- UNI (0-1) looks to bounce back this Saturday when it hosts Cal Poly (0-2).
- The last time the Panthers hosted the Mustangs at the UNI-Dome was in head coach Mark Farley's first season. UNI won that 2001 contest, 31-13.
- Since opening the series with a loss in 1997, UNI has won the last six meetings against CP.
- Last time out, UNI lost a high-scoring affair against lowa State in Ames, 42-24.
- The Panthers had three turnovers that lead to 14 points for the Cyclones.
- Junior quarterback Eli Dunne went 23-for-38 and threw for 259 yards. The Panther signal caller aired it out for threw touchdowns, but also had three interceptions.
- In his Panther debut, redshirt freshman Isaiah Weston grabbed his first career touchdown.
 The Albertville, Minn. native finished the game with four catches and 72 yards receiving.

LAST TIME AGAINST THE MUSTANGS

- UNI downed a ranked Cal Poly squad during its last visit to San Luis Obispo in 2015, winning 34-20 over the Mustangs. Quarterback Aaron Bailey finished the game 15-for-20 with 218 yards and a touchdown. Bailey also added 57 yards on the ground and two scores.
- Daurice Fountain, a sophomore at the time, caught eight passes for 123 yards.

SERIES WITH CAL POLY

- UNI and Cal Poly have faced off seven times on the gridiron, with the Panthers owning a 6-1 advantage. The two squads played for six-consecutive years starting in 1997, before reviving the series in 2015.
- The Mustangs have not played in Cedar Falls since 2001, which was head coach Mark Farley's first season at the helm.

SCOUTING THE MUSTANGS

- Cal Poly is in its ninth season of the Tim Walsh era, as the head coach holds a 50-44 record with the Mustangs.
- Cal Poly earned its fourth FCS playoff berth in 12 seasons last fall, after finishing with a 7-5
 mark and tied for fourth place in the Big Sky with Southern Utah.
- The Mustangs will feature an offense built on the triple option, with Cal Poly averaging 203
 rushing yards per game this season.

UNI IN HOME OPENERS

- Under head coach Mark Farley, the Panthers are 14-2 in home openers. Last season's loss to a ranked Montana squad (20-14) broke a nine-game winning streak for UNI in home openers at the UNI-Dome.
- The Panthers have never opened with Cal Poly at home.

PANTHERS AGAINST BIG SKY FOES

- UNI has had success against the current members of the Big Sky Conference, racking up an all-time record of 52-25-1. UNI holds a winning record over 10 of the 13 schools, with Montana being the only series with a Big Sky opponent holds the edge in.
- The Panthers faced two Big Sky opponents last season, hosting Montana for the 2016 home opener before traveling to Eastern Washington the next week.
- UNI follows that same pattern this season, with a home opener against Cal Poly and a road trip to Southern Utah to cap the non-conference slate.
- The last Big Sky opponent the Panthers beat was Cal Poly in 2015.

THE PANTHER-MUSTANG CONNECTION FOR STAN SHERIFF

- The field at UNI is named after famed football coach (1960-82) and athletic director (1970-83) Stan Sheriff, who was also a Cal Poly alum (1950-53).
- Sheriff was an All-American with the Mustangs and spent three seasons playing professionally with the Pittsburgh Steelers (1954), San Fransisco 49ers (1956) and the Cleveland Browns (1957). He played center, quard and linebacker.
- Sheriff also has his namesake on the University of Hawaii's Stan Sheriff Center, the arena hosts events for Rainbow Warrior basketball and volleyball.

HOME SWEET DOME

 The Panthers are a dominating 203-54-1 all-time in the UNI-Dome. The UNI football team started playing home games in the UNI-Dome way back in 1976.

PANTHER DEFENSE VERSUS THE RUN

- Last season, the UNI defense held opponents to 164.1 yards on the ground per game to rank 16th in the ECS.
- The Panthers allowed 134 yards to Iowa State during last Saturday's season opener in Ames.
- In 2015's battle against Cal Poly, the Mustangs gained 350 yards rushing on 67 attempts
 against the Panther defense.
- The 350 allowed by the Panther defense to Cal Poly is the most rushing yards given up since Wofford gained 457 yards on Dec. 3, 2011. The Panthers won that FCS Playoff battle, 28-21.

STREAK OF FORCING TURNOVER UP TO 10-STRAIGHT GAMES

- The Panther defense continued its success against opposing offenses to open the season as the UNI D posted its 10th-consecutive game forcing at least one turnover.
- The streak dates back to last season's game against Eastern Washington.
- The Panther defense earned a turnover in 10 of 11 games last season, with the contest against Montana being the only game without forcing a turnover.

