NEED TO KNOW

- UNI (3-3, 2-1 MVFC) looks to carry momentum from Saturday's upset win over No. 7 SDSU, as the Panthers host No. 9 Youngstown State (3-3, 1-2 MVFC) Saturday at 1 p.m. CT.
- YSU has not won at the UNI-Dome since 1999.
- Head coach Mark Farley is 12-2 all-time against the Penguins.
- Last time out, UNI defeated No. 7 SDSU on the road in dominating fashion, 38-18.
- The Panthers were led by Marcus Weymiller's 170 yards on the ground and two scores.
- With the performance, Weymiller became the first UNI running back since David Johnson to earn two games with at least 170 yards rushing for his career.
- The 42 carries against the Jackrabbits ranks as the most by any player in the FCS this season. Before last Saturday's game, Weymiller had not carried the ball since Nov. 19, 2016 against SDSU.

LAST TIME AGAINST THE PENGUINS

- Youngstown State defeated UNI in the last meeting, with the Penguins taking a 14-10 decision.
- The Penguins marched back from a 10-0 deficit to beat the Panthers, after No. 12 YSU scored 14 points in the fourth quarter.
- YSU scored the go-ahead score with 28 seconds left, after Martin Ruiz earned a one-yard touchdown.

SERIES WITH YOUNGSTOWN STATE

- Saturday will be the 29th meeting between UNI and YSU. Last season's game was the first between the two squads since 2013. YSU has visited the UNI-Dome 15 total times, with the first meeting being in 1978.
- The Panthers owned an 11-game winning streak over the Penguins from 2001-2011 before YSU broke the streak in 2012.

SCOUTING THE PENGUINS

- Youngstown State enters Saturday with a 3-3 record, after dropping a tough decision to North Dakota State in overtime last time out.
- The Penguins have lost to Pittsburgh (28-21), South Dakota (31-28) and most recently to the Bison (27-24).
- YSU has wins over Robert Morris (30-0), Central Connecticut State (59-9) and South Dakota State (19-7).

UNI AGAINST THE MVFC

- The Panthers are 155-61 against the Missouri Valley Football Conference, with UNI going 84-39 during the Farley era.

NO OCTOBER SURPRISE FOR FARLEY

- Over his 17 seasons at UNI, head coach Mark Farley has amassed a 42-28 record for the month of October since 2001.
- Farley has gone undefeated during October three times (2003, 2007, 2008) while going winless only once during the month (2013).
- This season, the Panthers are currently 1-1 during October after splitting games against Western Illinois and South Dakota State.

CLUTCH CATS

- This season, the Panthers have been extremely efficient in the red zone with UNI scoring on 18 out of 20 attempts. UNI ranks 13th currently in the FCS for red zone offense.
- UNI has earned the majority of its red zone scores through the air, with 12 passing TDs inside the 20. That total is tied for second in the FCS.

CAGED PENGUINS

- UNI has only lost twice to Youngstown State since 2001. The Panthers are 12-2 against the Penguins over that stretch, with the two losses each coming on the road.
- Overall, UNI has built a 21-8 record against YSU and has not lost to the Penguins at home since 1999.

PANTHER DEFENSE VERSUS THE RUN

- Last season, the UNI defense held opponents to 119.7 yards per game to rank 16th in the FCS.
- The Panthers rank 67th in the country this season, allowing 156.7 yards on the ground per game.
- This season, Youngstown State's rushing attack has gained 248.5 yards per game, to rank ninth in the nation.

PANTHERS AGAINST THE PASS

- The Panther defense has allowed a total of 268.0 yards passing per game this season, to rank 104th overall in the FCS.
- UNI has given up 14 passing touchdowns this season, with four coming against Cal Poly.
- This week's opponent - Youngstown State - has gained 186.0 yards through the air per game this season. That total is 82nd overall in the FCS.

WEYMILLER'S COMEBACK

- Before last Saturday's game, Marcus Weymiller had not carried the ball since Nov. 19, 2016 against South Dakota State. Against the Jackrabbits in 2017, Weymiller had 42 rushes, 170 yards and two touchdowns.
- The 42 carries rank as the most by any FCS player this season.
- The 170-yard total was just one yard shy of Weymiller's career-high 171 set last season against Indiana State on Nov. 5, 2016.
- Weymiller is the first Panther back since David Johnson to earn at least two 170-yard rushing performances for his career.

FOUNTAIN ON A MISSION

- Senior Daurice Fountain has put up monster numbers in his final season at UNI. The 6-foot-1 receiver has hauled in five touchdowns this season, with 526 yards receiving.
- This season, Fountain has earned three 100-yard receiving games (all in consecutive weeks).
- The senior has 120 catches as a Panther and 16 total touchdowns during his stellar UNI career.

