Named UNCW's 11th head coach on April 3, 2017...Came to the coast after 14 seasons on the staff of Hall of Fame Coach Roy Williams at North Carolina...Has piloted Seahawks to 11-21 (2017-18) and 10-23 (2018-19) records in first two seasons...Lettered four years as a point guard for Williams at Kansas and served on his staff in Lawrence for four years before moving with his mentor to Chapel Hill...Has coached in seven Final Fours and owns rings for three national championships (2005, 2009 and 2017) with Tar Heels...Multi-sport athlete at Topeka West High School...Named Kansas Basketball Player-of-the-Year in 1994...1998 graduate of Kansas...Native of Indianapolis, Ind...Age 43.

Head Coach C.B. McGrath

Colin Bryan (C.B.) McGrath, an assistant coach on The University of North Carolina's 2005, 2009 and 2017 national championship teams, was named the 11th men's basketball history in UNCW history on April 3, 2017.

In his first season on the coast, McGrath piloted the Seahawks to an 11-21 record and sixth place finish in the Colonial Athletic Association, fashioning an 8-5 home mark and reaching the semifinals of the CAA Tournament. McGrath's second year on the Seahawk bench in 2018-19 closed with an overall mark of 10-23.

McGrath, 43, spent 14 seasons with Hall of Fame Coach Roy Williams at North Carolina. He lettered four years as a point guard under Williams at Kansas and served on his staff in Lawrence for four years before moving with his mentor to the Tar Heel state.

McGrath is recognized as one of the nation's foremost recruiters and bench coaches. In addition, McGrath oversaw UNC's clinics and coached the junior varsity team in Chapel Hill.

McGrath's association with Williams goes back to his days as a walk-on player at Kansas. McGrath earned a scholarship before the start of his freshman season and was a top reserve behind First-Team All-American Jacque Vaughn in 1994-95 and Ryan Robertson as a senior.

The Jayhawks did not lose a home game during McGrath's time in Lawrence, going a perfect 58-0 during his career.

A tri-captain for KU in 1997-98 and a two-time Academic All-Big 12 selection, McGrath appeared in 112 games for the Jayhawks, scoring 82 points, with 35 steals and 113 assists, including a better than 2:1 assist-turnover ratio. McGrath's first collegiate bucket was a three-pointer at N.C. State's Reynolds Coliseum.

McGrath is one of 20 members of his family who attended Kansas.

Overall, McGrath served on Williams' staff in seven Final Four appearances, including his final two seasons with the Tar Heels. McGrath was an assistant coach on UNC's 2005, 2009 and 2017 NCAA Championship teams.

McGrath was a multi-sport standout at Topeka West High School and earned a total of 13 varsity letters in basketball, cross country, track and field and golf from 1991-94. He was named the Kansas Basketball Player-of-the-Year as a senior, placed in the top-10 in the state in cross country and golf and was inducted into the Topeka West High School Hall of Fame in 2001.

McGrath earned his Bachelor of Arts Degree in Human Biology from the University of Kansas in 1998 and completed his Master's Degree in Education at KU in 2000.

McGrath's wife, Kris, played tennis at KU, where she was the Big-12 Player-of-the-Year in 1999. The couple has twin daughters, Kate and Addison, and a son, Hunter.

April 12, 2017: Mercer assistant coach Doug Esleeck becomes the first member of C.B. McGrath's new coaching staff.

April 14, 2017: Former North Carolina defensive standout Jackie Manuel is named assistant men's basketball coach.

April 27, 2017: C.B. McGrath completes his on-the-floor coaching staff with the hiring of former North Carolina star and NBA veteran Joe Wolf.

April 28, 2017: C.B. McGrath begins to build his first recruiting class with the signing of talented guard Jay Estime to a National Letter of Intent.

May 11, 2017: Former Youngstown State staffer Matt Lynch joins the Seahawks as video coordinator on C.B. McGrath's staff.

May 17, 2017: Long distance shooter Jeffrey Gary of Colorado Springs, Colo., signs a NLI to play for C.B. McGrath in 2017-18.

May 18, 2017: Coffeyville (Kan.) Community College seven-footer Trey Kalina becomes the fourth recruit for C.B. McGrath.

May 24, 2017: Rob Burke joins the staff of C.B. McGrath as Director of Basketball Operations.

