Notes: Bryce Hensley will start his tenth game of the season on Tuesday afternoon. Hensley worked as the Saturday starter for the first nine weekends of the year, going 4-1 in those starts. Hensley has logged five starts of at least 6.0 innings pitched, going 3-0 in those games. His season-high for strikeouts in a game is eight. Noble has started five games this year, including Campbell's midweek game against UNCW in Wilmington, N.C. Noble worked 5.2 innings, allowing nine hits, five runs, four earned walked three and struck out six. Noble is a familiar name for the Spartans, having started the last game these two teams played. In that contest, Nobel worked 4.0 innings, allowing just one hit and striking out two batters.

#### A Little History -- Campbell

Campbell and UNCG have played nine games over the years, with the Spartans earning a 6-4 advantage in that time. In the first four years of UNCG baseball, the Spartans and Camels faced each other seven times, with UNCG going 5-2 in those games. Over the last seven years, UNCG and Campbell have played three times, with UNCG taking the most recent game. Link Jarrett is 1-1 against Campbell, having lost in 2014 before winning the game in Buies Creek earlier this season.

#### **Scouting the Camels**

The Camels enter the contest with a 22-19 record on the year. Campbell is 6-4 in their last ten games, including winning two of their last three games in Farmville, Va. against Longwood. Campbell suffered a 14-7 loss in their last midweek contest to UNCW. In midweek games this season, the Camels are a combined 5-6 including a loss the UNCG in Buies Creek on Mar. 30th.

The Campbell offense is paced by Matt Parrish. The senior catcher leads the Camels with a .368 batting average in 37 games this season. Parrish has driven in a team-high 34 runs on 15 extra-base hits. Drew Butler and Anthony Lopez have been key contributors to the Camel offense. Lopez has a .335 average in 39 games this season. Lopez has scored 32 runs to go with 15 extra-base hits,, including a team-high five triples. Butler has a .333 average in 36 games, with only three extra-base hits. Brian Taylor has provided the thump in the Camel lineup, connecting for five home runs, most in the lineup. Ben Calvano has been a threat on the base paths all season, going 16-for-18 in stolen bases this year.

Wes Nobel is set to start the contest on Tuesday evening. The sophomore right-hander has appeared in ten games with five starts. In his 35.0 innings, he has fanned 37 hitters while earning a 1-2 record with a 4.37 ERA. Nobel started the midweek game between UNCG and Campbell earlier this season, throwing 4.0 innings, allowing one hit and striking out two. In his last outing, the righty went 5.2 innings, allowing nine hits, five runs, four earned and struck out six batters. Erik Dowse has acted as the closer for Campbell. Dowse has earned a 1.22 ERA in 19 appearances. In his 37.0 innings, The junior right-hander has struck out 50 batters and has earned three saves, while earning a 2-1 record and a 1.22 ERA. Phil Stokes and Tyson Messer are the only other two Camels that have appeared in at least 10 games. Stokes has earned a 6.60 ERA in 15.0 innings. Messer has logged 13 appearances, with two starts. He has earned a 10.89 ERA in 20.2 innings, allowing 25 earned runs.

#### **Breaking out the Brooms**

UNCG has already swept five different weekend series this year, including two with Southern Conference opponents. The Spartans didn't sweep any series in 2015. The last time UNCG swept five series in the same season was 2008.

#### **Born to Run**

UNCG has swiped 75 bases this season, through 42 games. In 2015, the Spartans stole just 32 on the year. The 75 stolen bases are the most since 2006, when UNCG swiped 70 during the year. The school record for stolen basesin a single season was set in 1997 at 169, when the Spartan qualified for the NCAA Regional in Baton Rouge, La. That season UNCG played in 62 games, averaging 2.73 stolen bases per game.

#### **Spartans Sweep SoCon Awards**

Redshirt Senior L.J. Kalawaia and Freshman Matt Frisbee swept the Pitcher and Player of the Week awards for their efforts April 11-17.

Kalawaia was also named to Collegiate Baseball's National Players of the Week. Kalawaia is the second Spartan to receive Collegiate Baseball National Player of the Week Honors after Andrew Wantz (Holly Springs, N.C./Holly Springs) took home the award for the week of Mar. 28th-April 4th.

Kalawaia hit .600 and slugged 1.150 with 18 RBI in five games on the week, while Frisbee pitched a complete-game shutout as the Spartans went 3-2, splitting a midweek home-and-home with Wake Forest and taking two of three from Furman on the road.

Frisbee turned in the first shutout of his career Sunday, allowing just two hits and four walks as the Spartans cruised to the 14-0 win, which finished in seven innings due to the 10-run rule. The freshman, who struck out five and didn't allow an extra-base hit, settled in after issuing all four walks in the first three innings.

Against the Paladins over the weekend, Kalawaia was 8-for-13 (.615) with 13 RBIs in the three contests. On Friday, the redshirt senior from Wailuku, Hawai'i, was 2-for-4 with a double and three RBIs. He went 3-for-4 with five RBIs and three runs scored Saturday, belting another RBI triple, and closed his week with two homers and another five RBIs in his third three-hit game of the week.

#### SoCon Pitcher of the Month

Chad Sykes was named SoCon Pitcher of the Month for the month of March. This is the first time the sophomore right-handed pitcher has earned the honor.

UNCG finished March with a league-best 14-5 record. Sykes went 2-1 and recorded a save to go with his 2.20 ERA in 10 appearances during the month. The sophomore right-hander allowed only six hits; one for extra bases and nine walks through 16.1 innings, good for a 0.92 WHIP. Sykes allowed just four earned runs on the month, striking out 17 batters.

