#### NORTH FLORIDA OPENS 2025-26 SEASON AT DEFENDING NATIONAL CHAMPIONS NO. 3/3 FLORIDA

- North Florida opens the 2025-26 season at the defending National Champions No. 3/3 Florida inside Exactech Arena at Stephen C. O'Connell Center on Thursday, Nov. 6 at 8 p.m. ET on SEC Network+.
- North Florida tips off against five opponents that competed in the 2025 NCAA Tournament Florida, Tennessee, Wofford, SIU Edwardsville, Gonzaga, four 2024-25 conference champions - Florida (SEC), Wofford (SOCON), Gonzaga (WCC) and SIUE (OVC) and three preseason 2025-26 Associated Press (AP)/USA TODAY Coaches' Top 25 Poll opponents - No. 3/3 Florida, No. 18/17 Tennessee and No. 21/20 Gonzaga - in its non-conference slate.
- In his 27th season on a Division I staff and 17th season with North Florida, Head Coach Bobby Kennen, an Ocala, Fla. native, makes his debut as Head Coach on Thursday.

#### NORTH FLORIDA TIPS OFF TOUGH NON-CONFERENCE SLATE

- North Florida opens its 2025-26 season with a pair of ranked road games at No. 3/3 Florida on Nov. 6 and No. 18/17 Tennessee on Nov. 12. Florida and Tennessee mark two of three opponents, in addition to No. 21/20 Gonzaga, ranked in the preseason 2025-26 Associated Press (AP)/USA TODAY Coaches' Top 25 Poll that North Florida plays in its non-conference schedule.
- North Florida faces five opponents in non-conference action that competed in the 2025 NCAA Tournament Florida, Tennessee, Wofford, SIU Edwardsville, Gonzaga. North Florida faces 2024-25 four conference champions - Florida (SEC), Wofford (SOCON), Gonzaga (WCC) and SIUE (OVC) in its non-conference schedule.
- For the first time in program history, North Florida will compete with Tennessee, New College of Florida, Southern Miss and Columbia.
- North Florida opens its 2025-26 season with a pair of road games against SEC opponents, both who advanced to the 2025 NCAA Tournament Elite Eight, in Florida and Tennessee. North Florida defeated South Carolina, 74-71, in its 2024-25 season opener for its first win against an SEC opponent in program history.
- Only four of North Florida's 13 non-conference games will be at home in UNF Arena.
- North Florida has opened its season on the road against a Power Four opponent in four of its last five seasons.
- Florida (SEC) and Gonzaga (WCC) were 2025-26 preseason favorites to win their conferences.
- Florida is ranked No. 4 in the latest 2026 KenPom College Basketball Ratings on Nov. 4.

#### KAMRIN ORIOL RETURNS FOR OSPREYS IN 2025

- Head Coach Bobby Kennen has expressed that senior guard Kamrin Oriol has established himself as a leader ahead of his second season at North Florida in 2025-26. Oriol joined sophomore guard Kent Jackson as the two North Florida representatives at the 2025 ASUN Basketball Tipoff.
- "I don't know what his future holds, but I told Kamrin [Oriol] the other day that he's a pro. He's been a pro in everything he's done. From his work habits, to the weight room, to the training room, getting up extra shots, in everything he's done. He's a 4.0 student. He's a fantastic kid and he's been a leader. He's been fantastic for us and I'll be surprised if he's not a First Team All-League guy. -Head Coach Bobby Kennen on Oriol on Talon Talk on Sept. 30.
- Oriol averaged 7.3 points, 2.3 rebounds and 1.4 assists on 37.1 percent from the field, 35.0 percent from three and 77.8 percent from the free-throw line in 20.8 minutes per game in 32 games at North Florida in 2024-25.
- One of seven returners, Oriol is the top returning scorer and accounts for 7.3 points of the 11.8 points per game returning for North Florida. Oriol is also the top returner in terms of rebounds, assists and minutes played.
- Oriol posted 16 points, five rebounds, five assists and four steals on 6-11 from the field in 24 minutes in an exhibition against Warner on Oct. 29.
- Oriol notched 11 games of 10 or more points, which included a five-game stretch from at Georgia Tech on Nov. 10 - at SIUE on Nov. 29, and one game of 20 or more points in his debut season at North Florida in 2024-25. Oriol posted 10 or more points in five ASUN Conference games.