FOUR EARN CAREER FIRST STARTS FOR PANTHERS

- UNI's season opener against lowa State was a momentous one for four Panthers, as Spencer Brown, Nikholi Jaghai, Isaiah Nimmers and Seth Thomas all earned their first collegiate starts on the field.
- Sophomores Jaghai and Thomas saw playing time last season, but did not receive starts on the defensive side of the ball.
- For redshirt freshmen Brown and Nimmers, the season opener against the Cyclones was their first debut as Panthers.

NEWBIES MAKE A SPLASH IN SEASON OPENER

- UNI had its fair share of newcomers making a significant impact in the season opener
 against lowa State, with two redshirt freshmen starting and II seeing playing time against
 the Cyclones.
- Redshirt freshman Isaiah Weston made the biggest splash for Panther newcomers, as the
 6-8, 207-pound wideout caught four passes for 72 yards and a touchdown.
- Fellow redshirt freshman Alfonzo Lambert II turned in a stellar performance at linebacker, making 10 tackles to rank second behind senior Jared Farley's 14 against the Cyclones.

UNI RANKED NO. 21 IN COACHES/STATS POLL

- The Panthers slid back one spot in this week's FCS Coaches Poll, tying for 21st overall with North Carolina A&T (1-0). UNI and NCAT earned 124 points in this week's rankings.
- UNI fell three spots in the STATS FCS Top 25, owning sole possession of No. 21 overall.
- This week's opponent, Cal Poly, was ranked outside of the Top 25 in both polls, but was receiving votes.

ANOTHER MULTI-TOUCHDOWN DAY FOR DUNNE

- Junior signal caller Eli Dunne earned three touchdowns through the air against lowa State in Saturday's season opener, earning a career-high mark for the Panther quarterback.
- Dunne has earned four multi-touchdown games for his career, with three coming in 2016.
- The junior threw a pair of touchdowns against Missouri State, North Dakota State and Western Illinois.

DUNNE SPREADS THE BALL AROUND

- Quarterback Eli Dunne found nine different targets during Saturday's season opener against lowa State, with three of those catching touchdowns.
- The 2015 win over Eastern Washington on Sept. 12 marked the last time the Panthers had three different receivers catch touchdowns.
- The nine receivers making a catch is also the most for UNI since Dunne found 10 targets in a 61-7 route over Missouri State on Oct. 22, 2016.

I-N-T MACHINE DUNCAN FERCH

- Junior linebacker Duncan Ferch continued to be a nightmare for opposing quarterbacks after he earned another interception in the season opener against lowa State.
- The State Center, lowe native has earned a total of four picks as a Panther.
- Last season, Ferch picked off three passes and returned two for touchdowns.

ALLEN JUST SHY OF 100-YARD MARK

- Sophomore tailback Trevor Allen had a stellar day against the Cyclones to open the 2017 season, with the Panther earning 87 yards on the ground to lead all rushers for the game.
- Allen averaged 7.3 yards a carry on just 12 attempts with a long of 28 to go along with his totals as well.
- The Waukee, lowa native also caught two passes for 18 yards against lowa State to add to his impressive performance.

DRYSDALE BOOTS CAREER LONG

- In a tight game at 14-7, sophomore Sam Drysdale nailed a career-long. 43-yard field goal
 in the season opener against lowa State. The field goal brought the score to 14-10 with 5:31
 remaining in the second quarter.
- Last season, Drysdale was a perfect 6-for-6, with his long being 40 yards to cap a successful freshman season with the Panthers.

JERSEY SWAP FOR CAMPBELL

- Junior defensive back Elijah Campbell turned in his #19 jersey for #1 this season with the Panthers.
- This isn't the first time Campbell has made a number change in college however, prior to joining UNI Campbell was #9 at Northern Illinois.

PANTHERS AGAINST RANKED FOES

- UNI has 81 wins over Top-25 opponents all-time and 20 over Top-10 foes.
- In 2016, the Panthers were 1-5 against ranked teams. Four of the five ranked losses (No. 14 Montana, No. 8 Eastern Washington, No. 11 Youngstown State, No. 4 North Dakota State) were decided by an average 4.5-point margin.
- This season the Panthers will face five preseason Top-25 foes (Cal Poly, Western Illinois, South Dakota State, Youngstown State, North Dakota State'

TEAM CAPTAINS NAMED FOR 2017

- Linebacker Jared Farley, wide receiver Daurice Fountain, defensive lineman Adam Reth and defensive lineman Preston Woods were named as the 2017 team captains by head coach Mark Farley before the start of the season.
- All four players are seniors.

