What's On Tap . . .

The Spartans continue their recent home stretch Wednesday night as UNCG plays its second of four-straight games against in-state foes when it welcomes in UNCW to the Greensboro Coliseum ... The Spartans and Seahawks will tip-off Wednesday at 7 p.m. and the game will be broadcast on ESPN3 and the ESPN App with Scott Pryzwansky and Darryl Kosciak on the call.

Home Cooking . . .

The Spartans are 5-0 at home this season, including 3-0 at home at the Greensboro Coliseum ... The Spartans posted home wins over Delaware, Longwood and Elon at the Coliseum while picking up wins over North Carolina Wesleyan and Ferrum College on campus at Fleming Gymnasium ... In the Spartans' three games in the Greensboro Coliseum this year against NCAA Division I foes, they are out-scoring opponents by a 75.0-50.00 margin ... UNCG is shooting 47.1 percent (82-of-174) from the field and 39.3 percent (35-of-89) from 3-point land at the Coliseum compared to just 37.3 percent (53-of-142) from the field and 23.7 percent (14-of-59) from distance for its opponents ... Eight different Spartans average at least 5.0 points per game this season in the Greensboro Coliseum with **Francis Alonso** leading the way at 18.7 points per game.

Last year, UNCG recorded a 13-4 record at home marking the most home wins in a single season in program history ... Since the 2015-16 season, the Spartans are 30-8 at home, good for a 78.9 winning percentage.

Winning With Defense . . .

The Spartans enter Wednesday's game leading the Southern Conference and ranking fifth in the nation in scoring defense, holding opponents to just 59.0 points per game ... This is a vast improvement over last year's team, which finished the year allowing 69.3 points per game ... The Spartans are holding opponents to 28.3 percent (51-of-180) shooting from 3-point land, ranking 21st in the nation, and 40.4 percent (176-of-436) shooting from the field to rank 67th in the country ... In five out of the Spartans' six wins this year, UNCG has held opponents under 40 percent shooting from the field ... In six out of nine total games, the Spartans have held opponents under 30 percent shooting from 3-point land.

Series History . . .

UNCG and UNCW have met six times prior to Wednesday's meeting ... The teams have split the first six meetings, 3-3 ... UNCW has won the last two matchups, posting an 84-72 victory at the Greensboro Coliseum in 2014 and an 87-73 victory in Wilmington in 2012 ... The Spartans won three-straight in the series with wins in the 2007-08, 2006-07 and 1991-92 seasons ... UNCG won home games in that span in 2006 and 1991 ... The teams first met November 23, 1990 with the Seahawks posted a 69-51 victory.

Last Time Out . . .

The Spartans turned in one of their top all-around performances of the season last week, dominating Elon 75-44 defensively to snap a 12-game losing streak to the Phoenix ... UNCG held Elon to just 34.7 percent (17-of-49) shooting from the field and only 14.3 percent (4-of-28) from 3-point land in the victory, holding the Phoenix to their lowest scoring total since 2010 ... The Spartans posted 13 steals and

forced 16 turnovers on the night, turning those miscues into 14 points ... Eight different Spartans scored at least seven points in the balanced attack ... Senior forward **Marvin Smith** and freshman guard **Isaiah Miller** led the way with 12 points each in 21 and 19 minutes, respectively ... Sophomore forward **James Dickey** posted nine points and eight rebounds while **Francis Alonso**, **Demetrius Troy** and **Malik Massey** each scored eight points.

Triple Overtime Thriller ...

The Spartans posted a thrilling, come-from-behind triple overtime victory Dec. 2 at Liberty by a 76-75 margin ... The game marked just the second triple overtime game in UNCG basketball history and the first-ever win by the Spartans in triple overtime ... UNCG's only other game to reach three extra sessions game February 28, 2004 with a 112-108 loss at Elon.

Saturday, the Spartans overcame a 11-point second half effort and trailed by seven points with 1:37 remaining ... Junior guard **Francis Alonso** scored a career-high 36 points and was clutch late in the game, hitting three last-second shots to either extend the game or win the game ... Alonso hit the game-winning shot with 2.4 second left in triple overtime ... He also hit game-tying 3-pointers in the final seconds at the end of regulation and at the end of the second overtime to keep the Spartans alive ... Alonso shook off a slow start, scoring 31 of his 36 points after halftime, finishing the night shooting 10-of-31 from the field, 7-of-19 from 3-point land and 9-of-11 from the free throw line ... His 36 points are the most for a Spartan since Trevis Simpson scored 41 points in 2013 ... Alonso earned Southern Conference Player of the Week honors for his play against the Flames. Freshman guard **Isaiah Miller** was the only other Spartan in double figure scoring Saturday, adding 13 points, six rebounds and five steals off the bench before fouling out.

