Game time is set for 7 p.m. at the LJVM Coliseum ... UNCG brings a four-game winning streak into the game against the Demon Deacons ... Friday's game is set to air on the ACC Network Plus, ESPN3 and the ESPN App with Ty Collins and James Overstreet on the call ... The game will be radio streamed on TuneIn with Scott Pryzwansky and Darryl Kosciak on the call.

Series History ...

Friday's game marks the 11th meeting all-time between UNCG and Wake Forest ... The Spartans are 0-10 all-time against the Demon Deacons since moving to the NCAA Division I level in 1991 ... The Spartans played the Demon Deacons in their first-ever game at the Division I level, dropping an 87-59 contest.

The teams played a tough game last year in the Greensboro Coliseum, with the Spartans suffering a heart-breaking 78-75 contest to Wake Forest ... UNCG rallied from a 16-point second half deficit and tied the game at 75-75 with 28.6 seconds remaining on a basket by Diante Baldwin ... Wake Forest scored the game-winning basket on a deep 25-foot 3-pointer from Bryant Crawford with 2.0 seconds remaining to win the game for the Demon Deacons ... Former Spartan R.J. White led UNCG with 22 points in 27 minutes while Baldwin scored 18 points in the loss ... Former Wake Forest standout John Collins scored 17 points and grabbed 12 rebounds while Crawford added 17 points.

Turning Up The Defense ...

The Spartans have been a tough team to score against this season, holding opponents to just 51.4 points per game ... UNCG ranks first in the Southern Conference and third in NCAA Division I through five games ... The Spartans have not allowed more than 66 points in a game this season and are holding opponents to just 36.7 percent shooting from the field ... UNCG is coming of a 71-40 victory over Longwood, marking the lowest scoring output by an NCAA Division I opponent for the Spartans since Samford score 40 points in 2009.

Spartans Versus The ACC ...

UNCG will play three games against teams from the Atlantic Coast Conference teams this year, playing at Virginia, Wake Forest and NC State ... This marks the 15th straight season the Spartans have faced at least one ACC foe during the year ... Last season, UNCG played at home against Virginia, falling 76-51 and at home against Wake Forest falling 78-75 in the regular season ... UNCG also dropped a 90-77 contest in the first round of the National Invitation Tournament (NIT) at Syracuse ... The Spartans are 2-58 all-time against the ACC with their lone victories coming at Virginia Tech (2013) and at Georgia Tech (2007) ... Earlier this year, UNCG suffered a 60-48 loss at Virginia in its season opener.

Spanish Sensation . . .

Sophomore guard **Francis Alonso** became the 23rd player in UNCG men's basketball history to reach 1,000-career points, setting the mark last week against Delaware in fitting fashion on a 3-pointer coming off a screen ... Alonso enters Friday's game with 1,035 career points, ranking 20th in school history ... He surpassed Nicholas Paulos and Kevin Oleksiak last week and is just three points behind Nathan Jameson's 1,038 points ... Alonso scored 963 points in his first two seasons, scoring a freshman-record 443 points and pouring in 520 points as a sophomore ... Alonso's 963 points ranks second all-time in program history for a player through his sophomore season ... Only Kyle Hines, the school's all-time leading scorer, has scored more points in his first two seasons with 986 points.

Alonso was named to the preseason All-Southern Conference Team by both the league's head coaches and league's media ... He led the Spartans in scoring and ranked eighth in the league at 14.9 points per game ... He led the SoCon and ranked third in NCAA Division I last season hitting 46.2 percent from 3-point land ... He connected on 102-of-221 from deep, setting a UNCG single-season record for made 3-pointers ... He scored in double figures 25 times, including 10 games with 20 or more points.

Alonso Holds Record . . .

Junior guard **Francis Alonso** became the single-season record holder at UNCG for made 3-pointers last season with 102 makes ... He surpassed the previous record of 93 set by Scott Hartzell in 1994-95.

Last Time Out . . .

