Friday - UNCG | Hunter Smith (RHP, 6-2, 4.74 ERA, 74.0 IP, 58 K's) vs. Western Carolina | Bryan Sammons (LHP, 6-3, 5.47 ERA, 79.0 IP, 67 K's)

Notes: Smith will start his 13th Friday night of the season, having started the opener in every series. He has earned a 6-2 record in 74.0 innings. Smith has gone at least 5.1 innings in his last six outings, earning a 2-1 record in that time. When Smith is on the mound, UNCG has outscored opponents 122-61, and has gone 10-2. Sammons enters having started 13 games this season, and leads the Catamounts with six wins. His 79.0 innings are also the most on the squad. In his last outing against Furman, the junior southpaw logged 5.2 innings, allowing seven hits, seven earned runs as Western Carolina suffered an 11-4 loss to Furman.

Friday - UNCG | Matt Frisbee (RHP, 4-3, 4.61 ERA, 56.2 IP, 44 K's) vs. Western Carolina | Brendan Nail (LHP, 2-6, 5.03 ERA, 68.0 IP, 50 K's)

Notes: Frisbee is set to start his second Saturday of the season against the Catamounts. The freshman has started in 12 games this year, working as the Sunday starter until last weekend with Wofford. Frisbee has earned quality starts four times this year, including in his last outing against Wofford. Last weekend, he logged 6.2 innings, surrendering just three hits and one run while striking out four Terriers. Nail has earned a team-high 14 starts this season, working in 68.0 innings. The sophomore lefty has earned a 5.03 ERA and a 2-6 record. In his last outing against Furman, Nail logged 7.0 innings, surrendering eight hits, and five earned runs as the Catamounts gave up five runs in the eighth and ninth innings to fall 9-8 to the Paladins.

Sunday - UNCG | Keaton Haack (RHP, 4-2, 3.05 ERA, 38.1 IP, 29 K's) vs. Western Carolina | Korey Anderson (RHP, 1-2, 9.60 ERA, 30.0 IP, 29 K's)

Notes: Haack will work in his third weekend game this year on Sunday. The senior served as the midweek starter for the first two months of the season before transitioning to a weekend starter. Haack has earned given up less than three earned runs in at least 5.0 innings in three of his last four games. In his last outing, Haack worked 5.0 innings of shutout baseball against the Wofford Terriers, en route to earning the 6-1 victory and taking the series in Spartanburg. Anderson, a junior righty will be starting his sixth game of the year, having made six relief appearances. Anderson has earned a 1-2 record while working in 30.0 innings. In his last outing, Anderson helped earn the victory over Furman. He worked 7.0 innings, allowing four runs on nine hits and struck out seven batters on 101 pitches.

A Little History -- Western Carolina

Western Carolina and UNCG have met 60 times in program history, with the Spartans holding a slight 31-29 advantage. The Catamounts have had success lately, going 7-3 in the last ten matchups. This is the first trip to Cullowhee for UNCG Baseball since 2012, and the first under Link Jarrett. The Spartans are looking to repeat the outcome of the last trip to Cullowhee, when UNCG took two of three games from the Catamounts.

Scouting the Catamounts

The Catamounts enter the series with a 23-24 record, and are currently 13-8 in the Southern Conference. Western Carolina started the conference season hot, going 10-2 in the first four SoCon series. They have scuffled a little as of late, going 3-7 in their last ten games, including dropping two of three to three SoCon opponents, The Citadel, Mercer and Furman. Western Carolina is currently third in the SoCon with a .307 team batting average. The Catamounts have 78 stolen bases.

Individually, the Matt Smith has been a catalyst of the Catamount offense, hitting .376 through 47 games started this season. The junior left-handed bat has hit five doubles and is second on the team with 10 home runs. Garrett Brown has trouble for opposing teams this year. Brown has played in and started 44 games this year, and has hit for a .353 average in a team-high 201 at bats. The senior outfielder has hit 10 doubles, three triples and a trio of home runs. He has been the biggest threat on the bases, having swiped 30 this year. The 30 stolen bases are good for first in the SoCon, and rank eighth in the nation. Kramer Farrell has twice earned SoCon Player of the Week honors this season. Farrell has hit for a .333 average in 45 games. The senior outfielder has driven in 45 runs and scored 40 on the year. Bryson Bowman is another Catamount who has earned SoCon Player of the Week honors. Bowman leads the Catamounts with 48 RBI, 14 home runs and 12 doubles. The redshirt-junior has also hit for three triples, all of which are tops on the squad.

