THIS WEEK'S MATCHUP

For one last time Northern Colorado will make the trip to North Dakota on Saturday. The long time North Central Conference rivals will no longer be in the same conference after this season and have no future games scheduled against each other. The Fighting Hawks depart the Big Sky and join the Missouri Valley Football Conference starting in 2020.

UNC looks to bounce back after a tough 45-14 loss to Montana State last week, while North Dakota just missed out on a huge upset win over No. 3 Weber State falling 30-27.

Saturday's game between the Bears and Fighting Hawks is the 32nd meeting between the two programs and 14th in Grand Forks.

MEDIA SERVICES

General Policies

- All interviews with any member of the Athletic Program, including coaching staffs and student athletes must be coordinated through the Strategic Communication office.

- Regarding unique subject matter, such as human-interest angles, members of the media are welcome to approach the Communications office at least **48 hours** in advance with requests to interview any member of the program.

- Members of the media are strictly prohibited from directly contacting any coach, staff member or student-athlete by any means, including text messages, e-mail, phone calls (cell, office or home) or social media, such as Facebook and Twitter, without first approaching the Strategic Communications office.

- For all practices, no live reporting of practice details is permissible, nor live streaming of any method.

- Media are not permitted in the training room, locker rooms, or meeting rooms unless arrangements have been made with the communications office.

- Media may not photograph or report on individuals or groups participating in workouts outside of the organized team sessions within campus practices or competitions locations.

Game Days

- Every member of the program must report to the specified post-game interview site before conducting interviews. Other than Network TV and radio obligations, UNC does not allow on-field or on-court interviews in the minutes following the game's conclusion.

- Head coaches and requested players will be available to the media after a reasonable cooling-off period.

Injuries

- At all times throughout the calendar year, including offseason practices, the head coach of each respective program will serve as the sole source for injury information. All questions related to injuries should be directed to head coaches, and not to any other member of the program, including athletic trainers, doctors, the injured student-athlete, or his or her teammates.

Telephone Interviews

- Head coaches are available for phone interviews as time permits. Media should call to make an appointment through the Strategic Communications office.

- Phone calls (cell, office or home) to any coach or student-athlete are strictly prohibited, unless previously arranged through the Strategic Communications office

Media Credentials

- Credentials must be requested through the appropriate Strategic Communications contact in writing at least seven days in advance of an event. Approved requests will be mailed or can be picked up in the Communications office, or at the game.

Photographer Credentials

- Photo credentials are issued only to accredited photographers. Passes must be displayed at all times.

Game-day services

- Northern Colorado Athletics provides complimentary internet access. Check the seat-assignment label on press row for access information.

Weekly Releases

- The Weekly news releases of individual sports will be available approximately two to five days prior to the event. News releases are published on the school's official website www.uncbears.com, and can be e-mailed to media outlets upon request, and available via Twitter.

DR. KNIPP

• **Jacob Knipp** is back for a sixth year for the Bears after receiving a waiver from the NCAA after suffering an injury that ended his 2018 season early.

• In UNC's homecoming game against Portland State, Knipp became the team's first QB to run for 100-plus yards since becoming a Division I program. He led the team with 127 yards on the ground and added 300 more through the air.

• Knipp enters this week ranked second in career yards and touchdowns in Northern Colorado's Division I record book.

WORKHORSE BACK

• **Milo Hall** has put the team on his back when it comes to the run game in 2019. The senior has a trio of 30-plus carries games recording 31 at Washington State, 39 against Idaho and 30 at Idaho State.

• For the year he has carried the ball 222 times for 723 yards and seven scores. He doubled his output for rushing touchdowns with three at Eastern Washington.

• In his first season as a Bear Hall put together a strong campaign. He rushed for 757 yards and seven touchdowns ranking in the top five in the program's Division I record book. The rushing yards placed him fifth while the touchdowns tied for third-most.

• Hall became the seventh back in UNC's DI history to surpass the 1,000 yards mark in his career in the game against South Dakota. He currently has 1,480 yards as a Bear and 1,570 for his career.

• Hall ranks in the top 15 of career rushing yards as a Bear with his 1,480 to take 13th.

SHOES TO FILL

• The wide receivers group for Northern Colorado has some huge shoes to fill in 2019. Alex Wesley is graduated and in the NFL now after posting back-to-back 1,000 yards receiving seasons. With his departure, Northern Colorado is looking for a go-to target.

• Through nine games in the season no one has established themselves as a go to guy, but the committee approach makes it hard to cover each receiver on every play. Five Bears are over 200 yards receiving for the year in **Jaren Mitchell** (428), **Willie Fairman** (402), **Noah Sol** (309), **Noah Sarria** (286) and **Chase Lanckriet** (219).

