THINGS TO WATCH

UNCG reliever Chad Sykes ranks second in the nation in ERA (0.58). Sykes, who has allowed just two earned runs this season, recently had his longest stint (4 IP) against Furman on April 6th.

UNCG heads into the meeting with North Carolina with six wins against the Tar Heels in the all-time series. The last win came under head coach Link Jarrett on April 28, 2015 when UNCG emerged with a 5-3 victory in Chapel Hill.

UNCG head coach Link Jarrett has nine victories against Atlantic Coast Conference schools in his seven years at the helm. Three of the wins have come in extra innings against NC State, Duke and Wake Forest.

The UNCG hitter with the longest hitting streak of the season (15 games) is Coleman Sawyer. Sawyer extended his streak to 15 games with a walk-off single to left field in the ninth against Furman (April 7) as UNCG emerged with the 2-1 victory.

Spartan head coach Link Jarrett picked up his 200th and 201st career coaching victories this weekend as UNCG took 2-of-3 games in the series against Furman. The 200th win came in an 11-9 (13 inn.) victory.

QUICK HITS (vs. NORTH CAROLINA)

- ▶ The Spartans face their third Atlantic Coast Conference opponent of the season on Tuesday, April 9th, when they head to Chapel Hill to play North Carolina for the first time since April 28, 2015. It will mark the fifth game of the season against an ACC opponent for UNCG, after a pair of contests against Virginia Tech (Feb. 24-25) and meetings with Wake Forest on Feb. 27 and March 26.
- ▶ Three members of the UNCG baseball team—Coleman Sawyer, Greg Hardison, Josh Madole—have ongoing hitting streaks of at least 11 games. Sawyer owns the longest hitting streak for the Spartans this season (15 games), surpassing Hardison on Sunday, March 31 against Western Carolina, after Hardison missed the series with the Catamounts due to injury. Madole, who has reached base via a hit in his last 12 games, has put together the second-longest hitting streak of the season in the process.
- ▶The Spartans have faced seven different Atlantic Coast Conference opponents in the seven years under head coach Link Jarrett. UNCG has also squared off against Clemson (2x), Duke (5x), Georgia Tech (3x), NC State (7x), Virginia Tech (2x) and Wake Forest (12x). The Spartans are 9-23 in clashes with ACC opponents, with three of the wins coming in extra innings against NC State, Duke and Wake Forest. ▶The pair of Chad Sykes and Corey Jackson have proved to be a major force out of the UNCG bullpen in 2019.

The duo ranks among the top of five in six statistical categories for the Spartans, including ERA (Skyes-1st, 0.58 / Jackson-5th, 4.25), wins (Skyes-1st, 4 / Jackson-1st, 4), strikeouts (Sykes-1st, 42 / Jackson-2nd, 37), innings pitched (Sykes-4th, 31 / Jackson-5th, 29.2), appearances (Jackson-1st, 17 / Sykes-t-2nd, 14) and opposing batting average (Sykes-1st, .176 / Jackson-5th, .241).

Along with ranking atop the UNCG staff in multiple statistical categories, Sykes ranks nationally in ERA (2nd-0.58), strikeouts per nine innings (36th-12.19) and hits allowed per nine innings (36th-5.52).

►The two teams have faced only two common opponents at this juncture of the 2019 season—N.C. A&T and Virginia Tech.

North Carolina, ranked No. 5 in the nation when they took on the Aggies, scored two runs in the seventh inning to come away with the 2-1 victory. The Tar Heels were limited to three hits in the game, but a two-run double off the bat of Ashton McGee proved to be the difference. UNCG's meeting with A&T, which came at First National Bank Field on March 19, resulted in an 8-5 win by the Aggies.

The Tar Heels also made a trek to Blacksburg, Va., in 2019, coming away with a 2-1 series win. After dropping the first game by a 4-1 decision on March 22nd, North Carolina took the next two games of the series by scores of 7-5 (March 23) and 5-2 (March 24) to win its second ACC series of the season.

