QUICK HITS (vs. JACKSONVILLE)

► This weekend's games with Jacksonville mark the first time in program history that the two have played in Greensboro. The two previous games both occurred in the Sunshine State, taking place on March 2, 1997 and March 10, 2007. Both resulted in wins for the Spartans (16-11; March 2, 1997) and (10-7; March 10, 2007).

► The Spartans are 20-19 all-time against the current members that make up the Atlantic Sun Conference, winning three of the last four meetings against A-Sun schools under current head coach Link Jarrett. UNCG has hosted 15 games, owning a 9-6 mark, against Atlantic Sun member programs. The Spartans have gone to extra innings on two occasions, winning both games, versus A-Sun teams. Those two wins came against Liberty (5-4 {10}) and Lipscomb (13-9 {13}) in 1997 and 2018, respectively.

► The series against Jacksonville marks the first time in his career that UNCG head coach Link Jarrett has played a team from the Sunshine State, while with the Spartans. Jarrett played collegiately at Florida State from 1991-94 and in his four-year career with the Seminoles he was twice named Second Team All-American by the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association (1993, 1994).

Jarrett ended his career at Florida State with a .278 hitting percentage, enjoyed 72 multi-hit performances, and was responsible for 165 hits in 989 at bats. He finished his career with 65 doubles, four triples and five home runs, while driving in 122 RBI. One of the best offensive stretches of Jarrett's career came as a senior when he had at least two hits nine of 12 games during a stretch of late March and early April. Defensively, Jarrett was responsible for 358 put outs, 789 assists, 39 double plays and a .946 fielding percentage in his Seminole career.

► The 11 consecutive wins at home to open the 2019 season mark the best start at home under head coach Link Jarrett in his seven years at the helm. The current streak topped the 2016 start of 10-1 at home and is two wins better than the 9-2 beginning in 2018. UNCG has won at least six of the first 11 home games in each of Jarrett's seasons in Greensboro. (*Through first 11 home games by season-2013, 7-4; 2014, 8-3; 2015, 8-3; 2016, 10-1; 2017, 6-5; 2018, 9-2.*)

► Stetson garnered six first-place votes to sit atop this year's A-Sun Coaches Poll with a total of 77 points, followed by Jacksonville which took home two first-place votes and 73 points. Conference newcomer Liberty and FGCU rounded out the top-four in the poll with the Eagles receiving the final first-place nod. Kennesaw State sits in fifth place, followed by North Florida in sixth, Lipscomb in seventh, North Alabama in eighth and NJIT in ninth. Jacksonville's Angel Camacho was voted the A-Sun Preseason Player of the Year. Camacho, a senior first baseman returns to the Dolphins after leading the ASUN with 58 RBIs in helping the Dolphins make it into the Gainesville Regional of the NCAA Tournament. Also a member of the Gainesville Regional All-Tournament Team, the Florida native recorded of pair of runs batted in during the tournament.

LOOKING AT THE SERIES WITH THE DOLPHINS: The Spartans and Dolphins have met only two other times before this weekend's series with UNCG winning both contests, which took place in Jacksonville. The first time they squared off was on March 2, 1997, where the Spartans prevailed 16-11 under then head coach Mike Gaski. Ten years and eight days later the two met again, also under Gaski, with the Spartans claiming a 10-7 victory.

There are nine teams that comprise the current Atlantic Sun Conference, including Florida Gulf Coast, Jacksonville, Kennesaw State, Lipscomb, Liberty, NJIT, North Alabama, North Florida and Stetson.

UNCG has faced off against five of those programs including Jacksonville (twice), Lipscomb (3x), Liberty (29x), North Florida (3x) and Stetson (2x). Liberty, who just moved to the Atlantic Sun for the start of the 2018-19 athletic season, was a former member of the Big South Conference with UNCG. The two squared off 14 times between the 1994 and 1997 seasons as Big South Conference members, including a pair of meetings in the 1997 league tournament.

Those two wins came against Liberty (5-4 {10}) and Lipscomb (13-9 {13}) in 1997 and 2018, respectively.

Jarrett has faced Liberty and Lipscomb since taking the reigns at UNCG, posting a 6-5 victory over No. 24 Liberty on Feb. 21, 2015, marking his first win against a current A-Sun program. He followed that by winning two of three games against Lipscomb by scores of 9-3 and 13-9 (13 inn.) on March 16 and March 17, respectively, of last year.

