- During head coach Link Jarrett's seven-year tenure with the Spartans, which began in 2013, he has witnessed 15 players selected in the Major League Baseball Draft.

QUICK HITS (vs. PENN)

► This marks the first-ever meeting between Penn and UNC Greensboro. The Quakers are a combined 21-22-3 against teams that hail from North Carolina, dating back to a matchup between the Quakers and UNC in 1897.

► While UNCG has not faced off against Brown, Dartmouth or Penn, prior to this weekend, they have played a combined 40 games against Columbia (1x), Cornell, (3x), Harvard (5x), Princeton (26x) and Yale (5x). The Spartans, who are 24-15-1 all-time against these schools, have played 39 of the 40 games in Greensboro. The lone exception coming in 2015, when UNCG squared off against Columbia in Wilmington, N.C.

► In their 40 meetings against Ivy League teams, the Spartans have outscored their opponents 309-165, averaging 7.7 runs per contest along the way. UNCG has eclipsed double-digit runs on 15 occasions, including a 16-run output against Princeton on March 8, 2015, under Link Jarrett, that marks the most runs by a UNCG team against an Ivy League opponent. There have been six extra-inning affairs with Ivy League schools and UNCG is 2-4 in those contests, winning a 12-inning game under Jarrett on March 14, 2014 against Princeton most recently.

► UNCG and Penn share two common opponents on their 2019 schedules—Winthrop and Princeton. The Spartans will face Winthrop twice, on March 5 and May 14, before facing Princeton in a four-game set on March 8-10, which includes a doubleheader on March 9. The Quakers head to Rock Hill, S.C., to face the Eagles on March 8-10 and will face Princeton in a three-game series April 13-14, with a doubleheader on April 13.

► Penn was picked to finish fourth in the 2019 Ivy League preseason poll. The Quakers last won the Ivy League Championship in 1995, and their last appearance in the best-of-three Ivy Championship Series was in 2017. Penn was swept in two games by Yale.

► The Quakers return all four of their All-Ivy selections from last year including first-team selections Matt McGeagh and Eduardo Malinowski, and second-team selections Peter Matt and Phelan. Penn also returns seven of its starting field players from the 2018 season and ten letterwinners.

SPARTANS TABBED SECOND IN PRESEASON POLLS: One year after winning the Southern Conference regular season title, the UNC Greensboro baseball team was picked second in the 2019 preseason coaches and media polls that were released on Thursday, Feb. 7.

The Spartans, who won their second regular season league title in program history since joining the Southern Conference in 1998, were 39-15 overall and 18-3 in conference action a season ago. UNCG has posted at least 35 wins in three straight seasons for the first time in program history. After earning wins in two elimination games in as many days, the Spartans season came to a close at the 2018 SoCon Tournament with an 8-4 setback to Western Carolina.

ster was named as the league's Preseason Player of the Year and teammate Austin Embler was selected First Team Preseason All-SoCon in a vote by the panelists.

It marks the second time in as many seasons that Webster has been named to First Team Preseason All-SoCon and the first time in his career that he drew Preseason Player of the Year accolades.

Webster, who hit from the two-spot of the lineup in all 54 games, finished the 2018 season with second-best batting average (.380) on the team and fourth-best in the conference a season ago. He was responsible for 11 extra-base hits on the campaign, while scoring 51 runs and driving in 37.

Webster finished with 29 multi-hit games in 2018, ending with a single-season high four hits on two occasions against Marist (4-4, RBI, 2 runs; March 3) and Mercer (4-5, run). The junior from Randleman, N.C., was also responsible for a .456 slugging percentage, .417 on-base percentage and seven stolen bases over the course of the slate.

Embler, a redshirt senior from Southern Pines, N.C., was named to the First Team Preseason All-SoCon for the second time in as many seasons. He was the leadoff hitter in the UNCG lineup throughout the course of 2018, posting with a .357 batting average, ninth-best in the league and fourth-best on the team. Embler finished tied with Cesar Trejo for most doubles (15) and was third on the team in hits (81), earning the second-best on-base percentage (.438) for the Spartans in the process.

