THINGS TO WATCH

UNCG picked to finish second in SoCon in both the coaches and media poll. The Spartans are the defending regular season champions.

UNCG is unbeaten at home this season following a sweep of Penn last weekend on March 1-2, 4. The Spartans have outscored their opponents 41-22 at home in 2019, eclipsing double-digit runs on two occasions.

UNCG has faced off against the Tigers 12 times under head coach Link Jarrett. Jarrett is 8-4 as a head coach against Princeton, winning three of those games in extra innings.

UNCG head coach Link Jarrett needs 13 wins to reach 200 career wins. Jarrett picked up three wins against Penn in a recent series, moving him to 187 career victories. During head coach Link Jarrett's seven-year tenure with the Spar-

QUICK HITS (vs. PRINCETON)

- ▶The Spartans have played five of the eight schools that currently make up the Ivy League since the program's induction in 1991. UNCG has not faced off against Brown and Dartmouth, and recently squared off against Penn for the first-time last weekend. The Spartans have played a combined 43 games against Columbia (1x), Cornell, (3x), Harvard (5x), Penn (3x), Princeton (26x) and Yale (5x). The Spartans, who are 27-15-1 all-time against these schools, have played 42 of the 43 games in Greensboro. The lone exception coming in 2015, when UNCG squared off against Columbia in Wilmington, N.C.
- ▶In their 43 meetings against Ivy League teams, the Spartans have outscored their opponents 330-180, averaging 7.7 runs per contest along the way. UNCG has eclipsed double-digit runs on 16 occasions, including a 16-run output against Princeton on March 8, 2015, under Link Jarrett, that marks the most runs by a UNCG team against an Ivy League opponent. There have been seven extra-inning affairs with Ivy League schools and UNCG is 3-4 in those contests. The most recent extra-inning contest resulted in a 6-5 UNCG victory in 13 innings of game two of a double-header against Penn on March 2, 2018. That eclipsed the previous mark of 12 innings, which also resulted in an UNCG win (11-10) on March 14, 2014 against Princeton.
- ▶The Spartans have faced Princeton 26 times in program history (since 1991) and own a 16-10 lead in the all-time series. UNCG won seven of the first eight meetings in the series, which came between March 21, 2006 and March 17, 2008 under former head coach Mike Gaski. And, while the Spartans won the six of the next seven contests in the series, also under Gaski, the six wins were later vacated by the NCAA Infractions committee. Under current head coach Link Jarrett, UNCG won the first three meetings against the Tigers, which spanned between March 20, 2013 and March 15, 2014. However, since Princeton's 11-1 win on March 16, 2014, the two programs are 5-4 in the series, with UNCG holding a one-game edge in that span.
- ▶UNCG and Princeton share two common opponents on their 2019 schedules—George Mason and Penn. The Spartans recently concluded their three-game set against Penn, all resulting in victories, and will face George Mason for a three-game series on April 12-14. While UNCG was squaring off against Penn a week ago, Princeton traveled to Fairfax, Va., for a season-opening three-game series against George Mason. The Tigers opened the 2019 slate with a 5-3 win, but dropped the next two to the Patriots by scores of 6-0 and 7-6 (10 innings). Princeton will not face Penn until April 13-14, when they head to Philadelphia.
- ▶ Princeton was picked to finish sixth in the 2019 lvy League preseason poll. The Tigers have appeared in 12 of 26 lvy League Championship Series, while Dartmouth (12), Harvard (8), Columbia (7), Yale (6), Penn (4), Cornell (3) and Brown (1) have also made appearances.
- ▶The Ivy League has won five games in the NCAA Baseball Regionals over the last four years, with Columbia advancing to the regional final in Coral Gables in 2015 and Yale advancing to the regional finale in Corvallis in 2017.

SPARTANS TABBED SECOND IN PRESEASON POLLS: One year after winning the Southern Conference regular season title, the UNC Greensboro baseball team was picked second in the 2019 preseason coaches and media polls that were released on Thursday, Feb. 7.

The Spartans, who won their second regular season league title in program history since joining the Southern Conference in 1998, were 39-15 overall and 18-3 in conference action a season ago. UNCG has posted at least 35 wins in three straight seasons for the first time in program history. After earning wins in two elimination games in as many days, the Spartans season came to a close at the 2018 SoCon Tournament with an 8-4 setback to Western Carolina.