30-Something Scorer ...

Junior guard **Francis Alonso** has scored over 30 points in three contests this season after not reaching the mark in his first two seasons at UNCG ... Alonso set a then career-high with 32 points in the Spartans victory over Delaware ... Alonso connected on 10-of-14 from the field, 8-of-10 from 3-point land and 4-of-4 from the free throw line ... His eight made 3-pointers are also a record ... His 32 points are the most for UNCG since Tevon Saddler scored 34 in 2013.

He followed that up with a 31-point effort in the Spartans' loss at Wake Forest ... Alonso connected on 11-of-17 from the field and hit 7-of-10 from 3-point land in the game ... Alonso set a new career-high with 36 points in the victory Saturday over Liberty ... He earned Southern Conference Player of the Week honors for his play against the Flames.

He becomes the first Spartan to score over 30 points in a game three times in a season since Kyle Hines scored over 30 points three times in 2006-07 ... Hines scored 30 or more five times that season and scored over 30 points three times that year.

Block Party ...

Sophomore forward **James Dickey** leads the Southern Conference and ranks 45th in the nation with 20 blocked shots on the year ... Dickey is averaging 2.22 blocked shots per game, ranking 42nd in the country ... Kyle Hines holds the UNCG single-season record with 106 blocks in 2004-05.

Owning The Glass ...

The Spartans are second the Southern Conference in rebounding offense at 37.2 per game and second the SoCon in rebounding defense at 30.1 per game ... UNCG leads the league in rebounding margin at +7.1 per game, ranking 46th in the nation ... Sophomore forward **James Dickey** leads the SoCon and ranks 41st in nation on the glass, grabbing 9.6 rebounds per game ... Dickey leads the league and ranks 10th in the country with 3.89 offensive rebounds per game

Spanish Sensation ...

Junior guard **Francis Alonso** became the 23rd player in UNCG men's basketball history to reach 1,000-career points, setting the mark against Delaware in fitting fashion on a 3-pointer coming off a screen ... Alonso enters Wednesday's game with 1,126 career points, ranking 17th in school history ... He surpassed Ronnie Burrell for 17th Saturday afternoon with his 36-point effort ... He is just 11 points shy of Derrick Nix for 16th place.

Alonso scored 963 points in his first two seasons, scoring a freshman-record 443 points and pouring in 520 points as a sophomore ... Alonso's 963 points ranks second all-time in program history for a player through his sophomore season ... Only Kyle Hines, the school's all-time leading scorer, has scored more points in his first two seasons with 986 points ... Alonso was named to the preseason All-Southern Conference Team by both the league's head coaches and league's media.

Alonso Holds Record ...

Junior guard **Francis Alonso** became the single-season record holder at UNCG for made 3-pointers last season with 102 makes ... He surpassed the previous record of 93 set by Scott Hartzell in 1994-95.

This season, he ranks second in the Southern Conference and 12th in the nation with 3.67 3-point field goals per game ... He is second in the league and ranks 31st in the country with 75 total 3-point attempts on the year.

Scouting The Spartans ...

UNCG enters Wednesday's game with a 6-3 overall record after winning back-to-back games over Liberty and Elon ... The Spartans are 5-0 at home this season, including 3-0 at the Greensboro Coliseum ... UNCG is averaging 74.8 points per game while holding opponents to just 59.0 points per game ... The Spartans are shooting 44.8 percent (241-of-538) from the field and 36.3 percent (94-of-259) from 3-point land ... Opponents are shooting 40.4 percent (176-of-436) from the field and 28.3 percent (51-of-180) from 3-point land.

Junior guard **Francis Alonso** lead the offensive attack with 18.1 points per game ... Alonso is shooting 44 percent (33-of-75) from 3-point land and is hitting 86.7 percent (26-of-30) from the free throw line ... He also leads the team with 28 assists and is fourth with 10 steals ... Senior forward **Marvin Smith** is second on the team in scoring at 10.3 points per game while grabbing 4.1 rebounds per game ... Smith is second on the team with 18 made 3-pointers and leads the team hitting 94.4 percent (17-of-18) from the free throw line.

