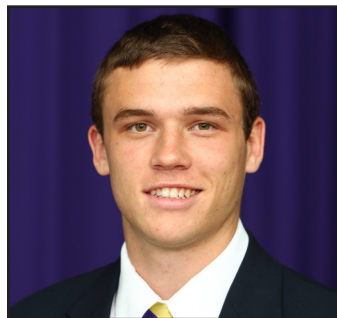

UNI RETURNS TO MCLEOD LOOKING TO SLOW DOWN REDBIRDS

UNI (16-12, 8-7 MVC) will play host to the Illinois State Redbirds (17-11, 11-4 MVC). Tip is set for 3 p.m. Saturday in the McLeod Center.

UNI-ILLINOIS STATE ON CBS SPORTS NETWORK

Brent Stover (play-by-play) and Bob Wetzell (analyst) will call the action for the CBS Sports Network broadcast.

SCOUTING ILLINOIS STATE

The Redbirds are the hottest team in the MVC as they ride into Cedar Falls with a five-game win streak. The Redbirds have also won eight of their last nine games overall.

Illinois State is 5-6 in road games this season but the Redbirds have produced a 4-3 road mark in league action.

Illinois State is led in scoring by DeVaughn Akoon-Purcell (14.5 ppg), MiKyle McIntosh (11.3 ppg), Paris Lee (10.8 ppg) and Deontae Hawkins (10.4 ppg).

ALL-TIME SERIES VS. REDBIRDS

Illinois State leads the all-time series, 39-32.

Illinois State won the earlier meeting this season at Redbird Arena, 76-67.

The Redbirds have lost 11 consecutive games in Cedar Falls, including all nine of their games in the McLeod Center.

Head coach Ben Jacobson is 16-8 vs. Illinois State.

DARK HORSE DUNKERS

Saturday's game will feature a pair of players in the Dark Horse Dunker competition. The winner of the event will take part in the dunk contest at this year's Final Four.

UNI's Wes Washpun moved into the quarterfinals with a 51.4-48.6 percent vote win over Bethune Cookman's Mario Moody.

Illinois State's DeVaughn Akoon-Purcell registered a 54.3-45.7 percent win over Oral Roberts' Brandon Conley.

UNI head coach Ben Jacobson has taken full advantage of the four schools representing the state of Illinois in the Missouri Valley Conference in his 10 seasons as UNI's head coach.

His 20 wins over Bradley are the most vs. any Valley opponent he has faced.

He has an overall mark of 56-24 vs. Southern Illinois, Illinois State, Bradley and Loyola.

Jacobson is 32-2 all-time in the McLeod Center against Southern Illinois (10-0), Illinois State (9-0), Bradley (10-1) and Loyola (3-1).

MAKING HAY AT THE LINE

UNI is shooting an MVC-best 75.2 percent (76.4 percent in MVC play) as a team at the free throw line.

Seven of UNI's eight players, that have played in every game, are shooting 70.0 percent or higher this season. In fact, UNI has four players shooting 80.0 percent or better at the free throw line.

UNI's single-season team record for free throw percentage is 76.9 percent set in the 1986-87 season under head coach Eldon Miller.

WINNING WAYS AT MCLEOD

The McLeod Center will celebrate its 10th anniversary this season and the Panthers have made winning a priority in their home venue.

UNI has posted an all-time mark of 122-31 (.797) in games played in the McLeod Center. UNI is 67-21 in MVC games in the McLeod Center.

UNI secured a school-record 16 home wins in the 2012-13 season. The previous mark of 15 home wins was set in the 1989-90 season.

UNI has posted a trio of perfect home seasons since moving to NCAA Division I. UNI was a perfect 14-0 in both the 1983-84 and 2009-10 seasons and then UNI notched a 15-0 mark at home last season.

UNI set its home-court win streak of 21 consecutive victories between the 2008-09 and 2010-11 seasons.

The McLeod Center opened in November 2006.

HEAD COACH BEN JACOBSON

10th Year at UNI

UNI head coach Ben Jacobson is in his 10th season at the helm of the Panther men's basketball program and is the program's all-time wins leader with 213.

In his tenure at UNI, Jacobson has posted an overall record of 213-117 (.645 winning percentage). Jacobson has averaged 21.9 wins per season at UNI.

