### TODAY, WE PLAY.

After posting the seventh consecutive winning season with a 6-5 record overall in 2009, head coach Chris Mussman and the 2010 North Dakota Fighting Sioux will kickoff the third year of NCAA Division I FCS football with a road game against the Idaho Vandals in Moscow, Idaho. Game time is slated for 8 p.m. (CST) at the Kibbie Dome.

### SERIES HISTORY

This will be the first meeting between North Dakota and Idaho since the two teams kicked off the series in UND's 1954 season finale. The Nov. 13 game was played in Moscow, Idaho, with the Fighting Sioux falling 0-45.

### ON THIS DAY IN FIGHTING SIOUX HISTORY

This marks just the second time in North Dakota football history that UND has opened the season on Sept. 2. The first was in 1978 when UND blanked Moorhead State 17-0 at Memorial Stadium. In 1989, the Fighting Sioux fell to Northern Michigan on the road 22-24 and in 2000, the Sioux picked up a 52-7 victory over Central Michigan.

UND has tallied a winning record in the past six-straight seasons and has turned in a winning record in 19 of the last 20 years.

**OFFENSIVE NOTES**

The UND offense returns six starters and 15 lettermen from the 2009 season, including 2010 Phil Steele Preseason All-Great West first team selection **Keith Queoff** (Sr., OL, Milwaukee, Wis.) and second team pick **Ian McGurran** (So., C, Fargo, N.D.) ... **Jake Landry** (Sr., Grand Forks, N.D.), a Phil Steele second team member, is back for his second season as the starting quarterback. He finished the season 178-for-301 (59.1 percent) with 1,968 yards and 12 touchdowns. Landry will be backed up again by **Brent Goska** (Jr., QB, Wisconsin Rapids, Wis.), who went 12-for-21 with 113 yards and two TDs last year. He also banked 159 yards on the ground with a touchdowns ... Back in the UND run-game arsenal is **Mitch Sutton** (So., RB, Plover, Wis.) and 2008 GWC All-Conference first team pick **Josh Murray** (Jr., RB, Pepin, Wis.). Murray led the Sioux in 2008 with 1,146 yards on 188 carries with 12 touchdowns and Sutton topped the team in 2009 with 689 yards on 149 carries with six TDs ... The offense will also return tailback **Catlin Solum** (Jr., Fargo, N.D.) and receivers **Ryan Dressler** (Sr., Bismark, N.D.), **Chris Anderson** (Jr., Duluth, Minn.), and **Drew Daggett** (Jr., Frazee, Minn.) and tight ends **Seth Wistoff** (So., Glenburn, N.D.) and **Nick Long** (Jr., Andover, Minn.) ... Redshirt freshman **Greg Hardin** (Bellvue, Neb.) and true freshman **R.J. McGill** (Phoenix, Ariz.) may also get a few reps ... To add to the offensive depth, **Marcus Hendrickson** (So., Perham, Minn.) has been moved from quarterback to wide receiver.

**DEFENSIVE NOTES**

The UND defense returns eight starters and 16 lettermen from the 2009 squad, including Great West All-Conference second team selections **Ty Boyle** (Sr., DL, International Falls, Minn.) and **Dominique Hawkins** (Jr., CB, Plymouth, Minn.) ... Nine of UND's top 12 top tacklers are back for another season ... Hawkins led the Fighting Sioux with 61 tackles (42 unassisted) and tallied a pair of interceptions turned touchdowns ... Led by Boyle, 2009 opponents were held to four-yards per rush and 11.6 yards per pass ... **Joel Schwenzfeier** (Sr., DB, Hallock, N.D.) led the team and the conference with five interceptions, including a UND record-tying three in the season opener at Texas Tech (Sept. 5) ... **Ryan Kasowski** (Sr., LB, Grand Forks, N.D.) led the team and tied with three others in the league at No. 2 with five quarterback sacks.

**SPECIAL TEAMS NOTES**

After losing one of the best kicker/punters to wear a Sioux jersey, **Brandon Hellevang**, UND will open the 2010 season with a youthful new set of legs. **Brett Cameron** (So., Winnipeg, Manitoba), who saw limited action in 2009, will take over as the starting punter and reserve kicker. He booted a career-best 55-yard punt last season during the 31-17 win over #16 Cal Poly (Oct. 31). Redshirt freshman **Zeb Miller** will serve as the primary kicker. If UND kicks off first on Sept. 2, it will mark the first collegiate play for the Ankey, Iowa native ... **Dominique Hawkins** (Jr., DB, Plymouth, Minn.) is back on kick return. Last year, Hawkins logged 336 yards on 19 returns (17.7 yards/return), including a season-best 39-yard run ... **Josh Murray** (Jr., Pepin, Wis.), who missed the 2009 season, will take over on punt return. Murray finished the 2008 season with 100 yards on 12 returns (8.3 yards/return), including a 28-yard run.

