The Spartans wrap up their three-game road trip Saturday afternoon as they travel to Big South Conference foe Liberty ... Game time is set for 1 p.m. at The Vines Center in Lynchburg, Va. ... The game will be broadcast on ESPN3 and the Big South Network with Ryan Clary and Kenn Blankenship on the call ... Additionally, the game will be radio broadcast on TuneIn with Scott Pryzwansky and Darryl Kosciak on the call.

Looking For Road Success . . .

The Spartans are closing out their three-game road swing Saturday and are in search of their first road win of the year ... UNCG is 0-3 on the road this year with losses at Virginia, Wake Forest and Presbyterian ... All three losses have come by a combined 20 points, including a last-second loss last time out to the Blue Hose ... Last season, UNCG posted an 8-5 record on the road last year but just a 1-3 mark in non-conference play with its lone win coming at Big South foe UNC Asheville.

Series History . . .

Saturday's game marks the 18th meeting all-time between UNCG and Liberty ... The Spartans hold a 9-8 record all-time against the Flames and have won three straight in the series ... UNCG has won eight out of the last 10 meetings dating back to the 1994-95 season ... The teams have played three times as non-conference foes with UNCG winning all three games ... UNCG won both games in a home-and-home series with wins in 2003 and 2004 by 74-63 and 74-79 margins, respectively ... The Spartans are 6-8 against the Flames as members of the Big South Conference.

Last year, the Spartans posted a 72-65 victory over Liberty on campus at Fleming Gymnasium ... UNCG and Liberty combined to shoot 59 free throws in the game with the Spartans hitting 25-of-36 from the charity stripe ... The free throws helped UNCG overcome a 5-of-17 (29.4%) shooting day from 3-point land ... Former Spartan R.J. White led the way with 16 points and nine rebounds ... Forward **Marvin Smith** added 17 points and six rebounds while guard **Francis Alonso** came off the bench to score 15 points, including 10-of-10 from the free throw line ... Caleb Homesley led the Flames with 18 points and 10 rebounds while Ray Chen came off the bench to score 14 points.

30-Something Scorer . . .

Junior guard **Francis Alonso** has scored over 30 points in two contests this season ... Alonso set a career-high with 32 points in the Spartans victory over Delaware ... Alonso connected on 10-of-14 from the field, 8-of-10 from 3-point land and 4-of-4 from the free throw line ... His eight made 3-pointers are also a record ... His 32 points are the most for UNCG since Tevon Saddler scored 34 in 2013.

He followed that up with a 31-point effort in the Spartans' loss at Wake Forest ... Alonso connected on 11-of-17 from the field and hit 7-of-10 from 3-point land in the game ... He becomes the first Spartan to score over 30 points in a game twice in a season since Kyle Hines scored over 30 points

High Scoring Game?...

Both UNCG and Liberty enter Saturday's game as one of the top defensive teams in the country in the early part of the season ... The Spartans rank 11th in NCAA Division I allowing just 58.9 points per game while the Flames rank 14th overall with 59.4 points per game allowed.

Block Party...

Sophomore forward **James Dickey** leads the Southern Conference and ranks 16th in the nation with 17 blocked shots on the year ... Dickey is averaging 2.43 blocked shots per game, ranking 29th in the country ... Kyle Hines holds the UNCG single-season record with 106 blocks in 2004-05.

Owning The Glass...

The Spartans are third the Southern Conference in rebounding offense at 36.0 per game and leads the SoCon in rebounding defense at 27.3 per game and rebounding margin at +8.7 per game ... UNCG ranks 32nd in the nation in rebounding margin and has out-rebounded six out of seven opponents with the lone exception coming out against Wake Forest.

Spanish Sensation...

Junior guard **Francis Alonso** became the 23rd player in UNCG men's basketball history to reach 1,000-career points, setting the mark against Delaware in fitting fashion on a 3-point-er coming off a screen ... Alonso enters Saturday's game with 1,082 career points, ranking 18th in school history ... He is just six points shy of 17th place.

