The Basics: The University of Northern Iowa football program returns home after two straight weeks on the road to host Missouri State for its annual Family Weekend. The game is set for a 1 p.m. kick on Panther Sports Network and ESPN3.

About the Bears: Missouri State enters the game against UNI 3-3 overall and 2-1 in MVFC play. The Bears opened their season on a two-game winning streak before falling to FBS opponent Kansas State, 35-0. They opened the conference season with a win over Indiana State on the road, but have lost two in a row to top-15 ranked North Dakota State and Western Illinois. The Bears are averaging 28.0 points per game, but are only allowing 24.3 points per game, ranking in the top-30 in total defense.

Five Facts:

- Malcolm Washington leads the MVFC in interceptions this season with three, including his key pick against #11 Youngstown State.
- UNI is ranked first in the FCS in strength of schedule.
- Karter Schult is tied for the lead in all of FCS in sacks (8.5).
- UNI ranks No. 7 in the FCS in interceptions, with 10 through six games.
- Head Coach Mark Farley earned his 130th career win against Iowa State (9/3), making him the all-time wins leader in program history.



UNI head coach Mark Farley, once known as the "walk on from Waukon", has led the Panthers to a mark of 131-65 in his 15 years at the helm of the program, becoming the UNI all-time wins leader with his win over Iowa State on Sept. 3. Entering his 16th season as the head coach of the Northern Iowa Panthers, Farley is set to hit the ground running.

In Missouri Valley Football Conference play, Farley has guided the Panthers to a record of 79-36 for an impressive .687 winning percentage in league play. Farley is the MVFC's all-time coaching wins leader with 79 league victories.

Included in that 15-year run for Farley and the Panthers are seven conference championships, nine playoff appearances, 12 top-25 final rankings, three national semifinal appearances and one national title game appearance in 2005. Farley holds the UNI record for postseason coaching victories with 13 with an overall playoff record of 13-9.

Through his leadership, the Panthers have returned to the glory days when they won seven straight conference titles and made seven consecutive FCS playoff appearances in the decade of the '90s. In Farley's 15 years at the helm, UNI has won at least a share of seven Missouri Valley Football Conference titles. UNI has also advanced to the quarterfinals (2003, 2007, 2011, 2015), semifinals (2001, 2008) and the national title game (2005) in seven of those nine playoff appearances. Twelve of Farley's 15 previous Panther teams have finished the season ranked in the top-25, defeating 79 top-25 ranked foes in the process.

Last Time Against Missouri State: UNI defeated Missouri State on the road in 2015, 41-0. Aaron Bailey led the team with 161 yards on the ground on 19 carries, scoring four rushing touchdowns. On defense, UNI held the Bears to just 139 total yards on offense and 43 yards on the ground.

Turnovers Gained: UNI is currently ranked No. 16 in the FCS in turnovers gained, coming up with 14 through six games. UNI had three turnovers in just the second quarter against Youngstown State (10/15), notching two interceptions and a forced fumble. It ties for the most turnovers in a half this season, with UNI also coming up with three in the fourth quarter against Iowa State (9/3).

Back-to-Back: Malcolm Washington has come up with key interceptions in back-to-back-to-back games for the Panthers. The Fresno State transfer scored his first pick-six in a Panther uniform against Southern Illinois (10/1), following it up with an interception in the third quarter against South Dakota (10/8) and one in the second quarter at Youngstown State (10/15).

Pick-Six: Duncan Ferch scored UNI's second defensive touchdown of the season and his first-career pick-six in the second guarter against YSU (10/15), putting UNI up 10-0. Malcolm Washington holds UNI's other defensive score, running back an interception against Southern Illinois (10/1).

Career-Highs: UNI had career-high nights on defense against Youngstown State (10/15), with both Elijah Campbell and Rickey Neal having standout performances. Campbell tied for the lead with a career-high nine tackles while Neal added eight, including three tackles for loss and a forced fumble.

Cracking Ranks: With his sack against Youngstown State (10/15), Karter Schult is ranked No. 4 all-time at UNI in career sacks. He has 8.5 sacks this season and 27.0 in his career at UNI.

Turnover Game: UNI is currently ranked No. 7 in the FCS in passes intercepted after the three they picked off against Youngstown State (10/15). It was the four game out the six this season that UNI has had one-or-more interceptions.

Double Threat: Aaron Bailey has proved to the country that he is a dual threat quarterback, scoring a total of 44 touchdowns (rushing/passing) in just 20 games. He ranks No. 15 all-time at UNI and just needs 10 more to crack the top-10 to tie Sawyer Kollmorgen and current associate head coach Bill Salmon, who both have 54.

Making the Rounds: Michael Malloy posted one of his most well-rounded games as a Panther, racking up 76 all-purpose yards against South Dakota (10/8). He finished the game with 37 rushing yards, 26 yards through the air that included a 17-yard touchdown, and added 24 yards on kick-off returns.

Quick Impact: In just his second season with the Panthers, Aaron Bailey has moved into a tie for eighth all-time at UNI in career rushing touchdowns, giving him a total of 25 after his after his 95-yard, two touchdown performance against South Dakota (10/8). He is tied with Errol Peebles, who had 25 rushing scores from 1985-88. The senior finished with two rushing touchdowns against the Coyotes (10/8), marking the seventh time in his career at UNI that he has had multiple rushing scores in a game.

