UNCG Quick Hits

- The Spartans lead the SoCon in scoring defense (60.5 points per game), rebounding margin (+3.4) and defensive rebounding percentage (.712).
- Nadine Soliman ranks in the conference second in scoring (19.1 points per game), made three's per game (2.3) and defensive rebounds per game (5.9) and third in rebounding (7.4 rebounds per game).
- Soliman has recorded 1,540 points in her career and needs 46 more points to move into second place ahead of Angie Polk (1985-89).
- UNCG has recorded 19 double-doubles by four different Spartans, led by Te'ja Twitty (eight) and Soliman (seven). Twitty has recorded 19 double-doubles in her career for third-most in school history.

Series History

- Chattanooga leads the series 44-9. The Mocs won at home 64-54 on Feb. 1, and the Spartans took the meeting in Fleming last week 53-49. No. 6 seed UNCG won 70-66 in double-overtime in last year's quarterfinals of the SoCon Tournament, but Chattanooga has won seven of the nine overall meetings in the tournament.

WHAT'S IN STORE

No. 6 seed UNC Greensboro squares off against No. 3 Chattanooga in the quarterfinals of the 2019 Ingles Southern Conference Women's Basketball Championship presented by General Shale. This is the second-straight year the two schools have matched up in the No. 3-No. 6 game.

SOLIMAN & TWITTY NAMED ALL-SOCON

Nadine Soliman was named to the All-Southern Conference First-Team while Te'ja Twitty garnered second-team honors, the league announced Tuesday. Both players earned the honors from the coaches and the SoCon Sports Media Association.

Soliman has earned all-SoCon honors each year of her career with selections to the second-team the previous two seasons in addition to being named the freshman of the year. This is the second season accolade for Twitty as she was picked to the all-freshmen team in 2016-17.

Soliman has been one of the top scorers and rebounders in the SoCon this season, ranking second and 31st in the nation in points per game (19.1) and third in boards per game (7.4). Leading the league in minutes played (35.3 per game), she's also placed second in defensive rebounds (5.9 per game), tied for second in made three's per game (2.3), third in free throw percentage (.815) and eighth in steals (1.5 per game) and three-point percentage (.338). She's recorded 14 games with 20+ points with only one game with less than 10 points and seven double-doubles, including five in league play, and set the school-record for most defensive rebounds in a single-season with 171.

Twitty ranks one slot above Soliman in rebounding at 8.0 rpg while being one of the most efficient scorers in the conference with a .513 field goal percentage (third-best in the league and 50th in D-I). Placing seventh in scoring (12.8 ppg), she has done her damage more so on the offensive glass, ranking second at 3.6 per game. She leads the team with eight double-doubles despite missing three non-conference games.

SOLIMAN LOOKS TO ENTER TOP-TWO IN SCORING

Nadine Soliman became the 25th player in school history to record her 1,000th career point. The Cairo, Egypt native needed 14 points against Georgia State to reach the milestone and Soliman finished with a game-high 20 points against the Panthers. Her 16.2 career points per game average currently ranks second all-time in school history after two-plus seasons.

With her 21-point effort earlier this season against Mercer, Soliman took sole possession of third place on the school's all-time scoring list with 1,465 points, surpassing Melinda Goodson who left with 1,464 points to her credit. Soliman reached the milestone by hitting 8-of-13 from the field and 3-of-6 from beyond the arc against the Bears. She needs 46 more points to move ahead of Angie Polk for second place.

SOLIMAN'S OTHER TOP MARKS IN SCHOOL HISTORY

As one of the top scorers in program history, Soliman ranks in the top-five in both career field goals (562) and three-point field goals (165) and is on pace to finish this season as third in both categories. She needs just 11 more field goals to move into third place ahead of Wendy Engelmann. For three's, five more will slide her ahead of Amanda Eaton and Amanda Leigh for third place.

Soliman is having one of the best scoring seasons in school history. With at least one more game left in the year, she ranks first in defensive rebounds (171), second in scoring (595) and tied for second in three-point field goals (67). She's on pace to finish second in total points and three's made.

TWITTY ENTERS TOP-10 IN REBOUNDING

Te'ja Twitty recorded five rebounds against Mercer (1/19) to record her 592nd rebound to enter the top-10 in school history. Twitty moved into ninth place past Michelle Blazevich at 660 with nine boards in the win over Western Carolina and then into eighth place last Thursday against Chattanooga with 11 boards. She needs just six more to slide ahead of Brianne Dodgen for seventh place.

TWITTY LOOKS TO JOIN 1,000-POINT CLUB

Te'ja Twitty has scored 12.8 points per game this season, the first time she's averaged over 10 points a game in her career. She has 963 career points and will become the 26th 1,000-point scorer in program history with 37 more points.

RANKINGS

Nadine Soliman ranks second in the SoCon and ranks 38th in the NCAA with 19.1 ppg. Shooting 51.3% from the field, Te'ja Twitty ranks 50th in the category.

The Spartans lead the SoCon in several areas:

- Scoring defense (60.5), ranking 86th in the NCAA.
- Rebounding margin (+3.4), 91st in the nation.
- Defensive rebounding percentage (.712).

DOUBLE-DOUBLES

Four Spartans have recorded double-doubles this season for a total of 19 double-doubles this season, led by Te'ja Twitty (eight) and Nadine Soliman (seven). Soliman had five in SoCon play while Twitty had four. Twitty ranks third all-time with 19 career double-doubles while Soliman is tied for eighth (eight).

HOME SWEET HOME

The Spartans were 9-4 this season at Fleming Gymnasium and won four of seven games in SoCon play. They outscored opponents by an average of 15.3 points (66.7-51.4) with a rebounding margin of +6.1.

SOLIMAN RANKS TOP-THREE IN SIX CATEGORIES

Nadine Soliman ranks in the top-three of the SoCon in six categories. She ranks first in minutes played (35.3 per game), second in scoring, tied for second in 3-point field goals made per game (2.4) and third in overall rebounding (7.4), defensive rebounds per game (5.7) and free throw percentage (.815). She's also eighth in three-point field goal percentage (.338) and steals (1.5 per game).

RECORDS BROKEN

In a 92-23 win against Pfeiffer on Nov. 11, the Spartans gave up less than 10 points in each of the four quarters and only gave up six points in the second half. The 23 points given up is the fourth least amount in school history and the lowest in the Division I era.

The 69-point margin of victory was the largest in the Division I era and the sixth most in school history, while the 64 rebounds in the second most in school history and the most in the Division I era.

NEW STAFF

Head coach Trina Patterson replaced four staff members this offseason. Patterson hired two assistant coaches Cetera DeGraffenreid and Ido Singer last summer.

DeGraffenreid is a graduate of North Carolina and comes from Gardner-Webb after three seasons, while Singer is a graduate of Capella and brings over 10 years of coaching experience.

Patterson also hired a graduate and a new director of operations to finish the women's basketball staff. Maya Solomon graduated and played at Maryville, while Ariel Caraway graduated from Texas and worked in the athletic

department at Texas.

2018-19 SQUAD

The Spartans returned 10 letterwinners and lost two from the youngest team in the NCAA.

UNCG has four newcomers with three transfers: Tori Powell (LIU Brooklyn), Rhianna Council (St. Bonaventure) and Kianna Funderburk (Vermont). Council and Funderburk are sitting out the season, while Powell returned after the conclusion of the fall semester.

The only true freshman on the team is Areon Laurent from Jacksonville, N.C. Laurent went to Jacksonville HS.