• Sol and Mitchell had career games against Portland State. Sol had 97 receiving yards, including a 53-yard touchdown and Mitchell made six catches for 96 yards.

• Sarria and Fairman went over 100 yards receiving against Northern Arizona. Sarria led the team with 121 yards and Fairman added in 102.

LET'S GET PHYSICAL

• **Jerone Jackson** is showing he can be a physical player at safety for the Bears, ranking second on the team with 88 tackles on the year. His 8.8 tackles per game rank seventh in the Big Sky and 39th nationally.

• Against Eastern Washington, Jackson recorded a career-best 16 tackles. He twice has made nine solo tackles in a game coming against Idaho and EWU.

DEFENSIVE QB

• **Luke Nelson** has become the defensive QB for Northern Colorado over the past two seasons. The now senior has raked up tackle after tackle over the years to rank third in DI total tackles with 268.

- Walker has twice been named the Root Sports Defensive Player of the Week. First for his performance against Idaho when he had a pair of interceptions in the red zone to help the Bears in their comeback win. The other came against Idaho State when he had another two pick day, including a 35-yard pick-six and he also forced a fumble in another UNC win.

ROOT WITH THE BOOT

- Senior kicker Collin Root is off to a strong start in 2019. He is 5-for-7 with a pair of 50-plus yard field goals. He made a 52-yarder at San Jose State and then a 50-yarder the next week. For his career he now has three 50-plus yard kicks including the program record for longest kick of 56 yards against College of Idaho in 2017.

- Root has the 11th most made field goals in program history with 16.

DEFENSE IS KEY

- Northern Colorado's defense played a key role in the team's comeback win over Idaho. The Bears defense held Idaho to 46 yards of offense in the fourth quarter and just seven points for the half. **Michael Walker** and **Jace Bobo** each had an interception in the half as well.

- It was again the defense that played a key role in the team's win over Idaho State. The team forced four turnovers, with Walker and **Aaron Harris** being a part of all four in some capacity. Walker had two interceptions and a forced fumble, while Harris had the game-winning interception and recovered the fumble forced by Walker.

2019 SCHEDULE TIDBITS

- For the second time in program history, UNC is scheduled to play a pair of FBS schools in San Jose State and Washington State. The Bears were scheduled to play against Florida and Colorado in 2017, but Hurricane Irma canceled the game at Florida.

- Northern Colorado faces three teams for the first time in 2019 in San Jose State, Washington State and Idaho. While UNC has been a member of the Big Sky Conference since 2006 and Idaho is a founding member of it the two have never faced each other as Idaho was a member of the FBS from 1996-2017.

- For the second consecutive year, the Bears and Sacramento State play against each other in a non-conference contest.

- Northern Colorado will face seven opponents that they also played in 2018.

- The November 16 trip to North Dakota will be the last time UNC and UND play against each other for the foreseeable future as UND officially becomes a member of the Missouri Valley Football Conference next season.

DEGREES IN HAND

- Last season Northern Colorado led the nation with the most student-athletes on the roster who already earned their Bachelors Degree with 13. This season UNC has nine

- Brandon Biggs, Jacob Knipp, Justice Littrell, Luke Nelson, Noel Reid, Collin Root, Noah Sol, Rand Turnbull, and Kamari Williams.

- That ranks as for tied for the third most in the FCS with Sacred Heart and William & Mary leading with 12, while Hampton and New Hampshire added in 11 each.

AROUND THE BIG SKY

- Four Big Sky teams sit in the top 10 nationally in Weber State (3), Sacramento State (6), Montana (8) and Montana State (10). WSU and UM faceoff in a game to determine the winner of the Big Sky Conference on Saturday as the Griz host the Wildcats.

FRESH FACES ON STAFF

- Northern Colorado welcomes five new faces to the coaching staff.

- Nick Fulton** - Offensive Coordinator & QB Coach
Fulton comes to UNC after three successful years as one of the top DII OCs coaching at Colorado School of Mines.

- Louis Cortes** - Outside Linebackers Coach
Cortes has been elevated from a Defensive GA to Outside LB coach. Prior to UNC Cortes was at Colorado School of Mines

- Ryan Diedrick** - Wide Receivers Coach
Diedrick will help new OC Fulton install his system coming from Colorado School of Mines as an offensive assistant.

- Miles Kochevar** - Safeties/Secondary Coach
A former Colorado State player, Kochevar came to UNC from West Texas A&M where he was the DC and secondary coach.

