WAKE FOREST AT UNCG

THE MATCHUP

Wake Forest continues its road swing at UNCG on Tuesday on ESPN+. The game time was moved up an hour to 5 p.m.

LAST TIME OUT

- The Demon Deacons picked up a second-straight ACC series win, bouncing back from a Friday defeat to clinch the series at Duke. Wake Forest won a pair of one-run games, including a 5-4 victory in 12 innings on Sunday.
- Patrick Frick was named the ACC Player of the Week after hitting .538 (.7-for-13) over the weekend with a home run, double, four RBIs and two stolen bases.
- The Wake Forest bullpen was stellar in the wins on Saturday and Sunday, going a combined 11.1 shutout innings with 13 strikeouts and only seven hits allowed.

WAKE FOREST STORYLINES

- The Demon Deacon offense has picked up significantly since the calendar turned to March. In the 16 games this month, Wake Forest is hitting .308 as a team with 38 doubles and 22 home runs, averaging 8.6 runs per game. Patrick Frick and Michael Turconi are both hitting better than .400 this month, while Chris Lanzilli and Bobby Seymour have combined for 16 doubles, seven homers and 45 RBIs.
- The back end of Wake Forest's bullpen has been impressive as of late. William Fleming and Antonio Menendez both have ERAs below 3.00. That duo has combined to work 17.1 consecutive scoreless innings; Menendez has three-straight shutout outings covering 7.0 innings, while Fleming has tossed six-straight scoreless appearances over 10.1 innings, allowing just four hits and two walks in that span.

OPPONENT & SERIES HISTORY

- Wake Forest leads the all-time series against UNCG, 41-15. The Deacs won the Feb. 27 meeting in Winston-Salem in 10 innings on a Patrick Frick walk-off RBI single. Wake Forest head coach Tom Walter missed the game due to an illness.
- UNCG is an impressive 12-1 as the home team, including a perfect 12-0 at UNCG Baseball Stadium as its only home loss was played at First National Bank Field. The Spartans have a team ERA of 3.80, led by Chad Sykes, whose only earned run surrendered in 22.0 innings (0.41 ERA) came at the hands of the Deacs.

- Wake Forest travels to No. 10 Louisville this weekend for a three-game series on ACC Network Extra.

LUCK O' THE IRISH?

Chris Lanzilli set a new program record with 10 RBIs in the 13-3 win over Boston College on St. Patrick's Day. The Massachusetts native hit a three-run homer in the fourth, an RBI groundout in the fifth, two-run single in the sixth and three-run homer in the eighth.

That capped a week (March 11-17) in which he hit .444 (8-for-18) with three homers, three doubles, 16 RBIs, two walks and a stolen base en route to ACC and National Player of the Week honors.

SWING AND A MISS

The Deacs broke a pair of program strikeout records the last two seasons. In 2017, Wake Forest surpassed the previous total strikeout record of 482 set in 1999 by more than 75, racking up 559.

Last year, Wake Forest set a new high mark in strikeouts per nine innings with 9.15, surpassing a strikeout per inning for the first time in program history.

Wake Forest's 58 strikeouts over four games (Feb. 23-25) are the most in a four-game stretch since at least 1999. The Deacs fanned 17 against Quinnipiac on Friday and 11 on Saturday, then against Elon, punched out 14 on Sunday and 16 on Monday.

WALTER CLIMBING THE CHARTS

Wake Forest head coach Tom Walter recently surpassed Marvin Crater for second-most victories in program history. Walter also claimed his 700th career win against Furman on March 3.

George Greer (1988-04) leads with 608 victories, and Marvin Crater (1976-87) is third all-time with 269.

Wake Forest was picked to finish fifth in the Atlantic Division in the ACC Baseball Preseason Coaches Poll. Louisville was projected to win the division and overall conference.

SHIFTING STAFF

Wake Forest elevated Bill Cilento to Associate Head Coach with a multi-year contract. Cilento has been on staff with Tom Walter for 10 years as hitting coach and recruiting coordinator.

Deacon alum John Hendricks has joined the staff as pitching coach. The 2000 Wake Forest graduate still leads Wake Forest with 34 career wins, and spent the last nine years working in Major League Baseball

including most recently as the National Pitching Supervisor for the New York Mets.

Connor Kaden comes aboard as a student assistant coach while finishing his Wake Forest degree. He signed after being drafted by the Giants his junior year, and had a 17-9 record and 3.45 ERA in four pro seasons.

