The Spartans remain unbeaten at home (13-1) in 2019. UNCG has outscored their opponents 86-50 at home over the course of the season, eclipsing double-digit runs on three occasions.

During head coach Link Jarrett's seven-year tenure with the Spartans, which began in 2013, he has witnessed 15 players selected in the Major League Baseball Draft.

QUICK HITS (vs. N.C. A&T)

► The Spartans are 48-11 all-time against schools that make up the Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference (MEAC), owning a 41-10 mark against crosstown rival N.C. A&T. Two of those losses against the Aggies came by virtue of vacated wins, under former UNCG head coach Mike Gaski. UNCG has also faced off against Bethune-Cookman (1-0), Delaware State (3-0), Maryland-Eastern Shore (2-0), N.C. Central (1-0) and Norfolk State (0-1), all current members of the MEAC.

► UNCG head coach Link Jarrett owns a 10-2 mark all-time against programs in the MEAC with seven of the wins coming against N.C. A&T. Two of the remaining victories came against Maryland-Eastern Shore and one was versus N.C. Central. Jarrett won his first five meetings with N.C. A&T between March 26, 2013 and March 24, 2015, before suffering a 9-8 setback in 10 innings on March 22, 2016, the only game in all-time series that has ever gone to extra innings.

► UNCG freshman Jacquez Koonce has moved on up in the lineup and has hit from the No. 2 spot in his last three games. In that span, Koonce has come through with three hits, two runs, two walks and swiped three bases for the Spartans. He had a .357 on-base percentage in three games against Jacksonville over the weekend and was the only Spartan with multiple stolen bases against the Dolphins.

► The two teams have met 10 times at Newbridge Bank Park since the 2006 campaign with the Spartans owning an 8-2 mark at the neutral venue. UNCG has outscored the Aggies by a combined score of 87-49 at Newbridge Bank Park, eclipsing the double-digit mark on five occasions.

► Coppin State and North Carolina A&T were selected as the preseason favorites to win the Northern and Southern Divisions, respectively. Coppin State won the Northern Division last season for the first time since 1996 and is expected to repeat the feat in 2019, picking up 13 first-place votes. Norfolk State, with four first-place votes, was picked to finish second, and Delaware State (one first-place vote) and Maryland Eastern Shore round out the Northern Division.

North Carolina A&T is fresh off its first MEAC title in baseball since 2005 and the Aggies are the favorite to win the Southern Division, picking up 15 first-place votes. Bethune-Cookman (two first-place votes), entering its first season under head coach Jonathan Hernandez, was picked to finish second – followed by Florida A&M (one first-place vote), North Carolina Central and Savannah State.

The Aggies had three selections to the Preseason All-MEAC first team including Michael Johnson (pitcher), Perry "AJ" Hunt (infielder) and Dawnoven Smith (outfielder).

LOOKING AT THE CLASH WITH THE AGGIES: UNC Greensboro and N.C. A&T are meeting for the 52nd time on the diamond on Tuesday, March 19 at Newbridge Bank Park, home of the South Atlantic League Class-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates.

The Spartans own a 41-10 lead in the all-time series, winning eight of the last 10 head-to-head meetings between the two programs. UNCG had won two additional games against the Aggies, but they were vacated due to NCAA Infractions Committee rulings.

The series between the two programs began on April 5, 1991 when then UNCG head coach Mike Gaski suffered an 11-5 setback to the Aggies. The Spartans returned to the field on April 12, 1992 against N.C. A&T and won the first of 25 consecutive games by a 6-5 margin, again under Gaski, marking the longest winning streak by either team in the series.

The longest winning streak by the Aggies spanned from April 2, 2008 to March 31, 2010, when they won six straight games, including two wins which were later vacated by the Spartans.

UNCG head coach Link Jarrett has faced the Aggies nine times since taking over the Spartans and has a 7-2 all-time record. Jarrett won his first five meetings with N.C. A&T between March 26, 2013 and March 24, 2015, before suffering a 9-8 setback in 10 innings on March 22, 2016, the only game in all-time series that has ever gone to extra innings.