Alonso scored 963 points in his first two seasons, scoring a freshman-record 443 points and pouring in 520 points as a sophomore ... Alonso's 963 points ranks second all-time in program history for a player through his sophomore season ... Only Kyle Hines, the school's all-time leading scorer, has scored more points in his first two seasons with 986 points ... Alonso was named to the preseason All-Southern Conference Team by both the league's head coaches and league's media ... He led the Spartans in scoring and ranked eighth in the league at 14.9 points per game ... He led the SoCon and ranked third in NCAA Division I last season hitting 46.2 percent from 3-point land ... He connected on 102-of-221 from deep, setting a UNCG single-season record for made 3-pointers ... He scored in double figures 25 times, including 10 games with 20 or more points.

Alonso Holds Record...

Junior guard **Francis Alonso** became the single-season record holder at UNCG for made 3-pointers last season with 102 makes ... He surpassed the previous record of 93 set by Scott Hartzell in 1994-95.

Last Time Out...

The Spartans suffered a last-second, buzzer-beating loss at Presbyterian Tuesday night by a 74-72 final ... The Blue Hose hit a game-winning falling down jump shot as time expired ... UNCG squandered a 15-point first half lead and a five-point lead with 1:19 remaining in the game ... Sophomore center **James Dickey** posted a double-double with a career-high 18 points and a season-high 13 rebounds ... Junior guard **Francis Alonso** added 16 points while classmate **Demetrius Troy** scored a season-high 15 points in the loss.

Scouting The Spartans...

The Spartans enter Saturday's game with a 4-3 overall record and have dropped their last two games at Wake Forest and at Presbyterian ... UNCG is 0-3 on the road this year and 4-0 at home this season ... The Spartans are averaging 74.6 points per game on offense and holding opponents to 58.9 points per game ... UNCG is out-rebounding opponents by a 36.0-27.3 margin this year ... The Spartans are shooting 46.4 percent (186-of-401) from the field and 38.2 percent (73-of-191) from 3-point land ... Opponents are shooting 42.6 percent (140-of-329) from the field and 33.3 percent (43-of-129) from deep.

Junior guard **Francis Alonso** leads the team and ranks third in the Southern Conference in scoring at 17.0 points per game ... Alonso leads the team with 24 made 3-pointers, hitting 48 percent from deep ... Senior forward **Marvin Smith** is second on the team in scoring at 11.6 points per game and third on the team grabbing 5.0 rebounds per game ... Smith is second on the team with 16 made 3-pointers.

Sophomore forward **James Dickey** leads the team and the SoCon on the glass grabbing 9.1 rebounds per game ... Dickey adds 9.3 points per game and is shooting 52.8 percent (28-of-53) from the field ... Junior guard **Demetrius Troy** chips in 7.6 points per game and leads the

team with 20 assists ... Troy has hit 11 3-pointers this year ... Senior forward **Jordy Kuiper** is second on the team with 5.1 rebounds per game.

Scouting The Flames ...

Liberty enters Saturday's game with a 5-2 overall record and a 4-2 mark at home this season ... The Flames have wins over Clarks Summit, Wake Forest, Quinnipiac, Toccoa Falls and Howard while dropping games to Mercer and Houston at home ... Liberty has won three-straight heading into Saturday's game ... The Flames are averaging 76.4 points per game while holding opponents to 59.4 points per game ... Liberty is shooting 47.6 percent (180-of-378) from the field and 36.2 percent (55-of-152) from 3-point land ... Opponents are shooting 41.2 percent (149-of-362) from the field and 30.9 percent (47-of-152) from deep.

Lovell Cabbil leads three Flames averaging double figures at 12.7 points per game while grabbing 4.6 rebounds per game ... Cabbil is shooting 92 percent (23-of-25) from the free throw line ... Scottie James is second on the team in scoring at 11.6 points per game while leading the team on the glass at 8.4 rebounds per game ... James is shooting 58 percent (29-of-50) from the field and has gone to the free throw line 25 times ... Georgie Pacheco-Ortiz rounds out the double figure scorers at 10.6 points per game and is shooting 92.9 percent (26-of-28) from the free throw line.