UNI RANKED 18/20 IN PRESEASON POLLS

- The Panthers enter the season ranked No. 18 (STATS) and No. 20 (Coaches) respectively.
 Last season, UNI opened the year ranked No. 5 (STATS/Coaches).
- UNI has finished the year in the Top 25 in 12 of the last 16 seasons and has taken home a top-five ranking seven of the last 16 seasons.

RETURNING PANTHERS

 Not including special teams, the Panthers return 17 starters from last year's squad (eight on offense, nine on defense). Five of the eight returning offensive starters are skill position players, whereas four of the nine defensive returnees are on the defensive line. On special teams, the Panthers return five starters.

ROAD WARRIORS

UNI will spend four of the first six games on the road this season with six total road games

COACH FARLEY CONTINUES RECORD WIN TOTAL

 After defeating the Cyclones last season, head coach Mark Farley set the program record for career wins at UNI. The win over lowa State gave Farley 130 for his career at UNI, before finishing the season at 134.

 In addition to being UNI's all-time winningest coach, Farley also holds the most league wins in MVFC history after earning an impressive 82-38 mark over his storied coaching career.

TOP OF THE LEAGUE

 UNI has had 47 student-athletes named to the MVFC All-Conference First Team since 2007, the most in the league. Last season, Karter Schultz continued the tradition after claiming First Team All-MVFC honors following his sensational final season with the Panthers.

PRESEASON ALL-MVFC

- UNI is represented by seven members on the 2017 Missouri Valley Football Conference's preseason squad. Senior defensive back Malcolm Washington and senior linebacker Jared Farley were each named to the first team heading into the 2017 season.
- The Panthers posted a league-high five members on the honorable mention preseason All-MVFC Team. Sophomore running back Trevor Allen, junior offensive lineman Cal Twait, senior defensive back Elijah Campbell, senior punter Sam Kuhter and sophomore return specialist Jalen Rima were all named as honorable mention selections to the preseason squad.

FARLEY NAMED TO PRESEASON TEAMS

Senior linebacker Jared Farley earned a pair of prestigious honors ahead of the 2017 season
as the Cedar Falls native was named to the STATS FCS Preseason All-America Second Team
and the Preseason All-MVFC First Team. Farley was just one of 17 MVFC players selected to
the STATS FCS All-America teams. In addition to the national honors, Farley was also named
one of UNI's team captains.

RETURNING PANTHERS

Not including special teams, the Panthers return 17 starters from last year's squad (eight
on offense, nine on defense). Five of the eight returning offensive starters are skill position
players, whereas four of the nine defensive returnees are on the defensive line. On special
teams, the Panthers return five starters.

NEW TURF FOR 2017

UNI will be playing on a new AstroTurf for the upcoming 2017 season. The surface will be
made of PureGrass® with Armacell® pad. The surface measures over 77,000 square feet
and will come in 26 rollable panels that are secured by a Velcro® system. The total cost of
the new turf was \$900,000.



UNI head coach Mark Farley, once known as the "walk on from Waukon", has led the Panthers to a mark of 134-67 in his 16 years at the helm of the program.

Entering his 17th season as the head coach of the UNI Panthers, Farley is eager to lead a mixture of energized youth and veteran student-athletes to new heights in 2017.

In Missouri Valley Football Conference play, Farley has guided the Panthers to a record of 82-38 for an impressive .683 winning percentage in league play. Farley is the MVFC's all-time coaching wins leader with 82 league victories.

Included in that 16-year run for Farley and the Panthers are seven conference championships, nine playoff appearances, 12 top-25 final rankings, three national semifinal appearances and one national title game appearance in 2005. Farley holds the UNI record for postseason coaching victories with 13 with an overall playoff record of 13-9.

Through his leadership, the Panthers returned to the glory days when they won seven straight conference titles and made seven consecutive FCS playoff ap-

pearances in the decade of the '90s. In Farley's 16 years at the helm, UNI has won at least a share of seven Missouri Valley Football Conference titles. UNI has also advanced to the quarterfinals (2003, 2007, 2011, 2015), semifinals (2001, 2008) and the national title game (2005) in seven of those nine playoff appearances. Twelve of Farley's 16 previous Panther teams have finished the season rank in the top-25, defeating 80 top-25 ranked foes in the process.

The Panthers kicked off the 2016 season with a win over lowa State, giving Farley 13D career victories, making him the all-time coaching wins leader at UNI. He passed former head coach Stan Sheriff, with whom he tied the record in 2015 with UNI's playoff win over No. 5 Portland State, giving him 129. Despite finishing the 2016 season 5-6 overall, UNI ended the season ranked in the top-35 in the FCS in 18 different statistical categories. UNI faced off against six top-25 ranked opponents throughout the year, beating #19 Western Illinois on the road and was one of just 10 FCS teams to beat an FBS opponent in 2016.
