Probable Rotation

Friday - UNCG | Hunter Smith (RHP, 5-1, 5.02 ERA, 61.0 IP, 45 K's) vs. Samford | Stephen Jones (RHP, 3-0, 3.06 ERA, 35.1 IP, 21 K's)

Notes: Smith continues to perform on Friday nights this season. The redshirt junior has made 10 starts this season, all being as the first pitcher opposing teams face to start the weekend. Smith has earned a 5-1 record in his 61.0 innings and has struck out 45 batters on the year. In his last outing against ETSU, Smith worked 5.2 innings, striking out one batter, helping UNCG earn a 6-5 victory. Jones has earned six starts this season, to go with six other appearances out of the bullpen. Jones worked primarily as the midweek starter until recently, when he's made the move to Friday nights. The Freshman's last started against the Kansas Jayhawks where he went 5.0 innings, allowing only two hits and striking out four batters. Jones has earned a 3.06 ERA, best of any pitcher with at least five starts.

Saturday - UNCG | Keaton Haack (RHP, 3-1, 2.73 ERA, 29.2 IP, 24 K's) vs. Samford | TBA

Notes: Haack has recently worked his way into the UNCG weekend rotation. The senior served as the primary midweek pitcher until last week when he earned the Saturday start against ETSU. Haack has worked in eight games, with six starts on the season. In his 29.2 innings pitched, he has allowed only nine earned runs while giving up 23 hits. In Haack's last outing against ETSU, he went a career-best 7.0 innings, allowing six hits, four runs; only one earned as UNCG defeated the Buccaneers 13-6. Samford has used Jared Brasher and Connor Radcliffe in the last three Saturday games. Brasher, who was the opening day starter, has appeared in 12 games, with 10 starts and has earned a 5.72 ERA. Radcliffe has a 7.20 ERA in nine starts.

Sunday - UNCG | Matt Frisbee (RHP, 3-2, 3.91 ERA, 46.0 IP, 38 K's) vs. Samford | TBA

Notes: Frisbee has emerged as a tremendous Sunday starter for UNCG this year. The freshman has worked in 10 games this season, all being in the series finale. Frisbee has worked 46.0 innings, and has struck out 38 batters. In his last two outings, he has gone a combined 12.0 innings, allowing only four runs, and struck out eight. Frisbee also earned a seven-inning complete game victory as UNCG defeated Furman 14-0. Radcliffe and Parker Curry have worked the last three Sundays. Curry has started four games this season, earning a 2.35 ERA in 13 total appearances. In his 46.0 innings, Curry has struck out 32 hitters.

A Little History -- Samford

Samford and UNCG have played 21 times, with the Bulldogs holding a 14-7 advantage in those games. Last season the two teams met in Birmingham, Ala. with Samford taking two of three games. The last time the Spartans took the series from the Bulldogs was in 2013. In that series, UNCG dropped the first game of the series 15-9, before rallying back to take games two and three, 8-3, and 7-6, respectively. Samford joined the Southern Conference in 2008, and the two teams have never met in postseason play.

Scouting the Bulldogs

The Bulldogs enter this weekend's games with a 24-18 overall record, and are 6-6 in the Southern Conference. Samford enters the weekend having played six-straight nonconference games. Samford last SoCon opponent was Western Carolina. The Bulldogs dropped two of three games in Cullowhee, N.C. before going 4-2 over the last week and a half. Samford earned a split with Alabama A&M, took two of three from Kansas last weekend, and earned a walk off win over SEC opponent Alabama at home during the midweek.

The Bulldog offense is powered by a pair of sluggers. Heath Quinn and Austin Edens are first and sixth in the NCAA in home runs, respectively. Quinn, a Preseason SoCon First-Team member, has slugged an NCAA-best 17, with Edens adding another 14. Both have hit for average as well, hitting .341 each. Quinn has added 10 doubles on the year, and one triple while leading the team with 57 RBI. Edens has had eight doubles this year, and driven in 43. Alex Lee leads the team with a .346 average, having hit seven home runs, and nine doubles. Samford has five players hitting over the .300 mark this year, with nine hitting over .250.

