NEED TO KNOW

- UNI (4-3, 3-1 MVFC) seeks its third-straight top-10 upset as the Panthers travel to No. 2
 North Dakota State (7-0, 4-0) on Saturday at 2:30 p.m. CT.
- UNI has not won in Fargo since 2009's 42-27 victory.
- Saturday's contest will mark the ninth time since 2008 that the Bison and Panthers have been ranked entering the game.
- Last time out, UNI defeated No. 9 Youngstown State at home, 19-14. The win marked UNI's
 first back-to-back victories over top-10 foes since taking down No. 6 Illinois State (Nov. 1)
 and No. 1 North Dakota State (Nov.8) in 2014.
- The Panthers were led by a tenacious pass rush, that recorded 10 sacks against YSU. The 10 sacks were one shy of a program record, while tying for the most in the FCS this year.
- Junior Rickey Neal claimed MVFC Defensive Player of the Week honors after racking up a career-high 3.5 sacks against YSU.

LAST TIME AGAINST THE BISON

- NDSU held off a late surge from UNI in 2016, to narrowly escape with a 24-20 win. The Bison were led by Lance Dunn, who earned 119 yards on 23 carries.
- UNI was picked off four times by the Bison, while two of those came late in the fourth quarter with the Panthers threatening to take the lead.

SERIES WITH NORTH DAKOTA STATE

- UNI and NDSU have experienced a long history on the gridiron, with the series dating back to 1938. The two squads have faced off 50 times, with a break between 1982 and 2008.
- The Bison have won six out of the last seven games against the Panthers.

SCOUTING THE BISON

- North Dakota State is one of three teams that remain undefeated with the Bison owning a 7-0 record this season and 4-0 mark in the MVFC.
- The Bison have beat three ranked opponents this season, while staying at No. 2 the entire season.
- NDSU sports the top defense in the FCS, allowing only 192.7 yards per game. The Bison have only allowed two passing touchdowns as well this season.

UNI AGAINST THE MVFC

 The Panthers are 156-61 against the Missouri Valley Football Conference, with UNI going 85-39 during the Farley era.

NO OCTOBER SURPRISE FOR FARLEY

- Over his 17 seasons at UNI, head coach Mark Farley has amassed a 43-28 record for the month of October since 2001.
- Farley has gone undefeated during October three times (2003, 2007, 2008) while going winless only once during the month (2013).
- This season, the Panthers are currently 2-1 during October after earning wins over a pair of top-10 foes in No. 7 South Dakota State and No. 9 Youngstown State.

CLUTCH CATS

- This season, the Panthers have been extremely efficient in the red zone with UNI scoring on 22 out of 24 attempts. UNI ranks 10th currently in the FCS for red zone offense.
- UNI has earned the majority of its red zone scores through the air, with 12 passing TDs inside the 20. That total is tied for eighth in the FCS.

TOP-10 GAUNTLET CONTINUES

- UNI continues its stretch against top-10 foes this Saturday, with the Panthers facing their third top-10 opponent in the last three weeks.
- With last Saturday's upset over No. 9 Youngstown State, the Panthers earned their first back-to-back wins over top-10 foes since 2014's victories over No. 6 Illinois State (Nov. 1) and No. 1 North Dakota State (Nov. 8).
- UNI has never beaten three top-10 foes in three-consecutive weeks. The last time the Panthers beat three top-10 foes in one season was in 2015.

LOSSES LOOKING BETTER FOR UNI

- The Panthers have lost to lowa State, Southern Utah and Western Illinois this season, all three of which own a 5-2 record this season.
- ISU and SUU have both knocked off top-10 foes this season, with the Cyclones beating No. 3
 Oklahoma and the Thunderbirds upsetting No. 8 Eastern Washington.