Jacobson guided UNI to a 31-4 record in the 2014-15 season, which included a school-record 16-game winning streak, an MVC Tournament title and the school's first-ever top-10 national ranking. UNI finished the season ranked No. 14 in the final Coaches Top 25 poll. The 2014-15 season also saw UNI's Seth Tuttle earned consensus second-team All-America honors.

For the third time in nine seasons, Jacobson was awarded the Missouri Valley Conference's Coach of the Year Award.

Jacobson has guided the Panthers to postseason play in six of his nine seasons as head coach, including three trips to the NCAA Tournament (2009, 2010 and 2015). UNI reached the Sweet 16 in 2010 following wins over UNLV and No. 1-ranked Kansas. The Panthers scored a 71-54 win over Wyoming in the 2015 NCAA Tournament to secure the program's fourth all-time tournament victory.

A native of Mayville, N.D., Jacobson graduated from Mayville-Portland High School in 1989 as valedictorian. He received his bachelor's degree in physical education from the University of North Dakota in 1994.

Following 2014-15, Jacobson signed a 10-year deal through 2024-25.

Jacobson and his wife, Dawn, have two children, Hunter (12) and Tanner (10).

BOHANNON REACHES 1,000 PTS

Senior guard Matt Bohannon became the 39th UNI Panther to score 1,000 points when he surpassed the 1K mark vs. Missouri State (Feb. 10).

Bohannon is the 14th Panther to join the 1,000-point club since the start of the 2001-02 season - the first season that Ben Jacobson joined the coaching staff as an assistant. Jacobson took over the head job in the 2006-07 season.

TAKING DOWN RANKED FOES ON THE ROAD

UNI secured the program's second road victory over a ranked opponent Saturday in its 53-50 win at No. 25-ranked Wichita State.

UNI's previous road victory over a ranked foe came Dec. 30, 2006, at Koch Arena. Under first-year head coach Ben Jacobson, the Panthers scored a 63-59 win over No. 16-ranked Wichita State in Koch Arena.

UNI is 4-3 all-time vs. Wichita State when the Shockers are ranked in the AP Top 25.

PERFECT VS AP RANKED FOES

UNI is 3-0 against foes ranked in the AP Top 25 this season with victories over No. 1 North Carolina (71-67), No. 5 Iowa State (81-79) and No. 25 Wichita State (53-50).

UNI picked up its third top-25 win of the season by halting Wichita State's 43-game homecourt win streak Saturday.

The Panthers are one of just 24 teams in the nation with 3+ wins against the AP Top 25. Virginia (4-0); Oregon (3-0) and UNI (3-0) are the only teams with 3+ wins against top-25 foes to have a perfect mark.

BENCH WAS BIG

UNI won the bench scoring battle Saturday at No. 25 Wichita State, 23-15.

It marked the highest point total for the UNI bench since a 23-point outburst at Richmond (Dec. 5). Against the Shockers,

UNI's Clint Carlson (12 points) and Wyatt Lohaus (11 points) each tallied double-figure scoring games. Carlson was 5-of-8 from the field with five rebounds, while Lohaus was 5-of-7 shooting with five rebounds and four assists.

DEFENSIVE LOCKDOWN

UNI limited Wichita State to six points in the final 11:30 of Saturday's 53-50 win at Koch Arena.

The Shockers had completed a 17-2 run to tie the game at 44-44 on a layup by Markis McDuffie. Following that bucket, the Panthers limited the Shockers to a three-pointer by Zach Brown with 3:50 left, a dunk by Shaquille Morris with 1:29 left and a free throw by Morris with :40.2 seconds remaining.

Wichita State finished the game by making only two of its final 17 shots from the field.

SINCE CHARLES KOCH ARENA'S RENOVATION

UNI has recorded the most wins (6) by any opponent in Charles Koch Arena in Wichita, Kan., since the arena's renovation in 2003.

UNI is 6-7, while Southern Illinois is 5-8 in Koch Arena since 2003. Creighton has a 3-7 mark in Koch Arena in the same time frame.

No other opponent has more than two victories since the renovation.

MORGAN SETS A CAREER-HIGH WITH 21 VS MISSOURI STATE

UNI junior guard Jeremy Morgan set a career-high with 21 points in an 83-69 win over Missouri State (2/10).

