation. Primarily a reliever in years past, Norman has appeared in 14 games this season, working in a total of 38.0 innings. In his last start, Norman gave the Paladins a quality start before Furman used six relief pitchers in an 8-6 win over West Virginia. Norman went 6.0 innings, giving up five hits, three runs, one earned, walking six and striking out three hitters.

Sunday - UNCG | Matt Frisbee (RHP, 2-2, 4.50 ERA, 34.0 IP, 30 K's) vs. Furman | Matthew Quarles (RHP, 3-3, 5.84 ERA, 44.2 IP, 35 K's)

Notes: Frisbee has worked in the series finale in all eight of the previous weekend series. Frisbee has earned quality starts in two of his last three outings, while giving up a combined two earned runs in taht time. In SoCon play, Frisbee has struck out 13 hitters while earning a 1-0 record. Quarles enters the weekend having started in all eight appearances this year. The junior righty has worked in the rotation since finding a spot towards the end of the 2015 season. Quarles picked up the loss in his last start, giving up six runs on ten hits. Quarles allowed two walks and a home run as he struck out one hitter.

A Little History -- Furman

The Spartans and Paladins have competed 65 times in baseball. The Paladins hold a 35-30 advantage in that time. UNCG and Furman have split the last two weekend series, both being played in Greensboro. The last time the two teams met in Greenville, S.C. was in 2013, Link Jarrett's first year at the helm. The last sweep for either team came by Furman in the 2010 season, ending UNCG's year on a three-game losing streak.

Scouting the Paladins

Furman enters the weekend series sporting a 14-18 record and are currently 3-3 in the Southern Conference. Furman split two earlier three-game SoCon series, taking two games from preseason favorite Samford, before falling in two of three games to East Tennessee State in Johnson City, Tenn. At home this season, Furman has picked up 10 of their 14 wins, including the two SoCon wins over Samford.

Furman's offense is led by Carter Grote. Grote is third on the squad with a .331 average, while playing in a team-high 32 games this year. The junior outfielder has driven in 20 runs this year, while hitting four home runs, a triple and five doubles. Grote leads the Paladins with 28 runs scored this season. Two other players have hit for a higher average than Grote, Jabari Richards and Jordan Simpson have hit for a .395, and a .351 average, respectively. Neither Richards, nor Simpson have had their names in the box scores for last several games. Among those players who have seen regular playing time, Brandon Elmy has driven in 21 runs this year, while leading Furman with seven doubles. Elmy has also scored 23 runs, while hitting for a .328 average. The sophomore infielder has hit just one home run on the year, while striking out 24

times. Furman isn't much for swiping bases, having only stolen 13 bases this season.

On the mound, the Paladins are scheduled to use the same rotation as last weekend.

Preseason SoCon second team selectin Will Gaddis will throw on Friday night, with Harry Noman and Matthew Quarles going on Saturday and Sunday, respectively. Gaddis holds a 3.52 ERA, with a 5-2 record, having worked in a team-high 53.2 innings. Norman has also been productive on the hill, moving into a starters role later in the season. Norman has started just four games this season, but has appeared in 14 total. Norman has earned a 3.55 ERA in 38.0 innings and has gone 1-2. Quarles is set to go on Sunday. Quarles, who has started in all eight of his appearances this season, has worked in 44.2 innings, while earning a 5.84 ERA and a 3-3 record. Nolan Mullen is key contributor to the Paladin pitching staff, having worked in 17 games this year. Mullen has served as the closer, recording five saves in 19.1 innings, with 19 strikeouts. Furman relies heavily on its starting rotation, with only four other players having worked in 10 or more innings. One of these players being Jake Crawford who was bumped from the starting rotation after making six starts. Ted Andrews has made seven appearances, working in 11.1 innings, earning a 4.76 ERA. Heath Hawkins has worked 11.0 innings, giving up 13 earned runs in that time. The last reliever to work in at least 10 innings, is Ryan Griffith who has allowed 15 runs in 10.1 innings.

Last Time Out

The Spartans split a pair of midweek games with the Wake Forest Demon Deacons in their last time out, with both teams winning on their home fields. UNCG suffered a narrow, 6-4 loss at David F. Couch Ballpark, before dominating the Demon Deacons 18-3 at the UNCG Baseball Stadium to earn their first win over an ACC team this season.

SoCon Pitcher of the Month

Chad Sykes has been named SoCon Pitcher of the Month for the month of March. This is the first time the sophomore right-handed pitcher has earned the honor.

UNCG finished March with a league-best 14-5 record. Sykes went 2-1 and recorded a save to go with his 2.20 ERA in 10 appearances during the month. The sophomore right-hander allowed only six hits; one for extra bases and nine walks through 16.1 innings, good for a 0.92 WHIP. Sykes allowed just four earned runs on the month, striking out 17 batters.

Six of Sykes' appearances went at least two innings, starting with a pair of scoreless frames against Coastal Carolina on Mar. 11 to earn his second save of the season. He noted at least one strikeout in each of his last eight appearances and did not allow a hit in his last seven contests. He also posted six straight scoreless outings, earning wins of Marist and Georgetown with two innings of work against each.