The Hokies and Spartans played two games in late February with Virginia Tech posting a 12-4 win in the first game on Feb. 25. UNCG limited the Hokies to two runs on eight hits in the second game, but Virginia Tech used a seventh inning home run by Kerry Carpenter to escape with the 2-1 victory.

BUDZIK NAMED SoCON PLAYER OF THE WEEK: After a week in which he finished 7-of-14 from the plate (.500 batting average) and was responsible for four RBI, four doubles and a walk-off home run, UNCG freshman Zack Budzik was named Southern Conference Player of the Week for all games April 1-7.

Budzik, who had not gotten a hit on the season in three at-bats, capped off the four-game stretch against High Point (one game) and Furman (three games) by amassing a .929 slugging percentage and a .563 on-base percentage, drawing just one walk in the four games, while swiping two bases.

The Stallings, N.C., native opened the week by going 2-for-3 against High Point (April 3). With UNCG facing a 3-0 deficit heading in to the bottom of the fifth, Budzik connected on a double down the left field line that scored David Flores for the first run of the game. UNCG took the lead in the home half of the seventh, scoring five runs on four hits when Budzik delivered a single to left that scored the pinch-runner Hogan Windish from third to knot the game at 3-3. Austin Embler followed with a single up the middle, scoring Budzik, to give UNCG its first lead.

Budzik improved on the High Point performance by going 2-for-3 in the opening game of the Furman series (April 5), both of which went for doubles. He helped the Spartans record at least two doubles in a game for the 14th time this season and UNCG has at least two doubles in nine of its last 13 games.

In the second game of the doubleheader, Budzik capped off a 2-for-6 performance with a walk-off two-run home run over the left field wall in the 13th inning to give UNCG its 19th win of the season and head coach Link Jarrett his 200th career coaching win. Budzik played a key role in a four-run ninth inning with a single to left, coming home on a two-run home run by Webster. Four innings later, with David Flores at first, Budzik lifted a 2-0 pitch to left field to give the Spartans their 16th home win.

Budzik wrapped up the week by going 1-for-2 from the plate against the Paladins in a 2-1 victory Sunday (April 7).

DIRTY DOZEN: The Spartans have 12 players who have recorded at least one multi-hit game over the course of the 2019 slate, including Josh Madole (12x) and Caleb Webster (11x), who have notched the most of any hitters on the UNCG roster.

Madole has rocketed to the top of the list after having five multi-hit performances in the last six contests, dating back to the second game of the Western Carolina series on March 30. He finished 2-for-5 against the Catamounts in that outing and followed with a 2-for-3 outing in the series finale with Western Carolina (March 31).

Last week opened Madole with a 2-for-4 performance against High Point (April 3), finishing with an RBI and two runs as a result. He continued his hot hitting in the series opener with Furman (April 5), going 2-for-4 from the plate with a run scored, before coming through with a 2-for-6 outing against the Paladins on April 6th.

Webster capped off the month of March with eight multi-hit performances, including his best single-game performance of the season versus Wake Forest on Tuesday, March 26, finishing 4-of-5 from the plate with an RBI and a run scored. Four days later, in the second game of the Western Carolina series, Webster was 2-for-3 from the plate with an RBI, marking his final multi-hit game of March.

Webster's most recent multi-hit performance came against High Point (April 3), where he was 2-of-5 from the plate with three RBI and two runs. One of the hits was his first homerun of the season, the other resulted in his eighth double of the campaign.

Freshman Zack Budzik, who has enjoyed three multi-hit outings in his last four games, is tied with Madole for the most multi-hit games in April (three). Budzik, who had not recorded a hit in his first three plate appearances of the season, came through with a 2-for-3 outing, which resulted in two RBI, two runs and a double in a clash with High Point on April 3rd.

In the series opener against Furman (April 5), Budzik capped off a 2-for-3 outing with two doubles. He followed that up by going 2-for-6 with two RBI and two runs versus the Paladins on April 6th. One of those two hits was a walk-off home run in the bottom of the 13th inning, which provided UNCG with the 11-9 victory.

