QUAKER NOTEMEAL

The Matchup

This marks the first-ever meeting between Penn and UNC Greensboro. The Quakers are a combined 21-22-3 against teams that hail from North Carolina, dating back to a matchup between the Quakers and UNC in 1897.

Oh Captain my Captain

Penn will be lead by four team captains this season: seniors **Sean Phelan** and **Matt O'Neill**, and juniors **Chris Adams** and **Christian Scafidi**.

Preseason Poll

Penn was picked to finish fourth in the 2019 Ivy League preseason poll. The Quakers last won the Ivy League Championship in 1995, and their last appearance in the best-of-three Ivy Championship Series was in 2017. Penn was swept in two games by Yale.

Returning Talent

The Quakers return all four of their All-Ivy selections from last year including first-team selections **Matt McGeagh** and **Eduardo Malinowski**, and second-team selections **Peter Matt** and **Phelan**. Penn also returns seven of its starting field players from the 2018 season and ten letterwinners.

Braniacs

The Quakers were selected as one of the programs to receive the 2018 ABCA Team Academic Excellence Award after posting a team GPA greater than 3.0 on a 4.0 scale during the 2018 season.

Freshman Honors

Malinowski is coming off a monster freshman year which saw him start 40 of Penn's 42 games. The sophomore utility player led the Ivy League in hits (59) and batting average (.347). Malinowski received honors for Ivy League Rookie of the Year, first-team All-Ivy, Philadelphia Big 5 Rookie of the Year, second-team All-ECAC, and *Collegiate Baseball* Freshman All-America.

QUAKER NOTE MEAL

Summer League Standouts

A plethora of Quakers took part in various summer leagues this past offseason. Freshman **Malinowski** played with the Riverhead Tomcats and was named Hamptons League MVP after leading the team to their first league championship.

Captains **Phelan** and **Scafidi** were both named to the Coastal Plain League All-CPL first-team. Scafidi was named Coastal Plain League Pitcher of the Year after posting a 0.66 ERA across seven starts and 41 innings pitched. Perhaps his most impressive feat was allowing just 19 hits and only one extra-base hit in those 41 innings.

Behind the Dish

Senior captain **O'Neill** has been a mainstay as one half of the Penn battery. The 2016 Ivy League Rookie of the Year has played 121 games with 117 starts and has a career fielding percentage of .985 with just 13 errors. He leads all active Quakers with 15 homers and has a career slugging percentage of .440.

Throw 'em out, Throw 'em out

O'Neill has been a nightmare for runners attempting to steal over his career at Penn. He has thrown out 36 total baserunners on 124 attempted steals (29%). During his junior year, he threw out a league leading 40% of runners attempting to steal (14-35).

Hot Bat

Senior **Matt McGeagh** is coming off another season as one of Penn's top offensive players. He started all 42 games for the Quakers at third base. McGeagh led the Ivy League with 43 RBIs and led the team with seven home runs. He was named co-Big 5 Player of the Year, Big 5 Student-Athlete of the Year, first-team All-Ivy, and first-team All-Big 5.

Who's At First?

Senior captain **Phelan** has been a regular at first base since his freshman year in 2016. He has a career fielding percentage of .990 and just 11 errors. He is one of Penn's best hitters as well, with 135 hits, 76 RBI, and a career slugging percentage of .420.

What A Steal!

Adams led the Quakers with nine steals and was only thrown out on one attempt in 2018.

Mr. Consistent

Junior captain **Adams** enters his third year for the Red and Blue as one of Penn's most consistent hitters. He recorded 50 hits after 171 at-bats in both his freshman and sophomore years. He led the team with 31 runs scored and 13 doubles hitting leadoff for Penn in 2018. He was one of the Quakers most consistent players on the other side of the ball, making just seven errors on 104 fielding opportunities at second base and shortstop.

Ace of Base(ball)

Scafidi emerged as Penn's ace after his sophomore year, totaling ten starts and pitching 61.2 innings with 52 strikeouts and 31 earned runs.

Long Serving Seniors

Seniors **Phelan** (127), **McGeagh** (125), and **O'Neill** (121) are all on pace to break Dan Williams record for career appearances (161) this season. McGeagh averages 41.7 games played per season, Phelan averages 43, and O'Neill averages 40.3 since their freshman year in 2016.

Sadowitz Saves

Jacob Sadowitz recorded Penn's only two saves of the season in 2018. All 17 of his appearances last year came in relief. He did not surrender a run or a hit in six of those appearances.

New JAK City

The Quakers will look to **John Alan Kendrick** as a key member of their starting rotation for the 2019 season. Kendrick made his first start at Villanova on May 9, and posted career highs in innings pitched (5.1) and strikeouts (9) in Penn's 2018 season finale at Yale. He earned a 3-0 record surrendering 14 earned runs across 30.1 frames pitched.

