QUICK HITS (vs. MERCER)

▶ The two schools have met 15 times on the diamond with UNCG holding a 9-6 advantage in the all-time series, which dates back to Feb. 27, 1998. Nine of the 15 games in the series have taken place in Macon, Ga., where UNCG is a combined 5-4. The series includes only one extra inning affair, which came in the first-ever meeting on Feb. 27, 1998, when UNCG emerged with an 11-inning victory over the Bears by a 7-6 margin.

▶ UNCG has won five of its last six games against the Bears since April 28, 2017, including a sweep in Greensboro in 2018. The three-game sweep came by virtue of 9-3 (May 5), 6-5 (May 6) and 7-1 (May 7) victories by the Spartans.

▶ Since the first SoCon baseball season in 1998, UNCG has swept five SoCon openers, including 1998 (East Tennessee State), 2000 (Western Carolina), 2005 (The Citadel), 2008 (Appalachian State) and 2016 (VMI). The Spartans also swept the 2011 SoCon opener against Western Carolina, but those three wins were later vacated.

▶ The Spartans own the longest winning streak in the head-to-head series, four games, which is an ongoing streak. It began with a 12-3 win over the Bears on April 30, 2017 and has includes wins by scores of 9-3 (May 5), 6-5 (May 6) and 7-1 (May 7) in the 2018 campaign.

▶ The Bears come into their first Southern Conference series of the season with an 11-11 mark following an 8-4 setback against Georgia Tech on Tuesday, March 19.

Mercer has been streaky in its first 34 days of play, putting together a six-game winning streak that included three wins over Florida A&M (Feb. 20 / Feb. 26 / Feb. 27) and Alabama A&M (Feb. 22-24), but also enduring a four-game losing streak which came at the hands of Georgia Southern (March 6) and Indiana State (March 8-10).

The Bears are 10-7 at home on the slate, posting their most recent home win on March 5th against Georgia State, 14-11.

Mercer has six players hitting .300 or better in its lineup, including Angelo DiSpigna, who leads all hitters with a .358 batting average (29-for-81) and is tied for third in doubles (four) and third in home runs (three). The hottest hitter in the Bears' lineup is Kel Johnson, who has a 21-game streak of reaching base safely. The top pitcher on staff is Kevin Coulter (2-0, 2.45 ERA), who is responsible for 26 K's in 22 innings. Sawyer Gipson-Long leads the pitching staff in strikeouts (30), making five starts and logging 23.2 innings on the mound.

SoCON OPENER AGAINST MERCER: The Spartans open Southern Conference play this weekend when they head to Mercer. The two schools have met 15 times on the diamond with UNCG holding a 9-6 advantage in the all-time series, which dates back to Feb. 27, 1998.

Nine of the 15 games in the series have taken place in Macon, Ga., where UNCG is a combined 5-4. The Spartans are 8-4 in head-to-head meetings against Mercer under head coach Link Jarrett, owning a 4-2 record when traveling to Macon under Jarrett.

UNCG has won five of its last six games against the Bears since April 28, 2017, including a sweep in Greensboro in 2018. The three-game sweep came by virtue of 9-3 (May 5), 6-5 (May 6) and 7-1 (May 7) victories by the Spartans.

The Spartans head into their first Southern Conference series with a 36-28 all-time mark in league openers, since joining the conference in the 1997-98 athletic season. UNCG has captured its last five straight series against SoCon opponents, dating back to the 2014 campaign.

Since the first SoCon baseball season in 1998, UNCG has swept five SoCon openers, including 1998 (East Tennessee State), 2000 (Western Carolina), 2005 (The Citadel), 2008 (Appalachian State) and 2016 (VMI). The Spartans also swept the 2011 SoCon opener against Western Carolina, but those three wins were later vacated.

LUCKY SEVENS: Greg Hardison extended his hitting streak to seven games after a leadoff single in the bottom of the first against N.C. A&T on Tuesday evening. The seven-game streak, which began in the opening game of the March 10th doubleheader versus Princeton, marks the longest by any Spartan this season.

The streak tops a series of six-game streaks by Mike Ferrara (March 2-March 9), Josh Madole (March 4-March 10) and Caleb Webster (March 10-March 16).

