- Senior Jeremy Morgan, the preseason MVC player of the year, leads the Panthers in scoring (16.6), rebounding (7.5), assists (3.2), blocks (1.5), steals (2.5), 3-pointers made (30) and free throws made (41).
- Morgan needs 29 more points to reach the 1,000 point mark in his career. He will become the 41st UNI Panther to score 1,000 or more points.
- Redshirt freshman Spencer Haldeman ranks second on the squad in scoring (9.5) and in 3-pointers made (26). Haldeman has made at least one 3-pointer in seven straight games.
- In UNI's five victories this season, the Panthers have shot 40.0 percent or better. In UNI's six losses, the Panthers have not shot better than 37.9 percent.

UNI (5-6 overall) will open up its Missouri Valley Conference play Wednesday at home in the McLeod Center against the Missouri State Bears (9-4 overall).

UNI is offering a ticket special for the Missouri State game. In the south bleachers, general admission tickets will be \$10 for adults and \$5 for youth (16 and under) for the Dec. 28 game. Call 319-273-4849 or order online at www.unipanthers. com/tickets.

### **BROADCAST INFORMATION**

Wednesday's game will be broadcast live on MVC TV.

Scott Warmann (play-by-play) and Kevin Lehman (analyst) will call the game.

The telecast will be cleared live on FOX Sports Midwest, FOX Sports Indiana Plus and FOX Sports Kansas City (combined 5.8 million homes), Comcast SportsNet Chicago, ESPN3 (outside the states of Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Kansas, Missouri and Nebraska), DirecTV (FOX Sports Midwest – Channel 671; Comcast SportsNet Chicago -Channel 665), Dish Network (FOX Sports Midwest - Channel 418: Comcast SportsNet Chicago - Channel 429) and AT&T U-verse (FOX Sports Midwest -- Channels 748 and 1748; Comcast SportsNet Chicago -Channels 741 and 1741). The game will also be shown on KSMO-TV (974,000 homes) in Kansas City, Missouri.

### **MISSOURI STATE BEARS**

Missouri State was pegged to finish fourth in the MVC Preseason Poll. The Bears. Last year's conference Newcomer of the Year Dequon Miller was named to the Preseason All-MVC second team

The Bears are led in scoring by Alize Johnson (13.2 ppg), Ronnie Rousseau III (12.8 ppg) and Miller (10.5 ppg).

Head coach Paul Lusk is in his sixth season at the helm of the Bear basket-ball program. In his five seasons, he has coached eight MVC Scholar-Athlete Team selections, four All-MVC players, four All-Freshman Team picks, three members of the MVC All-Newcomer Team and two members of the Most-Improved Team.

### **ALL-TIME SERIES**

Missouri State holds a 41-30 lead in the all-time series vs. UNI. The Panthers have won seven of the last eight games between the two schools dating back to the 2012-13 season.

UNI head coach Ben Jacobson is 15-5 against the Missouri State since taking over the program in 2006-07. Jacobson has posted a mark of 8-2 against the Bears in the McLeod Center.

### **MVC OPENERS UNDER JAKE**

UNI has posted a 5-5 mark, including a 3-2 record at home, in Missouri Valley Conference openers under 11th-year head coach Ben Jacobson.

### LAST SEASON VS THE BEARS

UNI and Missouri State split the season series last year with the home squad winning each game.

MSU trailed by 10 points at 50-40 with 9:17 left in the game in Springfield, Mo. Following a rally, MSU's Dequon Miller drove the length of the floor and made a layup with 6.1 left to give the Bears the 59-58 victory at JQH Arena.

UNI bounced back in the Mc-Leod Center and scored an 83-69 win over the Bears. UNI had four players reach double-figure scoring led by Jeremy Morgan's 21 points. Matt Bohannon and Bennett Koch each tallied 19 points. Wes Washpun chipped in with 11 points and a game-high nine assists.

### **FOR STARTERS**

UNI has used six different starting lineups this season in its 11 games.

Only senior Jeremy Morgan and freshman Juwan McCloud have started all 11 games.

UNI has had nine different players draw starts this season.

### **COMPARING 20-POINT MARGINS**

UNI head coach Ben Jacobson suffered his worst defeat as the Panthers mentor at No. 8-ranked North Carolina, 85-42.

It marked only the eighth time that a Jacobson-coached squad had lost a game by 20 or more points.

In contrast, Jacobson has guided UNI to 36 victories by 20 or more points since he took over the program in the 2006-07 season.

### AMONG THE ELITE

UNI is one of 13 teams to have won at least one game in the NCAA Tournament and accumulate 54 combined wins over the previous two seasons.

The elite list of squads include UNI, Duke, Gonzaga, Kansas, Kentucky, Maryland, North Carolina, Notre Dame, Oregon, Villanova, Wichita State, Wisconsin and Virginia.