Western Carolina will send two left-handed pitchers to the hill in the first two games of the series. Junior Bryan Sammons will start Friday night's contest. Sammons has worked in a team-high 79.0 innings. Sophomore southpaw Brendan Nail will start Saturday's matchup, and junior Korey Anderson will finish the series on Sunday. Anderson, a junior right handed pitcher, will be making his sixth start of the season, having made six appearances out of the bullpen. Colton Davis has earned a team-high 21 appearances out of the Catamount bullpen. The senior reliever has earned a 5-2 record, working in 49.1 innings. Davis also leads the WCU pitching staff with 71 strikeouts this season. B.J. Nobles has served as the closer for the Catamounts, having earned four saves in 17 appearances this season. Nobles has worked in 27.0 innings, allowed 10 earned runs, good for a 3.33 ERA. He has also struck out 31 batters and has only allowed six extra-base hits. Corey Sikes has worked in 20 games, all out of the bullpen. Sikes has logged 23.2 innings, earning a save and an 0-1 record in the process. Dylan Bium has earned a 3-1 record, having made 16 appearances out of the bullpen, and having started one game. Bium has 24.0 innings pitched this season and has struck out 28 batters.

Last Time Out

The Spartans suffered a 12-7 defeat to the UNC Asheville Bulldogs on Wednesday night. The Spartans gave up three runs in the first three innings and were unable to mount a comeback after falling behind early. Ben Spitznagel hit his first home run as a Spartan, and Tripp Shelton hit his second of the season, after missing the previous 27 games due to injury.

Bringing out the Brooms

UNCG has swept five different weekend series this year, including two with Southern Conference opponents. The Spartans didn't sweep any series in 2015. The last time UNCG swept five series in the same season was 2008.

Born to Run

UNCG has swiped 86 bases this season, through 50 games. In 2015, the Spartans stole just 32 on the year. The 86 stolen bases are the most since 2003, when UNCG swiped 101 during the year. The school record for stolen bases in a single season was set in 1997 at 169, when the Spartans qualified for the NCAA Regional in Baton Rouge, La. That season UNCG played in 62 games, averaging 2.73 stolen bases per game.

On the Brink

UNCG has had one of the most productive offensive seasons in school history in 2016. Currently, the 2016 Spartans have set records in triples, having hit 30 already this year. The previous record was 27, set in 1999. The program record for doubles in a season is at 131, and this year's team has already racked up 129, most in the nation. The Navy and Gold needs just 15 hits to break the team record for hits in a season, 650, set in 1997 when the Spartans reached the NCAA Regionals in Baton Rouge, La.

Spartans Sweep SoCon Awards

Redshirt Senior L.J. Kalawaia and Freshman Matt Frisbee swept the Pitcher and Player of the Week awards for their efforts April 11-17.

Kalawaia was also named to Collegiate Baseball's National Players of the Week. Kalawaia is the second Spartan to receive Collegiate Baseball National Player of the Week Honors after Andrew Wantz (Holly Springs, N.C./Holly Springs) took home the award for the week of Mar. 28th-April 4th.

Kalawaia hit .600 and slugged 1.150 with 18 RBI in five games on the week, while Frisbee pitched a complete-game shutout as the Spartans went 3-2, splitting a midweek home-and-home with Wake Forest and taking two of three from Furman on the road.

Frisbee turned in the first shutout of his career, allowing just two hits and four walks as the

Spartans cruised to the 14-0 win, which finished in seven innings due to the 10-run rule. The freshman, who struck out five and didn't allow an extra-base hit, settled in after issuing all four walks in the first three innings.

SoCon Pitcher of the Month

Chad Sykes was named SoCon Pitcher of the Month for the month of March. This is the first time the sophomore right-handed pitcher has earned the honor.

UNCG finished March with a league-best 14-5 record. Sykes went 2-1 and recorded a save to go with his 2.20 ERA in 10 appearances during the month. The sophomore right-hander allowed only six hits; one for extra bases and nine walks through 16.1 innings, good for a 0.92 WHIP. Sykes allowed just four earned runs on the month, striking out 17 batters.

Six of Sykes' appearances went at least two innings, starting with a pair of scoreless frames against Coastal Carolina on Mar. 11 to earn his second save of the season. He noted at least one strikeout in each of his last eight appearances and did not allow a hit in his last seven contests. He also posted six straight scoreless outings, earning wins of Marist and Georgetown with two innings of work against each.

Overall, Sykes has worked in 24 games, throwing in 39.0 innings. During his time on the hill, Sykes has earned a 2.54 ERA and has held opponents to a .181 average against him. Sykes has struck out 48 hitters on the year., including one in 19-straight appearances.

Pitcher of the Week and National Awards

Andrew Wantz earned a multitude of honors for his performance the week of Mar. 28th-Apr. 3rd. Wantz was named SoCon Pitcher of the Week, National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association Pitcher of the Week and was one of Collegiate Baseball's seven National Players of the Week.