The Spartans posted their fourth-straight win Tuesday evening, downing Longwood 71-40 in the UNCG Spartan Classic ... The victory raised UNCG's record to 3-0 in the UNCG Spartan Classic with wins over North Carolina Wesleyan, Delaware and Longwood ... The Spartans held Longwood to a season-low 40 points and limited the Lancers to just 29.3 percent (12-of-41) shooting from the field and 26.7 percent (4-of-1) from 3-point land ... UNCG out-rebounded

Longwood by a 43-27 margin, the fifth time this year it has out-rebounded its opponent.

Junior guard **Francis Alonso** led three Spartans in double figures and 10 players on the score sheet with 16 points on 5-of-10 shooting from the field, including three 3-pointers ... Sophomore forward **Kyrin Galloway** came off the bench and scored 11 points and grabbed five rebounds on 4-of-6 shooting from the field.

Block Party . . .

Sophomore forward **James Dickey** leads the Southern Conference and ranks sixth in the nation with 17 blocked shots on the year ... Dickey is averaging 3.40 blocked shots per game, ranking 15th in the country ... Kyle Hines holds the UNCG single-season record with 106 blocks in 2004-05.

Owning The Glass . . .

The Spartans lead the Southern Conference in rebounding offense at 39.6 per game, rebounding defense at 26.8 per game and rebounding margin at +12.8 per game ... UNCG ranks 18th in the nation in rebounding margin and has out-rebounded all five opponents this year, including Virginia in the season opener.

Scouting The Spartans . . .

The Spartans enter Friday's game with a 4-1 overall record and have won four-straight games with wins over North Carolina Wesleyan, Ferrum College, Delaware and Longwood ... UNCG is averaging 75.0 points per game while holding opponents to just 51.4 points per game ... The Spartans are shooting 45.5 percent (133-of-292) from the field and 35.2 percent (50-of-142) from 3-point land ... UNCG is holding its opponents to just 36.7 percent shooting from the field (87-of-237) and 28.4 percent (25-of-88) from distance ... UNCG is out-rebounding opponents by a 39.6-26.8 margin.

Junior guard **Francis Alonso** leads the Spartans in scoring at 14.4 points per game ... Alonso is shooting 42.4 percent from 3-point land and has hit a team-high 14 3-pointers (14-33) ... He also ranks second on the team with 13 assists ... Senior forward **Marvin Smith** is second on the team in scoring at 13.2 points per game and ranks third on the team with 5.4 rebounds per game ... Smith is tied for the team lead with 14 made 3-pointers, hitting at 35.9 percent ... Sophomore **James Dickey** leads the team on the glass grabbing 8.6 rebounds per game while scoring 8.4 points per game ... Dickey leads the team with 17 blocked shots.

Freshman guard **Isaiah Miller** is fourth on the team in scoring at 7.2 points per game off the bench ... Sophomore **Kyrin Galloway** chips in 7.0 points per game and 4.8 rebounds per game ... Senior forward **Jordy Kuiper** is second on the team with 5.6 rebounds per game.

Scouting The Demon Deacons . . .

Wake Forest enters Friday's game with a 1-4 overall record ... The Demon Deacons have

dropped games to Georgia Souther, Liberty, Drake and Houston while defeating Quinnipiac ... Three of their four losses have come by five points or less ... Wake Forest is 0-2 at home this season and is beginning a three-game home stretch Friday ... The Demon Deacons are averaging 73.6 points per game while allowing 74.8 points per game ... Wake Forest is shooting 42.6 percent (123-of-289) from the field and 37 percent (44-of-119) from 3-point land ... Opponents are shooting 43.5 percent (128-of-294) from the field and 41.3 percent (52-of-126) from deep.

Bryant Crawford leads three Wake Forest players averaging double figures scoring at 16.8 points per game ... Crawford has hit 9-of-29 (31%) from 3-point land and is second on the team with 19 assists ... Keyshawn Woods is second on the team in scoring at 16.3 points per game and second on the team with eight made 3-pointers ... Chaundee Brown rounds out the double figure scorers at 10.6 points per game while adding 4.8 rebounds per game ... Doral Moore leads Wake Forest with 8.0 rebounds per game.

