It's the dawn of a new era for New Hampshire football with the ascension of **Rick Santos** to head coach following the retirement of legendary coach **Sean McDonnell**. Santos did serve as UNH interim head coach for the 2019 season, when the Wildcats defeated a pair of nationally-ranked teams and went 5-0 at Wildcat Stadium.

Thursday night's game is the first matchup between New Hampshire and Monmouth on the gridiron.

The 2022 UNH Wildcats return eight starters on both sides of the ball and welcome back the return of two other 'Cats who were starters before missing the 2021 season because of injury.

Sophomore defensive end **Josiah Silver** was named to three preseason All-America teams; he garnered three 2021 All-America Team honors and was named the 2021 CAA Defensive Rookie of the Year. On the national leaderboard, Silver tied for #2 in forced fumbles, was #5 in sacks and #7 in tackles for loss. He was the CAA leader in sacks, tackles for loss and forced fumbles.

Junior running back **Dylan Laube** ranked #4 in the nation in all-purpose yards per game (147.4) and #13 in combined kick return yards. Laube led the CAA in all-purpose yards per game and was UNH's leader in all-purpose yards, all-purpose yards per game, rushing average (6.3 yards/carry), rushing yards per game (55.7) and rushing TDs (four), as well as kickoff returns (30), kickoff return yards (620) and yards per kickoff return (20.7).

UNH has two captains on both sides of the ball: wide receiver **Brian Espanet** and offensive lineman **Patrick Flynn**, and safety **Pop Bush** and defensive lineman **Niko Kvietskus**.

One of the aforementioned starters coming off a 2021 injury is sophomore quarterback Max Brosmer. He started 10 games as a true freshman in 2019, when he completed 58.8 percent of his passes for 1,967 yards and 12 touchdowns.

SEASON OPENERS: New Hampshire has a 13-9 record the past 22 season openers and that includes last year's 27-21 win at Stony Brook.

HOME OPENERS: The Wildcats are 15-2 the past 17 home openers and that includes last year's 26-14 win vs. Towson; the losses were in 2020-21 and 2018.

WILDCAT STADIUM: New Hampshire has a 19-10 lifetime record at Wildcat Stadium (opened in the 2016 season) and that includes 13-8 against CAA conference opponents.

HOME SWEET HOME: Since 2008, UNH has a 61-15 home record (.803 win percentage) in Durham, which includes 42-11 (.792) against CAA teams.

BROSMER'S BACK: Sophomore quarterback **Max Brosmer**, who incurred a preseason season-ending injury in 2021, is back under center for the Sept. 1 season opener. Brosmer started 10 games as a true freshman in 2019, when he completed 58.8 percent of his passes for 1,967 yards and 12 touchdowns. He also had three rushing touchdowns. The Wildcats defeated nationally-ranked Stony Brook and Delaware in 2019 with Brosmer as the signal caller.

ALL-PURPOSE BACK: UNH's No. 1 offensive weapon is junior running back **Dylan Laube**, who ranked #4 in the nation in all-purpose yards per game (147.4) and #13 in combined kick return yards. Laube led the CAA in all-purpose yards per game and was UNH's leader in all-purpose yards, all-purpose yards per game, rushing average (6.3 yards/carry), rushing yards per game (55.7) and rushing TDs (four), as well as kickoff returns (30), kickoff return yards (620) and yards per kickoff return (20.7). Laube finished with 80 rushes for 501 yards and also had 22 receptions for 206 yards.

Laube will reprise his role as top kickoff returner and will also add punt returner to the list following the graduation of multiple-year punt returner Evan Horn.

SOWING THE SIEDE: Sophomore running back **Isaac Seide** will see an increase in workload this season. He averaged 5.1 yards per carry with 182 yards on 36 carries a year ago; he added six catches for 38 yards.

TOP TARGETS: Senior wide receiver and captain **Brian Espanet**, who led the Wildcats in touchdown catches in 2019 and 2021, returns for his final year of eligibility. Espanet had seven of UNH's 16 touchdown receptions last season and had five in 2019; the seven TD catches ranked fifth in the CAA. He led the team in receiving yards (454) and yards per catch (13.35) last fall as well.