Nov. 11, 2017: C.B. McGrath picks up his first career victory and first home win as the Seahawks crush NCAA Division II N.C. Wesleyan, 105-81, at Trask Coliseum.

Date Opened: Nov. 26, 1977 (Wake Forest 83, UNCW 79).

Largest Crowd: There have been 56 sellouts in the history of the arena, including a record 10 capacity crowds in 2003-04.

Surface: A new maple surface was installed in September of 2001, replacing the original floor.

Renovation: A \$2 million renovation was completed in the fall of 2012 that included new chairback seating in the lower level, a center-hung video board, LED tables for the official table and press row, and stat boards on the upper level.

Highlights In The UNCW-CU Series

- ▶ Garry Cooper ties a school record by hitting 12 straight free throws in UNCW's 87-65 victory over Campbell on Jan. 8, 1979.
- ▶ The Seahawks matches the school record for fewest winning points in a 46-43 victory over the Camels on Feb. 18, 1988.
- ▶ The Seahawks block a school-record 14 shots in a 62-58 loss to the Camels on Feb. 13, 1992. Matt Fish ties a school record with six blocks in the contest.
- ▶ The Seahawks cruises past the Camels, 67-48, on Nov. 29, 1997, in the inaugural basketball game played at the Crown Center in Fayetteville, N.C.
- ▶ Brett Blizzard ties a school record with seven 3-pointers and pours in 30 points as UNCW topped Campbell, 73-60, at the Cumberland County Civic Center on Nov. 27, 1999.
- ▶ In their first meeting at Campbell's Carter Gymnasium since the two schools turned Division I, the Seahawks win their sixth straight over the Camels, 71-59, on Dec. 1, 2003.
- ▶ Ruell Pringle pours in 27 points and Jonathan Rodriguez chips in 22 to lead four players in double figures as Campbell edges UNCW, 100-97, on Nov. 20, 2006, in the final game between the two teams at Carter Gymnasium. Temi Soyebó pumps in 23 points to pace five men in double digits for the Seahawks.
- ▶ UNCW holds Campbell scoreless over the first 6:31 of the contest and breezes to a 79-59 victory over the Camels in the 95th meeting between the two state rivals on Dec. 14, 2009, at Trask Coliseum. Campbell has its streak of 363 consecutive games with a 3-pointer snapped when the Camels go 0-for-6 behind the three-point arc.
- ▶ Senior guard Junard Hartley drains a long three-pointer from deep in the left corner with less than two seconds remaining to lift Campbell over UNCW, 57-56, on Dec. 22, 2010. Hartley spoils UNCW's first appearance at the Pope Center with the decisive shot, which gives CU its first lead since 15:03 remaining in the first half. Lorne Merthie paces the Camels with 14 points, while junior guard Trevor Deloach comes off the bench to collect a game-high 17 points in 19 minutes for the Seahawks.
- ▶ Junior center Matt Wilson's tip-in with 1.4 seconds remaining helps UNCW rally past Campbell, 67-65, on Dec. 19, 2011, in a thrilling finish at Trask Coliseum. Donte Morales comes off the bench to score 16 points, including 14 in the second half, as the Seahawks come from 11 points down to stun the Camels. Senior forward Eric Griffin has a monster game with 18 points and 15 rebounds for the Camels. Darren White also scores 29 points.
- ▶ Senior guard Darren White explodes for 32 points, including 23 in the second half, to power Campbell past UNCW, 72-60, on Dec. 29, 2012, at the Pope Convocation Center. The Camels shoot 50 percent from the floor to win their third straight over the Seahawks in Buies Creek. Trey Freeman chips in 18 points for CU. Keith Rendleman notches his fifth double-double of the season with 18 points and 11 rebounds and freshman guard Craig Ponder collects 12 points for the Seahawks.
- ▶ Senior forward Shane Reybold registers his first career double-double with 15 points and 10 rebounds to spark UNCW past Campbell, 69-50, on Dec. 3, 2013, in the annual renewal of the longest series on record for the Seahawks. UNCW races out to a 41-25 cushion at halftime and survives a late scare by Campbell to win for the 21st time in 23 meetings at Trask Coliseum. Reybold leads four players in double figures for the Seahawks.
- ▶ In Kevin Keatts' first game against the Camels as UNCW's skipper, Campbell shoots 54.2 percent from the floor - the most for a UNCW opponent on the season - to win the 100th meeting between the two state rivals, 69-63, on Dec. 23, 2014, at the Edwin Pope Center. Three players collect 15 points apiece for the Camels and Kevin McGeehan's club forces 16 Seahawk turnovers to keep UNCW winless in three tries at the Pope Center. Junior forward Dylan Sherwood comes off the bench to lead four Seahawks in double figures with 12 points.
- ▶ Freshman guard C.J. Bryce pours in 25 points to lead five players in double figures as UNCW wins its eighth straight at Trask Coliseum over longtime rival Campbell, 106-83, on Dec. 28, 2016. In their first game back from the Christmas break, the Seahawks shoot 69.4 percent in the second half and lead by as many as 26 points to offset six Campbell players in double digits. Chris Flemmings has a double-double of 18 points and 12 rebounds in his first game as a Seahawk vs. Campbell.
- ▶ Sophomore forward C.J. Bryce pours in a career-high 26 points and UNCW sets a school record for the best start by blowing past Campbell, 96-75, on Dec. 14, 2016, to stay unbeaten in true road games. The Seahawks win for the first time at Gore Arena by shooting 61.8 percent in the second half and lead by as many as 24 points. Devontae Cacak adds a double-double of 18 points and 10 rebounds and JaQuel Richmond contributes 11 off the bench. Shane Whitfield paces the Camels with 25 points.
- ▶ Guards Jordon Talley and Jaylen Fornes anchor four players in double figures with 18 points apiece to fuel UNCW past stubborn Campbell, 88-84, on Nov. 18, 2017, at Trask Coliseum. The Seahawks lead by three points at halftime, 37-34, but trail by seven points with 10 minutes remaining before rallying down the stretch to improve to 24-2 lifetime against CU at Trask Coliseum. Talley finishes with his second straight double-double on 18 points and 14 assists. Guard Marcus Burk explodes for a career-best 33 points for Campbell, while backcourt mate Chris Clemons battles through injuries and closes with 17 points on just 5-of-16 from the floor.
- ▶ Senior guard Chris Clemons scores all 15 points of his 44 points in overtime to lift Campbell past UNCW, 97-93, in the 104th meeting between the two eastern North Carolina foes. In a see-saw season opener, Campbell leads for 25:54 and survives 20 lead changes to knock off the Seahawks, who get a career-high 29 points from junior guard Ty Taylor. UNCW forces overtime with a dramatic banked three-pointer by Taylor, but can't solve Clemons in the extra period. Clemons goes 12-for-24 from the floor and 14-of-16 at the charity stripe in the back and forth contest.