UNCG rebounded to win the next two meetings on March 29, 2016 and March 22, 2017, but dropped the most recent outing to the N.C. A&T by a 3-2 margin at the UNCG Baseball Stadium on April 2, 2018.

The two teams have met 10 times at Newbridge Bank Park since the 2006 campaign with the Spartans owning an 8-2 mark at the neutral venue. UNCG has outscored the Aggies by a combined score of 87-49 at Newbridge Bank Park, eclipsing the double-digit mark on five occasions.

The Spartans have seen an offensive outburst in the all-time series with N.C. A&T, reaching double figures on 21 occasions. In three of those contests, UNCG scored at least 20 runs, which came on Feb. 16, 1994 (24-3), Feb. 12, 2003 (24-3) and April 23, 2003 (26-1).

HARDISON, WINDISH COMPLETE SOLID WEEKEND: Hogan Windish and Greg Hardison combined for 11 hits, six runs, six RBI and two doubles in the weekend series against Jacksonville as the Spartans won two of the three games in series.

Windish, the top hitter on the team against the Dolphins (.500, 6-for-12) finished with a .583 slugging percentage and a .538 on-base percentage in the three-game series. He accrued the most hits over the course of the series and tied for the most total bases (seven) with Zach Kuchmaner.

Hardison capped off the clash with Jacksonville by hitting .455 from the plate, going 5-for-11 on the weekend. While he was responsible for only one RBI, he was second on the team with five runs, one shy of Windish's mark. He also eclipsed the .500 mark in slugging percentage (.545), while positing a .533 slugging percentage.

Hardison enters the week with a six-game hitting streak, tying teammates Josh Madole and Caleb Webster for the longest hit streak by a Spartan hitter this season. In addition to having the longest hitting streak on the team, Hardison has also had the most multi-hit games for UNCG in 2019.

Hardison began his current hitting streak in the first game of a March 10th doubleheader with Princeton where he went 1-for-3 at the plate. He has three multi-hit games in that span, including three straight against Elon (2-5; March 12), Jacksonville (2-3; March 16) and Jacksonville (2-5; March 16).

Windish owns a five-game hitting streak for UNCG, which began in the second game

against Princeton on March 10, where he went 1-for-3 at the plate. The redshirt freshman has had multiple hits in each of his last two games for the Spartans, finishing 3-for-5 with three RBI in game two of the doubleheader against Jacksonville before going 2-for-4 at the plate in the final game of the series against the Dolphins.

Webster's six-game hitting streak came to a halt on Sunday, March 18 against the Dolphins, when he finished 0-for-4 at the plate with a pair of strikeouts.

LEAVING YOU LooKing: Six UNCG pitchers have managed at least 15 strikeouts on the season, including reliever Chad Sykes who has recorded a team-best 24 K's. He is followed closely by Jeremiah Triplett (23 K's), Phillip Sanderson (21), Corey Jackson (20), Austin Koehn (17) and Brandon Stephens (17). Phillip Sanderson (15)

Sykes has made eight appearances out of the bullpen, logging 16 innings on the season, recording two saves along the way. He has had at least two strikeouts in seven of his nine appearances, including a season-high five in two innings in a win at High Point (Feb. 19).

Triplett picked up eight of his 20 strikeouts as he earned his second win of the season in the first game of a doubleheader against Princeton (March 10). He tossed six innings, allowed two hits and three walks, while striking out eight Tiger hitters. The eight K's mark the most in a single game for any UNCG pitcher this season, topping a previous mark that was shared by both Triplett (7, vs. Quinnipiac {Feb. 16}) and Jack Voigt (7, vs. Penn {March 2}).

Sanderson climbed to third on the team in strikeouts after tying his season-high six over a seven-inning stretch in the first game of the doubleheader with Jacksonville (March 16). In what is arguably his best performance of the season, Sanderson scattered six hits, while allowing two runs and two walks to Dolphin hitters. He has made five starts over the course of the season, notching at least four K's in four of those outings.