Alonso's Career-High ...

Junior guard **Francis Alonso** scored a career-high 32 points Monday night in UNCG's win over Delaware ... Alonso connected on 10-of-14 from the field, 8-of-10 from 3-point land and 4-of-4 from the free throw line ... His eight made 3-pointers are also a record ... His 32 points are the most for UNCG since Tevon Saddler scored 34 in 2013.

Cashing In On The Freebies ...

Junior guard **Francis Alonso** led the team with an 87.7 free throw percentage last season, connecting on 114-of-130 ... He ranked third in the Southern Conference and 29th in the nation ... During his three-year career, he is currently the all-time career holder for free throw percentage in UNCG history (minimum 150 attempts) at 86.4 percent (204-of-236) ... He is just ahead of David Whiteside (.860/202-of-235), Mikko Koivisto (.8564/185-of-216) and Nathan Jameson (.8560/214-of-250).

Spartans In Preseason Polls ...

UNCG won the 2017 Southern Conference regular season championship with a 14-4 league record, finishing tied with ETSU and Furman ... The Spartans held the top seed in the SoCon Tournament and advanced to the National Invitation Tournament (NIT) last year ... UNCG was picked to finish fifth in the preseason coaches' poll and third in the preseason media poll ... The Spartans earned 52 total votes in the coaches' poll while Mercer was chosen as preseason favorite with 71 votes, including four first-place votes narrowly edging out Samford with 70 votes (3 first-place votes) ... Furman was picked third with 65 votes and ETSU was fourth with 64 votes. Wofford (43), The Citadel (27), Chattanooga (27), Western Carolina (22) and VMI (9) round out coaches' poll.

In the media poll, the Spartans were picked third overall with 183 votes, just one vote out of second-place Samford (184) ... UNCG also picked up four first-place votes in the preseason media poll ... Furman was chosen by the media as the preseason favorite with 197 votes while ETSU was fourth (178) followed by Wofford (165), Mercer (154), Chattanooga (97), The Citadel (70), Western Carolina (66) and VMI (26).

Record-Setting Season ...

The Spartans are coming off one of their top seasons in program history last year ... UNCG set a single-season record with 25 wins, posting a 25-10 overall record ... The Spartans' 14-4 record in Southern Conference play also was a program-best in league play ... UNCG posted three winning streaks of six games or more last year for the first time in program history ... The Spartans won their first-ever SoCon regular season overall championship and advanced to the postseason for the sixth time in program history and the second-straight season.

Fresh Faces ...

The Spartans welcome in two true freshmen in **Isaiah Miller** and **Kaleb Hunter**, along with one redshirt freshmen who sat out last season in **Kylia Sykes** ... Miller joins the Spartans after averaging 20.0 points, 6.0 rebounds and 3.1 steals per game as a senior as Newton High School ... Hunter joins the Spartans after averaging 24.0 points per game, 9.1 rebounds per game and 4.1 assists per game for Neuse Christian, leading the Lions to a 19-12 record and an Elite 8 appearance in the NCISSA championship.

Sykes redshirt last season and came to UNCG after leading St. John's College to the Washington Catholic Athletic Conference (WCAC) regular season title with a 30-5 overall record and a 16-2 mark in league play.

Transfer Rules ...

Junior Eric Hamilton transferred to UNCG from Wichita State this summer ... Hamilton will sit out the 2017-18 season due to NCAA transfer rules ... He will have two seasons of eligibility remaining starting in 2018-19.

Spartans Sign Two For 2018-19 ...