IN THE MIDST OF A STREAK: Three members of the UNCG baseball team—Coleman Sawyer, Greg Hardison, Josh Madole—have ongoing hitting streaks of at least 11 games.

Sawyer owns the longest hitting streak for the Spartans this season (15 games), surpassing Hardison on Sunday, March 31 against Western Carolina, after Hardison missed the series with the Catamounts due to injury.

Madole, who has reached base via a hit in his last 12 games, has put together the second-longest hitting streak of the season in the process.

Both Sawyer and Hardison began their hitting streaks in the first game of the doubleheader against Princeton on March 10. Sawyer finished 1-for-3 from the plate versus the Tigers, driving in an RBI and scoring one run in the process.

Sawyer has had a pair of two-hit games during his current 15-game hitting streak, notching his last multi-hit performance on March 30 against Western Carolina, where he finished 2-for-3 from the plate. In the four games since that point, Sawyer has finished with one hit in each contest, three of which came on a single, with the exception being a double versus Furman (April 6).

Madole has put together the second-longest hitting streak by a Spartan this season (12 games) by virtue of having at least two hits in five of his last six contests. His hitting streak began at First National Bank Field, versus crosstown rival N.C. A&T on March 19 when he finished 1-for-4 from the plate with a double. The sophomore slugger has a total of seven multi-hit games in his current streak, posting two hits against Mercer (March 22), Wake Forest (March 26), Western Carolina (March 30 / March 31), High Point (April 3) and Furman (April 5 / April 6).

Madole is one of three UNCG hitters, along with Caleb Webster, Ryan Caveness, to have at least a pair of five-game streaks for the Spartans this season.

Madole's first hitting streak (six games) spanned from March 2-March 10, ending after a 0-for-1 outing against Princeton (March 10). Webster's longest streak is six games, which stretched from March 9-March 16, while his second-longest streak (five games) went from March 23-March 30.

Caveness put together his first multi-game hitting streak (six games) of the slate between March 9-March 16. His current five-game hitting streak began on March 31st against Western Carolina, when he went 1-for-4 from the plate.

Hardison, who has missed the last seven games due to injury, began his hitting streak against Princeton on March 10. He has a trio of multi-hit outings in that span, which took place against Elon (March 12; 2-5), Jacksonville (March 16; 2-3) and Jacksonville (March 16; 2-5) in succession. The sophomore slugger has amassed three doubles during the current 11-game hitting streak, which came in games against Jack-

sonville (March 17), Mercer (March 23 / March 24).

SOLID ONE, TWO PUNCH: The pair of Chad Sykes and Corey Jackson have proved to be a major force out of the UNCG bullpen in 2019.

The duo ranks among the top of five in six statistical categories for the Spartans, including ERA (Skyes-1st, 0.58 / Jackson-5th, 4.25), wins (Skyes-1st, 4 / Jackson-1st, 4), strikeouts (Sykes-1st, 42 / Jackson-2nd, 37), innings pitched (Sykes-4th, 31 / Jackson-5th, 29.2), appearances (Jackson-1st, 17 / Sykes-t-2nd, 14) and opposing batting average (Sykes-1st, .176 / Jackson-5th, .241).

Along with ranking atop the UNCG staff in multiple statistical categories, Sykes ranks nationally in ERA (2nd-0.58), strikeouts per nine innings (36th-12.19) and hits allowed per nine innings (36th-5.52).

Sykes logged his longest outing of the season on Saturday, April 6th, against Furman where he tossed four innings, allowed one hit and three walks while striking out five Paladin batters. The five strikeouts tied his single-game season-high, which also took place against High Point (Feb. 19) and Mercer (March 22). His three walks also tied a single-game season-high, set against Western Carolina (March 31).