Morgan drained 6-of-9 field goals, 3-of-5 three-pointers and 6-of-6 free throws against the Bears.

He added a team-best eight rebounds and five assists vs. MSU.

It was Morgan's second 20-point plus performance this season after a 20-point contest vs. Colorado State in the season opener.

UNI also drained a season-high 34 field goals in the Knapp Center.

UNI's previous two season-highs came when the Panthers made 33 field goals and shot 61.1 percent in a 97-51 win at North Dakota (Nov. 28).

The 34 made field goals are the most by a Panther squad since they made 40 vs. Wartburg (Nov. 10, 2012).

PLENTY OF DISHING

UNI tied a season high with 20 assists in its 82-66 win at Drake (2/6). UNI's Jeremy Morgan and Wes

Washpun tied for team-high honors with six assists each in the victory.

JESPERSON NETS THIRD 20-POINT GAME THIS SEASON

UNI senior guard Paul Jespersen recorded his third 20-plus point scoring game of the season with a team-high 21 points in an 82-66 road win over Drake.

Jespersen has scored 28 vs. Bradley, 21 vs. Iowa State and 21 vs. Drake. All three games came away from the McLeod Center.

FINAL 30 SECONDS OF MAGIC

UNI outscored Evansville, 4-0, in the final 30 seconds of Wednesday's game to pull out a 57-54 victory over the Purple Aces.

Wes Washpun hit a layup with 27 seconds left to lift UNI to a 55-54 lead. Jeremy Morgan blocked a shot and made a pair of free throws with 1.3 seconds left to ice the victory.

It marks the first time UNI has trailed in the final minute this season and rallied for a victory. The last time UNI trailed with under a minute to go and won the game came last year at Illinois State (1/25/15). UNI trailed 53-51 with :26 left before Nate Buss nailed a three-pointer with :05.2 left for the game winner, 54-53.

SHUT DOWN DEFENSE VS UE

UNI had led for nearly 30 minutes in the game, but Evansville rallied from an eight-point halftime deficit to lead 44-40 with 11:37 left in the second half.

UNI held Evansville without a field goal from the 11:37 mark to the 4:41 mark of the second half.

The Panthers limited the Purple Aces to only two made field goals in the final 11:36 of the game.

The Panthers also limited the league's top scorer D.J. Balentine to a season-low nine points. It marked the first time this season that Balentine had failed to reach double figures - ending a streak of 30 consecutive games dating back to the 2014-15 season.

It was also the first time Balentine did not attempt a free throw this season.

UNI CONTINUES ITS HOME STREAK VS. SIU

UNI won its 13th consecutive game against Southern Illinois staged in Cedar Falls.

UNI is a perfect 10-0 in the McLeod Center against the Salukis, who have not surpassed the 60-point mark in its last eight McLeod Center appearances.

SIU lost its final three games in the UNI-Dome prior to the Panthers moving into the McLeod Center in the 2006-07 season.

SIU is averaging only 52.8 points per game in its 10 McLeod Center appearances.

In its 13 straight losses to UNI in Cedar Falls, SIU is averaging 54.3 points per game with a high of 65 in a 71-65 overtime loss in 2005-06 in the UNI-Dome.

ANOTHER COMEBACK WIN

For the second time this season, UNI overcame a double-digit deficit to come back and score a victory.

UNI trailed North Carolina by 16 points at 50-34 with 17:10 left in the game. UNI used a 22-4 run to take a 56-54 lead with 9:17 left in the game. The Panthers would take down the Tar Heels, 71-67.

The Panthers trailed the SIU Salukis Sunday by 11 points at 23-12 with 6:27 left in the first half. UNI would use a 15-2 run to take a 27-25 lead with 1:18 left in the first half. UNI eventually scored a 67-58 victory over SIU.

SEASON HIGH IN BLOCKS

UNI recorded a season-high six blocks in its 67-58 win over Southern Illinois (1/31).

It marks the second straight game that UNI has set a season-high in blocks. The Panthers also blocked five shots in their 68-50 win at Bradley (1/27).

HIGHS AND LOWS FROM 3

Just four days after setting its season with by making 15 three-pointers at Bradley, UNI came back with a season-low three three-pointers in a victory at home over Southern Illinois on Sunday.