The Vandals were the 2009 Humanitarian Bowl champions with a 43-42 win over Bowling Green.

## OPEN SEASON

Last season's 13-38 loss to Texas Tech (Sept) marked the first season-opening loss since 1992 when UND fell to Indiana (Pa.) 13-31 on the road. A more detailed look at openers shows that:

- This marks the first time the Fighting Sioux have ever opened the season against a team from Idaho, also know as The Gem State.
- Over the past 20 years, the Sioux are 17-3 in season openers and are 6-3 when they have opened the season on the road.
- The Sioux are 7-5 when their first road game is not the season opener.
- When opening in September, UND is 66-20-1.

## TAKING BACK THURSDAY

This will mark the third time in history that UND has opened the football season on a Thursday and the 15th time overall a game has been played on the fifth day of the week.

- UND played its first Thursday game when it capped the 1894 season, the inaugural football season at North Dakota, with an 18-4 victory over Grand Forks City.
- On Thursdays, UND is 8-6-1 overall, 5-2-0 at home and 3-4-1 on the road.
- UND is 3-0-0 when opening the season on a Thursday.
- The 2010 Fighting Sioux will be the first in history to open a season away from Grand Forks on a Thursday.

## WEIGHT A MINUTE

According to the *Wall Street Journal* and the Phil Steele's College Football Preview, the Idaho Vandal offensive line (projected starters only) is set to be the biggest in the nation. The article lists the "Big Five" — **Matt Cleveland** (LT, 311 lbs.), **Sam Tupua** (LG, 374 lbs.), **Clell Hasenbank** (C, 287 lbs.), **Tevita Halaholo** (RG, 335 lbs.), and **Tyron Novikoff** (RT, 318 lbs.) — at an average of 333.8 pounds. With the updated weights, that number has shifted to 325 lbs.

How does UND measure up? The "Hogs" — **Creighton Schroyer** (LT, 283 lbs.), **Joe Kleason** (LG, 293 lbs.), **Ian McGurran** (C, 282 lbs.), **Emmett Lynch** (RG, 298 lbs.), **Keith Queoff** (RT, 287 lbs.) — come in at an average of 288.6 lbs.



**NORTH DAKOTA PICKED LAST?**

After picking up Great West Conference wins over No. 16 Cal Poly and South Dakota last season, fans, players, and coaches were surprised when North Dakota (6-5, 2-2 GWC) was picked to finished last in the GWC Preseason Coaches Poll.

Defending Great West Conference champion UC Davis was selected by the league's coaches to win the 2010 GWC football race.

1. UC Davis (3) 23 pts.
2. Cal Poly (1) 18 pts.
3. Southern Utah (1) 14 pts.
4. South Dakota 11 pts.
5. North Dakota 9 pts.

The Sports Network thinks the season will pan out differently. The site predicts Southern Utah to finish at the top and South Dakota to bring up the rear.

The Sports Network's predicted order of finish:

1. Southern Utah
2. UC Davis
3. Cal Poly
4. North Dakota
5. South Dakota

**According to the site:** *There's been a different champion in each of the past four seasons, and last year's race was particularly close. No team was better than 6-5, no team worse than 4-7, and UC Davis reigned with a 3-1 conference mark, followed by North Dakota, South Dakota and Southern Utah at 2-2 each and Cal Poly, the 2008 champion, in last place at 1-3.*

*UC Davis probably would have been a clear favorite to repeat as champion this season had its terrific quarterback, **Greg Denham**, not decided to forgo his final season to pursue a career in the ministry. Nonetheless, Great West coaches picked the Aggies first in their preseason poll.*

*Cal Poly has the most returning starters among conference teams, but can it go from worst to first after disappointing in coach **Tim Walsh's** first season last year?*

*Southern Utah, behind All-America wide receiver **Tyson Poots**, believes it will win the title, but that's something the Thunderbirds have never done.*

*North Dakota probably has a better shot than South Dakota because of its young talent, but who knows what will happen in this back-and-forth conference? Count everybody in ... and nobody out.*

*History is on the side of UC Davis and Cal Poly, but if Southern Utah is ever going to knock down the door, it's this season. The Thunderbirds are 6-20 in Great West games since conference play began in 2004, with last year's 2-2 mark their best one.*