FARLEY IS A TACKLING MACHINE

- This season, senior Jared Farley has racked up the tackles as the linebacker averages 11.2 total stops per game.
- The total for Farley is tied for ninth in the FCS and second in the MVFC.
- Western Illinois' Brett Taylor holds first place in the country, with 14.5 tackles per game this season.

NISSSEN'S STELLAR SEASON

- The last three games for Elias Nissen have been nothing short of amazing, with the junior tight end hauling in four touchdowns and 109 yards.
- The junior had zero TDs for his career before catching one against SIU, and his three against WIU rank as the most for any Panther tight end in a single game.
- The four touchdowns in a season for Nissen are the most by any Panther tight end since Schuyler Dordt caught five in 2009.

MULTI-TOUCHDOWN GAMES FOR DUNNE

- Junior signal caller Eli Dunne threw two scores in last Saturday's win, to record his latest multi-touchdown game.
- Dunne has earned eight multi-touchdown games for his career, with five coming in 2017.
- The junior threw a pair of touchdowns against Missouri State, North Dakota State and Western Illinois in 2016, while throwing three in 2017's season opener against Iowa State, four against Cal Poly, three against SIU, four against WIU and two against SDSU.

FARLEY NAMED CAMPBELL SEMIFINALIST

- Senior linebacker Jared Farley was named a semifinalist for the 2017 William V. Campbell Trophy late September, which recognizes an individual as the absolute best football scholar-athlete in the nation.
- Farley is one of 181 semifinalists the National Football Foundation & College Hall of Fame (NFF) has chosen for the award. The Cedar Falls native is also one of 36 representing the FCS and one of seven from the MVFC.
- The senior is the ninth Panther to be named a semifinalist for this "academic Heisman", joining James Lindgren (2006), Chad Rinehart (2007), Josh Mahoney (2009), Ben Boothby (2011), Kyle Bernard (2012), David Johnson (2012), Isaac Ales (2015) and Karter Schult (2016).

FARLEY CLAIMS MVFC DEFENSIVE POW HONORS

- After a stellar game against Cal Poly, senior linebacker Jared Farley earned MVFC Defensive Player of the Week honors.
- With the game tied at 7-7, Farley scooped up a fumble and took it 48 yards to put the Panthers ahead. The return was Farley's first of his career, while the fumble recovery was his fifth at UNI.
- Farley finished the game posting 11 total tackles, with four solos and seven assists as well as one tackle for a loss.
- Farley has won Defensive POW honors twice as a Panther. The last time came after his sensational game against Iowa State during last season's 25-20 victory.

FOUR EARN CAREER FIRST STARTS FOR PANTHERS

- UNI's season opener against Iowa State was a momentous one for four Panthers, as Spencer Brown, Nikholi Jaghai, Isaiah Nimmers and Seth Thomas all earned their first collegiate starts on the field.
- Sophomores Jaghai and Thomas saw playing time last season, but did not receive starts on the defensive side of the ball.
- For redshirt freshmen Brown and Nimmers, the season opener against the Cyclones was their first debut as Panthers.

NEWBIES MAKE A SPLASH IN SEASON OPENER

- UNI had its fair share of newcomers making a significant impact in the season opener against Iowa State, with two redshirt freshmen starting and 11 seeing playing time against the Cyclones.
- Redshirt freshman Isaiah Weston made the biggest splash for Panther newcomers, as the 6-8, 207-pound wideout caught four passes for 72 yards and a touchdown.
- Fellow redshirt freshman Alfonzo Lambert II turned in a stellar performance at linebacker, making 10 tackles to rank second behind senior Jared Farley's 14 against the Cyclones.

UNI DROPS OUT OF RANKINGS

- Following the home loss to Western Illinois, UNI fell out of the FCS Coaches Poll Top 25 for the first time this season. The Panthers were receiving votes however, with 49 this week.
- The Panthers have defeated one team from this week's rankings, No. 13 South Dakota State (No. 7 SDSU on Oct. 9).

PANTHERS AGAINST RANKED FOES

- UNI has 82 wins over Top-25 opponents all-time and 21 over Top-10 foes.
- In 2016, the Panthers were 1-5 against ranked teams. Four of the five ranked losses (No. 14 Montana, No. 8 Eastern Washington, No. 11 Youngstown State, No. 4 North Dakota State) were decided by an average 4.5-point margin.
- This season, the Panthers are 1-1 after splitting games against No. 18 Western Illinois and No. 7 South Dakota State.