Senior wide receiver **Sean Coyne** led last year's Wildcats with 35 receptions, including three for touchdowns, and his 324 receiving yards ranked second. Prior to that in the abbreviated 2020-21 season (one game), he had five catches for 34 yards and two TDs.

Junior tight end **Kyle Lepkowski** ranked third on the squad in both catches (25) and receiving yards (297); he averaged 11.9 yards per catch and hauled in one TD pass.

PAVING THE WAY: Senior captain **Patrick Flynn**, a CAA Pre-season All-Conference Honorable Mention selection, started all 11 games at left tackle last season and enters the 2022 season with 34 consecutive starts – that is every New Hampshire game

played the previous four years – as an anchor on the Wildcats' offensive line at left tackle.

Junior **Osho Omoyeni** is making the transition to center. He played in all 11 games with 10 starts a year ago; he started the first eight games and last two games of the season at left guard.

Junior **David Perry, Jr.** established himself as the starter at left guard, sophomore **Dylan Poirier** is at right tackle and junior **Matt O'Neill** will line up alongside Poirier at right guard.

GETTING AFTER THE QB: Senior defensive tackle and captain **Niko Kvietkus** and sophomore All-American **Josiah Silver** provide pressure from the front line of the defensive unit.

Kvietkus, who missed the last three games of the 2021 season, finished with 25 tackles, including 4.5 tackles for loss and two sacks.

Silver had an absolutely huge year last fall as a freshman. The defensive end was named to three All-America teams, the CAA Defensive Rookie of the Year, All-CAA First Team and All-New England Team. Silver was also a finalist for the Jerry Rice Award (national freshman of the year).

On the national leaderboard, Silver tied for #2 in forced fumbles, was #5 in sacks and #7 in tackles for loss. He was the CAA leader in sacks, tackles for loss and forced fumbles, as well as seventh in solo tackles and 12th in total tackles. Silver led UNH in solo tackles, assisted tackles, total tackles, tackles for loss, sacks and forced fumbles.

Sophomores **Nathan Kapongo**, **Neil Politano**, **Zach Garron** and **Dylan Ruiz** and junior **Chris Donnelly** are all in the mix for playing time on the defensive line. Politano, who started two games in Kvietkus' absence, is slated to start alongside Kvietkus while Ruiz is the bookend opposite Silver.

A pair of transfers are expected to figure prominently on the D-line. Grad student **Pierce DeV Vaughn** is a defensive end who played at UConn and junior **Kyle Finnick** started at defensive tackle for three years at Dayton. Both are penciled in as backups on the 2-deep.

LINEBACKER DEPTH: Linebacker might be the deepest position on the team, as the Wildcats have six players battling for two spots.

They are juniors **Bryce Shaw** and **Oleh Manzyk**, sophomores **Ryan Toscano**, **Zedane Williams** and **Max Tillett** and redshirt freshman **Brandon Perkins**.

Shaw and Toscano are retaining their spot in the starting lineup. Toscano recorded 67 tackles and Shaw made 65 stops to rank second and third, respectively, on the team.

Toscano, who also ranked second in assisted tackles, was UNH's tackles leader in three games and recorded double-digits tackles twice.

Shaw led the team in tackles for loss and finished with 10+ tackles three times.

Williams and Perkins enter Thursday Night Throwdown as the backups. Williams played in 8 of 11 games with two starts a year ago while Perkins played in two games.

Manzyk started and played well as a true freshman in 2019 -- he ranked fifth on the team in tackles and tied for second in sacks -- but missed much of last season with injuries. Tillett saw action in nine games in 2021.

has a number of playmakers. Bush enters the 2022 season as UNH's active leader in career tackles with 132 and is tied for the lead in career interceptions (three). He played in 8 of 11 games with seven starts last season and finished with 47 total tackles, three forced fumbles, two interceptions and five pass breakups, which tied for second on the team. In 2019, Bush ranked second in tackles.