#### TOUGHNESS, TOGETHERNESS, TRUST / WTA

• The two team mantras for the 2025-26 North Florida Men's Basketball team is Toughness, Togetherness and Trust and WTA,

Head Coach Bobby Kennen is in his 17th season at North Florida and his first as Head Coach.

which stands for "What's the advantage?"

- Head Coach Bobby Kennen has stated that the program is built on the three pillars of Toughness, Togetherness and Trust.
- When asked about WTA "What's the advantage?", Kennen expressed the mantra is centered around finding an advantage in all aspects. Kennen has stated that one of the advantages of this team is the depth and competitiveness across each position and the everyday mindset of the players.



#### A LOOK AT WHAT'S RETURNING FOR THE OSPREYS

- Despite seven returners, North Florida aims to replace the large piece of its production from its 2024-25 roster.
- Senior guard Kamrin Oriol is the top returning scorer and accounts for 7.3 points of the 11.8 points per game returning for North Florida. Oriol is also the top returner in terms of rebounds, assists and minutes played.
- Oriol averaged 7.3 points, 2.3 rebounds and 1.4 assists on 37.1 percent from the field, 35.0 percent from three and 77.8 percent from the free-throw line in 20.8 minutes per game in 32 games at North Florida in 2024-25.
- North Florida returns 14.3 percent of its points, (11.8 of 82.8 points), 16.8 percent of its rebounds (6.0 of 35.8 rebounds) and 16.5 percent of its assists (2.7 of 16.3 assists).
- Head Coach Bobby Kennen has expressed to the team that the collective ask is for all players and staff, Kennen included, to trust, buy in and play a role that they have never played before to this point in their career.

#### NORTH FLORIDA ADDS TALENTED TRIO IN THE PORTAL

- North Florida added three players in graduate student guard Devin Hines (Lafayette), graduate student guard/forward Dalton Gayman (Purdue Northwest) and sophomore guard Kent Jackson (Jacksonville) in the transfer portal ahead of the 2025-26 season.
- Hines appeared in 79 games and made 37 starts at Lafayette from 2021-25. He started all eight games played in and posted 9.9 points, 4.3 rebounds and 1.4 assists on 40.0 percent from the field, 25.7 percent from three and 50.0 percent from the free-throw line in 22.4 minutes per game at Lafayette in 2024-25. He scored 10 or more points in five of eight games and opened the season with four-straight games eclipsing the mark.
- Hines was named to the 2023-24 All-Patriot League Third Team and appeared in 30 games with 29 starts and averaged 9.8 points, 3.9 rebounds, 1.4 assists on 37.2 percent from the field, 33.6 percent from three and 66.7 percent from the free throw line in 27.7 minutes per game at Lafayette in 2023-24. His 9.8 points per game

led the team in 2023-24.

- Jackson appeared in 32 games and averaged 2.7 points, 0.6 rebounds and 0.5 assists on 32.6 percent from the field, 32.5 percent from three and 80.0 percent from the free-throw line in 10.8 minutes per game at Jacksonville in 2024-25. He logged the second-most minutes out of the Dolphins' freshmen.
- Gayman played in 26 games with 22 starts and averaged 9.3 points, 6.8 rebounds, 1.3 assists on 42.7 percent from the field, 36.0 percent from three and 69.5 percent from the free-throw line in 24.0 minutes per game at Purdue Northwest in 2024-25.
- Gayman played in 55 games in two seasons at Purdue Northwest from 2023-25, and started his career at Arkansas-Fort Smith in 2020-21, Drury in 2021-22 and State Fair Community College in 2023-24.