PANTHER DEFENSE VERSUS THE RUN

- Last season, the UNI defense held opponents to 119.7 yards per game to rank 16th in the FCS.
- The Panthers rank 52nd in the country this season, allowing 141.0 yards on the ground per game.
- Over the last two weeks, the Panthers have stifled opponent rushing attacks as UNI has allowed a combined 99 yards to top-10 foes South Dakota State and Youngstown State.

PANTHERS AGAINST THE PASS

- The Panther defense has allowed a total of 266.6 yards passing per game this season, to rank 106th overall in the FCS.
- UNI has given up 16 passing touchdowns this season, with four coming against Cal Poly.
- This week's opponent North Dakota State has the FCS's best pass defense, only allowing 120.6 yards per game.

WEYMILLER'S COMEBACK

- Over the last two weeks, Marcus Weymiller has earned 303 yards rushing on 71 carries and four touchdowns. Weymiller had not run the ball this season before his spurt in activity.
- The 42 carries for Weymiller against South Dakota State ranks as the most by any FCS player this season.
- Weymiller is the first Panther back since David Johnson to earn at least two 170-yard rushing performances for his career. The back-to-back 100-yard rushing games for Weymiller are the first for a Panther since Aaron Bailey in 2015.

FOUNTAIN ON A MISSION

- Senior Daurice Fountain has put up monster numbers in his final season at UNI. The 6-foot-1
 receiver has hauled in five touchdowns this season, with 625 yards receiving.
- This season, Fountain has earned three 100-yard receiving games (all in consecutive weeks).
- The senior has 123 catches as a Panther, which is four catches shy of tying 10th all-time at UNI with Chris Nuss (1989-92).

NEAL SACKS PLAYER OF THE WEEK HONORS

- Junior Rickey Neal earned a career-high 3.5 sacks for UNI as the Panthers sacked Youngstown State a total of 10 times on Saturday.
- The 10 sacks were one shy of UNI's single-game record, while the number is tied for the
 most in the FCS this season since Eastern Washington recorded 10 quarterback take downs
 against Fordham on Sept. 16.
- Neal's 3.5 sacks against YSU is tied for third most in one game this season by any FCS player and ranks first for MVFC players
- The 6.5 sacks this season is tied for 12th overall in the FCS and tops the MVFC.

MULTI-TOUCHDOWN GAMES FOR DUNNE.

- Dunne has earned eight multi-touchdown games for his career, with five coming in 2017.
- The junior threw a pair of touchdowns against Missouri State, North Dakota State and Western Illinois in 2016, while throwing three in 2017's season opener against lowa State, four against Cal Poly, three against SIU, four against WIU and two against SDSU.

FARLEY NAMED CAMPBELL SEMIFINALIST

- Senior linebacker Jared Farley was named a semifinalist for the 2017 William V. Campbell
 Trophy late September, which recognizes an individual as the absolute best football scholar-athlete in the nation.
- Farley is one of 181 semifinalists the National Football Foundation & College Hall of Fame (NFF) has chosen for the award. The Cedar Falls native is also one of 36 representing the FCS and one of seven from the MVFC.
- The senior is the ninth Panther to be named a semifinalist for this "academic Heisman", joining James Lindgren (2006), Chad Rinehart (2007), Josh Mahoney (2009), Ben Boothby (2011), Kyle Bernard (2012), David Johnson (2012), Isaac Ales (2015) and Karter Schult (2016)

FARLEY CLAIMS MVFC DEFENSIVE POW HONORS

- After a stellar game against Cal Poly, senior linebacker Jared Farley earned MVFC Defensive Player of the Week honors.
- With the game tied at 7-7, Farley scooped up a fumble and took it 48 yards to put the Panthers ahead. The return was Farley's first of his career, while the fumble recovery was his fifth at UNI.
- Farley finished the game posting 11 total tackles, with four solos and seven assists as well as one tackle for a loss.
- Farley has won Defensive POW honors twice as a Panther. The last time came after his sensational game against lowa State during last season's 25-20 victory.