Jackson, like Sykes, has reached 20 strikeouts out of the bullpen for UNCG. His best single-game performance came at High Point, where he fanned six Panther hitters in a UNCG win on Feb. 19 and is one of five multi-strikeout games for Jackson.

Stephens has emerged as a dominant force out of the bullpen for the Spartans, making six appearances in March, resulting in two saves. He has four games with at least two strikeouts to his credit, including a pair of four-strikeout contests against Penn (March 2) and Winthrop (March 5).

"LINK" TO THE MLB: During UNCG head coach Link Jarrett's seven-year tenure as the Spartans head coach, which began in 2013, he has witnessed 15 players selected in the Major League Baseball Draft. That marks the most of any Southern Conference program with Samford (14), Western Carolina (11) and Mercer (10) also with 10 or more in that span.

SPARTANS TABBED SECOND IN PRESEASON POLLS: One year after winning the Southern Conference regular season title, the UNC Greensboro baseball team was picked second in the 2019 preseason coaches and media polls that were released on Thursday, Feb. 7.

The Spartans, who won their second regular season league title in program history since joining the Southern Conference in 1998, were 39-15 overall and 18-3 in conference action a season ago. UNCG has posted at least 35 wins in three straight seasons for the first time in program history. After earning wins in two elimination games in as many days, the Spartans season came to a close at the 2018 SoCon Tournament with an 8-4 setback to Western Carolina.

WEBSTER PRESEASON PLAYER OF THE YEAR, EMBLER FIRST TEAM ALL-CONFERENCE: Along with the distinction of being picked second as a team, junior infielder Caleb Webster was named as the league's Preseason Player of the Year and teammate Austin Embler was selected First Team Preseason All-SoCon in a vote by the panelists.

It marks the second time in as many seasons that Webster has been named to First Team Preseason All-SoCon and the first time in his career that he drew Preseason Player of the Year accolades.

Webster, who hit from the two-spot of the lineup in all 54 games, finished the 2018 season with second-best batting average (.380) on the team and fourth-best in the conference a season ago. He was responsible for 11 extra-base hits on the campaign, while scoring 51 runs and driving in 37.

Webster finished with 29 multi-hit games in 2018, ending with a single-season high four hits on two occasions against Marist (4-4, RBI, 2 runs; March 3) and Mercer (4-5, run). The junior from Randleman, N.C., was also responsible for a .456 slugging percentage, .417 on-base percentage and seven stolen bases over the course of the slate.

Embler, a redshirt senior from Southern Pines, N.C., was named to the First Team Preseason All-SoCon for the second time in as many seasons. He was the leadoff hitter in the UNCG lineup throughout the course of 2018, posting with a .357 batting average, ninth-best in the league and fourth-best on the team. Embler finished tied with Cesar Trejo for most doubles (15) and was third on the team in hits (81), earning the second-best on-base percentage (.438) for the Spartans in the process.

<RECAPING LAST THREE FOR THE SPARTANS>

SPARTANS TAKE SATURDAY DOUBLEHEADER AGAINST JU: The UNCG baseball maintained its perfect record at home with a pair of wins against Jacksonville University on Saturday, March 16. The Spartans rallied for four runs in the ninth inning to complete a 5-4 victory in game one, before putting together a pair of five-run innings to earn a 13-3 win in the nightcap.

UNCG's junior standout Caleb Webster extended his hitting streak to six straight games after going 1-for-5 in the first game of the day and 1-for-4 in the second contest. He is now tied with teammate Josh Madole for the longest hitting streak of the season.

Leading the way for the Spartans on the mound were Corey Jackson, who improved to 2-0 on the season in the first game, and Brandon Stephens, who evened his mark to 1-1 on the season in the second game.