Junior **Max Oxendine** was impressive in the spring after missing all last season with an injury; Oxendine started the last six games of 2019, started the only game in 2020-21 and is projected to start in 2022. Classmate **Joe Eichman** is UNH's third projected starter at safety.

Junior **Derek Thompson**, who was a starting cornerback the past two seasons, is at safety along with sophomore **Noah Palm** and redshirt freshman **Brendan Tighe**. Thompson was credited with 39 tackles a year ago. Last season, Palm played in 9 of 11 games with three starts, including a career-high 15 tackles at Pitt. Tighe did see game action twice in 2021.

SAFETY: Junior **Randall Harris** and sophomore **Noah Stansbury** are projected to start at the corners with sophomores **Jonathan Collins, Jr.** and **Caleb Mead** as the backups. Harris tied for the team lead with five pass breakups; his other stats included 48 tackles and two interceptions. Stansbury started all 11 games at free safety last season; he finished with a team-high three interceptions as well as 61 tackles and four pass breakups. Collins, Jr. tied Stansbury for fourth on the team with four pass breakups; he also tallied 30 tackles and an INT. Mead tallied 12 tackles in nine games.

KICKING THE BALL AROUND: Redshirt freshman **Nick Mazzie** and freshman **Charles Trentham** are the top two placekickers heading into the season. Neither have attempted a kick at the collegiate level.

Last year, that duty belonged to **Sean Lehane**, who made 14

of 15 PAT kicks and was 2-for-6 on field goal attempts.

Lehane also punted last season with 17 boots for a 42.6 yard average and a long of 70 at Rhode Island. He has climbed to the top of the depth chart following the preseason.

He supplants sophomore **Aidan Cadogan**, who ranked second in the CAA in punting last season with an average of 41.12 yards per boot. Cadogan recorded eight punts of 50+ yards, including a long of 65 at Pitt, and also pinned the opponent inside the 20 on 10 punts.

Bob Lipman, six-time N.H. Sportscaster of the Year, is in his 12th season as the Voice of the Wildcats and 12th season with the Network in the Spring 2021 season. RICK SANTOS**HEAD COACH**

Rick Santos '08 was named the 20th head coach in UNH football history on Dec. 7, 2021. Santos, a record-setting quarterback from 2004-07 and a 2016 UNH Athletics Hall of Fame inductee, served as associate head coach and quarterbacks coach for three seasons (2019-21) in his return to the Wildcats' staff before being elevated to head coach.

In March 2019, Santos was hired as New Hampshire's associate head coach and quarterbacks coach, which brought him back to his alma mater in a coaching capacity for the second time. With head coach Sean McDonnell stepping aside for health reasons on Aug. 26, 2019, Santos was promoted to interim head coach.

In the 2019 season, the Wildcats finished 6-5 overall with a perfect 5-0 home record. UNH knocked off nationally-ranked teams Stony Brook and Villanova to enter the top 25 polls, and brought the Brice-Cowell Musket back to Durham by defeating Maine in the regular-season finale. That season saw the rise of Max Brosmer as the team's first true freshman to start at quarterback in more than four decades, as well as that of running back Dylan Laube, who was a HERO Sports Freshman Honorable Mention All-American.

Santos resumed the position of associate head coach/quarterbacks coach for the 2020-21 season. He also took the lead on increasing alumni engagement and enhancing fundraising initiatives, highlighted by record-setting donations secured by UNH football in April 2021 during The (603) Challenge, which is an annual University-wide fundraising drive.

In his first tenure as a Wildcat assistant coach from 2013-15, Santos coached wide receivers. In 2015, he mentored R.J. Harris to the single greatest WR statistical season in program history. Harris tallied a school-record 100 catches and led the nation with 1,551 receiving yards, which tied the program's all-time single-season benchmark. In 2013, Harris and Justin Mello became the first WR duo in school history to each register 1,000 yards in a single season.

Santos, a native of Bellingham, Mass., worked three seasons (2016-18) as the QB coach/passing game coordinator at Columbia University of the Ivy League between his two stretches as an assistant coach and associate head coach at his alma mater.