TEAM CAPTAINS NAMED FOR 2017

- Linebacker Jared Farley, wide receiver Daurice Fountain, defensive lineman Adam Reth and defensive lineman Preston Woods were named as the 2017 team captains by head coach Mark Farley before the start of the season.
- All four players are seniors.

JERSEY SWAP FOR CAMPBELL

- Junior defensive back Elijah Campbell turned in his #19 jersey for #1 this season with the Panthers.
- This isn't the first time Campbell has made a number change in college however, prior to joining UNI Campbell was #9 at Northern Illinois.

ROAD PANTHERS

- UNI will spend four of the first six games on the road this season with six total road games on the docket. Out of those five games, UNI will face one FBS opponent in Iowa State and five teams either ranked in the Top 25.

COACH FARLEY CONTINUES RECORD WIN TOTAL

- After defeating the Cyclones last season, head coach Mark Farley set the program record for career wins at UNI. The win over Iowa State gave Farley 130 for his career at UNI, before finishing the season at 134.
- In addition to being UNI's all-time winningest coach, Farley also holds the most league wins in MVFC history after earning an impressive 83-38 mark over his storied coaching career.

TOP OF THE LEAGUE

- UNI has had 47 student-athletes named to the MVFC All-Conference First Team since 2007, the most in the league. Last season, Karter Schultz continued the tradition after claiming First Team All-MVFC honors following his sensational final season with the Panthers.

PRESEASON ALL-MVFC

- UNI is represented by seven members on the 2017 Missouri Valley Football Conference's preseason squad. Senior defensive back Malcolm Washington and senior linebacker Jared Farley were each named to the first team heading into the 2017 season.
- The Panthers posted a league-high five members on the honorable mention preseason All-MVFC Team. Sophomore running back Trevor Allen, junior offensive lineman Cal Twait, senior defensive back Elijah Campbell, senior punter Sam Kuhter and sophomore return specialist Jalen Rima were all named as honorable mention selections to the preseason squad.

FARLEY NAMED TO PRESEASON TEAMS

- Senior linebacker Jared Farley earned a pair of prestigious honors ahead of the 2017 season as the Cedar Falls native was named to the STATS FCS Preseason All-America Second Team and the Preseason All-MVFC First Team. Farley was just one of 17 MVFC players selected to the STATS FCS All-America teams. In addition to the national honors, Farley was also named one of UNI's team captains.

UNI RANKED 18/20 IN PRESEASON POLLS

- The Panthers enter the season ranked No. 18 (STATS) and No. 20 (Coaches) respectively. Last season, UNI opened the year ranked No. 5 (STATS/Coaches).
- UNI has finished the year in the Top 25 in 12 of the last 16 seasons and has taken home a top-five ranking seven of the last 16 seasons.

RETURNING PANTHERS

- Not including special teams, the Panthers return 17 starters from last year's squad (eight on offense, nine on defense). Five of the eight returning offensive starters are skill position players, whereas four of the nine defensive returnees are on the defensive line. On special teams, the Panthers return five starters.

NEW TURF FOR 2017

- UNI will be playing on a new AstroTurf for the upcoming 2017 season. The surface will be made of PureGrass® with Armacell® pad. The surface measures over 77,000 square feet and will come in 26 rollable panels that are secured by a Velcro® system. The total cost of the new turf was \$900,000.

UNI head coach Mark Farley, once known as the "walk on from Waukon", has led the Panthers to a mark of 134-67 in his 16 years at the helm of the program.

Entering his 17th season as the head coach of the UNI Panthers, Farley is eager to lead a mixture of energized youth and veteran student-athletes to new heights in 2017.

In Missouri Valley Football Conference play, Farley has guided the Panthers to a record of 82-38 for an impressive .683 winning percentage in league play. Farley is the MVFC's all-time coaching wins leader with 82 league victories.

Included in that 16-year run for Farley and the Panthers are seven conference championships, nine playoff appearances, 12 top-25 final rankings, three national semifinal appearances and one national title game appearance in 2005. Farley holds the UNI record for postseason coaching victories with 13 with an overall playoff record of 13-9.

Through his leadership, the Panthers returned to the glory days when they won seven straight conference titles and made seven consecutive FCS playoff appearances in the decade of the '90s. In Farley's 16 years at the helm, UNI has won at least a share of seven Missouri Valley Football Conference titles. UNI has also advanced to the quarterfinals (2003, 2007, 2011, 2015), semifinals (2001, 2008) and the national title game (2005) in seven of those nine playoff appearances. Twelve of Farley's 16 previous Panther teams have finished the season rank in the top-25, defeating 80 top-25 ranked foes in the process.