The Spartans announced the signings of **Angelo Allegri** and **Mohammed Abdulsalam** to National Letters of Intent Thursday ... Both Allegri and Abdulsalam will join the Spartans as freshman in the 2018-19 season ... Allegri is a 6-7, 203-pound wing from Kansas City, Mo., and will play his senior season at Link Year Prep School for coach Roberto Bergersen ... He spent the last two and a half years playing at St. Thomas Aquinas for coach John Rost and averaged 20.0 points and 7.0 rebounds per game as a junior ... He earned First Team All-State and First Team All-Eastern Kansas League honors last season ... Abdulsalam is a 6-9, 260-pound forward from Atlanta, Ga., and will play his senior season at Link Year Prep School ... He spent last season at Greenforest Christian Academy in Georgia for coach Larry Thompson ... He averaged 12.0 points per game and 10.0 rebounds per game for the Eagles, helping them post a 27-5 record last season as a junior.

Wes Miller is in his seventh season as the UNCG men's basketball coach in 2017-18 after taking over the reins of the program in December of 2011 on an interim basis. Miller has spent the last six years building a championship-mentality throughout the program and has laid the groundwork for future success.

Miller is coming off his most successful season at the helm of the Spartans in 2016-17, leading the Spartans the program's third Southern Conference regular season title in program history and the first-ever No. 1 seed in the SoCon Tournament. He guided UNCG to a program-record 25-10 overall record and a 14-4 mark in SoCon play.

The 25 wins are the most for UNCG in the 50-year history of men's basketball while the 14 wins are the most for the Spartans in their SoCon history and ties the program record for conference wins in a season. UNCG advanced to the SoCon Tournament Championship game for the third time in program history and the first time since 2005. The Spartans and ETSU played one of the best championship games in program history with UNCG falling in the final seconds.

Miller led the Spartans to their second-straight postseason appearance and just the fifth appearance in program history as UNCG earned the SoCon's automatic bid into the National Invitation Tournament (NIT). The Spartans made their second appearance all-time in the NIT and first since 2002 when they traveled to Atlantic Coast Conference foe Syracuse.

The 2016-17 Spartans set a program-record with a nine-game winning streak, the longest winning streak for UNCG at the NCAA Division I level. Additionally, the Spartans became the first UNCG team to post three winning streaks of at least six or more games. UNCG posted a 7-2 record on the road in SoCon play, marking the best record of any team on the road in league play that season and setting a new UNCG record for road wins in league play at the NCAA Division I level.

Miller also led the Spartans to individual success in 2016-17 with senior guard Diante Baldwin and sophomore guard Francis Alonso earning Second Team All-SoCon honors while senior center R.J. White was named Third Team All-SoCon. Alonso set a UNCG single-season record with 102 made 3-pointers while freshman forward James Dickey was named to the league's All-Freshman Team.

Miller, the 2012 Southern Conference Coach of the Year during his interim season, has led the Spartans to double digit wins in five out of the last six years breaking a streak of three straight seasons with eight or less wins (2008-2011). When he took over during the 2011-12 season, he led the Spartans to a 10-8 SoCon record and the SoCon North Division title as he was 11-11 overall that year.

In 2015-16, he led the Spartans to a 15-19 overall record – their highest win total since the 2007-08 season. He guided UNCG to just its fourth postseason appearance in program history as the Spartans took part in the College Basketball Invitational (CBI), advancing to the quarterfinals. UNCG picked up its first-ever postseason win in program history with a 69-65 win over Houston Baptist at home at the Greensboro Coliseum

The Spartans finished the regular season with a 10-8 record in SoCon play, matching their win total in the league from 2011-12. UNCG was especially strong at home posting a 12-4 record, the highest win total since moving to the Greensboro Coliseum and the top mark for home wins since the 2000-01 season (12-6).

Junior center R.J. White and classmate Diante Baldwin were named to the All-SoCon Team last season. White led the conference and ranked 13th in NCAA Division I in field goal percentage at 61.6 percent while Baldwin was the only player in the league to rank in the top 20 in scoring and rebounding while ranking in the top five in assists and steals. Freshman Francis Alonso also burst onto the scene in 2015-16, setting the UNCG single-season scoring record for a freshman with 443 points on his way to All-Freshman Team accolades.

In 2014-15, the Spartans were hit hard by injuries

from the outset of the year and played late in the year with just six available scholarship student-athletes. Despite the disadvantage, UNCG was still the only team in the SoCon with five different players averaging double figures in scoring, with four out of the five players set to return next year.

