Probable Rotation

Game 1 - UNCG | Hunter Smith (RHP, 6-3, 5.13 ERA, 79.0 IP, 64 K's) vs. Mercer | Ryan Askew (RHP, 4-2, 4.30 ERA, 81.2 IP, 56 K's)

Notes: Smith has been a series opener starter all season for UNCG. The redshirt junior will be making his 14th start of the season, all of which have come on the first game of a series. Smith has earned a 6-3 record. Smith has gone at least 5.0 innings in his last 11 starts, including 7.0 innings of two-hit baseball in a victory over Samford. Askew was the opening day starter for the Bears, and has started 13 games this year. The junior has logged a team-high 81.2 innings, with 56 strikeouts. In his last outing against Butler, Askew earned his seventh quality start, logging 6.0 innings, six hits and three earned runs plus a strikeout in a 6-5 Bear victory.

Game 2 - UNCG | Matt Frisbee (RHP, 4-3, 5.16 ERA, 59.1 IP, 45 K's) vs. Mercer | Kevin Coulter (RHP, 6-3, 5.24 ERA, 68.2 IP, 37 K's)

Notes: Frisbee has been a weekend starter all season for UNCG. The freshman has made 13 starts, 11 of which came on Sunday afternoon. After moving up in the rotation, Frisbee has worked 9.1 innings, and allowed only 6 runs. Coulter has made 15 appearances, including starting a team-high 14 games. In his 15 appearances, Coulter has logged 68.2 innings, and has surrendered 42 runs, 40 earned. Coulter has earned four quality starts, and is coming off of a 6.0 inning, seven hits, two run performance against Butler a week ago.

Game 3 - UNCG | Keaton Haack (RHP, 4-2, 3.46 ERA, 41.2 IP, 29 K's) vs. Mercer | TBA

Notes: Haack is set to make his fourth weekend start of his career on senior day. The right hander worked as a reliever his junior year before being a midweek starter for the Navy and Gold to being this season. In total, Haack has started nine games of his 11 appearances. Haack has only given up more than five hits once this season, and has earned a 3.46 ERA in 41.2 innings.

A Little History -- Mercer

Mercer and UNCG have played just six times in history. The series between the Spartans and Bears is level at three games each. The Bears have never made the trek to Greensboro, with all six meetings having been in Macon, Ga. Previous to meeting in 2015, the last time the Bears faced the Spartans was in 1998, the first year that UNCG was a member of the Southern Conference. 1998 was also the last time that UNCG won a SoCon regular season championship.

Scouting the Bears

The Bears enter this weekend's series tied with UNCG atop the Southern Conference standings. The Spartans and Bears each have earned a 14-7 record, with the Bears being 33-20 overall on the season. In the last ten games, Mercer has posted a 7-3 record and took two of three games from the Butler Bulldogs last weekend in Indianapolis. The Bears haven't dropped a series since April 1-3 when the Samford Bulldogs took two games in Birmingham.

Offensively, Mercer is led by Golden Spikes Award Watchlist, and preseason SoCon Player of the Year outfielder Kyle Lewis. Lewis has started all 53 games, and has hit for a .419 average. That average ranks fifth in the nation, and his 83 hits is good for eighth in the nation. The junior outfielder doesn't just get on base, but leads the Bears with 64 RBI this year to go with 17 home runs. Currently, Lewis is riding a 13-game hitting streak. Trey Truitt is another Bear that has had a successful 2016 campaign. The sophomore outfielder has been the Bears' leadoff hitter, hitting at a .335 clip. Truitt has started 52 of 53 games, and has earned 14 home runs and 45 RBI in that time. His 15 doubles are second on the team to Ryan Hagan. Hagan has started all 53 games, hitting at a .329 average. The junior infielder has hit 16 doubles and is second behind Lewis iwth 47 RBI. Charlie Madden and Danny Edgeworth are a couple other bats to watch in the Bear lineup. Madden and Edgeworth have each hit 10 home runs this year, with seven and ten doubles, respectively.