The Panthers kicked off the 2016 season with a win over Iowa State, giving Farley 130 career victories, making him the all-time coaching wins leader at UNI. He passed former head coach Stan Sheriff, with whom he tied the record in 2015 with UNI's playoff win over No. 5 Portland State, giving him 129. Despite finishing the 2016 season 5-6 overall, UNI ended the season ranked in the top-35 in the FCS in 18 different statistical categories. UNI faced off against six top-25 ranked opponents throughout the year, beating #19 Western Illinois on the road and was one of just 10 FCS teams to beat an FBS opponent in 2016.

AMES, Iowa – Despite a hard-fought effort in front of a hostile crowd of 61,500, the Northern Iowa Panthers (0-1) fell to the Iowa State Cyclones (1-0) 42-24 to open the season on Saturday night in Ames.

UNI took an early 7-0 lead after scoring on the opening drive, but turnovers shifted the momentum to ISU as the Cyclones took a 21-10 lead into halftime. ISU would push the advantage to as much as 35-10, but the Panthers stormed back to outscore the Cyclones 14-7 over the last 16:36 of the game.

UNI finished the game with 378 yards of total offense, to ISU's 405. The Panthers and Cyclones were almost neck-and-neck in every other statically category with UNI rushing for 119 yards and throwing it for 259 yards.

Junior Eli Dunne finished Saturday's opener going 23-for-38 for 259 yards, while throwing three touchdowns and three interceptions. Sophomore Trevor Allen was the overall leading rusher in the game, going for 87 yards on the ground.

Three different receivers caught touchdown passes for the Panthers as Isaiah Weston (four catches, 72 yards), Jaylin James (three catches, 44 yards) and Aaron Graham (two catches, 24 yards) all had scores.

On the defensive side, Jared Farley was the leading tackler with 14 stops while Duncan Ferch finished the game with nine tackles and an interception.

CEDAR FALLS, Iowa – Propelled by career days from quarterback Eli Dunne and wide receiver Daurice Fountain, the 21st-ranked Northern Iowa Panthers (1-1) defeated Cal Poly (0-3) in a shootout, 45-38, to open the home slate on a high note.

Dunne and Fountain connected for three scores – including the game winner – as the Panthers earned their first overtime victory since 2011 (Nov. 19 at Illinois State).

Dunne finished the game going 25-for-40 with 325 yards passing and four touchdowns through the air. The four scores were the most for Dunne since tossing three last week against Iowa State.

Fountain capped his stellar game after catching five passes, for 75 yards and three touchdowns. The senior recorded his second game with three touchdown grabs, matching 2016's total against Southern Illinois.

UNI out gained Cal Poly through the air (325-238), but the Mustangs controlled the ground attack (305-94).

On the defensive side, linebacker Duncan Ferch finished with a career-high 15 total tackles to lead both teams on Saturday. Defensive end Adam Reth turned in a stellar performance as well, making 14 stops.

CEDAR CITY, Utah – Despite a valiant effort on the road, No. 18 Northern Iowa (1-2) fell to Southern Utah (2-1) in a tight contest, 24-21.

The game was tied, 21-21 until SUU made a 26-yard field goal with 1:50 remaining as the Thunderbirds hung on to win the game, 24-21.

The Thunderbirds jumped out to a 14-0 lead to begin action on Saturday, as SUU earned scores on the ground and through the air. SUU would control most of the first half, before Seth Thomas energized the UNI sideline after rumbling to the end zone for a 15-yard interception touchdown.

Trailing, 14-7 in the third quarter the Panther defense sparked UNI once again after Adam Reth's big hit resulted in a sack and strip. The Panthers would turn the fumble into points, following Austin Errthum's 42-yard field goal.

Inching closer and only trailing 14-10, SUU would swing momentum after James Felila scored his second touchdown of the night – this time a 20-yard score – with 4:35 remaining in the third quarter.

Trailing 21-10 late, the Panthers would mount a comeback as UNI scored 11-unanswered to tie the game at 21-21. UNI's Dunne would master a seven-play drive to get the Panthers in the end zone, following a 21-yard pass to Trevor Allen. A Jared Farley interception return inside Thunderbird territory would also lead to points as Errthum nailed a 30-yard field goal to knot the score at 21-21.

The Panthers would be in position again for more points following a turnover on downs, but a long, 53-yard field goal from Errthum was blocked and returned to the 17. The Panther defense would hold the Thunderbirds to three points, after a 26-yard field goal, but SUU would hold on to the lead this time for the 24-21 win.