Cashing In On The Freebies ...

Junior guard **Francis Alonso** led the team with an 87.7 free throw percentage last season, connecting on 114-of-130 ... He ranked third in the Southern Conference and 29th in the nation ... During his three-year career, he is currently the all-time career holder for free throw percentage in UNCG history (minimum 150 attempts) at 86.8 percent (211-of-243) ... He is just ahead of David Whiteside (.860/202-of-235), Mikko Koivisto (.8564/185-of-216) and Nathan Jameson (.8560/214-of-250).

Spartans In Preseason Polls ...

UNCG won the 2017 Southern Conference regular season championship with a 14-4 league record, finishing tied with ETSU and Furman ... The Spartans held the top seed in the SoCon Tournament and advanced to the National Invitation Tournament (NIT) last year ... UNCG was picked to finish fifth in the preseason coaches' poll and third in the preseason media poll ... The Spartans earned 52 total votes in the coaches' poll while Mercer was chosen as preseason favorite with 71 votes, including four first-place votes narrowly edging out Samford with 70 votes (3 first-place votes) ... Furman was picked third with 65 votes and ETSU was fourth with 64 votes. Wofford (43), The Citadel (27), Chattanooga (27), Western Carolina (22) and VMI (9) round out coaches' poll.

In the media poll, the Spartans were picked third overall with 183 votes, just one vote out

of second-place Samford (184) ... UNCG also picked up four first-place votes in the preseason media poll ... Furman was chosen by the media as the preseason favorite with 197 votes while ETSU was fourth (178) followed by Wofford (165), Mercer (154), Chattanooga (97), The Citadel (70), Western Carolina (66) and VMI (26).

Record-Setting Season ...

The Spartans are coming off one of their top seasons in program history last year ... UNCG set a single-season record with 25 wins, posting a 25-10 overall record ... The Spartans' 14-4 record in Southern Conference play also was a program-best in league play ... UNCG posted three winning streaks of six games or more last year for the first time in program history ... The Spartans won their first-ever SoCon regular season overall championship and advanced to the postseason for the sixth time in program history and the second-straight season.

Fresh Faces ...

The Spartans welcome in two true freshmen in **Isaiah Miller** and **Kaleb Hunter**, along with one redshirt freshman who sat out last season in **Kylia Sykes** ... Miller joins the Spartans after averaging 20.0 points, 6.0 rebounds and 3.1 steals per game as a senior as Newton High School ... Hunter joins the Spartans after averaging 24.0 points per game, 9.1 rebounds per game and 4.1 assists per game for Neuse Christian, leading the Lions to a 19-12 record and an Elite 8 appearance in the NCISSA championship.

Sykes redshirt last season and came to UNCG

after leading St. John's College to the Washington Catholic Athletic Conference (WCAC) regular season title with a 30-5 overall record and a 16-2 mark in league play.

Transfer Rules ...

Junior Eric Hamilton transferred to UNCG from Wichita State this summer ... Hamilton will sit out the 2017-18 season due to NCAA transfer rules ... He will have two seasons of eligibility remaining starting in 2018-19.

Spartans Sign Two For 2018-19 ...

The Spartans announced the signings of **Angelo Allegri** and **Mohammed Abdulsalam** to National Letters of Intent Thursday ... Both Allegri and Abdulsalam will join the Spartans as freshman in the 2018-19 season ... Allegri is a 6-7, 203-pound wing from Kansas City, Mo., and will play his senior season at Link Year Prep School for coach Roberto Bergersen ... He spent the last two and a half years playing at St. Thomas Aquinas for coach John Rost and averaged 20.0 points and 7.0 rebounds per game as a junior ... He earned First Team All-State and First Team All-Eastern Kansas League honors last season ... Abdulsalam is a 6-9, 260-pound forward from Atlanta, Ga., and will play his senior season at Link Year Prep School ... He spent last season at Greenforest Christian Academy in Georgia for coach Larry Thompson ... He averaged 12.0 points per game and 10.0 rebounds per game for the Eagles, helping them post a 27-5 record last season as a junior.