Stephen Jones is the only pitcher scheduled to pitch this weekend. Jones started the year as a midweek pitcher, but has moved to the starting role over the last few weekends. Jones has yet to suffer a loss, appearing in 12 games on the year, earning a 3-0 record. Other starters who have seen time recently have been Parker Curry, and Connor Radcliffe. Curry owns a 2.35 ERA and a 4-1 record in 13 appearances this year, with four starts. Radcliffe has a 7.20 ERA in nine starts, with a 2-3 record. Jared Brasher got the nod on opening night, and has started

10 games this year. Brasher owns a 5.72 ERA, with a 2-4 record. Samford has used closer by committee this year, with three players earning multiple saves. If Curry doesn't start, it's likely to see him out of the bullpen. Curry has earned two saves to go with his record. Wyatt Burns is tied with Josh Rich for the team-lead with three saves each. Burns and Rich have worked solely out of the bullpen, combining for 46 appearances on the year. Burns owns a 1-1 record with a 2.73 ERA. Rich is 1-3, with a 3.97 ERA.

Last Time Out

The Spartans are riding a four-game winning streak for the fourth time this season. UNCG's longest winning streak lasted eight games, from Mar. 24th-Apr. 3rd, and including two series sweeps. UNCG defeated Campbell 10-2 at the UNCG Baseball Stadium in the midweek contest, for Link Jarrett's 100th career win. The Spartans have improved to 23-1 at home this season.

Bringing out the Brooms

UNCG has already swept five different weekend series this year, including two with Southern Conference opponents. The Spartans didn't sweep any series in 2015. The last time UNCG swept five series in the same season was 2008.

Born to Run

UNCG has swiped 77 bases this season, through 43 games. In 2015, the Spartans stole just 32 on the year. The 77 stolen bases are the most since 2006, when UNCG swiped 77 during the year. The school record for stolen bases in a single season was set in 1997 at 169, when the Spartan qualified for the NCAA Regional in Baton Rouge, La. That season UNCG played in 62 games, averaging 2.73 stolen bases per game.

Spartans Sweep SoCon Awards

Redshirt Senior L.J. Kalawaia and Freshman Matt Frisbee swept the Pitcher and Player of the Week awards for their efforts April 11-17.

Kalawaia was also named to Collegiate Baseball's National Players of the Week. Kalawaia is the second Spartan to receive Collegiate Baseball National Player of the Week Honors after Andrew Wantz (Holly Springs, N.C./Holly Springs) took home the award for the week of Mar. 28th-April 4th.

Kalawaia hit .600 and slugged 1.150 with 18 RBI in five games on the week, while Frisbee pitched a complete-game shutout as the Spartans went 3-2, splitting a midweek home-and-home with Wake Forest and taking two of three from Furman on the road.

Frisbee turned in the first shutout of his career Sunday, allowing just two hits and four walks as the Spartans cruised to the 14-0 win, which finished in seven innings due to the 10-run rule. The freshman, who struck out five and didn't allow an extra-base hit, settled in after issuing all four walks in the first three innings.

Against the Furman Paladins, Kalawaia was 8-for-13 (.615) with 13 RBIs in the three contests. On Friday, the redshirt senior from Wailuku, Hawai'i, was 2-for-4 with a double and three RBIs. He went 3-for-4 with five RBIs and three runs scored Saturday, belting another RBI triple, and closed his week with two homers and another five RBIs in his third three-hit game of the week.

SoCon Pitcher of the Month

Chad Sykes was named SoCon Pitcher of the Month for the month of March. This is the first time the sophomore right-handed pitcher has earned the honor.

UNCG finished March with a league-best 14-5 record. Sykes went 2-1 and recorded a save to go with his 2.20 ERA in 10 appearances during the month. The sophomore right-hander

allowed only six hits; one for extra bases and nine walks through 16.1 innings, good for a 0.92 WHIP. Sykes allowed just four earned runs on the month, striking out 17 batters.

Six of Sykes' appearances went at least two innings, starting with a pair of scoreless frames against Coastal Carolina on Mar. 11 to earn his second save of the season. He noted at least one strikeout in each of his last eight appearances and did not allow a hit in his last seven contests. He also posted six straight scoreless outings, earning wins of Marist and Georgetown with two innings of work against each.

Overall, Sykes has worked in 20 games, throwing in 33.2 innings. During his time on the hill, Sykes has earned a 2.67 ERA and has held opponents to a .157 average against him. Sykes has struck out 41 hitters on the year.

Pitcher of the Week and National Awards

Andrew Wantz earned a multitude of honors for his performance the week of Mar. 28th-Apr. 3rd. Wantz was named SoCon Pitcher of the Week, National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association Pitcher of the Week and was one of Collegiate Baseball's seven national Players of the Week.

Wantz finished the weekend 2-0 with a 1.00 ERA in nine innings over three appearances on the week. Striking out 17 batters. Wantz opened the week starting against North Carolina A&T, striking out six and earning the win. In two appearances against VMI, Wantz struck out 11 batters in 5.0 innings pitched.