Jackson toed the rubber twice for UNCG last week. His first outing, which lasted 3.1 innings, came against High Point (April 3). He surrendered three hits to the Panthers, but also struck out three High Point batters along the way. Jackson returned to the mound against Furman, where he hurled 3.1 innings in relief of starter Phillip Sanderson, allowing two hits and one run. He finished with five strikeouts against the Paladins, the second-most this season behind a six-strikeout performance against High Point (Feb. 19).

The Spartan bullpen has logged 151.2 innings, struck out 182 opposing batters, allowed 139 hits, walked 90 batters and surrendered just 75 runs in the first 30 games of the season. Meanwhile, the UNCG starters have spent 116.2 innings on the mound, surrendered 138 hits, converted 101 strikeouts, allowed 82 runs and walked 56 batters in 30 games.

Since the first game of March, which took place against Penn on March 2nd, the Spartan bullpen has accounted for 15 wins and five saves. In comparison, the starting rotation has just two wins, which came against Princeton (March 10) and at Mercer (March 22).

SPARTANS, TAR HEELS MEET FOR FIRST TIME SINCE 2015: The Spartans face their third Atlantic Coast Conference opponent of the season on Tuesday, April 9th, when they head to Chapel Hill to play North Carolina for the first time since April 28,



2015

It will mark the fifth game of the season against an ACC opponent for UNCG, after a pair of contests against Virginia Tech (Feb. 24-25) and meetings with Wake Forest on Feb. 27 and March 26.

The Spartans have faced seven different Atlantic Coast Conference opponents in the seven years under head coach Link Jarrett. UNCG has also squared off against Clemson (2x), Duke (5x), Georgia Tech (3x), North Carolina (1x), NC State (7x), Virginia Tech (2x) and Wake Forest (12x). The Spartans are 9-23 in clashes with ACC opponents, with three of the wins coming in extra innings against NC State, Duke and Wake Forest.

Jarrett is familiar with ACC competition having played collegiately at Florida State from 1991-94. In his four-year career with the Seminoles he was twice named Second Team All-American by the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association (1993, 1994)

Jarrett ended his career at Florida State with a .278 hitting percentage, enjoyed 72 multi-hit performances, and was responsible for 165 hits in 989 at bats. He finished his career with 65 doubles, four triples and five home runs, while driving in 122 RBI. One of the best offensive stretches of Jarrett's career came as a senior when he had at least two hits nine of 12 games during a stretch of late March and early April.

Defensively Jarrett was responsible for 358 put outs, 789 assists, 39 double plays and a .946 fielding percentage in his Florida State career.

LAST OUTING AGAINST THE TAR HEELS: The UNCG baseball team jumped out to a 5-0 lead and held on for a 5-3 victory over No. 17 North Carolina on April 28, 2015 at Boshamer Stadium. The win improved the Spartans to 6-16 in the all-time series against North Carolina.

The victory was the second this season for the Spartans over a team ranked in the top 25 and their second-straight triumph in Chapel Hill.

UNCG out-hit the Tar Heels 14-7 in the contest and was led by Jake Kusz, who

led the way offensively with three hits, two runs scored, two RBI and a home run. Eric Kalbfleisch also turned in three hits to go along with a run scored.

Michael Bates earned his first collegiate victory in perhaps his strongest start of the season. He tossed 5 1/3 innings allowing just one run on five hits with a walk and two strikeouts. He fell just one out short of the longest outing of his career. Hunter Williams was tagged with the loss after surrendering two runs (both unearned) on five hits with a walk and a strikeout in 2 1/3 innings of work.

The Blue and Gold struck first in a big way in the top of the third, throwing up four runs on five hits and a Tar Heel error. The big blow was a Long two-run single with the bases loaded. UNCG also benefitted from a two-out catcher's interference call that extended the inning.

After a scoreless fourth inning by both teams, Kusz extended UNCG's lead to 5-0 in the top of the fifth with his fourth home run of the season. Raburn responded in the bottom of the inning with a leadoff long ball of his own to trim the Spartan cushion back to four runs.