Additionally, the Spartans had two players join the illustrious 1,000-career point mark that season as junior Kayel Locke became the 19th member in early February and senior Nicholas Paulos joined the ranks later that month.

Miller led the Spartans to 14 wins in 2013-14, their highest-win total since 2007-08. Included in that mark was the program's first victory over an ACC school since 2007 and just their second victory all-time against the conference with a come-from-behind win at Virginia Tech. Freshman Tevon Saddler was named as the Southern Conference Player of the Year in 2013-14, the Spartans first such honor since Kyle Hines won the award in 2005.

Junior Kyle Cain was named First Team All-SoCon and Second Team All-Region last year. Cain became the second straight Spartan to sign a professional contract overseas, inking with Ramat Hasharon in Israel. Trevis Simpson is in his second year playing professionally in Greece after starring for the Spartans from 2011-2014.

Miller and his staff were very active on the recruiting trail in his first full season as the Spartans bringing in seven newcomers for the 2013-14 season, the first full recruiting class under Miller's tenure. The highly-touted class includes six freshmen and one transfer. The Spartans were aggressive in recruiting North Carolina where they signed three All-State selections, including Clay Byrd and Diante Baldwin.

Miller and his staff also built on their success recruiting from the Baltimore area as they signed the Maryland Player of the Year, Tevon Saddler, a year removed from signing another Baltimore area standout in top-returning scorer Kayel Locke.

Miller, who was the youngest head coach in NCAA Division I at the time of his hire, made the removal of the interim tag an easy decision as he was named the Southern Conference Coach of the Year after leading the Spartans to the SoCon North Division title at the end of the 2011-12 season.

Miller took control of the program Dec. 13, 2011 with the Spartans sitting at 2-8 and led them through one of the biggest turnarounds in program history. Miller guided the Spartans to an 11-11 record the rest of the season to finish with a 13-19 overall record, including a 10-8 mark in SoCon play.

The Spartans lost their first six games under Miller to fall to 2-14 on the season but the program made an 180-degree turnaround posting an 11-5 record down the stretch. UNCG posted a seven-game winning streak during league play, which included several dramatic victories. The Spartans carried that momentum into the conference tournament where they advanced to the SoCon semifinals for the first time since the 2007-08 season.

Miller, who also spent the 2010-11 season as an assistant coach at UNCG, is no stranger to the state of North Carolina. He played three seasons at the University of North Carolina and spent two seasons as an assistant coach at Elon and High Point. Miller also ran his own basketball camps in Charlotte and Greensboro for two summers.

In three seasons as a player at North Carolina under head coach and mentor Roy Williams, Miller helped the Tar Heels to the national championship in 2005, two Atlantic Coast Conference regular-season championships and one ACC Tournament title. He was team captain as a senior in 2006-07, leading UNC to 31 wins and the NCAA Elite 8 as well as the ACC regular-season and tournament titles, and a final No. 3 national ranking.

As a junior, Miller shot 44.1 percent from the 3-point line, which was seventh-best in a single season in the UNC record book. His 64 treys that season ranked eighth in the ACC. He earned the team's Defensive Player of the Year and Most Improved Player awards that season, as well.

A fan favorite at UNC, Miller authored a book entitled *The Road to Blue Heaven*, which was published as a diary of his experiences as a North Carolina basketball player. In addition to his success on the floor, Miller excelled off the court, earning ACC Academic Honor Roll recognition and the UNC Athletic Director's Scholar Athlete-Award. He earned his degree in political science from North Carolina in 2007.

Upon his graduation from North Carolina, Miller played one season of professional basketball for the London Capitals of the British Basketball League, where he averaged 19.6 points per game to rank eighth in the league.

Miller was a prep standout at the New Hampton School in New Hampshire. He earned a scholarship to James Madison University, where he played one season before transferring to North Carolina to become a walk-on for Roy Williams' squad.

Miller married the former Ashley Love in August 2011.