WEBSTER PRESEASON PLAYER OF THE YEAR, EMBLER FIRST TEAM ALL-CONFERENCE: Along with the distinction of being picked second as a team, junior infielder Caleb Webster was named as the league's Preseason Player of the Year and teammate Austin Embler was selected First Team Preseason All-SoCon

in a vote by the panelists.

It marks the second time in as many seasons that Webster has been named to First Team Preseason All-SoCon and the first time in his career that he drew Preseason Player of the Year accolades.

Webster, who hit from the two-spot of the lineup in all 54 games, finished the 2018 season with second-best batting average (.380) on the team and fourth-best in the conference a season ago. He was responsible for 11 extra-base hits on the campaign, while scoring 51 runs and driving in 37.

Webster finished with 29 multi-hit games in 2018, ending with a single-season high four hits on two occasions against Marist (4-4, RBI, 2 runs; March 3) and Mercer (4-5, run). The junior from Randleman, N.C., was also responsible for a .456 slugging percentage, .417 on-base percentage and seven stolen bases over the course of the slate.

Embler, a redshirt senior from Southern Pines, N.C., was named to the First Team Preseason All-SoCon for the second time in as many seasons. He was the leadoff hitter in the UNCG lineup throughout the course of 2018, posting with a .357 batting average, ninth-best in the league and fourth-best on the team. Embler finished tied with Cesar Trejo for most doubles (15) and was third on the team in hits (81), earning the second-best on-base percentage (.438) for the Spartans in the process.

Of those 43 meetings against Ivy League programs, 27 took place under former head coach Mike Gaski and 16 have come under current Spartan head coach Link Jarrett. Gaski was 16-10-1 in his tenure against schools from the Ivy League, with six of the losses coming by virtue of infractions that took place between 2009-11. Meanwhile, Jarrett is a combined 11-5 all-time in head-to-head meetings against Ivy League schools, owning a 8-4 mark versus Princeton, 3-0 all-time record against Penn and a 0-1 mark versus Columbia.

Webster, who hails from Randleman, N.C., is an infielder entering just junior season.

Sykes is in his redshirt senior season for the Spartans from Creedmoor, N.C. Kuchmaner, also a redshirt senior for the Spartans, joined the program from Charlotte, N.C. Embler is a redshirt senior at UNCG and is from Southern Pines, N.C.

LEAVING THE OPPOSING HITTERS LOOKING: Seven members of the Spartan pitching staff, including Chad Sykes (19 K's), Corey Jackson (14), Jeremiah Triplett (12), Austin Koehn (12), Brandon Stephens (11), Phillip Sanderson (10) and Jack Voigt (10) have recorded double-digit strikeouts over the first 10 games of the slate.

Two of those, Sykes and Jackson, have been integral parts of a bullpen that has combined for 69 strikeouts in 47 innings of work (1.5 strikeouts per inning). Meanwhile, trio of Sanderson, Triplett and Koehn lead the way for a UNCG starters, who have collectively struck out 38 opposing hitters in 44.1 innings on the mound (0.86 strikeouts per inning).

"LINK" TO THE MLB: During UNCG head coach Link Jarrett's seven-year tenure as the Spartans head coach, which began in 2013, he has witnessed 15 players selected in the Major League Baseball Draft. That marks the most of any Southern Conference program with Samford (14), Western Carolina (11) and Mercer (10) also with 10 or more in that span.

<LAST THREE GAMES RECAPS>

UNCG OPENS THREE-GAME SERIES AGAINST PENN WITH 5-3 VICTORY:

UNCG capitalized on two runs in the bottom of the eighth to break a three-all tie and earn the 5-3 victory in the opening game of the doubleheader on Saturday. Freshman Jacquez Koone reached on a bases loaded error at shortstop, scoring David Flores from third for the game-winning run. Despite Greg Hardison's swinging strikeout, Madole scored on a wild pitch from third to add the insurance run.