Hardison began his current hitting streak in the first game of a March 10th doubleheader with Princeton where he went 1-for-3 at the plate. He has three multi-hit games in that span, including three straight against Elon (2-5; March 12), Jacksonville (2-3; March 16) and Jacksonville (2-5; March 16).

In his streak, Hardison is 10-for-26 from the plate with a .385 batting average, .423 slugging percentage and a .500 on-base percentage, all tops in the UNCG lineup. He is responsible for 11 total bases, nine runs, one double, and one double. Hardison has also drawn six walks and been hit by a pitch.

In last weekend's series with Jacksonville, Hardison capped off the clash by hitting .455 from the plate, going 5-for-11 in three contests. While he was responsible for only one RBI, he was second on the team with five runs, one shy of Windish's mark. He also eclipsed the .500 mark in slugging percentage (.545), while positing a .533 slugging percentage.

In addition to having the longest hitting streak on the team, Hardison is tied with teammate Caleb Webster, who finished 2-for-3 against the Aggies on Tuesday evening, for the most multi-hit games for UNCG in 2019.

LEAVING YOU LookIng: Seven UNCG pitchers have managed at least 15 strikeouts on the season, including relievers Chad Sykes and Corey Jackson, who have recorded a team-best 24 K's. Jackson tied Sykes for the team lead after a four-strikeout performance against N.C. A&T on Tuesday, March 20.

The duo is followed closely by Jeremiah Triplett (23 K's), Phillip Sanderson (21), Austin Koehn (17) and Brandon Stephens (17) and Jack Voigt (15), who tallied a pair of strikeouts in relief against N.C. A&T.

Sykes has made nine appearances out of the bullpen, logging 16 innings on the season, recording two saves along the way. He has had at least two strikeouts in seven of his nine appearances, including a season-high five in two innings in a win at High Point (Feb. 19).

Jackson, like Sykes, has reached 24 strikeouts out of the bullpen for UNCG. His best single-game performances came at High Point (Feb. 19), where he fanned six Panther hitters in a UNCG win on Feb. 19 and is one of six multi-strikeout games for Jackson.

Triplett picked up eight of his 20 strikeouts as he earned his second win of the season in the first game of a doubleheader against Princeton (March 10). He tossed six innings, allowed two hits and three walks, while striking out eight Tiger hitters. The eight K's mark the most in a single game for any UNCG pitcher this season, topping a previous mark that was shared by both Triplett (7, vs. Quinnipiac (Feb. 16)) and Jack Voigt (7, vs. Penn (March 2)).

Sanderson climbed to fourth on the team in strikeouts after tying his season-high six over a seven-inning stretch in the first game of the doubleheader with Jacksonville (March 16). In what is arguably his best performance of the season, Sanderson scattered six hits, while allowing two runs and two walks to Dolphin hitters. He has made five starts over the course of the season, notching at least four K's in four of those outings.

Stephens has emerged as a dominant force out of the bullpen for the Spartans, making six appearances in March, resulting in two saves. He has four games with at least two strikeouts to his credit, including a pair of four-strikeout contests against Penn (March 2) and Winthrop (March 5).

"LINK" TO THE MLB: During UNCG head coach Link Jarrett's seven-year tenure as the Spartans head coach, which began in 2013, he has witnessed 15 players selected in the Major League Baseball Draft. That marks the most of any Southern Conference program with Samford (14), Western Carolina (11) and Mercer (10) also with 10 or more in that span.

SPARTANS TABBED SECOND IN PRESEASON POLLS: One year after winning the Southern Conference regular season title, the UNC Greensboro baseball team was picked second in the 2019 preseason coaches and media polls that were released on Thursday, Feb. 7.

The Spartans, who won their second regular season league title in program history since joining the Southern Conference in 1998, were 39-15 overall and 18-3 in conference action a season ago. UNCG has posted at least 35 wins in three straight seasons for the first time in program history. After earning wins in two elimination games in as many days, the Spartans season came to a close at the 2018 SoCon Tournament with an 8-4 setback to Western Carolina.

WEBSTER PRESEASON PLAYER OF THE YEAR, EMBLER FIRST TEAM ALL-CONFERENCE: Along with the distinction of being picked second as a team, junior infielder Caleb Webster was named as the league's Preseason Player of the Year and teammate Austin Emblar was selected First Team Preseason All-SoCon in a vote by the panelists.