FOUR EARN CAREER FIRST STARTS FOR PANTHERS

- UNI's season opener against lowa State was a momentous one for four Panthers, as Spencer Brown, Nikholi Jaghai, Isaiah Nimmers and Seth Thomas all earned their first collegiate starts on the field.
- Sophomores Jaghai and Thomas saw playing time last season, but did not receive starts on the defensive side of the ball.
- For redshirt freshmen Brown and Nimmers, the season opener against the Cyclones was their first debut as Panthers.

NEWBIES MAKE A SPLASH IN SEASON OPENER

- UNI had its fair share of newcomers making a significant impact in the season opener
 against lowa State, with two redshirt freshmen starting and II seeing playing time against
 the Cyclones.
- Redshirt freshman Isaiah Weston made the biggest splash for Panther newcomers, as the
 6-8, 207-pound wideout caught four passes for 72 yards and a touchdown.
- Fellow redshirt freshman Alfonzo Lambert II turned in a stellar performance at linebacker, making 10 tackles to rank second behind senior Jared Farley's 14 against the Cyclones.

PANTHERS AGAINST RANKED FOES

- UNI has 83 wins over Top-25 opponents all-time and 22 over Top-10 foes.
- In 2016, the Panthers were 1-5 against ranked teams. Four of the five ranked losses (No. 14 Montana, No. 8 Eastern Washington, No. 11 Youngstown State, No. 4 North Dakota State) were decided by an average 4.5-point margin.
- This season, the Panthers are 2-1 after wins over No. 7 South Dakota State and No. 9 Youngstown State.

- Junior defensive back Elijah Campbell turned in his #19 jersey for #1 this season with the Panthers.
- This isn't the first time Campbell has made a number change in college however, prior to joining UNI Campbell was #9 at Northern Illinois.

COACH FARLEY CONTINUES RECORD WIN TOTAL

 After defeating the Cyclones last season, head coach Mark Farley set the program record for career wins at UNI. The win over lowa State gave Farley 130 for his career at UNI, before finishing the season at 134.

In addition to being UNI's all-time winningest coach, Farley also holds the most league wins
in MVFC history after earning an impressive 83-38 mark over his storied coaching career.

TOP OF THE LEAGUE

 UNI has had 47 student-athletes named to the MVFC All-Conference First Team since 2007, the most in the league. Last season, Karter Schultz continued the tradition after claiming First Team All-MVFC honors following his sensational final season with the Panthers.

PRESEASON ALL-MVFC

- UNI is represented by seven members on the 2017 Missouri Valley Football Conference's preseason squad. Senior defensive back Malcolm Washington and senior linebacker Jared Farley were each named to the first team heading into the 2017 season.
- The Panthers posted a league-high five members on the honorable mention preseason All-MVFC Team. Sophomore running back Trevor Allen, junior offensive lineman Cal Twait, senior defensive back Elijah Campbell, senior punter Sam Kuhter and sophomore return specialist Jalen Rima were all named as honorable mention selections to the preseason squad.

FARLEY NAMED TO PRESEASON TEAMS

Senior linebacker Jared Farley earned a pair of prestigious honors ahead of the 2017 season
as the Cedar Falls native was named to the STATS FCS Preseason All-America Second Team
and the Preseason All-MVFC First Team. Farley was just one of 17 MVFC players selected to
the STATS FCS All-America teams. In addition to the national honors, Farley was also named
one of UNI's team captains.

UNI RANKED 18/20 IN PRESEASON POLLS

- The Panthers enter the season ranked No. 18 (STATS) and No. 20 (Coaches) respectively.
 Last season, UNI opened the year ranked No. 5 (STATS/Coaches).
- UNI has finished the year in the Top 25 in 12 of the last 16 seasons and has taken home a top-five ranking seven of the last 16 seasons.

RETURNING PANTHERS

 Not including special teams, the Panthers return 17 starters from last year's squad (eight on offense, nine on defense). Five of the eight returning offensive starters are skill position players, whereas four of the nine defensive returnees are on the defensive line. On special teams, the Panthers return five starters.