Santos, whose uniform No. 2 is one of four jerseys retired by the UNH football program, compiled a 37-14 record and directed the Wildcats to four NCAA Division I-AA/FCS playoff appearances. He guided UNH to its first-ever postseason victory at Georgia Southern (Nov. 27, 2004), was part of the 2005 Atlantic 10 championship team that was ranked No. 1 in the country, and he won two A-10 Northern Division titles (2004, 2006).

Santos passed for 13,212 yards and 123 touchdowns while accumulating 14,615 yards of total offense. The three-time Walter Camp All-American connected with UNH's all-time leading receiver and fellow University Hall of Famer David Ball for 53 touchdowns from 2004-06 to set an FCS record that still stands for most career TD connections for a QB-WR duo. Santos also owns the FCS single-game record for highest percentage of passes completed (96.2 percent) when he went 25 of 26 for 306 yards and five TDs in a 52-21 defeat of Northeastern on Oct. 22, 2005.

In 2006, Santos won the Walter Payton Award as the most outstanding offensive player in FCS football when he threw for 3,125 yards and 29 touchdowns. He was a three-time Atlantic-10/CAA Offensive Player of the Year (2005-07) and four-time All-Conference First Team QB. In 2004, he was named the ECAC Rookie of the Year, Atlantic 10 co-Rookie of the Year, set the FCS record for most yards gained by a freshman in a game (538, at Villanova, Oct. 2, 2004) and freshman TD passes in a season (31).

Santos possesses school career records in pass attempts (1,498), completions (1,024) and passing yards (12,189). He holds the top two and four of the top six single-season records in completions, headlined by 301 in 2005. His '05 season included a school all-time high 3,797 passing yards.

Following his graduation with a bachelor's degree in Kinesiology: Sport Studies with a concentration in sports management, Santos played football professionally for five years. He signed as an undrafted free agent with the Kansas City Chiefs in 2008 before moving north to play in the Canadian Football League from 2009-12.

COACHING STAFF

BRIAN SCOTT**Offensive Coordinator / Offensive Line**

Brian Scott enters his third season with the New Hampshire coaching staff in 2022, which will mark his first as offensive coordinator. He was co-offensive coordinator his first two years as a Wildcat. Scott will continue working with UNH's offensive linemen for the third consecutive year.

In the 2021 season, Scott was responsible for game-planning with an emphasis on the Wildcats' running game. UNH's top three running backs combined for 1,230 yards and six rushing TDs on 233 carries for an average of 5.3 yards per carry.

Scott was previously at Towson University as the team's offensive line coach and run game coordinator. Prior to Towson, he spent 13 seasons at Old Dominion and served as the team's offensive coordinator each year. He was the associate head coach from 2012-19 and the offensive line coach from 2007-11.

In his time with the Monarchs, he helped Old Dominion transition from FCS to FBS into Conference USA and led a team that was consistently one of the top offenses in college football. During his tenure, 20 Monarchs on offense earned all-conference recognition plus the team won its first game over a Power Five program, a 49-35 victory over then-#10 Virginia Tech, and its first bowl game, the 2016 Bahamas Bowl, after being the co-champion of the East Division of Conference USA.

Scott was a 2009 and 2012 FootballScoop.com Coordinator of the Year, and in 2016, he was a finalist for the Broyles Award for top assistant in college football.

Prior to ODU, Scott spent three seasons at his alma mater, the University of Maine, as the recruiting coordinator as well as working with the offensive line, running backs and tight ends. He worked at the University of Tennessee-Martin in 2003 with the wide receivers, tight ends and the special teams unit.

Scott's first job as a college coach was in 2002 as the quarterbacks coach at UMass Lowell. That year, the River Hawks set school single-season records for completions and passing yards.

Scott graduated from the University of Maine in 2000 with a degree in communications. He is a recipient of the Maine Sports Hall of Fame Special Achievement Award.

ED BORDEN**Tight Ends / Recruiting Coordinator**

The 2022 season will be Ed Borden's fourth as an assistant coach for the UNH football program and third year as tight ends coach; he was also named the recruiting coordinator during the staff reorganization in spring 2022.