With the victory, No. 20 UNI improved to 2-2 overall and 1-0 in the MVFC, while SIU dropped to 2-2 overall and 0-1 in the MVFC.

Eli Dunne led the Panthers in Carbondale, after throwing for 266 yards and three scores. Senior Daurice Fountain was Dunne's favorite target on the night, the 6-foot-1 receiver caught seven passes for 106 yards and a touchdown.

The Panther defense did their part as well after holding the Salukis below their season average for yards per game, while also forcing three key turnovers down the stretch. Senior Jared Farley led UNI with nine tackles.

SIU trimmed the UNI lead late in the third quarter after Sam Straub floated it to Darrell James for a 29-yard touchdown. The Panthers would again respond to a Saluki score with one of their own after Trevor Allen juke his way to the end zone following an 11-yard pass from Dunne.

A fumble near midfield by the Panthers in the fourth quarter gave SIU a golden opportunity, before the Salukis cashed in the turnover for seven points after Straub found Jacob Varble for a five-yard touchdown.

Three SIU scoring opportunities were halted by turnovers late in the fourth quarter after the Panthers earned a fumble and two interceptions. Korby Sander forced a fumble before Suni Lane picked up the grounder early in the fourth quarter for the first turnover. The two picks came after Jake Hartford snagged a tipped pass, while Malcolm Washington picked off a throw to put the final nail in the coffin with under a minute remaining.

WIU was led by Sean McGuire, who threw for 334 yards and three touchdowns. Jaelon Acklin was his favorite target on the night, catching seven passes for 158 yards and two scores.

UNI's Eli Dunne turned in another big passing day, throwing for 342 yards and four touchdowns. With the performance, Dunne is the first Panther quarterback to throw for at least 23 completions, 259 yards and a touchdown in each of his first five games to start a season.

Elias Nissen scored three times for the Panthers – to continue his hot streak at tight end – while Daurice Fountain caught a career-high nine passes for 103 yards.

On the defensive side, senior Jared Farley led the Panthers with a career-high 14 tackles while junior Rickey Neal recorded two key sacks to go along with his seven total tackles.

Trailing 14-5 in the third quarter, the Leathernecks turned a Panther interception into seven points after a Steve McShane's one-yard score. McGuire threw back-to-back touchdowns to give the Leathernecks a 25-14 lead late in the third quarter.

The fourth quarter would see a combined 35 points scored between the two teams, with the Panthers scoring twice to claw their way out of the 25-14 deficit and take a 25-22 lead. The two UNI scores would be on 18 and 16-yard passes from Dunne that found Nissen and Aaron Graham.

With only 1:12 remaining in the game, WIU would march down the field and earn a go-ahead score with six seconds left as McGuire and Acklin hooked up again – this time from 20 yards out. WIU's Michael Bishoff scooped up a Panther fumble on the ensuing kickoff, bringing the final score to 38-29 in favor of the Leathernecks.

The Panthers have knocked off a top-10 Jackrabbit team in two out of the last three seasons, with the last also coming in Brookings on Oct. 24, 2015 (10-7). The 20-point win against SDSU ranks as the largest margin of victory over a ranked foe since upsetting No. 1 North Dakota State (23-3) on Nov. 8, 2014.

UNI's Weymiller led the Panthers, with 170 yards rushing and two scores, while Eli Dunne threw two touchdowns through the air for 169 yards passing. The 170 yards for Weymiller were the most for the junior since gaining 171 against Indiana State on Nov. 5, 2016. Weymiller had not carried the ball this season before Saturday's game.

On the defensive side, the Panthers forced three turnovers with Elijah Campbell earning an early interception while Alfonso Lambert II and Joe Friedrich scooped up two fumbles for UNI.

Despite the cold weather, UNI came out of the gates on fire Saturday to earn an early 17-0 lead after one quarter of play. The Panthers began the scoring with a 41-yard field goal from Sam Drysdale, which was followed by a Christian Jegen one-yard score after Elijah Campbell returned an interception down to the two-yard line.

With the lead at 10-0, the Panthers would break out the "wildcat" as Weymiller raced around the edge for an 11-yard touchdown to end the first-quarter scoring. SDSU responded in the second quarter after Taryn Christion found Jake Wieneke for a touchdown. The first SDSU-kicking miscue of the day would rear its head as the Jackrabbits missed the extra point.

Dunne turned in a pair of touchdowns in the final quarter of Saturday's game, after finding Daurice Fountain and Isaiah Weston for 18 and 11-yard scores. The Jackrabbits made a futile push with the Panthers leading big, to bring the final score tot 38-18 after a two-yard touchdown run late.