NEW TURF FOR 2017

UNI will be playing on a new AstroTurf for the upcoming 2017 season. The surface will be
made of PureGrass® with Armacell® pad. The surface measures over 77,000 square feet
and will come in 26 rollable panels that are secured by a Velcro® system. The total cost of
the new turf was \$900,000.



UNI head coach Mark Farley, once known as the "walk on from Waukon", has led the Panthers to a mark of 134-67 in his 16 years at the helm of the program.

Entering his 17th season as the head coach of the UNI Panthers, Farley is eager to lead a mixture of energized youth and veteran student-athletes to new heights in 2017.

In Missouri Valley Football Conference play, Farley has guided the Panthers to a record of 82-38 for an impressive .683 winning percentage in league play. Farley is the MVFC's all-time coaching wins leader with 82 league victories.

Included in that 16-year run for Farley and the Panthers are seven conference championships, nine playoff appearances, 12 top-25 final rankings, three national semifinal appearances and one national title game appearance in 2005. Farley holds the UNI record for postseason coaching victories with 13 with an overall playoff record of 13-9.

Through his leadership, the Panthers returned to the glory days when they won seven straight conference titles and made seven consecutive FCS playoff ap-

pearances in the decade of the '90s. In Farley's 16 years at the helm, UNI has won at least a share of seven Missouri Valley Football Conference titles. UNI has also advanced to the quarterfinals (2003, 2007, 2011, 2015), semifinals (2001, 2008) and the national title game (2005) in seven of those nine playoff appearances. Twelve of Farley's 16 previous Panther teams have finished the season rank in the top-25, defeating 80 top-25 ranked foes in the process.

The Panthers kicked off the 2016 season with a win over lowa State, giving Farley 13D career victories, making him the all-time coaching wins leader at UNI. He passed former head coach Stan Sheriff, with whom he tied the record in 2015 with UNI's playoff win over No. 5 Portland State, giving him 129. Despite finishing the 2016 season 5-6 overall, UNI ended the season ranked in the top-35 in the FCS in 18 different statistical categories. UNI faced off against six top-25 ranked opponents throughout the year, beating #19 Western Illinois on the road and was one of just 10 FCS teams to beat an FBS opponent in 2016.

AMES, lowa — Despite a hard-fought effort in front of a hostile crowd of 61,500, the Northern lowa Panthers (0-1) fell to the lowa State Cyclones (1-0) 42-24 to open the season on Saturday night in Ames.

UNI took an early 7-0 lead after scoring on the opening drive, but turnovers shifted the momentum to ISU as the Cyclones took a 21-10 lead into halftime. ISU would push the advantage to as much as 35-10, but the Panthers stormed back to outscore the Cyclones 14-7 over the last 16:36 of the game.

UNI finished the game with 378 yards of total offense, to ISU's 405. The Panthers and Cyclones were almost neck-and-neck in every other statically category with UNI rushing for 119 yards and throwing it for 259 yards.

Junior Eli Dunne finished Saturday's opener going 23-for-38 for 259 yards, while throwing three touchdowns and three interceptions. Sophomore Trevor Allen was the overall leading rusher in the game, going for 87 yards on the ground.

Three different receivers caught touchdown passes for the Panthers as Isaiah Weston (four catches, 72 yards), Jaylin James (three catches, 44 yards) and Aaron Graham (two catches, 24 yards) all had scores.

On the defensive side, Jared Farley was the leading tackler with 14 stops while Duncan Ferch finished the game with nine tackles and an interception.

CEDAR FALLS, lowa – Propelled by career days from quarterback Eli Dunne and wide receiver Daurice Fountain, the 21st-ranked Northern lowa Panthers (1-1) defeated Cal Poly (0-3) in a shootout, 45-38, to open the home slate on a high note.