The 2021 season saw the emergence of sophomore tight end Kyle Lepkowski, who ranked third on the team in both receptions and receiving yards.

Prior to his current roles, Borden assisted co-offensive coordinator Michael Ferzoco with coaching wide receivers in 2019.

In 2018, Borden worked under head coach Mark Whipple at UMass as an offensive analyst for the Minutemen. He worked primarily with the team's quarterbacks.

Borden previously coached at Curry College, the Massachusetts Maritime Academy and Mount Ida College.

A 2009 graduate of Bentley University, Borden also worked under Jim Fassel with the Las Vegas Locomotives of the United Football League.

DREW BELCHER**Quarterbacks**

Drew Belcher enters his second season as assistant coach with the Wildcats. Belcher is the quarterbacks coach in 2022 after serving as the UNH running backs coach in his first year (2021).

In the 2021 season, UNH's top three running backs combined for 1,230 yards and six rushing TDs on 233 carries for an average of 5.3 yards per carry.

Belcher had a standout career at the University of Maine (2014-18) as a quarterback and tight end, and played one season in the NFL.

In 2019, Belcher broke into the NFL by signing an undrafted free agent contract with the Arizona Cardinals to compete for a roster spot on the squad at tight end.

At Maine, Belcher played a pivotal role in the Black Bears' historical 2018 season, which ended in the longest postseason run in program history. During that season, Maine captured the CAA championship, appeared in the FCS national semifinals, and finished the year with a No. 4 FCS national ranking. Individually in 2018, Belcher earned All-CAA Second Team honors at tight end and received the Jack Cosgrove Leadership Award.

Belcher's career accolades at Maine also included four Maine Scholar-Athlete awards and the 2016 Maine Football Strength and Conditioning Award.

Belcher graduated from Maine with a Bachelor of Science in Business Administration in Management.

STEPHEN BARNETTE**Wide Receivers**

Stephen Barnette, an all-conference player in the Colonial Athletic Conference while at Richmond, joins the UNH staff as wide receivers coach in 2022. He was most recently on the staff at Towson, where he was a quality control coach.

Barnette was a standout wide receiver at Richmond. He led the CAA in receiving yards with 1,189 as a junior in 2013 and tied with UNH's R.J. Harris in receptions with 76. Barnette's senior season ended abruptly with a knee injury after five games.

TOMMY HERION**Running Backs**

Tommy Herion enters his first season as a UNH assistant coach in 2022; he will work directly with the running backs. He joined the staff as a student assistant coach entering the 2021 season but returned to the sidelines as a quarterback.

Herion was a four-year quarterback for the Wildcats spanning the 2018-21 seasons. He came to New Hampshire as a transfer from the University of Iowa in January '18.

GARRETT GILICK Associate Head Coach / Defensive Coordinator / Linebackers

Garrett Gillick enters his ninth season on the New Hampshire coaching staff in 2022. He was promoted to UNH's associate head coach and defensive coordinator prior to the Spring 2022 season. Gillick was the Wildcats' linebacker coach the previous eight seasons (2014-21).

In the 2021 season, the young linebacking duo of Ryan Toscano and Bryce Shaw ranked 2-3 on the team in tackles with 67 and 65, respectively.

The 2019 season's linebacking unit helped UNH to the No. 2 ranking in scoring defense, total defense and pass defense efficiency, as well as No. 3 in rush defense.

In 2018, the two starting linebackers were the top two Wildcats in tackles for loss; they also ranked first and third in sacks as well as first and fifth in total tackles, and they were credited with five of the team's 11 forced fumbles. The LBs helped New Hampshire's defense to CAA conference rankings of first in pass defense, second in total defense, tied for second in sacks, and fourth in scoring defense.

In 2017, Quinlen Dean recorded a team- and CAA-high 124 tackles to earn a spot on the All-Conference Second Team. In 2016, Gillick's proteges ranked 3-4-5 on the team in tackles and those three combined for 23 of the team's 76 tackles for loss. In 2014, Gillick's two starting LBs ranked 1-2 on the team in tackles. The second level of the Wildcats' 4-2-5 defense was instrumental in UNH's No. 2-ranked scoring defense in the CAA.