It marks the second time in as many seasons that Webster has been named to First Team Preseason All-SoCon and the first time in his career that he drew Preseason Player of the Year accolades.

Webster, who hit from the two-spot of the lineup in all 54 games, finished the 2018 season with second-best batting average (.380) on the team and fourth-best in the conference a season ago. He was responsible for 11 extra-base hits on the campaign, while scoring 51 runs and driving in 37.

Webster finished with 29 multi-hit games in 2018, ending with a single-season high four hits on two occasions against Marist (4-4, RBI, 2 runs; March 3) and Mercer (4-5, run). The junior from Randleman, N.C., was also responsible for a .456 slugging percentage, .417 on-base percentage and seven stolen bases over the course of the slate.

Emblar, a redshirt senior from Southern Pines, N.C., was named to the First Team Preseason All-SoCon for the second time in as many seasons. He was the leadoff hitter in the UNCG lineup throughout the course of 2018, posting with a .357 batting average, ninth-best in the league and fourth-best on the team. Emblar finished tied with Cesar Trejo for most doubles (15) and was third on the team in hits (81), earning the second-best on-base percentage (.438) for the Spartans in the process.

<RECAPING LAST THREE FOR THE SPARTANS>

SPARTANS TAKE SATURDAY DOUBLEHEADER AGAINST JU: The UNCG baseball maintained its perfect record at home with a pair of wins against Jacksonville University on Saturday, March 16. The Spartans rallied for four runs in the ninth inning to complete a 5-4 victory in game one, before putting together a pair of five-run innings to earn a 13-3 win in the nightcap.

UNCG's junior standout Caleb Webster extended his hitting streak to six straight games after going 1-for-5 in the first game of the day and 1-for-4 in the second contest. He is now tied with teammate Josh Madole for the longest hitting streak of the season.

Leading the way for the Spartans on the mound were Corey Jackson, who improved to 2-0 on the season in the first game, and Brandon Stephens, who evened his mark to 1-1 on the season in the second game.

UNCG FAST FACTS (GAME 1)

-Spartan starter Phillip Sanderson tied his single-game season-high in strikeouts (six) as he faced 28 batters over seven innings of work where he scattered six hits, allowed two runs and two walks.

-Corey Jackson came out of the bullpen to grab his second win of the season. Jackson allowed three hits, two runs and two walks over two innings. It marked the first time in his 10 appearances in 2019 that he failed to record a strikeout.

-Greg Hardison (2-3, 2 runs) and Jacques Koonce (2-4, RBI) led the way for the top-third of the UNCG lineup, which accounted for five of the team's nine hits in the game.

-The four runs in the ninth mark the first time in 2019 that UNCG has scored in the ninth inning. The Spartans improved their mark to 1-3 on the season when leading after nine innings.

-While an 0-for-3 performance ended Ryan Caveness' hitting streak at five games, teammate Caleb Webster extended his hitting streak to five straight with a 1-for-5 outing at the plate that included an RBI.

UNCG FAST FACTS (GAME 2)

-The Spartans scored five runs in the bottom of the sixth inning, tying the most runs in a single inning with a five-run fifth that came against Quinnipiac (Feb. 15) in the season opener.

-UNCG topped double figure runs for the third time this season. The most in a single game was 12, which came in the 2019 opener versus Quinnipiac (Feb. 15).

-Spartans head coach Link Jarrett is now six wins away from his 200th career coaching victory.

-Caleb Webster tied Madole for the longest hitting streak by a Spartan this season (six games) after finishing the game 1-for-4 with an RBI and a run scored

-Brandon Stephens, one of three pitchers to toe the rubber for the Spartans in the game, evened his record to 1-1 on the season after tossing 2.2 innings, allowing one hit and striking out two of the 10 Dolphin hitters he faced.

-Austin Emblar recorded his third double of the season and Zach Kuchmaner had his first triple of the slate as UNCG tallied two extra-base hits in the contest.

JU TAKES THIRD GAME OF SERIES WITH 8-4 WIN: Zach Kuchmaner and Hogan Windish finished with two hits each, but it was a pair of multi-run innings that allowed visiting Jacksonville University to close out the third game of the series with an 8-4 victory at the UNCG Baseball Stadium on Sunday, March 17.