STREAKING INTO THE WEEKEND: Ryan Caveness is responsible for two key hitting statistics entering the weekend as he owns the longest current hitting streak (five games) for the Spartans and has the most multi-hit games on the season (six), Teammate Caleb Webster is a close second in consecutive games with a hit (four) and is tied with Caveness for the most multi-hit outings.

Josh Madole is the UNCG hitter with the longest streak in 2019 with six. Madole's hitting streak began in the first game of a doubleheader against Penn (March 2) and ended after going 0-for-1 in the second game of a doubleheader with Princeton (March 10). He had three two-hit games during the stretch, driving in six RBI.

The second-longest streak of the 2019 season belongs to Zach Kuchmaner, who opened the campaign with a five-game hitting streak, after going 2-for-4 in the season-opener against Quinnipiac on Feb. 15. He managed to go 1-for-4 from the plate in the next four games before seeing the streak end by virtue of an 0-for-3 performance at Wake Forest (Feb. 27).

Caveness begin his current streak by going 1-for-3 at Winthrop (March 5) and has followed with a pair of two-hit games against Princeton (March 8, March 9) before coming through with one hit against both Princeton (March 10) and Elon (March 12).

Webster's current four-game streak, which began on March 9 versus Princeton, where he finished 1-for-3 from the plate, includes a pair of two-hit performances against the Tigers in the March 10th doubleheader. He finished 1-for-4 from the plate in the 4-3 victory over Elon.

LEAVING YOU LooKing: Six UNCG pitchers have managed at least 15 strikeouts on the season, including reliever Chad Sykes who has recorded a team-best 22 K's. He is followed closely by Jeremiah Triplett (20 K's), Corey Jackson (20), Austin Koehn (16), Phillip Sanderson (15) and Brandon Stephens (15).

Sykes has made eight appearances out of the bullpen, logging 14.1 innings on the season, recording two saves along the way. He has had at least two strikeouts in six of his eight appearances, including a season-high five in two innings in a win at High Point (Feb. 19).

Triplett picked up eight of his 20 strikeouts as he earned his second win of the season in the first game of a doubleheader against Princeton (March 10). He tossed six innings,

allowed two hits and three walks, while striking out eight Tiger hitters. The eight K's mark the most in a single game for any UNCG pitcher this season, topping a previous mark that was shared by both Triplett (7, vs. Quinnipiac (Feb. 16)) and Jack Voigt (7, vs. Penn (March 2)).

Jackson, like Sykes, has reached 20 strikeouts out of the bullpen for UNCG. His best single-game performance came at High Point, where he fanned six Panther hitters in a UNCG win on Feb. 19 and is one of five multi-strikeout games for Jackson.

Sanderson is tied with Stephens for fourth-most strikeouts on the team. Sanderson has made four starts over the course of the season, notching at least four K's in three of those outings, including a season-best six against Quinnipiac on Feb. 15.

Stephens has emerged as a dominant force out of the bullpen for the Spartans, making five appearances in March, resulting in two saves. He has four games with at least two strikeouts to his credit, including a pair of four-strikeout contests against Penn (March 2) and Winthrop (March 5).

"LINK" TO THE MLB: During UNCG head coach Link Jarrett's seven-year tenure as the Spartans head coach, which began in 2013, he has witnessed 15 players selected in the Major League Baseball Draft. That marks the most of any Southern Conference program with Samford (14), Western Carolina (11) and Mercer (10) also with 10 or more in that span.

SPARTANS TABBED SECOND IN PRESEASON POLLS: One year after winning the Southern Conference regular season title, the UNC Greensboro baseball team was picked second in the 2019 preseason coaches and media polls that were released on Thursday, Feb. 7.

The Spartans, who won their second regular season league title in program history since joining the Southern Conference in 1998, were 39-15 overall and 18-3 in conference action a season ago. UNCG has posted at least 35 wins in three straight seasons for the first time in program history. After earning wins in two elimination games in as many days, the Spartans season came to a close at the 2018 SoCon Tournament with an 8-4 setback to Western Carolina.

WEBSTER PRESEASON PLAYER OF THE YEAR, EMBLER FIRST TEAM ALL-CONFERENCE: Along with the distinction of being picked second as a team, junior infielder Caleb Webster was named as the league's Preseason Player of the Year and teammate Austin Embler was selected First Team Preseason All-SoCon in a vote by the panelists.