HEAD COACH WES MILLER

Wes Miller is in his seventh season as the UNCG men's basketball coach in 2017-18 after taking over the reins of the program in December of 2011 on an interim basis. Miller has spent the last six years building a championship-mentality throughout the program and has laid the groundwork for future success.

Miller is coming off his most successful season at the helm of the Spartans in 2016-17, leading the Spartans the program's third Southern Conference regular season title in program history and the first-ever No. 1 seed in the SoCon Tournament. He guided UNCG to a program-record 25-10 overall record and a 14-4 mark in SoCon play.

The 25 wins are the most for UNCG in the 50-year history of men's basketball while the 14 wins are the most for the Spartans in their SoCon history and ties the program record for conference wins in a season. UNCG advanced to the SoCon Tournament Championship game for the third time in program history and the first time since 2005. The Spartans and ETSU played one of the best championship games in program history with UNCG falling in the final seconds.

Miller led the Spartans to their second-straight postseason appearance and just the fifth appearance in program history as UNCG earned the SoCon's automatic bid into the National Invitation Tournament (NIT). The Spartans made their second appearance all-time in the NIT and first since 2002 when they traveled to Atlantic Coast Conference foe Syracuse.

The 2016-17 Spartans set a program-record with a nine-game winning streak, the longest winning streak for UNCG at the NCAA Division I level. Additionally, the Spartans became the first UNCG team to post three winning streaks of at least six or more games. UNCG posted a 7-2 record on the road in SoCon play, marking the best record of any team on the road in league play that season and setting a new UNCG record for road wins in league play at the NCAA Division I level.

Miller also led the Spartans to individual success in 2016-17 with senior guard Diante Baldwin and sophomore guard Francis Alonso earning Second Team All-SoCon honors while senior center R.J. White was named Third Team All-SoCon. Alonso set a UNCG single-season record with 102 made 3-pointers while freshman forward James Dickey was named to the league's All-Freshman Team.

Miller, the 2012 Southern Conference Coach of the Year during his interim season, has led the Spartans to double digit wins in five out of the last six years breaking a streak of three straight seasons with eight or less wins (2008-2011). When he took over during the 2011-12 season, he led the Spartans to a 10-8 SoCon record and the SoCon North Division title as he was 11-11 overall that year.

In 2015-16, he led the Spartans to a 15-19 overall record – their highest win total since the 2007-08 season. He guided UNCG to just its fourth postseason appearance in program history as the Spartans took part in the College Basketball Invitational (CBI), advancing to the quarterfinals. UNCG picked up its first-ever postseason win in program history with a 69-65 win over Houston Baptist at home at the Greensboro Coliseum

The Spartans finished the regular season with a 10-8 record in SoCon play, matching their win total in the league from 2011-12. UNCG was especially strong at home posting a 12-4 record, the highest win total since moving to the Greensboro Coliseum and the top mark for home wins since the 2000-01 season (12-6).

Junior center R.J. White and classmate Diante Baldwin were named to the All-SoCon Team last season. White led the conference and ranked 13th in NCAA Division I in field goal percentage at 61.6 percent while Baldwin was the only player in the league to rank in the top 20 in scoring and rebounding while ranking in the top five in assists and steals. Freshman Francis Alonso also burst onto the scene in 2015-16, setting the UNCG single-season scoring record for a freshman with 443 points on his way to All-Freshman Team accolades.

In 2014-15, the Spartans were hit hard by injuries

from the outset of the year and played late in the year with just six available scholarship student-athletes. Despite the disadvantage, UNCG was still the only team in the SoCon with five different players averaging double figures in scoring, with four out of the five players set to return next year.

