UNCW (20-15) will take on its second ranked opponent of the season on Tuesday when they visit third-ranked North Carolina (30-6-1) for a 6 p.m. start. It'll be the first of a home-and-home series set to finish up at Brooks Field on May 12.

## ALL-TIME SERIES

The series favors the Tar Heels, 66-16, who have won the last eight meetings. UNCW knocked off the nationally-ranked Tar Heels twice in 2019 before falling in the NCAA Chapel Hill Regional. UNCW is 8-40 on the road in the series.

## ABOUT: NORTH CAROLINA

UNC is ranked as high as third in the recent polls ... Head Coach Scott Forbes is in his sixth season at the lead and owns a record of 230-110 ... The Tar Heels improved to 13-5 in the ACC with a series win at Clemson ... Owen Hull leads the team with a .379 batting average and is second with 12 doubles ... Colin Hynek has knocked in a team-high 35 runs and leads with 13 doubles ... UNC owns an ERA of 3.68 as a staff ... Caden Glauber is 4-0 with three saves in 14 appearances ... Walker McDuffis is 6-1 while making 20 relief appearances.

## LAST TIME OUT: APR. 10-12, AT CAMPBELL

The Seahawks dropped the final two games of its series at Campbell to lose the series ... It was UNCW's second series loss in as many weeks, but just the third on the season ... Trey Williford, the reigning CAA Rookie of the Week, earned the win in relief on Friday ... The freshman lefthander struck out a career-high nine in four innings of shutout baseball ... The Seahawks led the Camels, 5-2, after an inning and a half, but managed just two hits the rest of the game.

## QUICK NOTES

JP Pennella took over the team lead with .381 batting average, which is also tops in the conference ... Mason Hughes dropped into second with a .366 average ... The Seahawks are second in the league with a .282 batting average, behind Monmouth (.298) ... On the mound, the Seahawks pace the 11-team league with a 4.24 ERA and a .221 opponent batting average ... Defensively, UNCW is fielding at a .973 clip, tying for the league-lead with Charleston ... Cooper Allen continues to make a push for CAA Pitcher of the Year with a league-best 2.04 ERA and a league-leading 1.83 opponent batting average ... Trevor Lucas is tied with Jake Bechtel with six home runs ... He's knocked in a leading 35 runs ... With 15 stolen bases, Pennella is pushing to become the first Seahawk since Greg Jones (42 sb) in 2019 to steal 20 bases in a season ... Pennella also has a nine-game hitting streak in tack, the longest on the team this season ... He also leads with 17 multi-hit games.

## QUICK NOTES

Trey Williford was recognized as the CAA Rookie of the Week on Monday following another stellar appearance in conference play at Campbell. The freshman shutout Campbell on one hit over four innings while striking out a career-high nine. Over his last three appearances, a start and two out of the pen, Williford has allowed one run on three hits in 11 innings. He struck out 14 over that span. In eight of his 11 appearances, Williford has gone at least three innings. Four of those outings have been at least four innings, including a pair of 4.1 inning outings. He is 4-1 with a save while compiling a 2.70 ERA.

**HEAD COACH RANDY HOOD**

Head Coach Randy Hood is in his seventh season at the lead of the program and his 25th overall. Through six seasons as head coach, Hood fashioned an overall record of 182-119 and 87-40 in the CAA. During his tenure at the lead, the Seahawks have won two conference tournament titles and reached the finals of the 2021 and 2025 tournaments. Hood joined the program for the 2002 season and served as an assistant until 2009 when he was elevated to Associate Head Coach.

**CAA GOES TO DIVISIONS**

The Coastal Athletic Association split into two divisions this season for the first time since the Covid season of 2021. The CAA split into divisions for the first time in the 2002 and 2003 seasons. Joining the Seahawks in the six-team South Division are Campbell, North Carolina A&T, Elon, College of Charleston and William & Mary. UNCW will play home-and-home three-game series with Campbell, Elon and Charleston. Non-division series include at Stony Brook and home against Hofstra.

**COACHES SAY SEAHAWKS**

The Seahawks edged Charleston and Campbell to win the South Division by the division's coaches. Defending conference champion Northeastern was the prohibitive favorite in the north. Elon, William & Mary and North Carolina A&T rounded out the preseason predicted order of finish.

**PRESEASON CAA HONORS**

Connor Marshburn and Cole Nelson were also picked by the league's coaches for the preseason All-CAA squad. Joining Marshburn and Nelson were honorable mention selections Kevin Jones and Trevor Lucas. Marshburn posted a 4-3 record and a 3.51 earned run average as a sophomore while Nelson cranked a career-high 11 home runs, including a team-high-tying eight in conference action.

**POSTSEASON PLANS**

UNCW remains the only program in the league to play in all 39 conference tournaments. From 1986 through 2000, all programs qualified for the postseason tournament. In 2001 through 2009 it was a six-team field but was reduced to four teams for the 2010 and 2011 seasons. In 2012, it returned to a six-team format and has remained that way.

**30 WINS OR BUST**

With 34 wins last season, the Seahawks won at least 30 games in 25 seasons since 1999. The only time they failed to amass 30 wins were 2020 (11-5) and 2007 (29-27). During that span, UNCW has fashioned 40-win seasons on eight occasions.

Junior Cooper Allen has made the most of his season to date, leading the conference in ERA (2.04), WHIP (0.87) and batting average (.183). Here's how he compares to former Seahawk starters who were in the bidding or won Pitcher of the Year honors.

**BROOKS FIELD RENOVATION II**

After undergoing a complete renovation of the playing surface and dugouts for the 2025 season, Brooks Field saw a pair of upgrades for the 2026 season. A video board was erected beyond the wall in right and the 100 section of the seating area was upgraded with chair back seating as well as tabletop settings.

**BACK TO BROOKS**

Brooks Field will host the CAA Championship tournament again in 2026, marking the 16th time facility has hosted the event. Brooks Field and CofC's Patriots Point have alternated as host of the tournament the last three seasons. Elon hosted in 2021 and James Madison, who is now a member of the Sun Belt Conference, did so in both 2018 and 2019.

**EVERY SINGLE SEASON**

UNCW is the only program in the league's history to appear in all 39 conference tournaments. The tournament was reduced to a six-team field beginning in 2001 and further cut down in 2010 and 2011 to four-team brackets. The tournament returned to a 6-team field in 2012.