Prior to coming to Durham, Gillick had a three-season stint (2011-13) at Bentley University, including two years as defensive line coach and one as secondary coach.

The University of Maine graduate is a 2008 inductee into the Lowell H.S. Athletic Hall of Fame.

JOHN BOWES**Safeties**

John Bowes enters his fifth year as the UNH safeties coach in 2022 after joining the program in February 2018. In the 2019 season, safeties Evan Horn and Pop Bush ranked 1-2 on the team in tackles; Horn was named to the CAA All-Conference Second Team. The secondary unit helped lead New Hampshire to the No. 2 ranking in scoring defense, total defense and pass defense efficiency, as well as No. 3 in rush defense.

Under his tutelage in 2018, junior Pop Lacey tied for the team lead in total tackles and garnered All-CAA Second Team recognition; sophomore Evan Horn had a team-high four interceptions – scored on two of them – and ranked fourth in tackles. The corps of safeties helped UNH rank first in the CAA in pass defense, second in total defense and fourth in scoring defense.

Bowes spent the 2017 season as the defensive coordinator/safeties coach at Fordham University. He spent four seasons (2013-16) at Bucknell and that included the last three as the secondary coach/special teams coordinator. Prior to Bucknell, Bowes spent five years as an assistant coach at William & Mary from 2008-2013.

NYEEM WARTMAN-WHITE**Defensive Line**

Nyeem Wartman-White enters his third season with the UNH football program in 2022 after being hired as defensive line coach in March 2020. Under his tutelage in 2021, freshman defensive end Josiah Silver was named to three All-America teams after ranking fourth in the FCS in sacks as well as second in forced fumbles; Silver led UNH in solo tackles, assisted tackles, total tackles, tackles for loss, sacks and forced fumbles.

Wartman-White, a former standout linebacker at Penn State University from 2012-16, spent the 2018 and 2019 seasons as a defensive graduate assistant at Mississippi State. During his playing days with the Nittany Lions, Wartman-White was named to the Butkus Award Preseason Watch List as a senior (2016), earned 2013 Academic All-Big Ten honors and was one of only six true freshmen to see game action in 2012.

GARRETT McLAUGHLIN**Defensive Ends / Special Teams**

Garrett McLaughlin is in his third season with UNH, and the second consecutive season coaching the both the defensive ends and the special teams unit. In the 2020-21 season, he served as a volunteer assistant coach.

In 2021, freshman defensive end Josiah Silver was named to three All-America teams after ranking fourth in the FCS in sacks as well as second in forced fumbles; Silver led UNH in solo tackles, assisted tackles, total tackles, tackles for loss, sacks and forced fumbles.

McLaughlin spent the 2021 spring season coaching the running backs. He leads position meetings, individual drills, and assists in opponent breakdowns, self-scout, scout team operations, and transfer recruiting.

Prior to UNH, he served as an assistant coach at Bates College for three seasons (2018-2021) as the special teams and defensive line coordinator. He also had coaching stops at Wagner College (2017), New Haven (2016) and SUNY Buffalo State (2012-2015).

CASEY DeANDRADE**Defensive Backs / Defense Pass Game Coordinator**

Casey DeAndrade is returning to the UNH fold as the coach of the defensive backs – the position he excelled at as a player – after spending the last three seasons coaching at Holy Cross. DeAndrade is also UNH's defense pass game coordinator in 2022.

He was a four-year starter for the Wildcats and was a captain and named an All-America First Team as a senior. He interned for a season at UNH in strength and conditioning and quality control, coached running backs for a year with the team and then coached at Holy Cross for the three seasons.

DeAndrade was a starter in the defensive backfield from the first game of his red-shirt freshman season in 2013 and led the Cats to some of their best years ever, including appearances in the NCAA FCS semifinals in 2013 and 2014.

DeAndrade finished his career with nine INTs and 285 tackles. He ranked No. 1 on the team in tackles in 2015 and was in the top four in that category each season.