UNCG WHEN FACING THE IVY LEAGUE: The Spartans have played five of the eight schools that currently make up the Ivy League since the program's induction in 1991. While UNCG has not faced off against Brown, Dartmouth or Penn, prior to this weekend, they have played a combined 40 games against Columbia (1x), Cornell, (3x), Harvard (5x), Princeton (26x) and Yale (5x). The Spartans, who are 24-15-1 all-time against these schools, have played 39 of the 40 games in Greensboro. The lone exception coming in 2015, when UNCG squared off against Columbia in Wilmington, N.C.

Of those 40 meetings against Ivy League programs, 27 took place under former head coach Mike Gaski and 13 have come under current Spartan head coach Link Jarrett. Gaski was 16-10-1 in his tenure against schools from the Ivy League, with six of the losses coming by virtue of infractions that took place between 2009-11. Meanwhile, Jarrett is a combined 8-5 all-time in head-to-head meetings against Ivy League schools, owning a 7-4 mark versus Princeton and a 0-1 mark versus Columbia.

CAPTAINS NAMED FOR 2019 SEASON: After a vote by their teammates at the close of preseason, four members of the UNCG baseball team were named as team captains for the 2019 season. They include Caleb Webster, Chad Sykes, Zach Kuchmaner and Austin Embler.

"Such an honor for your teammates to choose you as 2019 Captains," said Head Coach Link Jarrett. "Congrats to Caleb Webster, Chad Sykes, Austin Embler, Zach Kuchmaner on their selection. This is an honor that will be with them forever and places them in tremendous company."

Webster, who hails from Randleman, N.C., is an infielder entering just junior season. Sykes is in his redshirt senior season for the Spartans from Creedmoor, N.C. Kuchmaner, also a redshirt senior for the Spartans, joined the program from

LEAVING THE OPPOSING HITTERS LOOKING: Four members of the Spartan pitching staff, including Chad Sykes (13 K's), Corey Jackson (12), Jeremiah Triplett (nine) and Austin Koehn (nine) have recorded at least nine strikeouts over the first six games of the slate.

Two of those, Sykes and Jackson, have been integral parts of a bullpen that has combined for 37 strikeouts in 16.2 innings of work (2.2 strikeouts per inning). Meanwhile, Triplett and Koehn lead all UNCG starters in strikeouts, which has fanned 25 opposing hitters in 25.2 innings on the mound (0.97 strikeouts per inning).

"LINK" TO THE MLB: During UNCG head coach Link Jarrett's seven-year tenure as the Spartans head coach, which began in 2013, he has witnessed 15 players selected in the Major League Baseball Draft. That marks the most of any Southern Conference program with Samford (14), Western Carolina (11) and Mercer (10) also with 10 or more in that span.

<LAST THREE GAMES RECAPS>

EMBLER RECORDS TRIPLE IN SETBACK TO HOKIES: Redshirt senior Austin Emblar finished with a team-best three hits, including his first triple of the season, in a 12-4 setback to host Virginia Tech on Sunday, Feb. 24 at Union Park in Blacksburg, Va.

Emblar (3-5, run), one three Spartan hitters with an extra-base hit on the afternoon, notched UNCG's first triple of the 2019 season. Joining him with extra-base hits were Hogan Windish (1-4, 2 RBI, run) and David Flores (2-4, RBI, run), who cracked back-to-back home runs in a three-run sixth inning.

UNCG enjoyed its biggest inning of the game in the sixth when Zach Kuchmaner reached base on a single down the left field line. Windish followed by lifting a two-run home run over the left centerfield wall that gave the Spartans their third run of the game. Flores followed with a home run down the left field line, scoring UNCG's final run.

The Spartan bullpen of Jackson, Maddux Holshouser and Alex Hoppe logged seven innings of work, facing 31 Virginia Tech batters along the way. They

combined to allow seven hits, six walks and three runs over that span, striking out eight Hokie hitters in the process.