"LINK" TO THE MLB: During UNCG head coach Link Jarrett's seven-year tenure as the Spartans head coach, which began in 2013, he has witnessed 15 players selected in the Major League Baseball Draft. That marks the most of any Southern Conference program with Samford (14), Western Carolina (11) and Mercer (10) also with 10 or more in that span.

WEBSTER PRESEASON PLAYER OF THE YEAR, EMBLER FIRST TEAM ALL-CON-

FERENCE: Along with the distinction of being picked second as a team, junior infielder Caleb Webster was named as the league's Preseason Player of the Year and teammate Austin Embler was selected First Team Preseason All-SoCon in a vote by the panelists.

It marks the second time in as many seasons that Webster has been named to First Team Preseason All-SoCon and the first time in his career that he drew Preseason Player of the Year accolades.

Webster, who hit from the two-spot of the lineup in all 54 games, finished the 2018 season with second-best batting average (.380) on the team and fourth-best in the conference a season ago. He was responsible for 11 extra-base hits on the campaign, while scoring 51 runs and driving in 37.

Webster finished with 29 multi-hit games in 2018, ending with a single-season high four hits on two occasions against Marist (4-4, RBI, 2 runs; March 3) and Mercer (4-5, run). The junior from Randleman, N.C., was also responsible for a .456 slugging percentage, .417 on-base percentage and seven stolen bases over the course of the slate.

Embler, a redshirt senior from Southern Pines, N.C., was named to the First Team Preseason All-SoCon for the second time in as many seasons. He was the leadoff hitter in the UNCG lineup throughout the course of 2018, posting with a .357 batting



average, ninth-best in the league and fourth-best on the team. Embler finished tied with Cesar Trejo for most doubles (15) and was third on the team in hits (81), earning the second-best on-base percentage (.438) for the Spartans in the process.

<RECAPPING LAST THREE GAMES FOR THE SPARTANS>

SPARTANS TALLY 11 RUNS, 10 HITS IN FINAL FOUR INNINGS: A single to left field by sophomore Coleman Sawyer proved to be the difference as the Spartans snagged their second walk-off win in as many games with a 2-1 victory over Furman on Sunday, April 7th at the UNCG Baseball Stadium.

With the game knotted at one-all in the bottom of the ninth, leadoff hitter Josh Madole singled to right field for the sixth UNCG hit of the day. Hogan Windish worked the count in his favor, drawing a walk that moved Madole into scoring position.

It was there that Sawyer connected on a 1-1 pitch with a single to left, extending his hitting streak to a season-long 15 games, that brought home Madole for the game-winning run. Teammate Phillip Sanderson (3-2), making his first relief appearance of the season, picked up the win in the process allowing just one walk while striking out four Furman batters in 1.1 innings.

Three UNCG pitchers toed the rubber, including starter Austin Koehn, who worked 6.2 innings, scattered six hits, allowed one run and one walk, while striking out six. He gave way to Jack Voigt, who lasted one inning, striking out two batters in the process, before Sanderson took over on the mound.

After recording its first hit in the bottom of the second, UNCG put the first run on the board in the third when freshman Jacquez Koonce took the first pitch of the frame over the left field wall for his first collegiate home run. Koonce finished with two extra-base hits on the game, including a double off the wall to lead off the eighth inning.

The lone Furman run came in the seventh when a single up the middle by Zach Ahearn brought home MJ Sasapan, tying the score at 1-1.

BUDZIK DELIVERS WALK-OFF TWO-RUN HOMER IN 13TH INNING: A walk-off two-run home run by Zack Budzik in the bottom of the 13th inning provided UNCG with an 11-9 victory over Furman and Spartan head coach Link Jarrett with his 200th career win on Saturday, April 6th at the UNCG Baseball Stadium.

Trailing 9-2 with two outs in the bottom of the sixth inning, UNCG received a double by Coleman Sawyer and a walk by Ryan Caveness to spark its offense. Zach Kuchmaner delivered a single to second, scoring Sawyer, and teammate Jacquez Koonce followed with a double to left field to score Kuchmaner and Caveness, trimming the lead to 9-5.

