Friday - UNCG | Hunter Smith (RHP, 4-0, 4.81 ERA, 43.0 IP, 34 K's) vs. The Citadel | JP Sears (LHP, 4-2, 2.53 ERA, 42.2 IP, 54 K's)

Notes: Hunter Smith will get the ball to start a series for the eighth time this season. Smith has been the Friday night starter all season, going 4-0 and UNCG has yet to drop a game on a Friday this year. In his last outing, Smith went 5.2 innings, allowing four earned runs and striking out five hitters. Sears was named SoCon Pitcher of the Week two weeks ago following a 19 strikeout performance against VMI. In his last outing against Stetson, Sears worked a quality start, throwing 6.0 innings, allowing three runs, all earned and striking out seven hitters.

Saturday - UNCG | Bryce Hensley (LHP, 4-0, 4.58 ERA, 37.1 IP, 24 K's) vs. The Citadel | Thomas Byelick (RHP, 0-3, 3.56 ERA, 43.0 IP, 29 K's)

Notes: Bryce Hensley has worked in the Saturday role all season for the Spartans. He has earned a 4-0 record, with a 4.58 ERA. Hensley has earned a quality start in five of his seven starts, including earning wins in his first three appearances. Thomas Byelick has started seven games this year, and has worked in 43.0 innings, most of any Bulldog pitcher. In his last outing, Byelick suffered his third loss of the year, going 6.0 innings, allowing four earned runs and striking out five.

Sunday - UNCG | Matt Frisbee (RHP, 1-2, 5.14 ERA, 28.0 IP, 24 K's) vs. The Citadel | Jacob Watcher (RHP, 4-2, 3.29 ERA, 27.1 IP, 24 K's)

Notes: Frisbee will start his eighth game of his freshman campaign Sunday. Frisbee earned a career-long start against Georgetown two weeks ago, going 6.0 innings, striking out two. Twice Frisbee has struck out seven hitters and earned his first collegiate win against Marist on Mar. 20th. Jacob Watcher has bounced around in his role with the pitching staff, making nine appearances, with only five starts. The sophomore pitcher has worked in 27.0 innings, allowing 10 earned runs this season. In his last outing, Watcher only went 1.1 innings, allowing five hits, five runs, only one was earned, and striking out one hitter.

A Little History -- The Citadel

The Spartans and Bulldogs have played 61 times, with the Bulldogs holding a 34-27 advantage in that time. In the last series, the Spartans won two of the three games, all being played at the UNCG Baseball Stadium. The Citadel did manage to defeat UNCG in an elimination game in the SoCon tournament last season.

Scouting the Bulldogs

The Citadel enter this weekend's series with a 12-18 overall record and are currently 2-1 in the SoCon after taking two games from VMI earlier this season. The Bulldogs started the season fast, going 5-1 in the first two weeks, defeating Virginia and Siena. The Citadel dropped four in a row to South Carolina and the College of Charleston to even their record at 5-5. After splitting a set of midweek games, the Bulldogs lost two of three to the Elon Phoenix. After losing a pair of midweeks to No. 19 Clemson, The Citadel took back-to-back series over Presbyterian and VMI before going on their current five-game losing skid.

The Citadel offense is led by Clay Martin. In 25 games this season, Martin has hit for a .273 average and has had four extra-base hits. Drew Ellis and Mike Deese lead the Bulldogs with three home runs each. Ellis is the RBI leads, driving in 19 runs this year while scoring 11 of his own. Ellis also leads the team with 12 extra-base hits. Jason Smith has started in 22 games and appeared in seven more. Smith has been a threat on the base paths, leading the bulldogs with nine stolen bases on the year. Seven more than any other Bulldog this year. Stephen Windham has hit in the cleanup role this year, driving in 13 runs on seven extra-base hits. The Citadel has had 12 different players start at least 13 games this year.

On the mound, The Citadel is set to start JP Sears Friday, Thomas Byelick Saturday, and Jacob Watcher Sunday. Sears, a preseason all SoCon second team selection, earned SoCon Pitcher of the Week for his last outing against a SoCon opponent. Sears struck out 19 Keydets in an

10-2 victory. Sears logged another quality start last weekend, throwing 6.0 innings allowing three earned runs and striking out seven in a 3-1 loss to Stetson. Thomas Byelick is set to start Saturday. Byelick started seven games this season, working in a team-high 43.0 innings. Behind Sears' 54 strikeouts, Byelick is second on The Citadel pitching staff with 29 K's this season. Byelick suffered a loss a week ago with the Bulldogs falling 7-0 to Stetson. Byelick worked 6.0 innings, allowing seven hits and four earned runs. Jacob Watcher is set to start on Sunday. Watcher has made four appearances out of the bullpen to go with five starts on the year. Zach Lavery has worked in the closers role for the Bulldogs this year. Lavery has appeared in 17 games, earning a 2-0 record, with five saves. Lavery has a 3.75 ERA in his 24.0 innings, and has struck out 23 hitters. Kyle Smith has also been a key contributor out of the bullpen, logging 14 appearances this year. In 16.2 innings, Smith has struck out 20 batters. Jordan Buster and Ryan Stamler have also made 12 appearances this season, with Zach McKay working in 11 games.

Last Time Out

The Spartans enter the matchup with the Bulldogs having dropped their last game with the Duke Blue Devils. UNCG took a lead in the top of the fifth scoring four runs, but the Blue Devils scored seven unanswered to take the game 7-4. UNCG fell to 3-5 on the road with the loss at Jack Coombs Field.

SoCon Pitcher of the Month

Chad Sykes has been named SoCon Pitcher of the Month for the month of March. This is the first time the sophomore right-handed pitcher has earned the honor.

