Last Time Out: vs Oral Roberts

The North Dakota women's basketball team opened the 2024-25 season with a 66-63 home win over Eastern Illinois.

Kiera Pemberton recorded her fourth career double-double with 21 points and a career-high 12 rebounds. Freshman Jocelyn Schiller and junior transfer Walker Demers both put up double digits with 12 and 16 points, respectively.



MEDIA CREDENTIALS/PARKING

Media credentials will be issued only to working media, sports information/media relations personnel, league officials or staff members of competing institutions with a legitimate need for access to press seating. Requests for media credentials, season or single-game, for the 2024-25 season must be made in advance with the UND athletic communications office. Please submit credential requests in advance with the athletic communications office. Please make requests at least one week prior to the game you will be covering.

PRESS SEATING

Members of the media will be seated either at the courtside press row table or in an auxiliary press row in the upper level of the east grandstand. Cheering and betting on press row will not be tolerated and violators will be removed.

PRESS ROW OPERATIONS

Game programs, game notes, statistics and media guides will be available at press row prior to and during all home games. Statistics will be distributed at halftime and immediately following each game. All working media will have access to wireless internet. A copy machine is also available behind press row.

PHOTOGRAPHERS

Photography credentials are issued to media and institutional photographers only and they must remain in designated areas.

RADIO/TELEVISION

The Betty Engelstad Sioux Center press row can accommodate two radio stations, and two additional stations may be accommodated in the upper press box. On-air television talent can also be accommodated in the upper press box. Radio and television stations wishing to broadcast UND home games are asked to contact the basketball athletic communications director at least two weeks prior to the event you are covering.

INTERVIEWS

The UND athletic communications office is eager to assist the media with student-athlete and coach interview requests. In order to help in this endeavor, it is asked that all media requests be made in advance through the basketball communications director.

Players will return phone calls once requested through the media relations office. As per UND Athletics policy, phone numbers of student-athletes will not be disclosed to members of the media.

Any requests to attend a practice must be cleared by the basketball communications director.

NO media interviews will be conducted with players on game day prior to games.

The coaching staff and student athletes will be available for post-game interviews and all interviews will take place in the J.J. Safranski Northwestern Mutual Team Room, adjacent to the main lobby of the Engelstad Sioux Center. The locker room, training room and weight room are closed to the media.

Starting the Season with a Win

NoDak's 66-63 win over Eastern Illinois was just the third time in the Division 1 era that the Hawks started the season with a win. The last season opener was a win over Detroit Mercy in 2022-23. The Hawks snapped a 13-season opening loss streak and are now 3-13 since moving to Division I.

Prior to 2022, the last time the Hawks won the season opener was during their first Division I season against Eastern Michigan in 2008.

A win tomorrow would be only the second time since moving to Division 1 that the Fighting Hawks would start the season 2-0, the last time being the 2022-23 season.

Home Sweet Home

Friday's home win was the eighth time in the D1 era UND had won in their first home game of the season.

NoDak went 6-10 overall last season in the Betty with a 3-5 record in both conference and non-conference play.

The Fighting Hawks averaged 68.6 points per game, while holding opponents to 73.0 points per game, including just 47 to Concordia Moorhead. UND poured in a season high 100 points in a home win over Omaha that saw four Fighting Hawks reach double digit scoring.

Schiller Thriller

Freshman Jocelyn Schiller opened her collegiate career with a bang. The Grand Forks native earned a spot on the starting five in her debut. Schiller made her mark on the books with her first collegiate basket marking the first points of the season for the Hawks. She didn't stop there though, the guard finished the night with 12 points, being one of three Hawks to hit the double-digit mark.

Seeing Doubles

Sophomore Kiera Pemberton wasted no time recording the Hawks first double-double of the season. With 21 points and a career-high 12 rebounds, Pemberton recorded her fourth career double-double.

Very Mindful, Very Demers

Junior transfer Walker Demers settled in nicely at the Betty. With 16 points, Demers was among the three to put up double-digits against EIU. She went 5-of-6 from the field and 6-of-7 from the charity stripe.