**LEADERS AMONG MEN**

Local fans will recognize the 2010 UND Fighting Sioux captains. Grand Forks, N.D., native **Jake Landry** (quarterback) and **Ryan Kasowski** (linebacker) will captain the young squad. The pair have assumed a role that has been held by the likes of **Lynn J. Frazier, Glenn L. "Red" Jarrett, Evan Lips, Dewey King, Eugene Murphy, Corey Colehour, B, Dale Lian, Dale Lennon, Mark Poolman, Monte Shaide, Shannon Burnell, Tim Tibesar, Jim Kleinsasser, Mike Mannausau, Philip Moore, Kelby Klosterman, Mac Schneider, Digger Anderson, Chris Kuper, Weston Dressler, and Danny Freund** ... to name a few.

**UND RECORD REWIND**

With the 17-16 2009 season finale victory over Central Arkansas, head coach **Chris Mussman's** career record improved to 12-9, his conference record remained at 3-4, and his record against non-conference shifted to 9-5.

- All-time, the Fighting Sioux are 601-358-30 (.608) on the gridiron.

**BOOM GOES THE SUTTON**

University of North Dakota sophomore **Mitch Sutton** was named the 2009 Great West Conference Rookie of the Year in a vote by the leagues' coaches.

A native of Plover, Wis., Sutton ranked second in the conference with 687 yards on 148 attempts and an average of 4.6 yards per rush. He averaged 62.5 yards per game and scored six touchdowns. With the addition of 280 yards receiving and 13 yards on punt return, he ranked seventh in the league in all-purpose yards.

With 30 attempts against Cal Poly (Oct. 31) and 29 attempts versus South Dakota (Oct. 3) Sutton posted the top two records in the league. Against the Coyotes he also registered the league's second-leading rushing game with 190 yards. To add to his conference accolades, Sutton tallied the conference's second-longest rush (47 yards) and held two of the top four 100-yard rushing performances this season.

**FIVE-FINGER DISCOUNT**

With a late-game interception against No. 16 Cal Poly, junior **Joel Schwenzfeier** (Hallock, Minn.) earned a spot in the UND regular-season record books. With five pick offs in 2009, he tied himself with nine others at No. 9 in single-season interceptions.

On Sept. 5, Schwenzfeier not only attained new personal records, but he also made a place for himself in the UND record books for the first time.

Against a team that is highly recognized for its passing game, Schwenzfeier thrice stepped in front of a Texas Tech wide receiver to tie a UND single-game record held by several former Fighting Sioux players. The last time the mark was hit was on Oct. 15, 1994 when **Mike Mooney** nabbed three interceptions against Augustana.

Schwenzfeier finished the season tied at No. 14 nationally with an average of .50 interceptions per game.

He was joined on this season's interception list by sophomore **Dominique Hawkins** (Plymouth, Minn.), seniors **Ryan Pollow** (Germantown, Wis.) and **Tyson Heiser** (Waunakee, Wis.), junior **Curtis Dublanko** (Thorsby, Alberta) and sophomores **Kenny Watkins** (Plano, Texas) and **Dan Hendrickson** (Minot, N.D.).

Hawkins has tallied a pair of interceptions this season and both of those pick offs have been taken in for a touchdown.

With a 6-5 record overall and a 2-2, runner-up finish in the Great West Conference, head coach Chris Mussman guided the Fighting Sioux to yet another winning season at the Division I level and marked the seventh-consecutive winning season for the Sioux.

Highlighting the season were UND's highly-anticipated road opener against its first BCS opponent (Texas Tech) since 1976, a 31-17 home victory over then 16th-ranked Cal Poly, the opportunity to play for the team's first NCAA DI conference title, and a season-ending, down-to-the-wire, one-point win over Central Arkansas.

For their efforts on the field, nine Sioux received GWC Player of the Week honors, including junior **Broc Bellmore**, who was one of six players to be recognized more than once. Redshirt freshman **Mitch Sutton** was named Great West Rookie of the Year and was selected to the all-conference first team. Sutton was joined on the all-conference roster by junior **Ryan Kasowski** (first team), sophomore **Ismael Bamba** (second team), senior **Kyle Bondy** (second team), junior **Ty Boyle** (second team), sophomore **Dominique Hawkins** (second team), senior **Brandon Hellevang** (second team), junior **Kris Ankenbauer** (honorable mention), and redshirt freshman **Ross Brennehan** (honorable mention).

While the on field achievements were easily recognizable, coach Mussman and his staff continually urged their student-athletes to strive for success in the classroom as well.