# WINNING TRADITION IN MCLEOD CENTER

UNI will be playing its 11th season in the McLeod Center and the Panthers have made winning a priority in their home venue.

UNI has posted an all-time mark of 127-32 (.799) in games played in the McLeod Center.

UNI secured a school-record 16 home wins in the 2012-13 season.

UNI has posted a trio of perfect home seasons since moving to NCAA Division I. UNI was a perfect 14-0 in both the 1983-84 and 2009-10 seasons and then UNI notched a 15-0 mark at home in 2014-15.

UNI set its home-court win

streak of 21 consecutive victories between the 2008-09 and 2010-11 seasons.

The McLeod Center opened in November 2006.

### PROTECTING THE HOME COURT

UNI has won 11 or more home games in the McLeod Center in nine consecutive seasons.

### **BOOK IT IN THE UPPER HALF**

UNI's streak of 13 straight upper-half finishes in the MVC is the league's longest active streak.

### **NINE OR MORE MVC WINS**

The Panthers have won nine or more MVC games in each of the past 13 seasons – also the MVC's longest active streak.

### **TOP-FOUR FINISHES IN MVC**

UNI has finished in the top four of the MVC standings in eight consecutive seasons.

### IN THE UPPER HALF

UNI has finished in the upper half of the Missouri Valley Conference's final standings in 13 straight seasons. It is the longest active streak in the league.

Prior to the 2003-04 season, when the current streak began, UNI had finished in the top half of the MVC on two occasions (1993-94 - 5th, 1996-97 - 4th) since joining the league in 1991-92.

### **MORE MVC WINS**

UNI has won nine or more MVC games in 13 consecutive seasons - the longest active streak in the league.

Wichita State has the second longest active streak at seven.

UNI has had 12 20-win seasons in program history - 10 of those 20-win seasons have come since 2003-04.

### **MORGAN LEADS UNI**

Senior Jeremy Morgan, the preseason MVC player of the year, leads the Panthers in scoring (16.6), rebounding (7.5), assists (3.2), blocks (1.5), steals (2.5), 3-pointers made (30) and free throws made (41).

### **MORGAN CLOSING IN ON 1,000 CAREER POINTS**

Jeremy Morgan is 29 points shy of joining the 1,000 career point-club at UNI. Morgan has posted 971 points heading into Wednesday's game vs. Missouri State.

Morgan would become the 41st UNI Panther to score 1,000 or more points.

### **MORGAN MOVING UP** THE DEFENSIVE CHARTS

Senior guard Jeremy Morgan, who earned a spot on last year's MVC All-Defensive squad, is making his way up the UNI defensive charts in regard to blocked shots and steals.

Morgan ranks No. 4 at UNI in steals (152) and No. 9 in blocked shots (82).

UNI has three neutral-court wins over ranked foes, with two of those coming in 1990 and 2010 NCAA tournaments.

UNI is 2-0 all-time against No. 1-ranked opponents. UNI secured a 71-67 win over North Carolina in the McLeod Center on Nov. 21. 2015. The Panthers also recorded a 69-67 win over No. 1 Kansas in the 2010 NCAA Tournament.

UNI has posted a mark of 3-2 in its last five matchups against topfive ranked foes.

### **HEAD COACH BEN JACOBSON**

11th Year at UNI Overall Record: 225-124

UNI head coach Ben Jacobson personifies class and dignity on and off the floor as the leader of the Panther men's basketball team



Jacobson, 46, is the UNI men's basketball program's all-time wins leader with 225 victories in 11 seasons. He has guided the Panthers to four NCAA Tournament appearances and four NCAA victories. He is also a three-time MVC Coach of the Year award recipient.

Jacobson has guided the Panthers to postseason play in seven of his 10 seasons as head coach, including four trips to the NCAA Tournament (2009, 2010, 2015 and 2016). UNI reached the Sweet 16 in 2010 following wins over UNLV and No. 1-ranked Kansas. UNI has recorded at least one victory in each of its last three NCAA Tournament appearances.

In 2015-16, Jacobson led the Panthers to a 23-13 overall record and the program's eighth NCAA Tournament appearance. UNI earned a spot in the 2016 NCAA Tournament by capturing the MVC Tournament title.

UNI then scored a 75-72 victory over Texas in the first round of the 2016 NCAA Tournament on a half-court buzzer-beater by senior Paul Jesperson.

The season also featured wins over No. 1 North Carolina, No. 5 Iowa State and No. 25 Wichita State.

A native of Mayville, N.D., Jacobson graduated from Mayville-Portland High School in 1989 as valedictorian. He received his bachelor's degree in physical education from the University of North Dakota in 1994.

Jacobson and his wife, Dawn, have two children, Hunter (13) and Tanner (11).

# RECORD-BREAKING NIGHT FROM BEHIND THE ARC

UNI put together a record-breaking night from behind the three-point arc by making 20 three-pointers in its 86-58 win over South Dakota State (12/7).

