Notes: Smith has kicked off every series this season, working in nine Friday night games this year. Smith has four quality starts this season, including a complete game against Marist, striking out a career-high, nine. In his last outing, Smith worked 5.1 innings against Furman, allowing nine hits and seven runs while picking up his first loss of the season. Gonzalez has earned a 3-0 mark with a 6.59 ERA in nine appearances this season. Gonzalez last worked in the midweek against Eastern Kentucky, where he threw 1.0 inning, earning the win.

### Saturday - UNCG | Keaton Haack (RHP, 2-1, 3.18 ERA, 22.2 IP, 22 K's) vs. ETSU | Lee Haeberle (RHP, 3-1, 6.62 ERA, 50.1 IP, 55 K's)

Notes: Haack makes his first weekend start of his career this Saturday. The senior has started a total of six games in his career, including five midweek games this season. Haack has worked in 42.2 innings in his career, and has struck out 37 hitters. In his last outing, Haack worked 6.0 innings, allowing two hits and one earned run with five strikeouts in an 18-3 victory over Wake Forest. Lee Haeberle also has an impressive 3-1 record, working in a team-high 50.1 innings this year. Haeberle has started nine games and made 13 relief appearances, also working in the midweek game against Eastern Kentucky. Haeberle went 1.0 innings, and allowed three runs on three hits.

### Sunday - UNCG | Matt Frisbee (RHP, 3-2 ERA, 41.0 IP, 35 K's) vs. ETSU | Blake Smith (RHP, 3-4, 5.17 ERA, 47.0 IP, 39 K's)

Notes: Frisbee, the current SoCon Pitcher of the Week, will start his 10th Sunday game this season. Frisbee has worked the series finale in every series this year. In his last two outings, Frisbee has earned quality starts. In his last outing at Furman, Frisbee worked a 7.0 innings complete game, allowing two hits and at one point retiring 11 batters in a row. Smith will work the final game of the series. Smith has earned a 3-4 record with a 5.17 ERA in 47.0 innings. Smith has started eight games and appeared in five more for a total of 47.0 innings. Smith also worked in the midweek against Eastern Kentucky, starting and throwing 2.0 innings, allowing three hits with three strikeouts.

#### **A Little History -- ETSU**

The Spartans and Buccaneers have met a total of 33 times, with UNCG holding a 21-12 advantage in that time. UNCG and ETSU last met in Johnson City, Tenn. a year ago, with UNCG taking two of three games from the Buccaneers. Prior to the 2015 season, UNCG and ETSU last met in 2005, in a nonconference series. ETSU was a member of the Atlantic Sun Conference from 2003 until 2014. Prior to that, the Buccaneers were members of the Southern Conference, where the bulk of the meetings between the two schools met.

#### **Scouting the Buccaneers**

ETSU is currently 3-6 in the SoCon, currently in seventh place in the conference. The Buccaneers have played Western Carolina, Furman and Mercer. After dropping two of three in Cullowhee to the league-leading Catamounts, the Bucs took two of three at home against the Paladins. In the last SoCon series, ETSU was swept by Mercer at home. Prior to defeating Eastern Kentucky on Wednesday evening, The Bucs had lost seven-straight, including a series sweep to the UNCW Seahawks.

ETSU is fourth in the conference with a .308 team batting average. The Buccaneers are led by senior Trey York. York has hit for a .388 average in 36 games this season. York leads the team with 10 home runs, and 16 doubles to go with 37 RBI on the year. York also leads ETSU with 42 runs scored and is tied with Aaron Maher for second on the squad with 11 stolen bases. Robby McCabe has started 24 games this season, and has earned a .355 average. McCabe has hit for extra bases seven times, including four home runs. Hagen Owenby has put together a solid season, hitting for a .336 average in 36 games this season. The right-handed hitting catcher has connected for nine home runs and 12 doubles with 37 RBI on the year. Ownenby has scored 24 runs on the year, while earning a .388 on-base percentage. Aaron Maher has worked in the cleanup spot the last few games, Maher has hit for a .331 average in 35 games. Maher has 18 extra-base hits and has driven in 27 runs and scored an additional 31. The outfielder has also swiped 11 bases on the year.