ONLY THREE TRIPLES?

UNI saw its streak of 39 consecutive games with at least four three-pointers made snapped when the Panthers made only a trio of three-pointers against Southern Illinois.

The last time UNI made less than four three-pointers came Jan. 18, 2015, in the McLeod Center when the Panthers made three three-pointers in a 60-46 victory over Missouri State.

30 TRIPS TO THE FOUL LINE

UNI collected a season-high 30 free throw attempts against SIU.

It is the most free throws attempted by the Panthers since they shot 34 last year against George Mason (12/6/2014) in the McLeod Center.

KOCH NOTCHES FIRST CAREER DOUBLE-DOUBLE

Sophomore center Bennett Koch recorded his first career double-double with a trifecta of career-highs in points (22), rebounds (11) and blocks (3) in a 67-58 win over Southern Illinois (1/31).

Koch drained 8-of-9 field goals against the Salukis - including a perfect 6-of-6 in the second half. Koch is averaging 11.1 points per game in Missouri Valley Conference play.

The award is named in honor of Lou Henson who coached 41 years. When he left the game in 2005 he was sixth all-time in career Division I wins with 779. He is the winningest coach at both Illinois and New Mexico State. He is one of only 12 coaches in the history of the game to take two schools to the Final Four.

The recipient of the 2016 award will be announced at the CollegeInsider.com Award Presentation on April 1 in Houston, site of the men's division I national championship.

WES IS MORE

Senior guard Wes Washpun recorded his fourth 20-plus point scoring game of the season with a game-high 23 points against the Illinois State Redbirds (1/23). Washpun has five career 20-plus point scoring games.

UNI shot a season-low 27.1 percent from the field in its 51-41 loss to Loyola (1/16). UNI had shot 40.0 percent or better in its previous 18 games this season.

It was UNI's lowest shooting percentage in 123 games. The last time UNI shot a worse percentage came when the Panthers shot 25.5 percent against the Illinois State Redbirds in the quarterfinals of 2012 MVC Tournament (March 2, 2012).

UNI's 27.1 percent shooting vs. Loyola was the lowest field goal percentage shooting game for the Panthers in the 10-year history of the McLeod Center. The previous low came when the Panthers shot 27.5 percent against SMU in the quarterfinals of the 2011 Collegelnsider.com Tournament (3/21/2011).

Bohannon drained five three-pointers and led the Panthers with 21 points in the 77-44 win over Drake (1/9).

Earlier this season, Bohannon sank seven three-pointers and scored 21 points vs. BYU (12/25).

THE UNDER 50 CLUB

When the Panthers held the Drake Bulldogs to 44 points in UNI's 77-44 win Jan. 9, it marked the 42nd time in the Ben Jacobson head coaching era that the Panthers had held a team under 50 points. UNI is 41-1 in those contests.

For the second time this season, UNI senior guard Wes Washpun has been named the Missouri Valley Conference's Player of the Week (Dec. 21).

Washpun was also named the CollegeSportsMadness.com National High-Major Player of the week.

Washpun collected career-highs in points (28) and assists (11) in leading UNI to an 81-79 win over No. 5-ranked Iowa State at the Big Four Classic in Des Moines. Washpun drained all six of his first-half shots and led the Panthers with 17 first-half points. Washpun finished

the game shooting 9-of-14 from the field, 8-of-10 at the line and 2-of-4 from three-point land. Washpun also led the Panthers with seven rebounds against the Cyclones.

DISHING IN DOUBLE FIGURES

Senior guard Wes Washpun handed out a career-high 11 assists in UNI's 81-79 win over Iowa State (Dec. 19).

It marked the most assists by a Panther since Brooks McKowen also dished out 11 assists in a 99-82 win over Iowa State (Dec. 1, 2004).

MULTIPLE WINS OVER RANKED FOES IN NON-CONFERENCE PLAY

For the second time in school history, UNI has posted two wins over ranked foes in the non-conference portion of its season. UNI scored a 71-67 win over No. 1 North Carolina (Nov. 21) and the Panthers added an 81-79 triumph over No. 5 Iowa State (Dec. 19).

UNI defeated No. 12 Iowa (12/6/05), 67-63 in overtime and then posted a victory over No. 24 Bucknell (2/18/06) in double overtime, 65-61.