Undefeated on Mulvihill

Sophomore **Dylan Mulvihill** emerged as one of Penn's most dynamic relievers last season, making 19 appearances out of the bullpen and tallying a 3-0 record. The Evanston, Ill. native finished the season with the team's second best ERA (1.99) pitching 22.2 innings and surrendering only 16 hits and striking out 23 batters.

Continuation

McGeagh is currently riding a 19-game streak in which he's reached base. **Matt** and **Malinowski** both enter this season having reached base in each of their last 13 games.

QUAKER NOTEMEAL

Youthful Optimism

The Quakers are coming off their worst season since 2014, largely due to a program-record four players selected in the 2017 MLB draft. Penn welcomes eight freshmen to the roster for the 2019 season, with half of them heading to the bullpen.

Bean Ball

Sophomore **Brendan Bean** evolved into a consistent threat out of the bullpen after starting his career as a utility player. He had 12 appearances and two starts, but his role evolved to that of a reliever. The New Jersey native pitched 12.1 frames and posted the team's best ERA (1.37). He tallied 33 strikeouts and allowed just 16 hits.

Houston Rocket

Grant Guillory will play his final season with the Quakers after serving as one of the team's top relievers over his Penn career. The Houston native has made 41 appearances, pitching 51.1 innings and fanning 52. He has surrendered 44 hits and allowed just 25 earned runs.

Sophomore Surge

Peter Matt broke into the starting nine midway through his sophomore season, making 32 appearances and 28 starts in the outfield. Matt was named second-team All-Ivy after batting .309 (33-107) with 17 RBIs, 15 runs scored, seven doubles, and a pair of homers.

Finishing Strong

Mitchell Holcomb bounced back from a mid-season lull to put in a career performance in the 2018 season finale at Yale. In his tenth start of the season he pitched a career-high 7.2 innings, fanning a career-best 12 batters.

Under the Hood

Freshman **Josh Hood** is the likely starter at shortstop for Penn. He was named Player of the Year by NJ.com, PBR New Jersey, Daily Journal, and Atlantic City Press after his senior year in 2018.

Palomar Prospect

Junior **Josh Sidney** will play his first season for the Red and Blue after transferring from California community college Palomar. He started eight games and pitched 39.1 innings, surrendering seven earned runs and striking out 33.

Penn Southpaws

The Quakers have four lefties in the bullpen, including starter **Kendrick**, closer **Sadowitz**, sophomore **Bean**, and freshman **Joe Miller**.

Christian Walton was an integral part of Penn's depth in the outfield last season, making 14 starts and 29 appearances. He finished with a perfect 1.000 fielding percentage and batted .224 (13-58).

In a Pinch

Walton led the team in substitute appearances last season with 15

Penn Pros

Billy Lescher has been making waves in the minor league circuit after his 17th round selection by the Detroit Tigers in 2017. His latest season with the Single-A West Michigan Whitecaps saw him post a 0.74 ERA and 39 strikeouts across 36.1 innings pitched.

Eaise on In

Freshman pitcher **Kevin Eaise** is anticipated to hit the ground running at Penn. The Richland, N.J. native helped St. Augustine Prep to three straight South Jersey Non-Public A Championships (2016-18) and was named AC Press player of the year and first-team All-South Jersey in 2017.

Hitting Above the Line

There were six different Quakers to average at least one hit per game in 2018: **Malinowski, Matt, McGeagh, Phelan, Adams, and Murane**. All but **Fishman** had over 100 plate appearances.

Five Plus

The Quakers had one player with five or more hits in a game and another with five or more RBIs. **Malinowski** tallied five hits against Harvard (4/8/18) while **McGeagh** plated five base runners against Cornell (4/21/18)

Back for Another

Six Quakers posted 10 or more multi-hit games in 2018. Five of those players (**Malinowski, Phelan, McGeagh, Adams, Matt**) will return for the 2019 season.

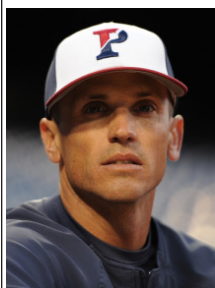

JOHN YURKOW, HEAD COACH



John Yurkow is entering his sixth season as Penn's W. Joseph Blood Head Coach of baseball and 13 year with the program after joining the team as an Assistant Coach in 2006

Since taking the helm in West Philly, the Quakers have fielded 34 All-Ivy selections, including 15 first-teamers and two Ivy League Player of the Year selections.

Over his five seasons in charge, Penn has posted a 62-38-1 record in Ivy League play - its best record across a five year span since the dissolve of the EIBL in 1993. Additionally, Penn's 16 conference wins in 2015 is a program record.

Yurkow moved into fifth place in Penn's all-time win column after tallying his 99th victory in charge of the Quakers with a 17-7 win over La Salle on April 17, 2018.

He became the fifth Penn baseball coach to tally 100 victories days later with a 9-5 victory over Cornell on April 21.