Sophomore forward **James Dickey** leads the team and the Southern Conference on the glass with 9.6 rebounds per game ... Dickey is adding 8.9 points per game while shooting 51.6 percent (33-of-64) from the field ... Freshman guard **Isaiah Miller** is fourth on the team in scoring at 7.4 points per game while shooting 53.7 percent (29-of-54) from the field ... Junior guard **Demetrius Troy** adds 7.3 points per game and 22 assists on the season.

Scouting The Seahawks ...

UNCW enters Wednesday's game with a 2-5 overall record, having dropped four-straight games with losses to Loyola Chicago, Valparaiso, East Carolina and LSU -- all away from home ... The Seahawks' two victories this year have come against North Carolina Wesleyan and Campbell ... UNCW is 0-3 on the road this year and 0-5 away from home ... The Seahawks are averaging 84.9 points per game but are allowing 92.0 points per game, having allowed 100-plus points on two occasions (Davidson & Loyola Chicago) ... UNCW is shooting 45.1 percent (215-of-477) from the field and 36.5 percent (61-of-167) from deep ... Opponents are shooting 50.2 percent (228-of-454) from the field and 41.4 percent (65-of-157) from 3-point land.

Devontae Cacok leads the Seahawks in scoring at 18.0 points per game and on the glass at 11.7 rebounds per game ... Cacok is shooting 63 percent (51-of-81) from the field and has gone to the free throw line a team-high 38 times ... Jordan Talley is second on the team in scoring at 176 points per game and leads the team with 53 assists ... Talley has hit a team-high 18 3-pointers.

Ty Taylor is third on the team in scoring at 12.7 points per game while adding 4.3 rebounds per game ... Taylor is second on the team with 14 3-pointers ... Jaylen Fornes rounds out the double figure scoring at 10.4 points per game and has hit 10 3-pointers.

Cashing In On The Freebies ...

Junior guard **Francis Alonso** led the team with an 87.7 free throw percentage last season, connecting on 114-of-130 ... He ranked third in the Southern Conference and 29th in the nation ... During his three-year career, he is currently the all-time career holder for free throw percentage in UNCG history (minimum 150 attempts) at 86.8 percent (211-of-243) ... He is just ahead of David Whiteside (.860/202-of-235), Mikko Koivisto (.8564/185-of-216) and Nathan Jameson (.8560/214-of-250).

Spartans In Preseason Polls ...

UNCG won the 2017 Southern Conference regular season championship with a 14-4 league record, finishing tied with ETSU and Furman ... UNCG was picked to finish fifth in the preseason coaches' poll and third in the preseason media poll ... The Spartans earned 52 total votes in the coaches' poll while Mercer was chosen as preseason favorite with 71 votes, including four first-place votes narrowly edging out Samford with 70 votes (3 first-place votes) ... Furman was picked third with 65 votes and ETSU was fourth with 64 votes. Wofford (43), The Citadel (27), Chattanooga (27), Western Carolina (22) and VMI (9) round out coaches' poll.

In the media poll, the Spartans were picked third overall with 183 votes, just one vote out of second-place Samford (184) ... UNCG also picked up

four first-place votes in the preseason media poll ... Furman was chosen by the media as the preseason favorite with 197 votes while ETSU was fourth (178) followed by Wofford (165), Mercer (154), Chattanooga (97), The Citadel (70), Western Carolina (66) and VMI (26).

Record-Setting Season ...

The Spartans are coming off one of their top seasons in program history last year ... UNCG set a single-season record with 25 wins, posting a 25-10 overall record ... The Spartans' 14-4 record in Southern Conference play also was a program-best in league play ... UNCG posted three winning streaks of six games or more last year for the first time in program history ... The Spartans won their first-ever SoCon regular season overall championship and advanced to the postseason for the sixth time in program history and the second-straight season.

Off The Bench ...

Freshman guard **Isaiah Miller** is averaging 7.4 points per game off the bench this season and has been an offensive spark for the Spartans ... He scored 13 points in 24 minutes last time out against Liberty before fouling out ... He is second on the team with 13 steals despite playing only 14.7 minutes per game ... He is coming off a 12-point performance against Elon, hitting 5-of-7 from the field.