Mercer will send Ryan Askew and Kevin Coulter to the hill Thursday and Friday, with the Saturday starter yet to be determined. Askew has worked in 13 games, serving as the Friday starter all season. His 81.2 innings leads the Bear pitching staff and he has earned a 4-2 record. Opponents are hitting .271 against Askew. Coulter has started a team-high 14 games, while making one relief appearance. The freshman right-hander has thrown in 68.2 innings, earning a 5.24 ERA in that time. Mercer has used six other pitchers who have started at least one game. Last weekend, the Bears sent Connor Herd to the hill, but used seven pitchers in a 7-3

loss to the Butler Bulldogs. Mercer has a pair of workhorses on the back end of the pitching staff. Conard Broom has made 38 appearances, through 53 games. Broom has logged 56.2 innings, earning four saves and a 4-3 record in the process. The freshman's longest outing came on April 19th, a 9-8 win over Georgia Tech in Atlanta. In 21 SoCon games, Broom has made appearances in 17 games. Austin Lord has made 30 appearances for the Bears, working in 34.2 innings. The junior lefty has earned a 4-1 record and four saves. Lord has shown great command this season, striking out 34 batters, compared to walking just nine.

Last Time Out

The Spartans dropped two of three games to the Western Carolina Catamounts in Cullowhee over the weekend. UNCG hit eight home runs over the three-game stretch, the most since the start of the 2012 season when the Spartans connected for eight home runs against Delaware State. UNCG has only dropped one other series this year, with Samford taking two of three games. The Spartans responded, taking two of three games in the following series with the Wofford Terriers.

Bringing out the Brooms

UNCG has swept five different weekend series this year, including two with Southern Conference opponents. The Spartans didn't sweep any series in 2015. The last time UNCG swept five series in the same season was 2008.

Born to Run

UNCG has swiped 87 bases this season, through 53 games. In 2015, the Spartans stole just 32 on the year. The 87 stolen bases are the most since 2003, when UNCG swiped 101 during the year. The school record for stolen bases in a single season was set in 1997 at 169, when the Spartans qualified for the NCAA Regional in Baton Rouge, La. That season UNCG played in 62 games, averaging 2.73 stolen bases per game.

Record Setting Season

UNCG has had one of the most productive offensive seasons in school history in 2016. The Spartans have set single season team records in multiple categories, including hits (668), doubles (134), triples (31), and RBI (424).

Spartans Sweep SoCon Awards

Redshirt Senior L.J. Kalawaia and Freshman Matt Frisbee swept the Pitcher and Player of the Week awards for their efforts April 11-17.

Kalawaia was also named to Collegiate Baseball's National Players of the Week. Kalawaia is the second Spartan to receive Collegiate Baseball National Player of the Week Honors after Andrew Wantz (Holly Springs, N.C./Holly Springs) took home the award for the week of Mar. 28th-April 4th.

Kalawaia hit .600 and slugged 1.150 with 18 RBI in five games on the week, while Frisbee pitched a complete-game shutout as the Spartans went 3-2, splitting a midweek home-and-home with Wake Forest and taking two of three from Furman on the road.

Frisbee turned in the first shutout of his career, allowing just two hits and four walks as the Spartans cruised to the 14-0 win, which finished in seven innings due to the 10-run rule. The freshman, who struck out five and didn't allow an extra-base hit, settled in after issuing all four walks in the first three innings.

SoCon Pitcher of the Month

Chad Sykes was named SoCon Pitcher of the Month for the month of March. This is the first time the sophomore right-handed pitcher has earned the honor.

UNCG finished March with a league-best 14-5 record. Sykes went 2-1 and recorded a save to go with his 2.20 ERA in 10 appearances during the month. The sophomore right-hander

allowed only six hits; one for extra bases and nine walks through 16.1 innings, good for a 0.92 WHIP. Sykes allowed just four earned runs on the month, striking out 17 batters.

Six of Sykes' appearances went at least two innings, starting with a pair of scoreless frames against Coastal Carolina on Mar. 11 to earn his second save of the season. He noted at least one strikeout in each of his last eight appearances and did not allow a hit in his last seven contests. He also posted six straight scoreless outings, earning wins of Marist and Georgetown with two innings of work against each.

Overall, Sykes has worked in 25 games, throwing in 42.2 innings. During his time on the hill, Sykes has earned a 2.53 ERA and has held opponents to a .181 average against him. Sykes has struck out 50 hitters on the year, including one in 19-straight appearances.

Pitcher of the Week and National Awards

Andrew Wantz earned a multitude of honors for his performance the week of Mar. 28th-Apr. 3rd. Wantz was named SoCon Pitcher of the Week, National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association Pitcher of the Week and was one of Collegiate Baseball's seven National Players of the Week.

Wantz finished the weekend 2-0 with a 1.00 ERA in nine innings over three appearances on the week. Striking out 17 batters. Wantz opened the week starting against North Carolina A&T, striking out six and earning the win. In two appearances against VMI, Wantz struck out 11 batters in 5.0 innings pitched.