Wake Forest also welcomed biomechanist Dr. Kristen Nicholson, director of equipment services Tony Joyce, and sports psychologist Rachel Conway to the support staff.

WAKE FOREST HEAD COACH TOM WALTER



HEAD COACH | 10TH YEAR | GEORGETOWN, 1991 | COACHES THIRD BASE | WEARS NO. 32

- Head coach Tom Walter is in his 10th season at the helm of Wake Forest baseball. Walter signed a new seven-year contract in 2017, which runs through 2024.
- Walter is one of two active head coaches in the country to lead three different programs to the NCAA Division I Tournament, becoming just the seventh coach all-time to do so. He joins the ranks of Larry Cochell, Augie Garrido, Sunny Golloway, Andy Lopez, Ron Polk and Jack Stallings. Randy Masey accomplished the feat in 2017.
- Players drafted in the top 10 rounds from Wake Forest under Walter include Mac Williamson (2012 - 3rd), Tim Cooney (2012 - 3rd), Will Craig (2016 - 1st), Stuart Fairchild (2017 - 2nd), Gavin Sheets (2017 - 2nd), Parker Dunshee (2017 - 7th), Ben Breazeale (2017 - 7th) and Griffin Roberts (2018 - 1st). Williamson and Cooney made their MLB debuts in 2015 after being third-round picks in 2012.
- At Wake Forest, Walter has overseen the development of 2016 National Player of the Year Will Craig, All-America selections Craig, Nate Mondou, Stuart Fairchild and Gavin Sheets, and a total of 20 All-ACC selections. Wake Forest had nine All-ACC picks in 2017, the most ever.
- Walter also has experience working with USA Baseball, spending time in the summer of 2016 as a manager of the Stars team at the 17U National Team Development

Program.

- Development off the field is equally as important as on the field under Walter. All of the program's seniors have graduated on time for five consecutive years, and the team has raised more than \$100,000 for various charities including the ALS Association, JDRF, and the Vs. Cancer Foundation. The team has had 100 percent roster participation in community service for eight straight years, and also took a service trip to the Dominican Republic in 2012. Walter also selflessly donated a kidney to outfielder Kevin Jordan just days before the 2011 season opener after Jordan was diagnosed with a serious kidney disease and needed a transplant.
- He guided his 2006 team at New Orleans through the aftermath of Hurricane Katrina. The team spent the fall in Las Cruces, New Mexico, then spent time in Mobile, Alabama, and Westwego, Louisiana, before returning to campus in March.
- The Johnstown, Pennsylvania native earned his degree in finance from Georgetown in 1991 and an MBA from George Washington in 1994. Walter started all four seasons for the Hoyas as a catcher and outfielder.
- Walter's son, Chase, is a freshman on the Georgetown baseball team.

Bill Ciento enters his 10th year at Wake Forest in 2019, after being promoted to Associate Head Coach in January 2019. He works primarily with the Demon Deacon hitters and infielders.

In his time as a coach, 56 of his student-athletes have gone on to play professionally, including five big leaguers.

He oversaw the development of National Player of the Year Will Craig, the first-round pick of the Pittsburgh Pirates in 2016. After not making an all-conference team his freshman year, Craig's improvement earned him ACC Player of the Year honors in 2015 and made him a unanimous first team All-American in 2016.

Wake Forest has had 13 hitters earn all-ACC honors the last four seasons. In 2017, Wake Forest became the first Division I school in the nation to surpass 100 home runs in the BBCOR era, leading the nation with 106 blasts and 1.68 longballs per game.

Ciento has coached with Tom Walter for 12 years, including a pair of seasons at New Orleans. Ciento was a four-year starter at Siena.

He and his wife, Jen, have three daughters: Brooke, Katie and Megan.

John Hendricks joined the coaching staff at his alma mater in December and will serve as the pitching coach.

Hendricks still ranks as the program's all-time leader with 34 career wins and 409.2 innings pitched, and was also the strikeout leader with 312 until 2017.

Hendricks spent more than nine years working in the MLB, including the last five seasons with the New York Mets. After two years as the Area Supervisor of the Carolinas, he was promoted to National Pitching Supervisor in 2015.

In that role, Hendricks was responsible for evaluating and drafting pitchers nationally. He served as a voice on the Mets' staff on the future of pitching development and mentored a staff on the science of scouting pitchers.