Decade Stats: The last time a Panther scored three receiving touchdowns in a game was in 2006 when Johnny Gray brought in three against Youngstown State. Daurice Fountain finished the game against Southern Illinois (10/1) with three scores on five receptions and 89 yards. The UNI record for receiving touchdowns in a game is four, set twice by Dick Beetsch (vs. South Dakota, 1954) and Dedric Ward (vs. Western Illinois, 1995).

Pick-Six: UNI notched its first defensive touchdown of the season against Southern Illinois (10/1) with Malcolm Washington's 43-yard interception return in the second quarter. It was Washington's first start as a Panther at cornerback.

Throwing Improvement: Aaron Bailey tied his career-high for passing touchdowns in UNI's win over Southern Illinois (10/1), going for three all to Daurice Fountain. The last time Bailey threw for three touchdowns was against Eastern Illinois (11/28/15) in the first round of the playoffs.

Conference Play: UNI currently holds a 151-58 overall record in the MVFC and 79-36 record during the Farley era. Farley's 79 league wins is the most by a head coach in Missouri Valley Football Conference history.

Jack of All Trades: Most football fans know defensive linemen for their sacks and tackles at the line of scrimmage, but Karter Schult has shown that with his size and speed, he can defend at all angles and all spots on the field. The senior lineman notched his first-career interception against Eastern Washington (9/17), returning it for 20 yards.

The Streak Continues: A.J. Allen had either tied or set a new career-high in tackles for three consecutive weeks prior to the game against SIU. The sophomore finished with 12 against Eastern Washington (9/17), surpassing his seven he set against Montana. His 12 tackles was a team-high.

Dual Threat: Michael Malloy has been an offensive threat for the Panthers since last season, taking snaps at wide receiver, running back and even fullback. He has started two games at wide receiver this season and added to his resume a career-long rushing touchdown at Eastern Washington (9/17). The senior scored a 30-yard rushing touchdown against the Eagles, his longest rush and longest rushing touchdown at UNI.

Strength in Numbers: The UNI defense has been ranked in the top-30 in the FCS in rushing defense in three consecutive seasons. In 2016 through the first fivegames, UNI is ranked No. 20 in the FCS and No. 2 in the Valley, holding opponents to an average of 116 yards on the ground. UNI had held its opponent to under 200 yards rushing for seven consecutive games, dating back to Nov. 28, UNI's 53-17 win over Eastern Illinois in the first round of the playoffs prior to UNI's game against South Dakota (10/8).

Breaking the Line: Karter Schult tied the school record for tackles for loss in a game against No. 14 Montana (9/10), recording 5.5 to match John Hermann who had 5.5 against Northern Arizona in 2005. He finished the game with a career-high tying 10 tackles along with two sacks

Farley Wins: Head coach Mark Farley earned his 130th career win at the helm, becoming the all-time wins leader in program history, passing Stan Sheriff who held a record of 129-101-4 from 1960-82. He was already the all-time wins leader in the Missouri Valley Football Conference and all-time conference wins leader with 79 in 15 seasons.

MVFC Defensive Player of the Week (Sept. 3): Junior linebacker Jared Farley was named the Valley Defensive Player of the Week for his exceptional performance in UNI's 25-20 win over Iowa State. The Cedar Falls, Iowa native racked up a team-high eight tackles, along with an interception that sealed the Panther victory and gave his father, Mark Farley, his 130th career win at the helm.

Starting Right: In his first collegiate football game and first collegiate start, redshirt freshman Hezekiah Applegate shined on the Panther defensive line against lowa State (9/3). He was a part of the line that allowed only 51 rushing yards by the Cyclones, adding in his seven tackles that included a sack and 2.5 TFLs.

Leading the Way: UNI named its four captains for the season in Karter Schult, Robert Rathje, D'Shawn Dexter and Aaron Bailey. The four have combined for 80-plus starts between 2013-2016.

Ground Running: Aaron Bailey hit the ground running with his 114 rushing yard performance against lowa State (9/3). He had 25 carries, averaging 4.6 yards per carry for his seventh game in a Panther uniform to reach 100-plus rushing.

Multi-Talented: Charles Brown, who played wide receiver for the Panthers the last two seasons, started at cornerback at lowa State (9/3), racking up three tackles and a key interception.

UNI in Non-Conference: UNI has the most victories among league members over top-25 non-conference opponents with 33 since 1985. UNI posted back-to-back wins against non-conference top-25 opponents in 2015 for the first time since the 2008 playoffs (Maine, New Hampshire) when they beat No. 7 Eastern Washington (9/12/15) and No. 17 Cal Poly (9/19/15). UNI plays Eastern Washington in week three of the 2016 season.

Road Warriors: The Panthers will take on six road games this season, including another trip out west. In total, the Panthers will travel 3,180 miles.

Consistently Ranked: Since 1985, UNI has been the only MVFC team ranked in a preseason or regular season poll every season.