Her .833 field goal percentage leads the Summit League and puts her in the top-10 nationally.

In the Rankings

After their victory, the Hawks can find themselves at the top of the charts. Their 39 rebounds and 24 free throws made against EIU ranks them fourth nationally and first in the conference for defensive rebounds and free throws made per game. UND's 47 total rebounds put them in the top 50 nationally while leading the conference.

Crashing the Boards

NoDak was one of the Summit League's best at crashing both the offensive and defensive boards last season. They ranked second in total rebounds per game with an average of 38.77. They ranked third in the conference with 26.9 defensive rebounds per game and fourth with 11.9 offensive rebounds per game.

Summit League Preseason Poll

NoDak was picked to finish seventh in the preseason poll after finishing sixth with an 5-11 record a season ago.

Young Blood

For the first time since the 2001-02 season, UND does not have a single senior (or fifth year) on the roster. This year's is arguably one of the youngest teams in the Summit League as NoDak is the only school with out a senior class.

North Dakota's roster is comprised of five freshman, four sophomores, and six juniors.

The Newcomers

North Dakota welcomes six newcomers to this year's squad with five freshman and one transfer.

The freshman class includes Skyler Volmer, a guard from Presho, S.D.; Anaiyah Fletcher a forward from Oshawa, Ontario; Mataeya Mathern a guard from Edgeley, N.D.; Sydney Piekny a guard from Fenwick, Ontario; and Jocie Schiller a guard from Grand Forks.

Walker Demers a junior center from Grafton, N.D. comes to the UND from the University of South Dakota where she played two years with the Coyotes.

Canadian Connections

The Fighting Hawks roster features seven players from five different Canadian Provinces including two freshmen. Freshman Anaiyah Fletcher and Sydney Piekny hails from Ontario along with junior Miranda Vanderwal, a center from Strathroy.

Record Rewind

The North Dakota women's basketball program holds a 977-497 all-time record since Dee Watson led the first team onto the court in 1974-75. After a dominating few decades at the Division II level that saw the Fighting Sioux finish with 22 NCAA Tournament appearances, three national titles and 733 wins, the 2023-24 season will be the 15th at the DI level for UND. NoDak is 242-197 at the DI level since moving up in 2008-09 and has reached the postseason six times, including the NCAA Tournament in 2014.

Mallory Bernhard (Youngblut) was named the Interim Head Coach of the University of North Dakota women's basketball program on March 11, 2020 before officially being named the head coach in March 2021 by Athletics Director Bill Chaves, making her the seventh head coach of the Fighting Hawks women's basketball program. She is the first former Fighting Sioux or Fighting Hawk student-athlete to be named to the position.

She followed up her strong first season with an even better 2022-23 campaign, helping the Fighting Hawks reach the postseason for the first time since the 2016-17 season with a berth in the WBI. Bernhard led UND to a 19-13 overall record and an 11-7 Summit League mark to finish third in the conference standings. The Fighting Hawks were nearly unbeatable at home, finishing with the second-best home record in the program's Division I history at 13-1.

Once again, Bernhard helped senior guard Kacie Borowicz take her game to new heights, as she paced the league in both overall scoring and assists to earn a spot on the All-Summit League First Team for the second straight year while graduate student Claire Orth claimed a spot on the Summit League All-Defensive Team.

Following the 2022-23 season, Bernhard was awarded a contract extension through the 2025-26 campaign.

Bernhard completed her first season as the official head coach with a largely improved record having gone from two wins in her interim season to 15 wins. She led North Dakota from being ranked ninth in the Summit League preseason poll to ending the season fifth and sitting at a .500 record (15-15 overall, 9-9 conference). Bernhard led the Fighting Hawks to be ranked eighth nationally (NCAA DI) for free-throw percentage with a team average of .789.