Dunne and Fountain connected for three scores – including the game winner – as the Panthers earned their first overtime victory since 2011 (Nov. 19 at Illinois State).

Dunne finished the game going 25-for-40 with 325 yards passing and four touchdowns through the air. The four scores were the most for Dunne since tossing three last week against lowa State.

Fountain capped his stellar game after catching five passes, for 75 yards and three touchdowns. The senior recorded his second game with three touchdown grabs, matching 2016's total against Southern Illinois.

UNI out gained Cal Poly through the air (325-238), but the Mustangs controlled the ground attack (305-94).

On the defensive side, linebacker Duncan Ferch finished with a career-high 15 total tackles to lead both teams on Saturday. Defensive end Adam Reth turned in a stellar performance as well, making 14 stops.

CEDAR CITY, Utah – Despite a valiant effort on the road, No. 18 Northern lowa (1-2) fell to Southern Utah (2-1) in a tight contest, 24-21.

The game was tied, 21-21 until SUU made a 26-yard field goal with 1:50 remaining as the Thunderbirds hung on to win the game, 24-21.

The Thunderbirds jumped out to a 14-D lead to begin action on Saturday, as SUU earned scores on the ground and through the air. SUU would control most of the first half, before Seth Thomas energized the UNI sideline after rumbling to the end zone for a 15-yard interception touchdown.

Trailing, 14-7 in the third quarter the Panther defense sparked UNI once again after Adam Reth's big hit resulted in a sack and strip. The Panthers would turn the fumble into points, following Austin Errthum's 42-yard field goal.

Inching closer and only trailing 14-10, SUU would swing momentum after James Felila scored his second touchdown of the night – this time a 20-yard score – with 4:35 remaining in the third quarter.

Trailing 21-10 late, the Panthers would mount a comeback as UNI scored II-unanswered to tie the game at 21-21. UNI's Dunne would master a seven-play drive to get the Panthers in the end zone, following a 21-yard pass to Trevor Allen. A Jared Farley interception return inside Thunderbird territory would also lead to points as Errthum nailed a 30-yard field goal to knot the score at 21-21.

The Panthers would be in position again for more points following a turnover on downs, but a long, 53-yard field goal from Errthum was blocked and returned to the 17. The Panther defense would hold the Thunderbirds to three points, after a 26-yard field goal, but SUU would hold on to the lead this time for the 24-21 win.

UNI's Eli Dunne turned in another big passing day, throwing for 342 yards and four touchdowns. With the performance, Dunne is the first Panther quarterback to throw for at least 23 completions, 259 yards and a touchdown in each of his first five games to start a season.

Elias Nissen scored three times for the Panthers – to continue his hot streak at tight end – while Daurice Fountain caught a career-high nine passes for 103 yards.

On the defensive side, senior Jared Farley led the Panthers with a career-high 14 tackles while junior Rickey Neal recorded two key sacks to go along with his seven total tackles.

Trailing 14-5 in the third quarter, the Leathernecks turned a Panther interception into seven points after a Steve McShane's one-yard score. McGuire threw back-to-back touchdowns to give the Leathernecks a 25-14 lead late in the third quarter.

The fourth quarter would see a combined 35 points scored between the two teams, with the Panthers scoring twice to claw their way out of the 25-14 deficit and take a 25-22 lead. The two UNI scores would be on 18 and 16-yard passes from Dunne that found Nissen and Aaron Graham.

With only 1:12 remaining in the game, WIU would march down the field and earn a go-ahead score with six seconds left as McGuire and Acklin hooked up again – this time from 20 yards out. WIU's Michael Bishoff scooped up a Panther fumble on the ensuing kickoff, bringing the final score to 38-29 in favor of the Leathernecks.

BROOKINGS, S.D. – Propelled by 170 yards rushing from junior Marcus Weymiller, Northern lowa (3-3, 2-1 MVFC) dominated No. 7 South Dakota State (4-2, 1-2 MVFC) on the road, 38-18.