UNCG finished March with a league-best 14-5 record. Sykes went 2-1 and recorded a save to go with his 2.20 ERA in 10 appearances during the month. The sophomore right-hander allowed only six hits; one for extra bases and nine walks through 16.1 innings, good for a 0.92 WHIP. Sykes allowed just four earned runs on the month, striking out 17 batters.

Six of Sykes' appearances went at least two innings, starting with a pair of scoreless frames against Coastal Carolina on Mar. 11 to earn his second save of the season. He noted at least one strikeout in each of his last eight appearances and did not allow a hit in his last seven contests. He also posted six straight scoreless outings, earning wins of Marist and Georgetown with two innings of work against each.

Overall, Sykes has worked in 15 games, throwing in 24.0 innings. During his time on the hill, Sykes has earned a 2.25 ERA and has held opponents to a .103 average against him. Sykes has struck out 28 hitters on the year.

Pitcher of the Week

Andrew Wantz earned a multitude of honors for yephis performance the week of Mar. 28th-Apr. 3rd. Wantz was named SoCon Pitcher of the Week, National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association Pitcher of the Week and was one of Colleigate Baseball's seven national Players of the Week.

Wantz finished the weekend 2-0 with a 1.00 ERA in nine innings over three appearances on the week. Striking out 17 batters. Wantz opened the week starting against North Carolina A&T, striking out six and earning the win.

Wantz worked in 2.1 innings out of the bullpen in Friday's win over VMI, allowing just one hit and getting six of his seven outs via the strikeout. UNCG took game one, 10-4 over the Keydets. In the series finale against VMI, the sophomore logged 2.2 innings, allowing two walks and striking out five batters. Wantz entered with the bases loaded and no outs in the fifth and shut VMI down, striking out the side and keep an inherited runner from scoring and picking up the win.

Wantz leads UNCG with 58 punch outs and is now 12th in the NCAA with a 12.53 strikeouts per nine innings pitched, and is 13th in the nation on total strikeouts.

Early Success

2016 UNCG baseball has had one of the best starts in program history with a 20-6 record heading into SoCon play. The 20 wins prior to the conference season is the most-ever for a UNCG squad, and the .769 winning percentage is the highest winning percentage entering conference play since 2003, when the Spartans were 12-0 entering conference.

Already this season, UNCG has earned four series sweeps, while winning six total series. Opening weekend UNCG took two of three from High Point and in the third weekend of the season, the Spartans took two of three from Army. Those sweeps and series wins don't take into account the Coastal Carolina Invitational in which UNCG defeated Illinois twice, while splitting a pair of games with the host Chanticleers. With six nonconference games remaining, UNCG has a chance to earn the school-record for nonconference wins in a season with the record being set 1997, with 23 nonconference wins.

10's the Magic Number

In 21 of 29 games this season, UNCG has racked up at least 10 hits. During that time, the Spartans have gone 19-3 in games that they have at least 10 hits. When not reaching the 10 hit plateau, UNCG is 4-4. six times UNCG has connected for nine hits. The season-low for hits in a game is six, a 6-4 loss to the Army Black Knights in the only home loss of the season.

Wantz Wows

Start Hot, Stay Hot

Currently, the UNCG offense currently leads the NCAA with a .356 team batting average. BYU has the next closest average at .332. UNCG also leads the NCAA in hits, runs, sacrifice flies, slugging, and on-base percentage. The Spartans are second in the nation in scoring and doubles.

UNCG has connected for at least 40 hits in every weekend since the start of the season. UNCG has also knocked out 10 or more hits in 21 of 29 games played so far this season, including going for 20+ in four games. The Spartans have had 20+ hit games 10 times in the 24 year history of the program, prior to this year.

Junior Ben Spitznagel leads the Spartan offense with a .405 average. Spitznagel has hit in the lead off spot of the order in 23 games this year. Spitznagel has scored 27 runs, tied for fifth-most on the team, while driving in nine on nine extra-base hits.

Dillon Stewart leads the Spartans with nine home runs, and has had multi-home run series in the past two weekends. Collin Woody has driven in 36 RBI, a team-best. The 36 RBI is 39th-most in the NCAA this season.

UNCG has nine players hitting above the .300 plateau who have played in at least 19 games this season.

Coastal Carolina Invitational

UNCG hit the road for its first road swing of the season on Mar. 9th UNCG opened the 2016 season with eight of 12 games played at the UNCG Baseball Stadium. The Spartans first games outside of North Carolina were in the Coastal Carolina Invitational, where UNCG finished 3-1.

UNCG opened the season with a split series against the High Point Panthers, going 2-1 and taking the game at home. The Spartans have gone 8-1 at home during the early part of the season, with a 2-4 record on the road, including a close loss in Raleigh to No. 8 NC State.

In their first road trip of the year, UNCG went 3-2 with two victories over Illinois and splitting a pair of games with Coastal Carolina. The Spartans also dropped the midweek game at UNCW, an NCAA Regional qualifier a year ago. Illinois was a 2015 Super Regional participant and Coastal Carolina has made the postseason in 12 seasons since 2001.

Home Cooking

UNCG is currently 18-1 in games played at the UNCG Baseball Stadium. The Spartans will play 30 of the 56 regular season games at the UNCG Baseball Stadium. Last season, UNCG only managed 13 wins in front of the home fans.

Johnny Bench Watch List

UNCG catcher Jake Kusz was named to the Johnny Bench Award Watch List earlier this season. The Greater Wichita Area Sports Commission announced the official watch list on March 8th. The watch list will be narrowed down on May 18th before the final vote occurs during the College World Series. 75 players were named to the list, four of which play for SoCon teams.

This season, Kusz has hit for a .274 average, with eight doubles and four home runs. Kusz has allowed just four passed balls this season, while being able to catch eight runners attempting to steal bases.