She coached junior Kacie Borowicz to a record-breaking and Summit League leading season. Borowicz ended the year being named Summit League Player of the Week twice (Jan. 17 & Jan. 24), named Summit League Female-Athlete of the Month in January, named First Team All-Summit League, and named to the Summit League Academic All-League Team. Along with the accolades she collected, under the direction of Bernhard, Borowicz ended the season second in the country (NCAA DI) for free-throw percentage with a .957, broke the Summit League All Games free-throws made record and University of North Dakota record for most in a game and free-throw percentage with her 20-for-20 (1.000) against Montana State, finished as the leader in the Summit League for points per game (19.4) and free-throw percentage (.957), and finished second in the Summit League for assists with 4.4 per game.

Bernhard also coached senior Melissa Leet to earning a spot on the Summit League's All-Defensive Team. Under Bernhard, Leet finished first in the Summit League in total blocks (67), finished tied for 24th in the country (NCAA DI) for total blocked shots with 67, and finished tied for 24th in the country (NCAA DI) for blocked shots per game with 2.23.

During her interim season, Bernhard attempted to restructure with program. The team struggled through injuries as sophomore Kacie

Borowicz and junior Makayla Wallace played limited minutes during the 2020-21 season. Alongside the injuries, the Fighting Hawks struggled with the new COVID-19 protocols throughout the season. Although Bernhard only led UND to two wins in her interim season, the Fighting Hawks pushed three games into overtime and kept it close with single digit losses in ten games.

Prior to becoming head coach, Bernhard completed her seventh season as an assistant at her alma mater in 2019-20, and spent the season as associate head coach, working primarily with the UND guards. Her teams have enjoyed great success with an NCAA Tournament appearance (2014), two Big Sky titles (2014, 2017), a pair of WBI appearances (2015, 2016) and a WNIT berth (2017) at UND.

Bernhard led a battery guards in 2019-20 made up of four true freshmen, a redshirt freshman and three returning letterwinners in Alaina Jarnot, Claire Orth and Mikayla Reinke, who combined for 25 starts last season. Jarnot became the first guard 2013-14 to dish 100+ assists in a season while freshmen Kacie Borowicz and Lilly Keplin each averaged over 7.0 points per game off the bench.

With seven true freshmen on the roster in 2019-20, North Dakota posted its first record of .500 or better since 2016-17 as the Fighting Hawks freshmen class scored almost 43-percent of the team's scoring in 2019-20.

Along with four postseason appearances and 13 all-conference players, Bernhard also helped mentor former All-Summit League forward Lexi Klabo, a top-10 finalist for the Cheryl Miller Award, given to college basketball's top-small forward annually. Klabo signed professionally to play in Belgium, one of two players from the 2018-19 team to sign professionally. Jill Morton signed to play in Germany in August 2019.

As North Dakota's Associate Head Coach from 2018-20, Bernhard was instrumental in recruiting Miss Basketball North Dakota Megan Zander and Miss Basketball Minnesota Kacie Borowicz

Bernhard also helped mentor former All-American Madi Buck, the 2014 Big Sky Conference Player of the Year. Buck was also an all-region selection and The Grand Forks Herald Sportsperson of the Year for 2014.

Her return to UND came after leading her high school alma mater, Davenport Assumption High School, to back-to-back Iowa State Class 3A titles in her two years at the helm. Her teams went a combined 31-1 in conference play and went 50-4 overall in her two seasons at the helm, earning Iowa State Class 3A, District and Quad-City Times Metro Coach of the Year in 2012 and 2013.

Youngblut finished her five-year playing career at North Dakota ranked 15th all-time with 1,307 career points. The 29th player in program history to join the 1,000 Point Club, she ranks third in career free-throw percentage (81.6), fifth in career three-pointers made (220) and attempted (573), and 10th in career steals (175) and career three-point field goal percentage (.380).

She was part of a 2013-14 staff that captured the Big Sky Conference regular season and tournament titles. UND has qualified for the postseason four times with Bernhard on the bench, recording 90 wins in that span.

She is married to husband, Nick. They live in Grand Forks with their son, Louis.