UNI set its school record and the McLeod Center mark for 3-point field goals made with 20. The previous mark of 17 was set Jan. 29, 2014, in a 95-81 win over Evansville.

UNI tied the Missouri Valley Conference record for 3-pointers made with Creighton (vs. Chattanooga - 2/19/05) and Bradley (vs. Florida A&M - 11/21/06).

The 20 three-pointers made is the third-highest single-game total in all of NCAA Division I basketball this season.

The Panthers also set a school record for most three-point attempts (37 - previous mark was 35 set vs. BYU on Dec. 25, 2015).

UNI's 37 three-point attempts is the 12th-most in MVC history in a single game.

### LOW PERCENTAGE VS. MASON

UNI shot its lowest field goal percentage game at 25.9 percent in the 11-year history of the McLeod Center vs. George Mason (11/30).

The previous low came when the Panthers shot 27.1 percent vs. Loyola in a 51-41 loss to the Ramblers on Jan. 16, 2016.

It was UNI's lowest shooting percentage in 147 games. The last time UNI shot a worse percentage came when the Panthers shot 25.5 percent against the Illinois State Redbirds in the quarterfinals of 2012 MVC Tournament (March 2, 2012).

Morgan scored 57 points (19.0 ppg), grabbed 30 rebounds (10.0 rpg), handed out 12 assists (4.0 apg), notched 12 steals (4.0 spg) and blocked eight shots (2.67 bpg), while shooting 10-of-24 from three-point range.

Morgan posted a double-double with 20 points and 12 rebounds in an 82-63 win over Arizona State. Morgan was 4-of-6 from 3-point range and handed out four assists vs. the Sun Devils.

Morgan keyed an 18-point second-half comeback against Oklahoma by scoring 17 points, grabbing seven rebounds, handing out four assists, notching seven steals and blocking four shots against the Sooners.

The Panthers were paced four four double-digit scorers in Jeremy Morgan, Juwan McCloud, Spencer Haldeman and Wyatt Lohaus. Each tallied 10 points in the victory. Bennett Koch secured a team-best nine rebounds and scored eight points.

### UNI MBB IN APR TOP-10 PERCENT

The UNI men's basketball, men's golf, women's golf, women's cross country and women's volleyball teams have been recognized by the NCAA for their latest multi-year Academic Progress Rate (APR) scores. These teams posted multi-year APR scores in the top 10 percent of all squads in their respective sports.

The UNI men's basketball team has been recognized with a perfect APR score (1,000) in each of the last four seasons - the only MVC school to do that in each of the past three years.

The APR provides a real-time look at a team's academic success each semester by tracking the academic progress of each student-ath-

lete on scholarship. The APR accounts for eligibility, retention and graduation and provides a measure of each team's academic performance.

### **UNI SIGNS PHYFE TO NLI**

UNI head men's basketball coach Ben Jacobson announced the signing of Austin Phyfe (Waverly, Iowa/ Waverly-Shell Rock HS) to a National Letter-of-Intent to play for the Panthers beginning in 2017-18.

Phyfe (6'9", 235 lbs., Forward) is the No. 2 recruit in the state of lowa, according to lowaPreps.com. He earned second-team all-state honors from the Iowa Newspaper Association as a junior for head coach Nate Stegge. Phyfe notched third-team all-state accolades as a sophomore. Phyfe is a three-time all-Northeast Iowa Conference pick, including a pair of first-team honors the past two seasons. Phyfe averaged 14.5 points, grabbed 8.4 rebounds and shot 64 percent from the field in leading Waverly-Shell Rock to an 18-6 record in 2015-16. Phyfe scored 13.7 points and grabbed 7.9 rebounds as a sophomore in helping the GoHawks to a 22-3 record and a berth into the state tournament. As a freshman, he helped the GoHawks the state tournament and into the semifinals. Phyfe played AAU for the Iowa Barnstormers.

He is the son of Steve and Lisa Phyfe. His father, Steve, played basketball for the Panthers from 1987-1990. His sister, Aftin, is a member of the UNI swimming and diving team.

# UNI TO PLAY IN 2017 BATTLE 4 ATLANTIS

Celebrating its seventh year of elite collegiate tournament play, the 2017 Battle 4 Atlantis will include Villanova, Arizona, Purdue, North Carolina State, Tennessee, Southern Methodist, Western Kentucky and UNI.

The 2017 early season tournament field boasts a combined 16 Final Four appearances and five National Championships between the field. The annual Battle 4 Atlantis once again falls during the Thanksgiving holiday, scheduled to

take place November 22-24, 2017. The 12-game, three-day tournament is regarded as one of the most challenging early-season tournaments.

It will mark UNI's second appearance in the Battle 4 Atlantis. UNI also took part in the tournament in the 2012 Battle 4 Atlantis as the Panthers played Louisville, Stanford and Memphis.
