- He started in 28 of the 29 games of his sophomore and junior seasons, including the last 18 of his career.
- He was named to the annual "College Football Freak" list by The Athletic's Bruce Feldman in the summer of 2020 before the season was canceled.
- Was named a First-Team Preseason All-American by Phil Steele for 2020.
- Earned Second-Team All-MVFC Honors after the 2019 season.
- Is a member of the National Football Foundation's Hampshire Honor Society.
- Was ranked first out of 1134 offensive tackles measured since 1987 on the "Relative Athletic Score" metric.\*
- Participated in the Senior Bowl.



#### **STATS AND FACTS**

- UNI has had 19 players drafted since 1966.
- UNI has had two players drafted in one year three times in the draft era, the last coming in 2008 when Chad Rinehart and Brandon Keith were drafted.
- Brad Meester was the highest UNI draft pick ever when he was picked 60th overall in 2000 by the Jaguars.
- Six Panthers have been drafted since Mark Farley took over the program in 2001.
- Ten Panthers have been drafted since the draft was shortened to seven rounds in 1994.
- Former Panther Tight End Briley Moore who graduated in 2020 with a degree in Exercise Science and finished his career at Kansas State is also projected to be drafted.