Additionally, the Spartans had two players join the illustrious 1,000-career point mark that season as junior Kayel Locke became the 19th member in early February and senior Nicholas Paulos joined the ranks later that month.

Miller led the Spartans to 14 wins in 2013-14, their highest-win total since 2007-08. Included in that mark was the program's first victory over an ACC school since 2007 and just their second victory all-time against the conference with a come-from-behind win at Virginia Tech. Freshman Tevon Saddler was named as the Southern Conference Player of the Year in 2013-14, the Spartans first such honor since Kyle Hines won the award in 2005.

Junior Kyle Cain was named First Team All-SoCon and Second Team All-Region last year. Cain became the second straight Spartan to sign a professional contract overseas, inking with Ramat Hasharon in Israel. Trevis Simpson is in his second year playing professionally in Greece after starring for the Spartans from 2011-2014.

Miller and his staff were very active on the recruiting trail in his first full season as the Spartans bringing in seven newcomers for the 2013-14 season, the first full recruiting class under Miller's tenure. The highly-touted class includes six freshmen and one transfer. The Spartans were aggressive in recruiting North Carolina where they signed three All-State selections, including Clay Byrd and Diante Baldwin.

Miller and his staff also built on their success recruiting from the Baltimore area as they signed the Maryland Player of the Year, Tevon Saddler, a year removed from signing another Baltimore area standout in top-returning scorer Kayel Locke.

Miller, who was the youngest head coach in NCAA Division I at the time of his hire, made the removal of the interim tag an easy decision as he was named the Southern Conference Coach of the Year after leading the Spartans to the SoCon North Division title at the end of the 2011-12 season.

Miller took control of the program Dec. 13, 2011 with the Spartans sitting at 2-8 and led them through one of the biggest turnarounds in program history. Miller guided the Spartans to an 11-11 record the rest of the season to finish with a 13-19 overall record, including a 10-8 mark in SoCon play.

The Spartans lost their first six games under Miller to fall to 2-14 on the season but the program made an 180-degree turnaround posting an 11-5 record down the stretch. UNCG posted a seven-game winning streak during league play, which included several dramatic victories. The Spartans carried that momentum into the conference tournament where they advanced to the SoCon semifinals for the first time since the 2007-08 season.

Miller, who also spent the 2010-11 season as an assistant coach at UNCG, is no stranger to the state of North Carolina. He played three seasons at the University of North Carolina and spent two seasons as an assistant coach at Elon and High Point. Miller also ran his own basketball camps in Charlotte and Greensboro for two summers.

In three seasons as a player at North Carolina under head coach and mentor Roy Williams, Miller helped the Tar Heels to the national championship in 2005, two Atlantic Coast Conference regular-season championships and one ACC Tournament title. He was team captain as a senior in 2006-07, leading UNC to 31 wins and the NCAA Elite 8 as well as the ACC regular-season and tournament titles, and a final No. 3 national ranking.

As a junior, Miller shot 44.1 percent from the 3-point line, which was seventh-best in a single season in the UNC record book. His 64 treys that season ranked eighth in the ACC. He earned the team's Defensive Player of the Year and Most Improved Player awards that season, as well.

A fan favorite at UNC, Miller authored a book entitled *The Road to Blue Heaven*, which was published as a diary of his experiences as a North Carolina basketball player. In addition to his success on the floor, Miller excelled off the court, earning ACC Academic Honor Roll recognition and the UNC Athletic Director's Scholar Athlete-Award. He earned his degree in political science from North Carolina in 2007.

Upon his graduation from North Carolina, Miller played one season of professional basketball for the London Capitals of the British Basketball League, where he averaged 19.6 points per game to rank eighth in the league.

Miller was a prep standout at the New Hampton School in New Hampshire. He earned a scholarship to James Madison University, where he played one season before transferring to North Carolina to become a walk-on for Roy Williams' squad.

Miller married the former Ashley Love in August 2011.