Transfer Rules ...

Junior Eric Hamilton transferred to UNCG from Wichita State this summer ... Hamilton will sit out the 2017-18 season due to NCAA transfer rules ... He will have two seasons of eligibility remaining starting in 2018-19.

Wes Miller is in his seventh season as the UNCG men's basketball coach in 2017-18 after taking over the reins of the program in December of 2011 on an interim basis. Miller has spent the last six years building a championship-mentality throughout the program and has laid the groundwork for future success.

Miller is coming off his most successful season at the helm of the Spartans in 2016-17, leading the Spartans the program's third Southern Conference regular season title in program history and the first-ever No. 1 seed in the SoCon Tournament. He guided UNCG to a program-record 25-10 overall record and a 14-4 mark in SoCon play.

The 25 wins are the most for UNCG in the 50-year history of men's basketball while the 14 wins are the most for the Spartans in their SoCon history and ties the program record for conference wins in a season. UNCG advanced to the SoCon Tournament Championship game for the third time in program history and the first time since 2005. The Spartans and ETSU played one of the best championship games in program history with UNCG falling in the final seconds.

Miller led the Spartans to their second-straight postseason appearance and just the fifth appearance in program history as UNCG earned the SoCon's automatic bid into the National Invitation Tournament (NIT). The Spartans made their second appearance all-time in the NIT and first since 2002 when they traveled to Atlantic Coast Conference foe Syracuse.

The 2016-17 Spartans set a program-record with a nine-game winning streak, the longest winning streak for UNCG at the NCAA Division I level. Additionally, the Spartans became the first UNCG team to post three winning streaks of at least six or more games. UNCG posted a 7-2 record on the road in SoCon play, marking the best record of any team on the road in league play that season and setting a new UNCG record for road wins in league play at the NCAA Division I level.

Miller also led the Spartans to individual success in 2016-17 with senior guard Diante Baldwin and sophomore guard Francis Alonso earning Second Team All-SoCon honors while senior center R.J. White was named Third Team All-SoCon. Alonso set a UNCG single-season record with 102 made 3-pointers while freshman forward James Dickey was named to the league's All-Freshman Team.

Miller, the 2012 Southern Conference Coach of the Year during his interim season, has led the Spartans to double digit wins in five out of the last six years breaking a streak of three straight seasons with eight or less wins (2008-2011). When he took over during the 2011-12 season, he led the Spartans to a 10-8 SoCon record and the SoCon North Division title as he was 11-11 overall that year.

In 2015-16, he led the Spartans to a 15-19 overall record – their highest win total since the 2007-08 season. He guided UNCG to just its fourth postseason appearance in program history as the Spartans took part in the College Basketball Invitational (CBI), advancing to the quarterfinals. UNCG picked up its first-ever postseason win in program history with a 69-65 win over Houston Baptist at home at the Greensboro Coliseum

The Spartans finished the regular season with a 10-8 record in SoCon play, matching their win total in the league from 2011-12. UNCG was especially strong at home posting a 12-4 record, the highest win total since moving to the Greensboro Coliseum and the top mark for home wins since the 2000-01 season (12-6).

Junior center R.J. White and classmate Diante Baldwin were named to the All-SoCon Team last season. White led the conference and ranked 13th in NCAA Division I in field goal percentage at 61.6 percent while Baldwin was the only player in the league to rank in the top 20 in scoring and rebounding while ranking in the top five in assists and steals. Freshman Francis Alonso also burst onto the scene in 2015-16, setting the UNCG single-season scoring record for a freshman with 443 points on his way to All-Freshman Team accolades.

In 2014-15, the Spartans were hit hard by injuries

from the outset of the year and played late in the year with just six available scholarship student-athletes. Despite the disadvantage, UNCG was still the only team in the SoCon with five different players averaging double figures in scoring, with four out of the five players set to return next year.

Additionally, the Spartans had two players join the illustrious 1,000-career point mark that season as junior Kayel Locke became the 19th member in early February and senior Nicholas Paulos joined the ranks later that month.

Miller led the Spartans to 14 wins in 2013-14, their highest-win total since 2007-08. Included in that mark was the program's first victory over an ACC school since 2007 and just their second victory all-time against the conference with a come-from-behind win at Virginia Tech. Freshman Tevon Saddler was named as the Southern Conference Player of the Year in 2013-14, the Spartans first such honor since Kyle Hines won the award in 2005.