On the mound, ETSU has earned a 7.06 ERA, the highest of all SoCon teams. ETSU is set to

send a trio of right-handers to the hill against the Spartans. Victor Gonzalez will get the ball on Friday night. Gonzalez has pitched in nine games this season, including seven starts. Gonzalez has earned a 6.53 ERA in 30.1 innings to go with 16 strikeouts. Gonzalez last started on Sunday, April 17th against UNCW. Gonzalez went 1.1 innings, allowing four hits and six earned runs in the process. Gonzalez worked an inning against Eastern Kentucky in the midweek, earning the win while not allowing a run through 1.0 inning. Lee Haeberle will start on Saturday. Haeberle has started nine games this season, making four appearances out of the bullpen. The 6-5 senior has worked in a team-high 50.1 innings along with a team-high 55 strikeouts on the year. In his last start, Haeberle earned his first loss, going 2.2 innings against UNCW. He allowed 12 hits and 10 earned runs in the process. Haeberle worked in the EKU matchup, allowing three earned runs in one inning. Blake Smith will wrap up the series on Sunday. Smith has started eight games and appeared in five out of the bullpen. Smith has the lowest ERA of ETSU pitchers with at least 10.0 innings pitched, at 5.17. The right-hander has worked in 47.0 innings, and has struck out 39 batters this season to go with a 3-4 record. Smith's last start came on April 1st in the series opener against Furman. Smith worked 5.0 innings, allowing six runs on eight hits. Peyton Taylor has worked as the closer, appearing in 21 games this year. Taylor has earned three saves in 25.0 innings, striking out 13 hitters to go with a 3-4 record, and a 6.48 ERA.

The Spartans suffered a 14-8 loss to Elon at Latham Park on Wednesday evening. Jake Kusz hit his sixth home run of the season in the loss, as UNCG connected for 10 hits in the game. Spartan pitching issued 13 free passes, including 10 walks in the contest. Aside from Kusz, Spitznagel, Woody, and Stewart all had extra-base hits.

#### **Spartans Sweep SoCon Awards**

Redshirt Senior L.J. Kalawaia and Freshman Matt Frisbee swept the Pitcher and Player of the Week awards for their efforts April 11-17.

Kalawaia was also named to Collegiate Baseball's National Players of the Week. Kalawaia is the second Spartan to receive Collegiate Baseball National Player of the Week Honors after Andrew Wantz (Holly Springs, N.C./Holly Springs) took home the award for the week of Mar. 28th-April 4th.

Kalawaia hit .600 and slugged 1.150 with 18 RBI in five games on the week, while Frisbee pitched a complete-game shutout as the Spartans went 3-2, splitting a midweek home-and-home with Wake Forest and taking two of three from Furman on the road.

Frisbee turned in the first shutout of his career Sunday, allowing just two hits and four walks as the Spartans cruised to the 14-0 win, which finished in seven innings due to the 10-run rule. The freshman, who struck out five and didn't allow an extra-base hit, settled in after issuing all four walks in the first three innings.

Against the Paladins over the weekend, Kalawaia was 8-for-13 (.615) with 13 RBIs in the three contests. On Friday, the redshirt senior from Wailuku, Hawai'i, was 2-for-4 with a double and three RBIs. He went 3-for-4 with five RBIs and three runs scored Saturday, belting another RBI triple, and closed his week with two homers and another five RBIs in his third three-hit game of the week.

#### **SoCon Pitcher of the Month**

Chad Sykes has been named SoCon Pitcher of the Month for the month of March. This is the first time the sophomore right-handed pitcher has earned the honor.

UNCG finished March with a league-best 14-5 record. Sykes went 2-1 and recorded a save to go with his 2.20 ERA in 10 appearances during the month. The sophomore right-hander

allowed only six hits; one for extra bases and nine walks through 16.1 innings, good for a 0.92 WHIP. Sykes allowed just four earned runs on the month, striking out 17 batters.

Six of Sykes' appearances went at least two innings, starting with a pair of scoreless frames against Coastal Carolina on Mar. 11 to earn his second save of the season. He noted at least one strikeout in each of his last eight appearances and did not allow a hit in his last seven contests. He also posted six straight scoreless outings, earning wins of Marist and Georgetown with two innings of work against each.

Overall, Sykes has worked in 18 games, throwing in 31.0 innings. During his time on the hill, Sykes has earned a 2.61 ERA and has held opponents to a .135 average against him. Sykes has struck out 37 hitters on the year.

#### **Pitcher of the Week and National Awards**

Andrew Wantz earned a multitude of honors for his performance the week of Mar. 28th-Apr. 3rd. Wantz was named SoCon Pitcher of the Week, National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association Pitcher of the Week and was one of Collegiate Baseball's seven national Players of the Week.

Wantz finished the weekend 2-0 with a 1.00 ERA in nine innings over three appearances on the week. Striking out 17 batters. Wantz opened the week starting against North Carolina A&T, striking out six and earning the win. In two appearances against VMI, Wantz struck out 11 batters in 5.0 innings pitched.

