# #16 Josh Alber sophomore - 133 pounds

- NCAA qualifier in 2016
- Highest finisher for UNI at Midlands last year (2nd).
- Second at 2016 Grand View Open.
- Ranked fourth in the MAC.



# #18 Max Thomsen redshirt freshman - 149 pounds

- Grand View champion last weekend.
- lowa's 24th wrestler to win four state titles as a prep.
- Won three open tournaments redshirting last year.



# #13 Bryce Steiert sophomore - 157 pounds

- First true freshman from UNI to qualify for NCAAs since 2003.
- Had four wins over top-20 opponents last year.
- Ranked second in the MAC.



# **#10 Cooper Moore** senior - 165 pounds

- Three-time NCAA qualifier.
- Only current Panther with two MAC titles.
- Ranked second in the MAC.

UNI will be hosting the most duals and tournaments since the 2002-03 season when UNI hosted nine duals and the UNI Open tournament. The Panthers will have eight duals and have scheduled two tournaments on campus for 2016-17.

The Mid-American Conference Championships will be held in Cedar Falls, Iowa, for the first time since UNI joined the league for the tournament in 2013. UNI implemented a full MAC schedule the following season.

#### **TOURNAMENTS**

UNI is set to host an open tournament before heading to the Southern Scuffle for the first time. The Panthers are not expected to compete in Midlands or the Cliff Keen Invite this season.

#### LAST SEASON

Dylan Peters fought through a severe injury to earn his second All-American honor at the 2016 NCAA tournament. Peters took sixth after being seeded ninth.

Bryce Steiert became UNI's first true freshman in the starting lineup since former All-American Joey Lazor started in 2010. He went on to be one of five UNI qualifiers for the NCAA national tournament.

In addition to Peters and Steiert, Cooper Moore earned his third trip to the NCAA tournament. Josh Alber made his debut at nationals seeded 15th, and heavy-weight Blaize Cabell rounded out the squad. Illness kept Cabell from competing at the national tournament. He was seeded 14th.

The four competitors combined to give the team a top-25 finish.

#### PANTHER EXPERIENCE

All four wrestlers who competed at last year's national tournament return. A fifth Panther qualified for the NCAA Division I Championships in 2015. JJ Everard redshirted last season after transferring from South Dakota State, where he qualified for nationals as a junior.

Junior Tyler Hoffman, an Iowa Central Community College transfer, won the NJCAA tournament as a freshman and sophomore.

Six Panthers are ranked in the MAC's preseason polls. One Panther is listed as the conference leader. Peters leads UNI ranked second in most national polls. Moore returns as the second Panther to earn two consecutive MAC championships.

#### **TOP 10 IN ATTENDANCE**

The home schedule provides plenty of opportunity to improve in the national attendance standings. UNI has been in the top 10 among wrestling programs for attendance the last three seasons.

In 2013-14, UNI saw its biggest jump in attendance in at least 14 years. Four sell-outs pushed them to ninth in the national rankings for attendance. The Panthers were eighth in the nation in 2014-15 and 10th in the 2015-16 season.

Last year's home duals against Missouri and Iowa State were sold out. The final three duals with Central Michigan, Ohio and Kent State were about 300 fans shy of being sold out.

#### IN THE SERIES

This will be the first meeting between the UNK Lopers and UNI Panthers. The series with Utah Valley is tied 1-1 and dates back to 2010. The last meeting was in 2012, where UNI grabbed a 24-18 win under head coach Doug Schwab.