UNCG FAST FACTS (GAME 1)

-Spartan starter Phillip Sanderson tied his single-game season-high in strikeouts (six) as he faced 28 batters over seven innings of work where he scattered six hits, allowed two runs and two walks.

-Corey Jackson came out of the bullpen to grab his second win of the season. Jackson allowed three hits, two runs and two walks over two innings. It marked the first time in his 10 appearances in 2019 that he failed to record a strikeout.

-Greg Hardison (2-3, 2 runs) and Jacquez Koonce (2-4, RBI) led the way for the top-third of the UNCG lineup, which accounted for five of the team's nine hits in the game.

-The four runs in the ninth mark the first time in 2019 that UNCG has scored in the ninth inning. The Spartans improved their mark to 1-3 on the season when leading after nine innings.

-While an 0-for-3 performance ended Ryan Caveness' hitting streak at five games, teammate Caleb Webster extended his hitting streak to five straight with a 1-for-5 outing at the plate that included an RBI.

UNCG FAST FACTS (GAME 2)

-The Spartans scored five runs in the bottom of the sixth inning, tying the most runs in a single inning with a five-run fifth that came against Quinnipiac (Feb. 15) in the season opener.

-UNCG topped double figure runs for the third time this season. The most in a single game was 12, which came in the 2019 opener versus Quinnipiac (Feb. 15).

-Spartans head coach Link Jarrett is now six wins away from his 200th career coaching victory.

-Caleb Webster tied Madole for the longest hitting streak by a Spartan this season (six games) after finishing the game 1-for-4 with an RBI and a run scored

-Brandon Stephens, one of three pitchers to toe the rubber for the Spartans in the game, evened his record to 1-1 on the season after tossing 2.2 innings, allowing one hit and striking out two of the 10 Dolphin hitters he faced.

-Austin Embler recorded his third double of the season and Zach Kuchmaner had his first triple of the slate as UNCG tallied two extra-base hits in the contest.

JU TAKES THIRD GAME OF SERIES WITH 8-4 WIN: Zach Kuchmaner and Hogan Windish finished with two hits each, but it was a pair of multi-run innings that allowed visiting Jacksonville University to close out the third game of the series with an 8-4 victory at the UNCG Baseball Stadium on Sunday, March 17.

Kuchmaner capped off his fourth multi-hit performance of the season by going 2-of-3 from the plate with a pair of runs scored. Among the two hits included his second triple in as many games. Windish ended the day by hitting 2-for-4 at the plate, accruing his third extra-base hit of the season and first double along the way.

Facing a 7-2 deficit in the bottom of the seventh, UNCG (13-5) got its first runner on base in the frame when Ryan Caveness drew a walk. Kuchmaner followed with a single to centerfield, advancing to second on the throw as Caveness moved to third. After a pitching change, which brought Nick Love out of the bullpen for AJ Jones, Windish sent the third pitch through the left side of the infield for a pair of RBI.

Jacksonville (12-8) would tack on an insurance run in the ninth to complete the four-run victory, handing UNCG its first setback at home this season. The Dolphins offense finished the game with 13 hits, with four players having at least two hits in the game. Jones provided a solid presence on the mound for JU, tossing 6.1 innings, allowing four hits and four runs along the way, while striking out five UNCG hitters as he snagged his third win of the year.

UNCG Fast Facts

-Jacquez Koonce, who swiped a base on Sunday, capped off the weekend with three stolen bases for the Spartans this weekend.

-Caleb Webster's six-game hitting streak was halted after he finished 0-for-4 from the plate.

-The 8-4 setback at home marks the first since the Spartans dropped an 8-7 decision to Elon on Tuesday, May 15, 2018.

-The 13 hits by the Dolphins mark just the fifth time this season and first time in the last nine games that an opponent has had double figure hits against the Spartans.

-Chad Sykes who finished with two strikeouts in 1.2 innings of work, is now the team's leader in K's with 24. He has one more than Jeremiah Triplett, three more than Phillip Sanderson and four more than Corey Jackson.