Two players received *ESPN the Magazine* Academic All-America honors and four were named to the *ESPN the Magazine* Academic All-District team. Hellevang and senior **Andrew Miller** were selected to the Football Championship Subdivision Athletics Directors Association Academic All-Star team and both were finalists for the ninth annual FCS ADA postgraduate scholarship. Miller becomes the first Fighting Sioux player to receive the award. He also received an NCAA Post-Graduate Scholarship.

During his first season as the head coach of the Fighting Sioux, Mussman guided the tradition-rich program to a 6-4 record as the University of North Dakota made its NCAA Division I Football Championship debut.

The Sioux registered their first victory as a DI program on Sept. 18 when they defeated the Idaho State Bengals, 38-35, in Pocatello, Idaho. They went on to finish 2-3 against DI opponents. UND was undefeated (4-0) against non-DI schools with a records of 3-0 and 1-0 against DII and DIII opponents, respectively.

Mussman also led North Dakota to a 1-2 record in its first season as member of the Great West Conference alongside Cal Poly, South Dakota, Southern Utah, and UC Davis.

The Sioux finished at the top of the GWC in several team categories, but most notably, they produced the league's most productive running back (Josh Murray) and kick returner (Dominique Hawkins).

The 2008 squad was not only recognized for its efforts on the field, but in the classroom as well. Four student-athletes were honored as academic all-Americans and league-high nine were selected to the Great West all-conference team. UND also topped the GWC as 16 players received fall all-academic honors.

Mussman became the 25th head coach in UND football history when he was introduced at a press conference on Jan. 4, 2008, after nine seasons on the Sioux coaching staff, including the last four as assistant head coach and the last seven as offensive coordinator.

Mussman possesses nearly two decades of collegiate coaching experience. During his nine seasons as an assistant on the UND staff, the Sioux went 90-24 (.789), won a Division II national championship in 2001, won five North Central Conference titles and made five NCAA Division II postseason appearances.

In 2007, Mussman directed arguably the most explosive offensive unit in the history of Fighting Sioux football. UND set school records for total yards (5,924), total touchdowns (60) and regular season scoring average (40.7 points per game).

UND finished the 2007 season as the NCC's top-ranked offense in scoring, total offense, total first downs, 3rd-down conversions and time of possession.

Individually, senior wide receiver **Weston Dressler** set a UND single-season record for receiving yardage and was named a Harlon Hill Trophy finalist, while two of Mussman's offensive linemen, juniors **Mitch Braegelmann** and **Brian Troen**, garnered several postseason awards between the two of them.

Additionally, junior quarterback **Danny Freund** set UND regular season records for passing yards (2,573) and touchdowns (24), while sophomore running back **Ryan Chappell** shattered the team's single-game rushing record with 306 yards against Central Washington on Sept. 15.

Offensive prominence was a staple of Sioux football during Mussman's time as offensive coordinator. UND's offensive record books are littered with accomplishments achieved under Mussman's watch, including the top three single-season passing yardage performances, top seven completion percentage performances and seven of the top eight marks for single-season receptions. Also, six of the top 10 highest-rated passers in UND history were tutored by Mussman.

During his seven years as UND's offensive coordinator, Mussman coached 32 All-NCC players on offense, including the two-time (2007, 2006) NCC Most Valuable Receiver in Dressler.

Since Mussman joined the UND coaching staff as offensive line coach in 1999, eight Sioux offensive linemen have earned first team all-conference honors, four have received first team All-America honors and Ben Olson (2003) and Chris Kuper (2004, 2005) were honored as the NCC's Most Valuable Offensive Linemen.

Kuper currently plays for the NFL's Denver Broncos, while Dressler now plays for the Saskatchewan Roughriders of the Canadian Football League.

Prior to coming to UND, Mussman spent the previous eight seasons on the staff at Minnesota State University, Mankato. In 1996 Mussman was promoted to assistant head coach and offensive coordinator at MSU after serving as the Mavericks' offensive line and tight ends coach. Under Mussman, the 1996 Mavericks led the NCC in total offense.

In addition to coaching at UND and MSU, Mussman has also served as an instructor for UND's Physical Education and Exercise Science department and MSU's Health and Human Performance department.

Mussman holds a bachelor's degree in political science from Iowa State and a master's degree in sports management from MSU. He was a four-year letterwinner and starting offensive lineman at Iowa State, serving as a team captain in 1990.

Mussman and his wife, Shelley, have two sons: Jacob (14) and Jackson (12).