That score would remain until the bottom of the ninth when Budzik singled to left and advanced to second on a throwing error. Two batters later, Caleb Webster smacked

a two-run home run over the left field wall to slice Furman's (11-19, 4-4 SoCon) lead to 9-7

Josh Madole extended the ninth inning with a single up the middle, setting the table for Hogan Windish. Windish delivered his fourth home run of the season, a two-run shot to left, to knot the game at nine-all on the first pitch of the at-bat.

The two teams would remain tied for the next four innings until Caveness walked to leadoff the 13th. David Flores pinch ran for Caveness, moving to second two batters later on a grounder to third by Koonce. With Budzik at the plate, facing a 2-0 pitch, the freshman from Stallings, N.C., delivered a home run over the foul pole in left field to give the Spartans the 11-9 win.

Chad Sykes (4-2) picked up the win for the Spartans after limiting Furman to one hit over four innings, striking out five Paladin hitters along the way. He was one of three relievers, Brandon Stephens and Alex Hoppe the others, to toe the rubber for UNCG. That trio combined for 16 strikeouts and issued just seven walks over 11.2 innings.

Eric Taylor (0-1) took the loss for Furman after walking the winning run, Caveness, to start the 13th.

FAST FACTS (Game 2: vs. Furman)

- -Brandon Stephens finished off the game by tossing 4.2 innings, allowing six hits and four runs, striking out a single-game season-high eight batters. His previous season-best was six K's, which came at Mercer on March 23rd.

PALADINS USE THREE MULTI-RUN INNINGS TO DOWN UNCG: The opening game of the series, which began on Friday, April 5th, and concluded the following afternoon after inclement weather forced a suspension in play, went to Furman by a 10-3 decision.

The key to Furman's success in the game was hurler John Michael Bertrand, who improved to 2-2 on the season after tossing a complete game eight-hitter. Bertrand, who struck out five UNCG hitters in the game, allowed three runs (two earned) while walking three

The Paladins offense provided a 6-0 lead through the first three innings, taking advantage of two doubles and a triple in the top half of the first to score three runs. John Michael Boswell, who recorded the first inning triple, came through with a two-RBI single in the second to provide the fifth run for Furman. The sixth run came on a home run to right field by Sterling Turmon.

UNCG put its first run of the game across the plate in the fifth inning when a sacrifice fly to centerfield by Austin Embler scored Zach Kuchmaner from third. The second Spartan run came in the eighth after Jacquez Koonce reached on a fielder's choice that allowed Josh Madole to score from third.

Furman countered with four runs in the top of the ninth, scoring the first run on a single into centerfield by Trent Alley. After a sacrifice fly to right field brought home the eighth run of the game for the Paladins, a miscue at second allowed Logan Taplett and Alley to move home for the final two Furman runs.

UNCG answered with one in the home half of the frame, which came off the bat of Austin Embler, whose sacrifice fly to right field brought Hogan Windish home for the final run of the contest

Madole, who finished 2-for-4 from the plate, extended his season-long hitting streak to nine games. Budzik also had two hits on the afternoon, both doubles, as the pair highlighted a Spartan lineup that finished with eight hits.

FAST FACTS (Game 1: vs. Furman)

-Spartans finished with eight hits in the game. That is the seventh time in as many SoCon contests that UNCG has had at least seven hits in a game.

-Zack Budzik, who tallied two doubles in the game, helped the Spartans record at least two doubles in a game for the 14th time this season. UNCG has at least two doubles in eight of its last 12 games.

-UNCG slips to 15-4 at home in the setback.

-The Spartans' combo of Corey Jackson, Maddux Holshouser, Austin Parsley and Alex Hoppe combined to tally eight strikeouts out of the bullpen. That marks the sixth time this season that the UNCG bullpen has notched at least eight K's against an opponent.