It marks the second time in as many seasons that Webster has been named to First Team Preseason All-SoCon and the first time in his career that he drew Preseason Player of the Year accolades.

Webster, who hit from the two-spot of the lineup in all 54 games, finished the 2018 season with second-best batting average (.380) on the team and fourth-best in the conference a season ago. He was responsible for 11 extra-base hits on the campaign, while scoring 51 runs and driving in 37.

Webster finished with 29 multi-hit games in 2018, ending with a single-season high four hits on two occasions against Marist (4-4, RBI, 2 runs; March 3) and Mercer (4-5, run). The junior from Randleman, N.C., was also responsible for a .456 slugging percentage, .417 on-base percentage and seven stolen bases over the course of the slate.

Embler, a redshirt senior from Southern Pines, N.C., was named to the First Team Preseason All-SoCon for the second time in as many seasons. He was the leadoff hitter in the UNCG lineup throughout the course of 2018, posting with a .357 batting average, ninth-best in the league and fourth-best on the team. Embler finished tied with Cesar Trejo for most doubles (15) and was third on the team in hits (81), earning the second-best on-base percentage (.438) for the Spartans in the process.

<RECAPING LAST THREE>

SPARTANS RALLY TO DOWN PHOENIX, 4-3: UNCG overcame a two-run deficit in the bottom of the eighth inning by scoring three runs, earning its 10th home victory by downing Elon 4-3 at the UNCG Baseball Stadium on Tuesday, March 12.

Trailing 3-1, UNCG (11-4) opened the eighth by getting Josh Madole on base via a hit by pitch. Jacquez Koonce followed with a bunt single, moving Madole into scoring position, before Zach Kuchmaner drew a walk to load the bases for the Spartans with no outs. With designated hitter David Flores at the plate, a wild pitch by Jared Weatherbee brought home Koonce for the second Spartans run of the contest.

Flores lifted a sacrifice fly to right field, plating Koonce for the game-tying run. Greg Hardison kept the inning alive, while at the same time providing UNCG the lead, with a single through the left side of the infield to score Kuchmaner from third for the 4-3 lead.

Elon made an attempt to get the run back in the top of the ninth, as Tyler Stanley reached and stole second, but Brandon Stephens slammed the door as he got Garrett Stonehouse to strike out and two outs in the field to preserve the one-run victory.

The Spartans finished with nine hits on the game, including two each from Greg Hardison (2-5, RBI, run) and Jacquez Koonce (2-4, run). Jake Mayhew (1-0) picked up the win for UNCG after tossing a perfect eighth where he struck out one Phoenix hitter. Stephens came on in relief to earn his second save of the campaign after recording one strikeout and facing three batters.

UNCG tallied the first run of the game in the home half of the first as Hardison began the frame with a single left field, advancing to second on a fielding error in right. Hardison moved to third on a failed pickoff attempt, scoring on a grounder to third by Caleb Webster.

Elon put together a three-run inning in the fourth, capitalizing on two hits. Cam Devaney opened with a single to left and Anthony Galason reached on a hit by pitch. Two batters later, Jarrett Pico singled through the right side of the infield to bring Devaney home. The

second run for the Phoenix came home on a walk of Stonehouse and Pico trotted home to tally the third run of the game on a wild pitch.

UNCG COMPLETES DOUBLEHEADER SWEEP OF TIGERS: The UNCG baseball team maintained its perfect mark at home with a doubleheader sweep of Princeton on Sunday, March 10, by winning the first game 6-2 and the second game by a 5-3 margin, as the Spartans completed the series sweep in the process.

The first game of the afternoon was a pitcher's duel over the first three innings, as UNCG's Jeremiah Triplett and Princeton's Andrew Gnazzo held the opposing lineup without a hit. The Tigers broke through with a hit in the top of the fourth, while UNCG came through with two in the bottom of the frame.

The Spartans offense got rolling in the fifth when Mike Ferrara and Zach Kuchmaner reached base ahead of Coleman Sawyer, who delivered a hit that scored Ferrara from second for the 1-0 advantage. Sawyer moved to second on a wild pitch, which was followed by a single to centerfield by Jacquez Koonce that pushed the UNCG lead to 2-0.