Wantz leads UNCG with 69 punch outs and is now 30th in the NCAA with a 11.22 strikeouts per nine innings pitched.

Early Success

2016 UNCG baseball had one of the best starts in program history with a 20-6 record heading into SoCon play. The 20 wins prior to the conference season is the most-ever for a UNCG squad, and the .769 winning percentage is the highest winning percentage entering conference play since 2003, when the Spartans were 12-0 entering conference.

Already this season, UNCG has earned five series sweeps, while winning nine total series. Those sweeps and series wins don't take into account the Coastal Carolina Invitational in which UNCG defeated Illinois twice, and split a pair of games with the host Chanticleers. With two nonconference games remaining, UNCG has a chance to tie the school-record for nonconference wins in a season with the record being set 1997, with 23 nonconference wins. The Spartans currently have 22 nonconference wins, with one remaining.

10's the Magic Number

In 32 of 43 games this season, UNCG has racked up at least 10 hits. During that time, the Spartans have gone 27-5 in games that they have at least 10 hits. When not reaching the 10 hit plateau, UNCG is 5-6. Eight times UNCG has connected for nine hits. The season-low for hits in a game is six, a 6-4 loss to the Army Black Knights in the only home loss of the season.

Start Hot, Stay Hot

Currently, the UNCG offense currently leads the NCAA with a .363 team batting average. Louisville and Texas A&M are currently battling for second, but trail by an impressive 34 points. UNCG also leads the NCAA in scoring, runs, hits, doubles, triples, slugging percentage, sacrifice flies and on-base percentage.

UNCG has connected for at least 38 hits in all but one weekend since the start of the season. UNCG has also knocked out 10 or more hits in 32 of 43 games played so far this season, including going for 20+ in five games. The Spartans have had 20+ hit games 10 times in the 24 year history of the program, prior to this year.

Ben Spitznagel leads the team with a .420 average. Spitznagel leads the NCAA with 75 hits this season, as he has had multiple hits in 25 games. UNCG has four players in the top 20 in the NCAA's hits category.

LJ Kalawaia has had a tremendous final season at UNCG. The redshirt senior has hit for a .395

Coastal Carolina Invitational

UNCG opened the 2016 season with eight of 12 games played at the UNCG Baseball Stadium. The Spartans first games outside of North Carolina were in the Coastal Carolina Invitational, where UNCG finished 3-1.

In their first road trip of the year, UNCG went 3-2 with two victories over Illinois and splitting a pair of games with Coastal Carolina. The Spartans also dropped the midweek game at UNCW, an NCAA Regional qualifier a year ago. Illinois was a 2015 Super Regional participant and Coastal Carolina has made the postseason in 12 seasons since 2001.

Home Cooking

UNCG is currently 23-1 in games played at the UNCG Baseball Stadium. The Spartans will play 30 of the 56 regular season games at the UNCG Baseball Stadium. Last season, UNCG only managed 13 wins in front of the home fans.

Johnny Bench Watch List

UNCG catcher Jake Kusz was named to the Johnny Bench Award Watch List earlier this season. The Greater Wichita Area Sports Commission announced the official watch list on March 8th. The watch list will be narrowed down on May 18th before the final vote occurs during the College World Series. 75 players were named to the list, four of which play for SoCon teams.

This season, Kusz has hit for a .284 average, with 13 doubles and six home runs. The junior catcher has driven in 40 runs on the year, including one in his last 11 games. Defensively, Kusz has allowed just six passed balls this season, while being able to catch eight runners attempting to steal bases. Kusz has made only two errors this season, and has a team-best .994 fielding percentage for players with over 100 chances.

Oh Captain, My Captain

Head Coach Link Jarrett announced the captains of the 2016 UNCG Baseball team prior to the start of the season. L.J. Kalawaia, Collin Woody, Hunter Smith and Jake Kusz have earned the right to be called captain this season. The four receive this honor after a vote conducted of the UNCG baseball team.

Kalawaia and Woody are each seniors, while Smith and Kusz are juniors. Kalawaia received a redshirt after suffering a preseason injury in 2015. Smith is a redshirt junior, having sat out the 2015 season due to NCAA transfer rules.

Return to Action

The Spartans return to action on Friday, May 1st as they travel to Spartanburg, S.C. for a three-game series with the Wofford Terriers. Friday's game begins at 6:00 p.m., Saturday 3:00 p.m., with Sunday beginning at 1:00 p.m.