#### 37 WEEKS TO EARN TWO MORE

- Head Coach Bobby Kennen has stated that with the changing landscape of college athletics, the most important element is being bought in and invested on the common goal for the lifespan of the team/season - which for North Florida is 37 weeks from the start of the summer workouts on June 22, 2025 until March 8, 2026, which is the 2025-26 ASUN Men's Basketball Championship Final.
- The motto of "37 weeks to earn two more" was built around this idea of being invested in the time together until the 2026 ASUN Men's Basketball Championship Final to earn an opportunity to play in the 2026 NCAA Tournament.
- "One of the things that I have talked to our team about all offseason is the idea of "37 weeks to earn two more". We met to start summer school on June 22, from that Sunday night to March 8, which is the ASUN Championship, is 37 weeks. The life of our team is 37 weeks, we are 37 weeks to earn two more because for us, as the first conference tournament, our two weeks is the week leading up to Selection Sunday and the first week of the NCAA Tournament. So our goal is to be all in for those 37 weeks to earn those two. We have made it a conscientious effort to be all in every day and to be invested and support each other." - Kennen on The Frangie Show on Oct. 29.

#### **COACH KENNEN'S HEAD COACHING DEBUT**

- In his 27th season on a Division I staff and 17th season with North Florida, Head Coach Bobby Kennen makes his head coaching debut on Thursday.
- Kennen, an Ocala, Fla. native, also has a couple of connections to the University of Florida ahead of his debut.
- · Kennen graduated from Florida with a Master's Degree in Educational Leadership in 1998.
- Kennen's father is a plumber and one of his final projects with the commercial firm he worked for was the renovation of the Stephen C. O'Connell Center.
- · Kennen's first college game he attended as a kid was Auburn at Florida on Feb. 6, 1982, and now his first game as a Head Coach will be in the same arena.
- Kennen was the Head Coach at Williston High School in Williston, Fla., 22 miles from Gainesville, Fla., for three seasons in 1995-98. At Williston, he led the Red Devils to three-straight Suwannee Conference Championships, earning Coach of the Year honors each season.

#### NORTH FLORIDA SHINES IN HOME EXHIBITION

- North Florida defeated Warner, 84-60, in a home exhibition in UNE Arena on Oct 29
- Senior guard Kamrin Oriol and sophomore guard Kent Jackson each led North Florida with 16 points. Oriol finished 6-11 from the field and 3-3 from the free-throw line, in addition to five rebounds five assists and four steals in 24 minutes, while Jackson connected on 6-10 from the field and 4-8 from three in 26 minutes.
- Oriol and Jackson were two of four Ospreys with 10 or more points. Graduate student guard/forward Dalton Gayman added 14 points in 25 minutes and freshman guard/forward Trey Cady posted 11 points in 14 minutes.
- North Florida forced 16 turnovers and outscored Warner 20-5 in points off turnovers.

#### **OSPREYS RETOOLS, RETAINS EXPERIENCED STAFF**

- Head Coach Bobby Kennen retained part of its experienced coaching staff and retooled with important additions in the transition.
- Assistant Coaches Stephen Perkins and Bruce Evans return for their 13th season at North Florida.
- Kennen hired longtime Head Coach Bob Marlin in August. Marlin joined North Florida as an Assistant Coach after he led Louisiana to a 269-198 record in 15 seasons. He is the winningest coach in Sun Belt Conference history with 151 wins. He totaled five postseason appearances, which included 2014 and 2023 NCAA Tournament berths and three Sun Belt Conference titles at the helm. The 2018 Sun Belt Coach of the Year. Marlin led Louisiana to its two winningest seasons in program history, which included a program-record 27 wins in 2017-18, and he eclipsed the 20-win mark five times with a 20-win average from 2013-23.
- Prior to Louisiana, Marlin was the winningest coach in Sam Houston State program history and compiled a 225-131 record that included winning records in 10 of the 12 seasons. The winningest coach in the Southland Conference during his tenure, he won 20 or more games six times and three Southland Regular Season and two Southland Tournament titles with appearances to the 2003 and 2010 NCAA Tournament. He was named the Southland Conference Coach of the Year three times and was the Southland Coach of the Decade. He has amassed 494 Division I wins and coached 823 Division I games in his career.
- Kennen added Osprey legend Carter Hendricksen as an Assistant Coach in August. A three-time All-ASUN selection, Hendricksen was one of the most decorated players in program history from 2018-23. He remains tied for the most games played in program history at 135 and is second with 1,651 career points. He is top-five in program history in games played, points, field goals made, threepoint field goals, free throws made, rebounds and minutes. He was named 2020-21 First Team All-ASUN, 2019-20 and 2022-23 Second Team All-ASUN and 2020-21 ASUN Scholar Athlete of the Year.
- Hendricksen is one of five Ospreys to reach 1,500 points and one of four to total 1,000 points, 500 rebounds and 200 assists in
- Kennen hired Assistant Coach David Aucremann in June. his first addition to the staff in the transition. Aucremann returns for his second stint at North Florida after he served in a Head Student Manager role in 2018-21 before he was elevated to a Graduate Assistant in 2021-23. Aucremann was most recently a Graduate Assistant at Wichita State in 2023-25.