Chad Sykes (1-1), who struck out four of the eight batters he faced in 2.1

innings on the mound, earned the victory for the Spartans. He allowed only one walk and threw 36 pitches. Starter Phillip Sanderson scattered six hits over 5.2 innings, allowing two earned runs and one walk, while striking out four Quaker hitters.

Koonce (2-4, RBI) came through multiple hits for UNCG in the game, while Flores (1-3, RBI, HR, 2 runs), Hardison (1-4, RBI, double, run) and Webster (1-4, RBI) also had solid outings.

THREE-RUN EIGHTH INNING LEADS UNCG TO 10-7 WIN: UNC Greensboro used a three-run eighth inning to break a seven-all tie with Penn to sweep the Quakers by a score of 10-7 at UNCG Baseball Stadium on Monday afternoon. The game-winning run came when David Flores drew a bases loaded walk to score teammate Greg Hardison from third.

Three Spartan hitters had two hits on the day, including Hardison (2-5, 2 runs), Caleb Webster (2-5, double, 2 runs) and Zach Kuchmaner (2-4, RBI). UNCG also received two each RBI from the trio of Josh Madole (1-4, 2 runs), Mike Ferrara (1-3, run) and Jacquez Koonce (1-4, run).

Chad Sykes (1-1) got the win after tossing the final 1.1 innings, allowing two hits while striking out two Penn hitters. Starter Jeremiah Triplett logged 6.1 innings, scattering six hits, four runs (three earned) and two walks while striking out three hitters. He gave way to Corey Jackson, who had a rough outing with three runs on three hits, along with two walks in 1.1 innings.

UNCG (6-3) established a 7-1 lead in the contest, scoring two runs in the first inning after back-to-back hits to lead off the game by Hardison and Webster. Ryan Caveness drew a bases loaded walk to provide the first run and Madole grounded to first to bring home the second.

After Penn (0-3) scored in the top of the fourth, to cut the Spartans' lead to 2-1, UNCG answered with three runs in the home half of the frame. Madole singled to right centerfield to become the first batter to reach base in the fourth, moving to third on a walk and a hit by pitch. Koonce came through with a single down the left field line, scoring Ferrara and Madole to make for a 4-1 Spartan lead. After stealing third, Koonce advanced home on a wild pitch for the four-run advantage.

UNCG had its third multi-run inning of the day in the fifth, which began with a Flores double to right centerfield. Two batters later, Madole reached on a fielder's choice to put runners on the corner for Ferrara. The freshman delivered a single through the right side of the infield, scoring Flores for the 6-1 lead. Zach Kuchmaner roped a single up the middle for the Spartans, plating Madole for the six-run lead.

Penn took advantage of a four-run seventh and a two-run eighth to pull even at seven-all. Hardison got things going in the eighth by reaching on a fielding error, moving to third on a double to left by Webster. Embler was intentionally walked to load the bases and Flores worked the count to draw the walk for the 8-7 lead. Madole followed with a walk, which scored Webster, before a free pass was issued to Ferrara for the final run of the game in the form of Embler.

WINTHROP RALLIES LATE, WINS 6-3: UNCG finished the game with eight hits, two coming off the bat of Josh Madole, but it was a run in the sixth and two runs in the eighth that proved to be the difference as Winthrop emerged with a 6-3 victory on Tuesday, March 5 at the Winthrop Ballpark.

Madole (2-4) was the lone hitter in the UNCG lineup with multiple hits. The Spartans (6-4) finished with three extra base hits in the contest, including doubles by Caleb Webster (1-3) and Ryan Caveness (1-3, RBI, run) along with the team leading third home run off the bat of David Flores (1-4, RBI, run).

A total of five pitchers took the mound for the Spartans, allowing seven Winthrop (4-6) hits and six earned runs. Among them was starter Austin Koehn, who had a no decision after logging five innings, allowing three runs on four hits while striking out three Eagle hitters.

The quartet of relivers included Brandon Stephens, Alex Hoppe, Maddux Holshouser and Austin Parsley. Stephens (0-1) was responsible for the loss after allowing three runs on three hits, despite striking out a game-high four Winthrop hitters that he faced over two innings. The trio of Hoppe, Houlshouser and Parsley did not allow a run, but issued two walks over the final inning on the mound.