Wantz leads UNCG with 80 punch outs and is now 38th in the NCAA with a 10.75 strikeouts per nine innings pitched. His 30 appearances leads the team and is 11th in the nation.

Early Success

2016 UNCG baseball had one of the best starts in program history with a 20-6 record heading into SoCon play. The 20 wins prior to the conference season is the most-ever for a UNCG squad, and the .769 winning percentage is the highest winning percentage entering conference play since 2003, when the Spartans were 12-0 entering conference.

10's the Magic Number

In 37 of 53 games this season, UNCG has racked up at least 10 hits. During that time, the Spartans have gone 29-8 in games that they have at least 10 hits. When not reaching the 10 hit plateau, UNCG is 6-10. Eight times UNCG has connected for nine hits. The season-low for hits in a game is six which has occurred only twice.

Start Hot, Stay Hot

Currently, the UNCG offense currently leads the NCAA with a .351 team batting average. UNCW trails the Spartans by an impressive 22 points. UNCG also leads the NCAA in hits, doubles, triples, slugging percentage, sacrifice flies and on base percentage.

The Spartan offense is led by a pair of hitters who are above the .395 mark. L.J. Kalawaia (Wailuku, Hawai'i/Ohlone College) and Ben Spitznagel (Cincinnati, Ohio/Wabash Valley CC) have hit .401, and .396 respectively. Spitznagel is second in the NCAA with 88 hits, Kalawaia is 12th with 381. Collin Woody (Tampa, Fla./College of Central Florida) is 19th in the nation with 79 hits, but leads the NCAA with 11 sacrifice flies, while placing seventh in the NCAA with 63 RBI. Kalawaia ranks tenth in the NCAA with 61 RBI, as well as leading UNCG with 22 stolen bases. (Rankings as of May 16th)

Four different players rank in the top 18 in runs scored this year. Kalawaia ranks eighth with 59, Spitznagel and Woody are tied at sixth with 57 runs scored, Dillon Stewart (Dunn, N.C./Brunswick CC) is 18th at 56. Stewart leads the Spartans with 11 home runs this year. Woody has hit 10 out of the ballpark, with three others hitting at least five home runs this year. Jake Kusz (Durham, N.C./Riverside) has hit eight, Cesar Trejo (Greensboro, N.C./Ragsdale) has seven, Kalawaia has hit six and Ryne Sigmon (Danville, Va./Danville CC) has had five leave the yard this season.

UNCG has four players in the top 38 of RBI producers, the most of any NCAA Division I institution. Woody and Kalawaia are fighting for the top spot on the UNCG squad, at 63 and

UNCG is currently 24-3 in games played at the UNCG Baseball Stadium. The Spartans will play 30 of the 56 regular season games at the UNCG Baseball Stadium. Last season, UNCG only managed 13 wins in front of the home fans. The 24 wins are the most home wins in a season since 2011, with UNCG went 23-11 at home before vacating wins due to NCAA violations.

Johnny Bench Watch List

UNCG catcher Jake Kusz was named to the Johnny Bench Award Watch List earlier this season. The Greater Wichita Area Sports Commission announced the official watch list on March 8th. The watch list will be narrowed down on May 18th before the final vote occurs during the College World Series. 75 players were named to the list, four of which play for SoCon teams.

This season, Kusz has hit for a .275 average, with 15 doubles and eight home runs. The junior catcher has driven in 47 runs on the year. Defensively, Kusz has allowed just seven passed balls this season, while being able to catch 10 runners attempting to steal bases. Kusz has made only two errors this season, and has a team-best .995 fielding percentage for players with over 100 chances.

Oh Captain, My Captain

Head Coach Link Jarrett announced the captains of the 2016 UNCG Baseball team prior to the start of the season. L.J. Kalawaia, Collin Woody, Hunter Smith and Jake Kusz have earned the right to be called captain this season. The four receive this honor after a vote conducted of the UNCG baseball team.

Kalawaia and Woody are each seniors, while Smith and Kusz are juniors. Kalawaia received a redshirt after suffering a preseason injury in 2015. Smith is a redshirt junior, having sat out the 2015 season due to NCAA transfer rules.

Return to Action

The Spartans return to action on Wednesday May 25th for the first game of the Southern Conference Tournament in Greenville, S.C. The outcome of this weekend's series will determine which time and opponent UNCG will play in the SoCon Tournament at Fluor Field.