Kuchmaner capped off his fourth multi-hit performance of the season by going 2-of-3 from the plate with a pair of runs scored. Among the two hits included his second triple in as many games. Windish ended the day by hitting 2-for-4 at the plate, accruing his third extra-base hit of the season and first double along the way.

Facing a 7-2 deficit in the bottom of the seventh, UNCG (13-5) got its first runner on base in the frame when Ryan Caveness drew a walk. Kuchmaner followed with a single to centerfield, advancing to second on the throw as Caveness moved to third. After a pitching change, which brought Nick Love out of the bullpen for AJ Jones, Windish sent the third pitch through the left side of the infield for a pair of RBI.

Jacksonville (12-8) would tack on an insurance run in the ninth to complete the four-run victory, handing UNCG its first setback at home this season. The Dolphins offense finished the game with 13 hits, with four players having at least two hits in the game. Jones provided a solid presence on the mound for JU, tossing 6.1 innings, allowing four hits and four runs along the way, while striking out five UNCG hitters as he snagged his third win of the year.

UNCG Fast Facts

-Jacques Koonce, who swiped a base on Sunday, capped off the weekend with three stolen bases for the Spartans this weekend.

-Caleb Webster's six-game hitting streak was halted after he finished 0-for-4 from the plate.

-The 8-4 setback at home marks the first since the Spartans dropped an 8-7 decision to Elon on Tuesday, May 15, 2018.

-The 13 hits by the Dolphins mark just the fifth time this season and first time in the last nine games that an opponent has had double figure hits against the Spartans.

-Chad Sykes who finished with two strikeouts in 1.2 innings of work, is now the team's leader in K's with 24. He has one more than Jeremiah Triplett, three more than Phillip Sanderson and four more than Corey Jackson.

CAVENESS RESPONSIBLE FOR HR, FOUR RBI AGAINST AGGIES: UNCG junior Ryan Caveness finished 1-for-3 from the plate and tallied four RBI, while teammate Caleb Webster closed the game 2-for-3 with one RBI, but it was a three-run home run in the fifth inning by N.C. A&T that lifted the crosstown rivals to an 8-5 victory on Tuesday evening at the First National Bank Ballpark.

The Spartans (13-5) bolted out to a 3-0 lead in the first inning as Greg Hardison singled through the right side of the infield for the first UNCG hit. He came home shortly thereafter following a triple to right field by Caleb Webster, establishing a 1-0 lead. Two batters later, with Webster at third, Ryan Caveness lifted a two-run home run over the left field wall to give the Spartans a 3-0 lead.

The Aggies got one run back in the top of the second and eventually tied the game at three-all with a two-run third inning.

UNCG climbed back in front 4-3 when Caveness plated Caleb Webster with a sacrifice fly to right field in the fourth. The one-run lead remained intact until the fifth, when N.C. A&T (11-9) used a three-run home run by Camden Williamson to take a 6-4 lead. The Aggies would add runs in the sixth and ninth, while UNCG manufactured its fifth run in the seventh, on a grounder to third by Caveness, to make for the 8-5 final.

FAST FACTS VERSUS THE AGGIES

-The eight runs for the Aggies mark the most in the series against UNCG since they scored nine on March 22, 2016.

-Caveness' four-RBI outing against the Aggies mark the fourth time this season that he has multiple RBIs in a contest. His previous single-game season-high was three RBI, which came against High Point (2-5, 3 RBI / Feb. 19) and Jacksonville (1-2, 3 RBI / March 16).

-Greg Hardison extended his hitting streak to seven games after a leadoff single in the bottom of the first. The seven-game streak, which began on March 10 against Princeton, marks the longest by any Spartan this season, topping a series of six-game streaks by Mike Ferrara (March 2-March 9), Josh Madole (March 4-March 10) and Caleb Webster (March 10-March 16).

-Hogan Windish's five-game hitting streak came to an end after a 0-for-3 outing against the Aggies.

-Aggies have won back-to-back games in the series for the first time since the 2008 when N.C. A&T claimed a 10-7 win on April 2 and followed with a 5-3 victory on May 7. Before Tuesday's 8-5 victory, the Aggies posted a 3-2 win on April 2, 2018 at the UNCG Baseball Stadium.
