1. WHAT TO KNOW

- North Florida looks to produce its first result since its scoreless draw against Mercer on Sept. 1.
- Rentaro Miyakawa, Nick Kishchenko and Rafa Rios have started all seven games for the Ospreys this season.
- David Perez and Jaxon Reinhardt remain the SOG leaders with four each between the both of them.
- UNF switched back to Luciano Natoli in the goal, where he produced a career-high four saves.
- Ospreys will look to take the all-time series lead over USC Upstate, where they are 10-10-1 against each other in program history.
- UNF also has won seven of the past eight matchups with a combined score of 24-2.

2. SCOUTING THE OPPONENT

- USC Upstate come into this matchup with a 1-6 overall record, beating ETSU, 2-0, in their home opener.
- The Spartans have not produced a result in a road match since drawing 1-1 to Winthrop on Sept. 30, 2023.
- Junior Elijah Jackson was the lone Spartan player to be selected to the Big South Preseason All-Conference.
- Dzenan Cerimagic has the slight edge on the team for most goals scored with three total in two starts.
- Adrian Panaite and Luke Halkett each have multiple scores as well in their games played.
- Cooper Jennings has been in front of the net for all seven games, recording 32 saves and 22 GA.

3. SERIES HISTORY

- UNF holds the edge in home games against USC Upstate with a 6-3-1 record at Hodges Stadium.
- When the two were conference opponents in the ASUN, they were 7-7-1.
- Since the Spartans have left the ASUN, each team has picked up a 1-0 win in their two matchups.
- Ospreys look to get their revenge from last season's road loss in Spartansburg, S.C.

NORTH FLORIDA STRATEGIC COMMUNICATIONS

The North Florida Strategic Communications office is located on the first floor of the UNF Arena in room 1062. Entering the arena through the front entrance, the office can be accessed by going past the main office, through two double doors and turning to the double doors to the left.

CREDENTIAL REQUESTS

The North Florida Strategic Communications Office will issue credentials to **WORKING** press only. All passes will be left at the security table at the main entrance to Hodges Stadium.

VISITING RADIO

All visiting radio crews **MUST** request credentials through their school's sports information director. Please make arrangements well in advance so necessary arrangements can be made.

PHOTOGRAPHERS

Only photographers shooting for accredited media outlets, opposing teams or for North Florida Strategic Communications will be allowed to shoot home events from field level. No photographers are permitted along the team benches or in the team areas.

POST-MATCH INTERVIEWS

Following a 10-minute "cooling off" period, a post-match press conference will take place on the field. The North Florida Strategic Communications staff will poll the media prior to the end of the match to determine which players will be made available after the match. The visiting coach and players will be made available outside their locker room. Pre-game interviews are **NOT** allowed.

INTERVIEWS

Most practices are open to the media and public. However, there may be instances when all or parts of practice are closed. Contact the Strategic Communications Office for practice times and to set up any interviews with North Florida players and coaches.

PARKING

Parking for UNF men's soccer matches is located in UNF Lot 18 just north of Hodges Stadium.