Junior Kyle Cain was named First Team All-SoCon and Second Team All-Region last year. Cain became the second straight Spartan to sign a professional contract overseas, inking with Ramat Hasharon in Israel. Trevis Simpson is in his second year playing professionally in Greece after starring for the Spartans from 2011-2014.

Miller and his staff were very active on the recruiting trail in his first full season as the Spartans bringing in seven newcomers for the 2013-14 season, the first full recruiting class under Miller's tenure. The highly-touted class includes six freshmen and one transfer. The Spartans were aggressive in recruiting North Carolina where they signed three All-State selections, including Clay Byrd and Diante Baldwin.

Miller and his staff also built on their success recruiting from the Baltimore area as they signed the Maryland Player of the Year, Tevon Saddler, a year removed from signing another Baltimore area standout in top-returning scorer Kayel Locke.

Miller, who was the youngest head coach in NCAA Division I at the time of his hire, made the removal of the interim tag an easy decision as he was named the Southern Conference Coach of the Year after leading the Spartans to the SoCon North Division title at the end of the 2011-12 season.

Miller took control of the program Dec. 13, 2011 with the Spartans sitting at 2-8 and led them through one of the biggest turnarounds in program history. Miller guided the Spartans to an 11-11 record the rest of the season to finish with a 13-19 overall record, including a 10-8 mark in SoCon play.

The Spartans lost their first six games under Miller to fall to 2-14 on the season but the program made an 180-degree turnaround posting an 11-5 record down the stretch. UNCG posted a seven-game winning streak during league play, which included several dramatic victories. The Spartans carried that momentum into the conference tournament where they advanced to the SoCon semifinals for the first time since the 2007-08 season.

Miller, who also spent the 2010-11 season as an assistant coach at UNCG, is no stranger to the state of North Carolina. He played three seasons at the University of North Carolina and spent two seasons as an assistant coach at Elon and High Point. Miller also ran his own basketball camps in Charlotte and Greensboro for two summers.

In three seasons as a player at North Carolina under head coach and mentor Roy Williams, Miller helped the Tar Heels to the national championship in 2005, two Atlantic Coast Conference regular-season championships and one ACC Tournament title. He was team captain as a senior in 2006-07, leading UNC to 31 wins and the NCAA Elite 8 as well as the ACC regular-season and tournament titles, and a final No. 3 national ranking.

As a junior, Miller shot 44.1 percent from the 3-point line, which was seventh-best in a single season in the UNC record book. His 64 treys that season ranked eighth in the ACC. He earned the team's Defensive Player of the Year and Most Improved Player awards that season, as well.

A fan favorite at UNC, Miller authored a book entitled *The Road to Blue Heaven*, which was published as a diary of his experiences as a North Carolina basketball player. In addition to his success on the floor, Miller excelled off the court, earning ACC Academic Honor Roll recognition and the UNC Athletic Director's Scholar Athlete-Award. He earned his degree in political science from North Carolina in 2007.

Upon his graduation from North Carolina, Miller played one season of professional basketball for the London Capitals of the British Basketball League, where he averaged 19.6 points per game to rank eighth in the league.

Miller was a prep standout at the New Hampton School in New Hampshire. He earned a scholarship to James Madison University, where he played one season before transferring to North Carolina to become a walk-on for Roy Williams' squad.

Miller married the former Ashley Love in August 2011.

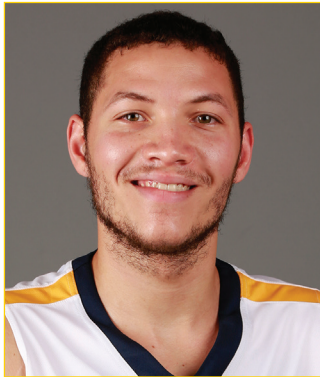

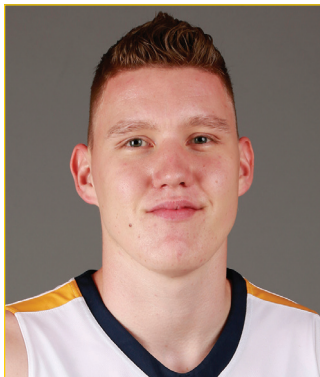