He has also served as a roving pitching coordinator with the USA Baseball U-18 National Team Program. He has assisted in the player evaluation and roster building process, and also served as an on-field pitching coach and head coach.

Hendricks has worked at the collegiate level. He spent two seasons at Tennessee Wesleyan, serving as an assistant coach, where the team reached the NAIA World Series, and also spent five years at Lenoir Rhyne, starting as a graduate assistant and working his way up to associate head coach.

Joey Hammond joined the Wake Forest coaching staff as the volunteer assistant coach and enters his fifth season in 2019. A former professional baseball player for 11 years, Hammond came to Wake Forest after spending five seasons as the head coach of Westchester Country Day School.

Hammond works extensively with the Wake Forest outfielders. Under his watch, Stuart Fairchild was perfect defensively in both 2015 and 2017, earning the 2017 Rawlings Gold Glove Award in the outfield.

The Deacs have become one of the nation's top offenses under Hammond's assistance. Wake Forest became the first Division I school in the nation to surpass 100 home runs in the BBCOR era, leading the nation with 106 blasts in 2017.

Hammond was drafted in the 25th round of the 1998 MLB Draft by the Baltimore Orioles and spent eight seasons with the Orioles and three with the Phillies. He recorded more than 1,000 career hits, playing primarily at the AAA level.

Hammond earned a bachelor's degree from Charlotte and was a standout shortstop from 1996-98. He was First Team All-Conference USA in 1998 after batting .398 with 100 hits.

He and his wife, Rebecca, have three sons: Caleb, Josh and Mason.

THE COUCH

- David F. Couch Ballpark is home to the Demon Deacon baseball team. The Deacons moved in to the facility before the start of the 2009 season after playing the previous 28 seasons on campus at historic Gene Hooks Stadium.
- Formerly known as Ernie Shore Field, the park was home to Winston-Salem's Carolina League minor league team for more than 40 years. Wake Forest purchased the facility after the team, now known as the Winston-Salem Dash, moved in to a new downtown ballpark.
- In February 2016, Wake Forest baseball park has been named David F. Couch Ballpark in honor of former baseball player David Couch ('84). A longtime supporter of Wake Forest Athletics and the baseball program, Couch made the lead gift toward new \$12 million facility, which opened in February 2017, and included construction of a new dugout and bullpen, locker room, equipment room, training room, team lounge, nutrition area, and pitching lab.
- The latest phase of the Chris Hurd Player Development Center was made possible, in part, thanks to the generosity of Chris and Nancy Hurd who made the lead gift toward the project. It features a team meeting room, dedicated video room, coaches' offices, a biomechanist's office, a conference room, game day suites, and a baseball heritage area. It was dedicated on Oct. 12, 2018, and the construction wrapped up in January 2019.
- With the completion of the pitching lab inside the Chris Hurd Player Development Center at David F. Couch Ballpark, the state-of-the-art biomechanics lab will be used to develop Wake Forest student-athletes and transform the game of baseball. Wake Forest Athletics is partnering with Wake Forest Baptist Health on a historic agreement, which will combine the two units to enhance player safety and development. On Wake Forest's side, pitching coach John Hendricks, athletic trainer Jeff Strahm and strength coach Mark Seaver will work with Wake Baptist's Dr. Brian Waterman, the team physician specializing in shoulder and elbow care, and biophysicist Dr. Kristen Nicholson.
- Wake Forest players also have access to state-of-the-art technology with the Trackman Pro video system with cameras set up on both the first and third base dugouts, center field and behind home plate. The system allows hitters to view their swings and pitchers their pitching motions following each game, and tracks 27 different data points varying from pitch velocity to spin rate to launch angle.
- Previous renovations include:
 - 2015: Visiting clubhouse converted into state-of-the-art weight room facility.
 - 2013: Multi-colored chairback seats replaced with modern all-black seats.
 - 2012: 18' x 24' LED video board installed.
 - 2011: AstroTurf GameDay 3D52H Grass installed, as well as the manual scoreboard in left field.
 - 2010: Indoor hitting facility built beyond left field.
 - 2009: Wake Forest purchased and moved into stadium. It previously belonged to the Winston-Salem Dash since it was built in 1956.

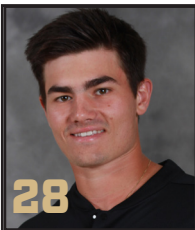