After holding the Tigers hitless in the top of the sixth, UNCG's offense put three more runs on the board in the home half of the inning. It began when Caleb Webster reached on a single to short, moving to second on a throwing error. Ryan Caveness followed with a single up the middle, putting runners on the corners. Josh Madole drove a single through the left side of the infield, plating Webster for the third run of the game.

Ferrara continued the UNCG sixth by reaching on a fielder's choice that got Caveness at third. Kuchmaner roped a one-out single to third, loading the bases for Sawyer. A passed ball with Sawyer at bat plated Madole for the fourth UNCG run of the day and second of the inning. With two outs in the inning, after Ferrara was out on a play at the plate, Kuchmaner scored from third on a passed ball to give the Spartans a 5-0 advantage.

Princeton managed to get two runs back in the top of the seventh when Alex Dickinson drove a two-run home run over the left-centerfield wall. UNCG got one of those runs back in the bottom of the inning when Madole drove a single into right field, scoring Webster from second base after the junior standout reached on a single to third for his second hit of the game.

The two teams completed the four-game series with a seven-inning game that helped UNCG maintain its perfect 9-0 mark at home.

The Spartans (10-4) scored all five runs in the second inning, which came as a result of five hits. Josh Madole started the process when he was hit by a pitch, moving to second a sacrifice bunt by Jacquez Koonce. David Flores grounded out to short, scoring Madole from third, providing UNCG with the 1-0 lead. Hogan Windish reached on a fielder's choice that put runners on the corners, which was followed by a single down the left field line by Greg Hardison that scored Coleman Sawyer for the second UNCG run.

Austin Embler continued the offensive onslaught for the Spartans, loading the bases for Caleb Webster. With Webster at the plate a wild pitch by Reece Rabin allowed Windish to score from third for the 3-0 UNCG advantage. Webster followed with a bases-clearing double to right field, scoring Embler and Hardison as the lead grew to 5-0.

Princeton (1-6) retaliated in the top of the fourth, scoring its first run of the game on a bases loaded grounder by Max West. Teammate Joseph Flynn recorded the second run on a wild pitch by Colin Best, slicing the Spartan lead to 5-2.

The Tigers tacked on their final run of the game in the seventh after Nadir Lewis reached on a two-out double to left field. Flynn dropped a single to left, scoring Lewis in the process, before moving to second on a single up the middle by David Harding. The Spartans defense converted the final out with a fly ball to right field, ending the threat.

Freshman Austin Koehn, who pitched 3.2 innings of relief, earned the first victory of his collegiate career after holding the Tigers to one run on three hits, while striking out four. He came in relief of Best, who worked 3.1 innings, allowed one hit, two runs and four walks while striking out two.

THREE-RUN EIGHTH INNING LEADS UNCG TO 10-7 WIN: After being held to one hit over a four-inning stretch between the third and seventh innings, the UNCG baseball team came through with two hits and four runs in the home half of the eighth to earn a 5-3 win at UNCG Stadium on Saturday, March 9 versus Princeton.

The Spartans took advantage of two walks and a hit by pitch in the first three batters of the eighth inning when Mike Ferrara drove a single through the left side of the infield to score the second run of the game. Josh Madole followed with two-run single to centerfield, scoring Austin Embler and Ryan Caveness in the process, giving UNCG a 4-3 advantage. The final Spartan run crossed the plate when Coleman Sawyer grounded into a double play, scoring pinch runner Hogan Windish from third, extending the lead to 5-3.

Princeton attempted a rally in the ninth, when Joseph Flynn reached on a walk and Max West followed with a double to centerfield that put runners at second and third, but a Brandon Stephens strikeout coupled with a diving catch by Zach Kuchmaner to end the game slammed the door on the Tigers comeback.

Stephens picked up his first save of the season after getting the final two outs of the game. Junior lefthander Jack Voigt (2-1) earned his second win in as many days after recording two outs in the top of the eighth, including one for a strikeout.

Maddux Holshouser tossed the first five innings for UNCG, allowing three runs on four hits along with a walk, while striking out three Princeton batters along the way. He gave way to Corey Jackson, who faced eight batters over the next 2.1 innings, where he tallied one strikeout.

Caveness (2-3, 2 RBI, run) and Madole (2-3, 2 RBI, run) were the only hitters in the UNCG lineup with multiple hits on the day. The Spartans finished the afternoon with eight hits, five of which came in the first two innings of the game.