Overall, Sykes has worked in 15 games, throwing in 24.0 innings. During his time on the hill, Sykes has earned a 2.25 ERA and has held opponents to a .103 average against him. Sykes has struck out 28 hitters on the year.

Pitcher of the Week

Andrew Wantz earned a multitude of honors for yephis performance the week of Mar. 28th-Apr. 3rd. Wantz was named SoCon Pitcher of the Week, National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association Pitcher of the Week and was one of Collegiate Baseball's seven national Players of the Week.

Wantz finished the weekend 2-0 with a 1.00 ERA in nine innings over three appearances on the week. Striking out 17 batters. Wantz opened the week starting against North Carolina A&T, striking out six and earning the win.

Wantz worked in 2.1 innings out of the bullpen in Friday's win over VMI, allowing just one hit and getting six of his seven outs via the strikeout. UNCG took game one, 10-4 over the Keydets. In the series finale against VMI, the sophomore logged 2.2 innings, allowing two walks and striking out five batters. Wantz entered with the bases loaded and no outs in the fifth and shut VMI down, striking out the side and keep an inherited runner from scoring and picking up the win.

Wantz leads UNCG with 61 punch outs and is now 30th in the NCAA with a 11.68 strikeouts per nine innings pitched, and is 24th in the nation on total strikeouts.

Early Success

2016 UNCG baseball has had one of the best starts in program history with a 20-6 record heading into SoCon play. The 20 wins prior to the conference season is the most-ever for a UNCG squad, and the .769 winning percentage is the highest winning percentage entering conference play since 2003, when the Spartans were 12-0 entering conference.

Already this season, UNCG has earned four series sweeps, while winning seven total series. Opening weekend UNCG took two of three from High Point and in the third weekend of the season, the Spartans took two of three from Army. Those sweeps and series wins don't take into account the Coastal Carolina Invitational in which UNCG defeated Illinois twice, while splitting a pair of games with the host Chanticleers. With five nonconference games remaining, UNCG has a chance to earn the school-record for nonconference wins in a season with the record being set 1997, with 23 nonconference wins.

10's the Magic Number

In 25 of 35 games this season, UNCG has racked up at least 10 hits. During that time, the Spartans have gone 22-3 in games that they have at least 10 hits. When not reaching the 10 hit plateau, UNCG is 4-6. Six times UNCG has connected for nine hits. The season-low for hits in a game is six, a 6-4 loss to the Army Black Knights in the only home loss of the season.

Start Hot, Stay Hot

Currently, the UNCG offense currently leads the NCAA with a .356 team batting average. Air Force and BYU have fought for the second-highest average all season, with BYU holding a .001 advantage. UNCG also leads the NCAA in hits, runs, sacrifice flies, slugging, and on-base percentage. The Spartans are second in the nation in scoring, doubles, and triples.

UNCG has connected for at least 40 hits in every weekend since the start of the season. UNCG has also knocked out 10 or more hits in 25 of 35 games played so far this season, including going for 20+ in four games. The Spartans have had 20+ hit games 10 times in the 24 year history of the program, prior to this year.

Freshman Andrew Mortiz leads the Spartans with a .400 average. The Charlotte, N.C. native has started every game in centerfield, and leads UNCG with six triples. His 18 extra-base hits is second only to Dillon Stewart, who currently leads the team with nine home runs. Moritz hit his first career home run against Wake Forest (4/12).

Collin Woody leads the Spartans with 43 RBI this year. UNCG has six players who have driven in at least 30 runs this year, the most of any Southern Conference team. UNCG has four players in the top 51 of RBI producers, the most of any NCAA Division I institution.

UNCG has nine players hitting above the .300 plateau who have played in at least 21 games this season.

Coastal Carolina Invitational

UNCG opened the 2016 season with eight of 12 games played at the UNCG Baseball Stadium. The Spartans first games outside of North Carolina were in the Coastal Carolina Invitational, where UNCG finished 3-1.

In their first road trip of the year, UNCG went 3-2 with two victories over Illinois and splitting a pair of games with Coastal Carolina. The Spartans also dropped the midweek game at UNCW, an NCAA Regional qualifier a year ago. Illinois was a 2015 Super Regional participant and Coastal Carolina has made the postseason in 12 seasons since 2001.

Home Cooking

UNCG is currently 19-1 in games played at the UNCG Baseball Stadium. The Spartans will play 30 of the 56 regular season games at the UNCG Baseball Stadium. Last season, UNCG only managed 13 wins in front of the home fans.

Johnny Bench Watch List

UNCG catcher Jake Kusz was named to the Johnny Bench Award Watch List earlier this season. The Greater Wichita Area Sports Commission announced the official watch list on March 8th. The watch list will be narrowed down on May 18th before the final vote occurs during the College World Series. 75 players were named to the list, four of which play for SoCon teams.

This season, Kusz has hit for a .274 average, with nine doubles and four home runs. Kusz has allowed just five passed balls this season, while being able to catch eight runners attempting to steal bases. Kusz has made only one error this season, and has a team-best .997 fielding percentage for players with over 100 chances.

Oh Captain, My Captain