▶ OPENING TIP

The Seahawks put the wraps on a season-opening three-game homestand when longtime state rival Campbell pays its 27th visit to Trask Coliseum.

▶ UP NEXT

Following tonight's matchup, the Seahawks embark on their first road trip of the season when they travel to the Charlotte area to battle Davidson on Saturday, Nov. 16, at Belk Arena.

▶ OLD FRIENDS

The UNCW-CU rivalry is the longest series on record for the Seahawks - by far. UNCW and Campbell are lacing it up for the 105th time. George Mason is the second oldest rivalry (69 games) for the Seahawks.

▶ THE VENUES

UNCW and CU have squared off at nine different sites through the years. The Seahawks stand 38-14 against the Camels in Wilmington, including 24-2 at Trask Coliseum. UNCW won the first 15 games between the two teams in Trask Coliseum before CU slipped past the Seahawks, 62-58, on Feb. 13, 1992.

▶ SCOUTING THE CAMELS

The Camels, who play three of their first five games on the road, are off to a 2-0 start in the new season following a pair of victories at Coastal Carolina (75-74) and home vs. Central Penn (101-47). Kevin McGeehan's club blitzed Central Penn by 54 points in its home debut on Friday at Gore Arena.

▶ THE UNCW-CU SERIES

Tonight is the 105th meeting between the two long-time rivals since the series began in the fall of 1952. UNCW leads the all-time series, 60-44, including a 38-14 record in Wilmington and a commanding 40-12 advantage in NCAA Division I play. The Seahawks have won three of the last four pairings and six of the last 10 clashes between the two rivals.