#### **HEAD COACH BOBBY KENNEN**



With 27 years in the Division-I coaching ranks, which includes more than two decades in the ASUN Conference, Bobby Kennen is in his first season at the helm of North Florida in 2025-26.

Now in his 17th season at North Florida, Kennen was elevated to Head Coach after the departure of Matthew Driscoll on May 22, 2025. Kennen was previously promoted to Associate Head Coach in August 2012 after he joined the staff in an Assistant Coach role in April 2009.

An integral part of the program's success, Kennen assisted Driscoll to become the winningest coach in North Florida and ASUN Conference history.

Kennen served on the staff that helped North Florida secure three ASUN Regular Season Championships in 2014-15, 2015-16 and 2019-20, three appearances in the ASUN Championship title game in 2010-11, 2014-15 and 2016-17 and a ASUN Championship title in 2014-15. He was on staff for the program's first appearance in the NCAA Tournament in 2015.

In 2024-25, Kennen assisted North Florida to defeat two Power Four opponents on the road in the first week of the season – South Carolina and Georgia Tech. It marked the program's first-ever wins against a SEC and ACC opponent. Kennen has been part of four Power Four wins - Purdue, Illinois, South Carolina and Georgia Tech - while at North Florida.

North Florida received its first-ever votes in the Associated Press (AP) poll with 14 votes on Nov. 11, 2024

Kennen has been on staff for all three of the program's 20 or more win seasons with 23 in 2014-15, 22 in 2015-16 and 21 in 2019-20.

Kennen has coached 20 All-ASUN and nine ASUN All-Freshman Team honorees while at North Florida.

North Florida has led the nation in total threes made three times (409 in 2024-25, 391 in 2019-20, 411 in 2015-16) with Kennen on staff.

Following an appearance in the 2015 NCAA Tournament, Kennen assisted the program to secure a top-20 ranking in the final CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Poll. Prior to the 2010-11 season, Kennen was voted as one of the top assistant coaches in the ASUN Conference, selected by the league's head coaches.

Prior to North Florida, Kennen served as the top assistant at Campbell for four seasons from 2005-09. While at Campbell, Kennen helped turn around a program that won just two games in the 2004-05 season to finish 11-9 in the ASUN Conference and total 14 wins in 2008-09.

Kennen served as an Assistant Coach at Jacksonville for five seasons from 2000-05.

In 2002, Kennen was appointed to the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) Assistant Coaches Committee, serving all assistant coaches with their needs and concerns related to the profession.

Kennen's career also included stints at Wichita State in 1999-2000 and Central Florida Community College in 1998-99.

At the high school level, Kennen was the Head Coach at Williston High School in Williston, Fla. for three seasons in 1995-98. At Williston, he led the Red Devils to three-straight Suwannee Conference Championships, earning Coach of the Year honors each season.

Kennen started his coaching career at Santaluces High School in Lantana, Fla.

Kennen was a four-year starter at guard at Palm Beach Atlantic University from 1989-93, earning 1993 PBAC Athlete of the Year honors. The Ocala, Fla., native served as team captain for three years and finished his career as Palm Beach Atlantic's all-time single-game (20), single-season (294) and career (918) assists leader.

Kennen graduated Cum Laude with a Bachelor's Degree in Biology and Physical Education from Palm Beach Atlantic University in 1993. He then went on to earn a Master's in Educational Leadership from Florida in 1998.

Kennen was born in Lakewood, N.J., and has a daughter, Regan, and a son, Trey. Regan played volleyball at Coker University. Kennen resides in Jacksonville, Fla.