Wantz leads UNCG with 64 punch outs and is now 28th in the NCAA with a 11.37 strikeouts per nine innings pitched, and is 42nd in the nation on total strikeouts.

#### **Early Success**

2016 UNCG baseball has had one of the best starts in program history with a 20-6 record heading into SoCon play. The 20 wins prior to the conference season is the most-ever for a UNCG squad, and the .769 winning percentage is the highest winning percentage entering conference play since 2003, when the Spartans were 12-0 entering conference.

Already this season, UNCG has earned four series sweeps, while winning eight total series. Those sweeps and series wins don't take into account the Coastal Carolina Invitational in which UNCG defeated Illinois twice, and split a pair of games with the host Chanticleers. With two nonconference games remaining, UNCG has a chance to tie the school-record for nonconference wins in a season with the record being set 1997, with 23 nonconference wins. The Spartans currently have 21 nonconference wins.

#### 10's the Magic Number

In 29 of 39 games this season, UNCG has racked up at least 10 hits. During that time, the Spartans have gone 24-5 in games that they have at least 10 hits. When not reaching the 10 hit plateau, UNCG is 4-6. Seven times UNCG has connected for nine hits. The season-low for hits in a game is six, a 6-4 loss to the Army Black Knights in the only home loss of the season.

#### Start Hot, Stay Hot

Currently, the UNCG offense currently leads the NCAA with a .361 team batting average. Louisville and Texas A&M are currently battling for second, but trail by an impressive 27 points. UNCG also leads the NCAA in scoring (9.4), runs (361), hits (513), doubles (104), slugging percentage (.548), sacrifice flies (30) and on-base percentage (.441).

UNCG has connected for at least 38 hits in every weekend since the start of the season. UNCG has also knocked out 10 or more hits in 29 of 39 games played so far this season, including going for 20+ in five games. The Spartans have had 20+ hit games 10 times in the 24 year history of the program, prior to this year.

The Spartans have three players hitting above .400 this season, the most of any NCAA Division I team. Ben Spitznagel leads the team with a .429 average, 9th in the NCAA, after an impressive 13-for-15 performance in three games against the Furman Paladins. Freshman Andrew Moritz has hit for a .408 average, and has a SoCon-best 23-game hitting streak. The outfielder has also reached base in 38 of 39 games, including having reached in 35-straight.

#### Coastal Carolina Invitational

UNCG opened the 2016 season with eight of 12 games played at the UNCG Baseball Stadium. The Spartans first games outside of North Carolina were in the Coastal Carolina Invitational, where UNCG finished 3-1.

In their first road trip of the year, UNCG went 3-2 with two victories over Illinois and splitting a pair of games with Coastal Carolina. The Spartans also dropped the midweek game at UNCW, an NCAA Regional qualifier a year ago. Illinois was a 2015 Super Regional participant and Coastal Carolina has made the postseason in 12 seasons since 2001.

#### **Home Cooking**

UNCG is currently 19-1 in games played at the UNCG Baseball Stadium. The Spartans will play 30 of the 56 regular season games at the UNCG Baseball Stadium. Last season, UNCG only managed 13 wins in front of the home fans.

#### **Johnny Bench Watch List**

UNCG catcher Jake Kusz was named to the Johnny Bench Award Watch List earlier this season. The Greater Wichita Area Sports Commission announced the official watch list on March 8th. The watch list will be narrowed down on May 18th before the final vote occurs during the College World Series. 75 players were named to the list, four of which play for SoCon teams.

This season, Kusz has hit for a .279 average, with ten doubles and six home runs. Kusz has allowed just six passed balls this season, while being able to catch eight runners attempting to steal bases. Kusz has made only two errors this season, and has a team-best .994 fielding percentage for players with over 100 chances.

#### Oh Captain, My Captain

Head Coach Link Jarrett announced the captains of the 2016 UNCG Baseball team prior to the start of the season. L.J. Kalawaia, Collin Woody, Hunter Smith and Jake Kusz have earned the right to be called captain this season. The four receive this honor after a vote conducted of the UNCG baseball team.

Kalawaia and Woody are each seniors, while Smith and Kusz are juniors. Kalawaia received a redshirt after suffering a preseason injury in 2015. Smith is a redshirt junior, having sat out the 2015 season due to NCAA transfer rules.

#### **Return to Action**

The Spartans return to action on Tuesday, April 26th as they host the Campbell Camels in the final home midweek game of the season at 6:00 p.m.