The Panthers have knocked off a top-10 Jackrabbit team in two out of the last three seasons, with the last also coming in Brookings on Oct. 24, 2015 (10-7). The 20-point win against SDSU ranks as the largest margin of victory over a ranked foe since upsetting No. 1 North Dakota State (23-3) on Nov. 8, 2014.

UNI's Weymiller led the Panthers, with 170 yards rushing and two scores, while Eli Dunne threw two touchdowns through the air for 169 yards passing. The 170 yards for Weymiller were the most for the junior since gaining 171 against Indiana State on Nov. 5, 2016. Weymiller had not carried the ball this season before Saturday's game.

On the defensive side, the Panthers forced three turnovers with Elijah Campbell earning an early interception while Alfonzo Lambert II and Joe Friedrich scooped up two fumbles for UNI.

Despite the cold weather, UNI came out of the gates on fire Saturday to earn an early 17-0 lead after one quarter of play. The Panthers began the scoring with a 41-yard field goal from Sam Drysdale, which was followed by a Christian Jegen one-yard score after Elijah Campbell returned an interception down to the two-yard line.

With the lead at 10-0, the Panthers would break out the "wildcat" as Weymiller raced around the edge for an 11-yard touchdown to end the first-quarter scoring. SDSU responded in the second quarter after Taryn Christion found Jake Wieneke for a touchdown. The first SDSU-kicking miscue of the day would rear its head as the Jackrabbits missed the extra point.

Dunne turned in a pair of touchdowns in the final quarter of Saturday's game, after finding Daurice Fountain and Isaiah Weston for 18 and 11-yard scores. The Jackrabbits made a futile push with the Panthers leading big, to bring the final score tot 38-18 after a two-yard touchdown run late.

CEDAR FALLS, lowa – Fueled by a dominating pass rush, Northern lowa (4-3, 3-1 MVFC) knocked off another top-10 foe on Saturday after beating No. 9 Youngstown State (3-4, 1-3 MVFC), 19-14.

.The Panther defense recorded 10 sacks on Saturday, coming within one quarterback take down from tying the program record. The 10 sacks are tied for the most by any FCS team this season, with Eastern Washington also earning 10 against Fordham on Sept. 16.

Junior Rickey Neal earned a career-high 3.5 sacks for UNI, while Keelon Brookins and Hezekiah Applegate added 2.0. Duncan Ferch earned 1.0 sack, along with Elijah Campbell, while Seth Thomas rounded out the stat sheet with a half sack.

UNI held YSU well below its season average for rushing yards, as the Panthers only gave up 47 on the ground. Coming into Saturday, the Penguins sported the ninth-ranked rushing attack and earned 248.5 yards per game.

Junior Marcus Weymiller poured in 133 on the ground for the Panthers, while scoring both of UNI's touchdowns. Weymiller became the first Panther to rush over 100 yards in back-to-back weeks since 2015 when Aaron Bailey achieved the feat against Missouri State (Nov. 14) and Southern Illinois (Nov. 21). Quarterback Eli Dunne had another mistake-free day throwing the ball, with 151 yards on 9-of-20 passing.

Much like last week's upset of No. 7 South Dakota State, the Panthers jumped out to an early lead against their top-10 foe. This time, UNI plowed ahead for a 10-0 lead with 11:31 remaining in the second quarter following Weymiller's 1-yard plunge.

The Penguins bounced back to score a touchdown of their own after a deep throw from Nathan Mays to Damoun Patterson found the end zone. With the lead trimmed to 10-7, UNI went back to Weymiller as he bounced outside for a six-yard score to extend the lead to 16-7 following the failed extra point.

A late surge from the Penguins through the air scored another touchdown – this time from Ricky Davis to Alvin Bailey – for 15 yards. YSU attempted a last gasp outside kick to follow, but Weymiller pounced on the ball and UNI went into the victory formation.