- Trent Matthews** - Safeties/Secondary Coach
Matthews reunites with his former Defensive Coordinator, Marty English from his playing days at Colorado State. Matthews was previously at CSU as a defensive GA

COLORADO BORN

- As the only FCS program in the state of Colorado, the Bears aim to own the state and keep the talent at home. Of the team's 31 newcomers, 27 hail from the Centennial State.

- Overall, 52 players on the roster come from Colorado.

BEARS IN THE NFL

- Northern Colorado sent four former players to NFL Rookie mini camps this season in Alex Wesley (New York Giants), Jacob Bobenmoyer (Denver), Fisayo Awalaja (New Orleans) and Tank Terrell (New Orleans).

EARNEST COLLINS, JR.

Head Coach • Ninth Season at UNC • 11th Overall

Head Coach Earnest Collins Jr. was named the 16th football coach in school history on December 28, 2010. He returned to his alma mater to serve as head coach. In 1996, Collins received his bachelor's degree in kinesiology from Northern Colorado after playing for the Bears from 1991-94, where he amassed 978 punt return yards, then the school record and still second all-time. His 497 punt return yards from his senior season are still atop the school's leaderboard.



Collins and the Bears struggled in his first season at the helm going winless but then turned it around with a 5-6 season in 2012. Following two down seasons in 2013 and '14, he led the team to its first winning season as a Division I program in 2015 at 6-5. Northern Colorado repeated the feat in 2016 with another 6-5 season. Injuries riddled Collins' seventh season in charge of UNC leading to a 3-7 record. Against a grueling 2018 schedule that featured eight teams either ranked or receiving votes the Bears went 2-9.

During his time as the head man at Northern Colorado, five Bears have earned time with NFL teams in Jace Davis, Seth Lobato, Lexington Smith, Kyle Sloter and Frank Stephens. Collins has also coached 64 All-Big Sky players during his seven seasons with UNC.

After a stellar career at Northern Colorado, where he lettered every season from 1991 through 1994 and earned all-conference honors in 1994, Collins spent 1996-99 at Northwest Missouri State as the secondary and assistant special teams coach, helping the Bearcats to the 1998 and 1999 NCAA Division II National Championships. In both seasons, Collins and the Bearcats got the best of the Bears in the playoffs, winning the quarterfinals in 1998 in Maryville (42-17) and then winning the 1999 semifinals at Nottingham Field (41-35).

From 2000-03, Collins returned to Greeley where he served as the secondary and special teams coach. In 2002, the Bears reached the NCAA Division II Semifinals and had the top-ranked defense in the North Central Conference (NCC) and No. 8 defense among Division II (249.8 yards per game).

After his second coaching stint with UNC, Collins became the special teams and cornerbacks coach at Kansas from 2003-06. The Jayhawks advanced to two bowl games and he coached a pair of All-Americans in the defensive backfield.

He spent 2007 at Central Florida before heading to Alcorn State in 2008 as the associate head coach. In 2009, he was promoted to head coach at Alcorn State.

In two years at the helm of Alcorn State, the Braves went 8-12 with significant signs of improvement. Alcorn State ranked 30th in FCS in scoring offense in 2010, averaging 29.64 points per game.

Collins and his wife Tabatha have two daughters, Tayler and Marci, and a son, DeShawn.

Named for Northern Colorado Hall of Famer Vic Nottingham, who played tennis for the Bears from 1948-52 and has been an invaluable contributor to the program, Nottingham Field opened its doors on Sept. 9, 1995.

The stadium's first game pitted Northern Colorado against Colorado Mesa and the Bears were most ungracious hosts, handing the Mavericks a 58-7 defeat.

The Bears went on to win their first 13 games at Nottingham and enter 2019 with a 76-54 record at home since moving over from Jackson Field.

In the last several years Northern Colorado has made several renovations to the stadium.

The facility saw an across-the-board facelift in spring 2007 that included upgraded concessions, new restrooms and ticket booths. The East Plaza Concourse is now the hub of activity on game day.

Then, in summer 2011, the High Plains Club on the west side of the stadium saw an upgrade. A VIP donor lounge was created, complete with a built-in bar, ample seating, new carpet and a pair of high-definition flat-screen TVs.

The 2012 season brought a new sound system to Nottingham Field, resulting in crisper gameday music and public-address system. Over the 2013 summer, the track surrounding the field was resurfaced and several amenities were added to the terraces.

The summer of 2014 brought in a brand-new Daktronics video board to enhance the game-day experience, and 2015 brought in a video replay room and wind screens.

2018 saw the interior of Nottingham get a facelift with new graphics in the High Plains Room and the second level terrace lobby. The graphics were put in place to instill the rich history and tradition of success of the football program.