MVC WINS OVER TOP-5 FOES

An MVC team has beaten two top-5 (AP poll) non-conference teams in the same season just 5 times in its 109-year history.

Counting UNI's two wins this year No. 1 North Carolina and No. 5 Iowa State the league has 30 wins all-time against non-conference top-5 teams.

The Panthers are the first MVC team to win two such regular-season games in the span of a month, having beaten UNC on Nov. 21.

The last MVC team to beat two Top-5 non-conference teams in the same season (AP poll) was Wichita State in 1965-66, and in the five times it has happened, only three times have both games been during the regular season.

AUSTIN GRANTED RELEASE

Junior guard Aarias Austin has asked for and been granted his release from the University of Northern Iowa men's basketball team according to UNI head coach Ben Jacobson on Dec. 14.

"We appreciate Aarias's contributions to our men's basketball program," Jacobson said. "We also understand his desire for an opportunity to have a different and larger role at another program. We wish Aarias all the best going forward."

Austin saw action in all nine games this season for the Panthers. Austin joined the Panthers after playing the previous two seasons at Des Moines Area Community College.

TWO 30-WIN SEASONS IN THE LAST SIX YEARS

UNI is one of 14 schools to have won 30 or more games twice in the last six seasons, joining Duke (4 times), Kansas (4), Kentucky (3), Louisville (3), Syracuse (3), Wichita State (3), BYU (2), Gonzaga (2), Murray State (2), Ohio State (2), San Diego State (2), Virginia (2) and Wisconsin (2).

7TH-LARGEST VICTORY IN SCHOOL HISTORY

UNI's 97-51 win at North Dakota resulted in a 46-point margin of victory - the seventh-largest margin of victory in school history.

It was UNI's largest margin of victory since a 53-point win over Wartburg (Nov. 12, 2012).

WASHPUN GOES BACK-TO-BACK WITH 20-POINT SCORING GAMES

Senior guard Wes Washpun has recorded back-to-back 20-point scoring games for the first time in his collegiate career.

Washpun tallied 21 points in UNI's 71-67 win over No. 1 North Carolina. Washpun followed that up with 22 points in an 83-63 victory over Dubuque on Nov. 25.

WASHPUN NAMED MVC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Senior guard Wes Washpun has been recognized by the Missouri

Valley Conference as its men's basketball player of the week (Nov. 23) for his play in a pair of Panther victories.

Washpun averaged 17.5 points, 5.5 assists, 4.0 rebounds and shot 63.6 percent from the field in leading UNI to wins over Stephen F. Austin and No. 1-ranked North Carolina.

Washpun began the week with a 14-point, five-rebound, three-assist effort in a 70-60 win over Stephen F. Austin. Washpun made 5-of-7 field goals against the Lumberjacks.

Washpun dropped in 21 points and handed out eight assists in a 71-67 triumph over No. 1 North Carolina. Washpun drained a 57-foot shot at the first-half buzzer. He then added 12 points and five assists in the second half to lead UNI back from a 16-point deficit. Washpun made 9-of-15 shots from the field, grabbed three rebounds and notched two steals vs. the Tar Heels.

It is the first MVC player of the week award in Washpun's collegiate career.

The University of Northern Iowa men's basketball, men's golf, women's golf, women's cross country and women's volleyball teams have been recognized by the NCAA for

their latest multi-year Academic Progress Rate (APR) scores. These teams posted multi-year APR scores in the top 10 percent of all squads in their respective sports.

The UNI men's basketball team has been recognized with a perfect APR score (1,000) in each of the last three seasons - the only MVC school to do that in each of the past three years.

The APR provides a real-time look at a team's academic success each semester by tracking the academic progress of each student-athlete on scholarship. The APR accounts for eligibility, retention and graduation and provides a measure of each team's academic performance.

Brown (Flower Mound, Texas/Flower Mound HS) is a 6'5", 170-pound, guard from Flower Mound, Texas. Brown averaged 14 points, 4.0 rebounds, 4.0 assists and 2.0 steals as a junior at Flower Mound High School for head coach Eric Littleton. Flower Mound finished third in their district in 2014-15. McCloud played AAU with the Wisconsin Swing coached by Justin Litscher. He is the son of Brian and Mellisa McCloud. He has an older brother, Jalen.