Wantz finished the weekend 2-0 with a 1.00 ERA in nine innings over three appearances on the week. Striking out 17 batters. Wantz opened the week starting against North Carolina A&T, striking out six and earning the win. In two appearances against VMI, Wantz struck out 11 batters in 5.0 innings pitched.

Wantz leads UNCG with 78 punch outs and is now 29th in the NCAA with a 11.08 strikeouts per nine innings pitched. His 28 appearances leads the team and is 16th in the nation.

Early Success

2016 UNCG baseball had one of the best starts in program history with a 20-6 record heading into SoCon play. The 20 wins prior to the conference season is the most-ever for a UNCG squad, and the .769 winning percentage is the highest winning percentage entering conference play since 2003, when the Spartans were 12-0 entering conference.

10's the Magic Number

In 34 of 50 games this season, UNCG has racked up at least 10 hits. During that time, the Spartans have gone 28-6 in games that they have at least 10 hits. When not reaching the 10 hit plateau, UNCG is 6-10. Eight times UNCG has connected for nine hits. The season-low for hits in a game is six which has occurred only twice.

Start Hot, Stay Hot

Currently, the UNCG offense currently leads the NCAA with a .353 team batting average. UNCW trails the Spartans by an impressive 18 points. UNCG also leads the NCAA in hits, doubles per game, triples, slugging percentage, sacrifice flies and on-base percentage.

The Spartan offense is led by a pair of hitters who are above the .400 mark. L.J. Kalawaia (Wailuku, Hawai'i/Ohlone College) and Ben Spitznagel (Cincinnati, Ohio/Wabash Valley CC) have hit .400, and .401 respectively. Spitznagel is second in the NCAA with 83 hits, Kalawaia is seventh with 73. Collin Woody (Tampa, Fla./College of Central Florida) is tenth in the nation with 71 hits, but leads the NCAA with 11 sacrifice flies, while placing third in the NCAA with 63 RBI. Kalawaia ranks tenth in the NCAA with 55 RBI, as well as leading UNCG with 21 stolen bases. (Rankings as of May 9th)

Four different players rank in the top 12 in runs scored this year. Kalawaia ranks third with 57, Spitznagel is sixth at 53, Dillon Stewart (Dunn, N.C./Brunswick CC) is eighth at 52, and Woody has scored 51. Stewart and Woody are tied for the team-lead with ten home runs each. Jake Kusz (Durham, N.C./Riverside) is second on the squad with seven home runs on the year. UNCG has four players in the top 26 of RBI producers, the most of any NCAA Division I institution.

Coastal Carolina Invitational

UNCG opened the 2016 season with eight of 12 games played at the UNCG Baseball Stadium. The Spartans first games outside of North Carolina were in the Coastal Carolina Invitational, where UNCG finished 3-1.

In their first road trip of the year, UNCG went 3-2 with two victories over Illinois and splitting a pair of games with Coastal Carolina. The Spartans also dropped the midweek game at UNCW, an NCAA Regional qualifier a year ago. Illinois was a 2015 Super Regional participant and Coastal Carolina has made the postseason in 12 seasons since 2001.

Home Cooking

UNCG is currently 24-3 in games played at the UNCG Baseball Stadium. The Spartans will play 30 of the 56 regular season games at the UNCG Baseball Stadium. Last season, UNCG only managed 13 wins in front of the home fans.

Johnny Bench Watch List

UNCG catcher Jake Kusz was named to the Johnny Bench Award Watch List earlier this season. The Greater Wichita Area Sports Commission announced the official watch list on March 8th. The watch list will be narrowed down on May 18th before the final vote occurs during the College World Series. 75 players were named to the list, four of which play for SoCon teams.

This season, Kusz has hit for a .271 average, with 13 doubles and seven home runs. The junior catcher has driven in 44 runs on the year. Defensively, Kusz has allowed just six passed balls this season, while being able to catch nine runners attempting to steal bases. Kusz has made only two errors this season, and has a team-best .995 fielding percentage for players with over 100 chances.

Oh Captain, My Captain

Head Coach Link Jarrett announced the captains of the 2016 UNCG Baseball team prior to the start of the season. L.J. Kalawaia, Collin Woody, Hunter Smith and Jake Kusz have earned the right to be called captain this season. The four receive this honor after a vote conducted of the UNCG baseball team.

Kalawaia and Woody are each seniors, while Smith and Kusz are juniors. Kalawaia received a redshirt after suffering a preseason injury in 2015. Smith is a redshirt junior, having sat out the 2015 season due to NCAA transfer rules.

Return to Action

The Spartans return to action on Thursday, May 19th as they host the Mercer Bears for the first of three games at the UNCG Baseball Stadium.