Six of Sykes' appearances went at least two innings, starting with a pair of scoreless frames against Coastal Carolina on Mar. 11 to earn his second save of the season. He noted at least one strikeout in each of his last eight appearances and did not allow a hit in his last seven contests. He also posted six straight scoreless outings, earning wins of Marist and Georgetown with two innings of work against each.

Overall, Sykes has worked in 20 games, throwing in 33.2 innings. During his time on the hill, Sykes has earned a 2.67 ERA and has held opponents to a .157 average against him. Sykes has struck out 41 hitters on the year.

#### Pitcher of the Week and National Awards

Andrew Wantz earned a multitude of honors for his performance the week of Mar. 28th-Apr. 3rd. Wantz was named SoCon Pitcher of the Week, National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association Pitcher of the Week and was one of Collegiate Baseball's seven national Players of the Week.

Wantz finished the weekend 2-0 with a 1.00 ERA in nine innings over three appearances on the week. Striking out 17 batters. Wantz opened the week starting against North Carolina A&T, striking out six and earning the win. In two appearances against VMI, Wantz struck out 11 batters in 5.0 innings pitched.

Wantz leads UNCG with 69 punch outs and is now 30th in the NCAA with a 11.22 strikeouts per nine innings pitched.

#### **Early Success**

2016 UNCG baseball had one of the best starts in program history with a 20-6 record heading into SoCon play. The 20 wins prior to the conference season is the most-ever for a UNCG squad, and the .769 winning percentage is the highest winning percentage entering conference play since 2003, when the Spartans were 12-0 entering conference.

Already this season, UNCG has earned five series sweeps, while winning nine total series. Those sweeps and series wins don't take into account the Coastal Carolina Invitational in which UNCG defeated Illinois twice, and split a pair of games with the host Chanticleers. With two nonconference games remaining, UNCG has a chance to tie the school-record for nonconference wins in a season with the record being set 1997, with 23 nonconference wins. The Spartans currently have 21 nonconference wins.

#### 10's the Magic Number

In 31 of 42 games this season, UNCG has racked up at least 10 hits. During that time, the Spartans have gone 26-5 in games that they have at least 10 hits. When not reaching the 10 hit plateau, UNCG is 5-6. Eight times UNCG has connected for nine hits. The season-low for hits in a game is six, a 6-4 loss to the Army Black Knights in the only home loss of the season.

#### Start Hot, Stay Hot

Currently, the UNCG offense currently leads the NCAA with a .361 team batting average. Louisville and Texas A&M are currently battling for second, but trail by an impressive 30 points. UNCG also leads the NCAA in scoring, runs, hits, doubles, slugging percentage, sacrifice flies and on-base percentage.

UNCG has connected for at least 38 hits in all but one weekend since the start of the season. UNCG has also knocked out 10 or more hits in 31 of 42 games played so far this season, including going for 20+ in five games. The Spartans have had 20+ hit games 10 times in the 24 year history of the program, prior to this year.

The Spartans have two players hitting above .400 this season, the most of any NCAA Division I team. Ben Spitznagel leads the team with a .420 average. Spitznagel leads the NCAA with 73 hits this season, as he has had multple hits in 24 games this year. UNCG has four players in the top 20 in the NCAA's hits category.

LJ Kalawaia has had a tremendous finals season at UNCG. The redshirt senior has hit for a .395 average, with 15 extra-base hits. He has driven in 51 runs this year, scored 52, while leading the team with 19 stolen bases.

Collin Woody leads the Spartans with 57 RBI this season. UNCG has six players who have driven in at least 32 runs this year, the most of any Southern Conference team. UNCG has four players in the top 26 of RBI producers, the most of any NCAA Division I institution.

#### **Coastal Carolina Invitational**

UNCG opened the 2016 season with eight of 12 games played at the UNCG Baseball Stadium. The Spartans first games outside of North Carolina were in the Coastal Carolina Invitational, where UNCG finished 3-1.

In their first road trip of the year, UNCG went 3-2 with two victories over Illinois and splitting a pair of games with Coastal Carolina. The Spartans also dropped the midweek game at UNCW, an NCAA Regional qualifier a year ago. Illinois was a 2015 Super Regional participant and Coastal Carolina has made the postseason in 12 seasons since 2001.

#### **Home Cooking**

UNCG is currently 22-1 in games played at the UNCG Baseball Stadium. The Spartans will play 30 of the 56 regular season games at the UNCG Baseball Stadium. Last season, UNCG only managed 13 wins in front of the home fans.

#### Johnny Bench Watch List

UNCG catcher Jake Kusz was named to the Johnny Bench Award Watch List earlier this season. The Greater Wichita Area Sports Commission announced the official watch list on March 8th. The watch list will be narrowed down on May 18th before the final vote occurs during the College World Series. 75 players were named to the list, four of which play for SoCon teams.

This season, Kusz has hit for a .285 average, with 13 doubles and six home runs. Kusz has allowed just six passed balls this season, while being able to catch eight runners attempting to steal bases. Kusz has made only two errors this season, and has a team-best .994 fielding percentage for players with over 100 chances.

#### Oh Captain, My Captain

Head Coach Link Jarrett announced the captains of the 2016 UNCG Baseball team prior to the start of the season. L.J. Kalawaia, Collin Woody, Hunter Smith and Jake Kusz have earned the right to be called captain this season. The four receive this honor after a vote conducted of the UNCG baseball team.

Kalawaia and Woody are each seniors, while Smith and Kusz are juniors. Kalawaia received a redshirt after suffering a preseason injury in 2015. Smith is a redshirt junior, having sat out the 2015 season due to NCAA transfer rules.

#### **Return to Action**

The Spartans return to action on Friday, April 29th as they host the Samford Bulldogs in the first of three Southern Conference games.