LATE INNING HEROICS PUSH VT PAST SPARTANS: Greg Hardison, who finished 3-for-5 from the plate, was one of three UNCG hitters in the lineup with multiple hits, but it was a seventh inning home run by Virginia Tech's Kerry Carpenter that made the difference as the Hokies earned a 2-1 victory at Union Park on Monday, Feb. 25.

While Hardison, who collected three singles in the game, led the way for the Spartans (3-2), the combination of Austin Emblar (2-5) and Ryan Caveness (2-4, run) also enjoyed solid performances.

Leading the way on the mound for UNCG was Jeremiah Triplett, who went 4.2 innings, allowed three hits, one run, five walks and fanned two Virginia Tech hitters. He gave way to Jack Voigt (0-1) for the next 2.2 innings, who surrendered four hits, one run, and closed with three strikeouts. Chad Sykes came into close out the final 0.2 innings, facing three batters in the process, and allowed one hit and converted one strikeout.

The Spartans put the first run of the game on the board in the second inning when Caveness reached on a single to left and Hogan Windish followed by virtue of an error in right field. Zach Kuchmaner delivered a one-out single, loading the bases for the Spartans for Jacquez Koonce. Koonce reached on a fielder's choice, which resulted in Kuchmaner's out at second, and scored Caveness from third to result in the 1-0 lead.

Virginia Tech's offense broke through in the fifth after Nick Owens drew a two-out walk. Carson Taylor followed with the third Hokies hit of the game in the form of a single. Voigt came in relief of Triplett and surrendered a double to Luke Horanski, plating Owens from third to tie the game at one-all.

The Hokies scored the game's final run in the seventh when Carpenter lifted a 3-1 pitch over the wall for the 2-1 lead. UNCG placed only one runner on base, Hardison who drew a walk in the ninth, in the final two innings as Virginia Tech closed out the win.

DEMON DEACONS GET 2-1 WIN IN 10 INNINGS: The UNCG pitching staff of Austin Koehn, Maddux Holshouser, Corey Jackson and Chad Sykes combined for 10 strikeouts and allowed Wake Forest to 11 hits, but it was a 10th-inning bases-loaded single off the bat of Patrick Frick that helped the Demon Deacons to earn the 2-1 victory on Tuesday, Feb. 27 at David F. Couch Ballpark.

Koehn, making his second start of the season, struck out four Demon Deacon hitters while allowing four hits, two walks and one run over five innings of work. He gave way to Holshouser, who surrendered one hit and one walk to the two batters he faced.

Jackson, the third UNCG (3-3) pitcher to take the mound, tossed the next 1.2 innings and allowed two walks while converting two strikeouts along the way. Sykes (0-1) spent the next 2.2 innings on the mound for the Spartans, allowing six hits and one run while striking out four Wake Forest batters.

UNCG put the first run of the game across in the top of the second when Caveness sent a 3-2 pitch up the middle for the first hit by either team. Josh Madole moved Caveness to second, after being hit by a pitch, ahead of a Zach Kuchmaner walk that loaded the bases. Flores followed with a sacrifice fly to left field, scoring Caveness in the process, but Madole was throw out on a relay throw to third base.

The Spartan defensive and pitching staff kept Wake Forest scoreless until the bottom of the sixth when Jake Mueller opened the frame with a single to left. Michael Ludwig drew a six-pitch walk to move Mueller to second before a Bobby Seymour single through the right side of the infield knotted the game at one-all.

UNCG limited the Demon Deacons to just two hits between the seventh and ninth innings, but a leadoff to single to right by Ludwig started things off. Bobby Seymour followed with a single to left and Chris Lanzilli loaded the bases with a single through the right side of the infield. After a strikeout by pinch hitter Brendan Tinsman, Frick followed with the walk-off single up the middle.

Menendez earned the victory for Wake Forest after tossing three innings, allowing one hit and striking out three hitters in that stretch.
