MILESTONES & MATCH-UPS

- Fans can watch the 7 p.m. CT Feb. 10 dual on FloWrestling and follow stats on Trackwrestling.
- Doug Schwab earned his 100th career win as a head coach in the Panthers' first Big 12 dual of the season against Wyoming. He has the third most wins of any coach in Panther history:
Chuck Patten 1965-82 218 wins
Don Briggs 1983-97 163 wins
Doug Schwab 2011 103 wins
Dave McCuskey 1931-52 102 wins
- Kyle Biscoglia (133 pounds) and Austin Yant (165 pounds) both earned their 20th career dual wins last week. Parker Keckeisen (184 pounds) leads the team in career dual wins with 25. Derek Holschlag (157) joined Biscoglia, Yant and Keckeisen with 60+ career wins Friday against Cal Baptist.
- UNI notched four falls against CBU, marking UNI's eighth 40+ point dual under head coach Doug Schwab, and the program's first dual shutout since Nov. 11, 2016, against Nebraska-Kearney. It was also the Panthers' highest scoring dual since posting 44 points against Indiana Tech in 2015.
- Prior to the Cal Baptist dual, the last time UNI pinned four Division I opponents in the same dual was Jan. 11, 2013, against Northern Colorado. UNI won 40-6.

LEADING THE PANTHER PACK

- Parker Keckeisen leads UNI in dual scoring with 43 points. He is 10-0 in duals, which includes a pin over then-ranked No. 2 Trent Hidlay of NC State. Ten of his 14 wins this year have included bonus points. He has three falls so far this year.
- Cael Happel (141 pounds) is the only Panther with Big 12 Wrestler of the Week honors so far this season.
- Parker Keckeisen (64-4) and Senior Austin Yant (64-34) have a slight edge in career wins.

BIG CHANGES, BIG WINS, BIG 12

- Of the 13 weeks the conference has named a Big 12 Wrestler of the Week, seven wrestlers in the 141-pound weight class have been named, including the last five weeks. UNI's Cael Happel was the first, earning the honor Nov. 22.
- This is the first season under Schwab that UNI will wrestle a full season in the McLeod Center. The Panthers competed in McLeod in the 2008-09 and 2009-10 seasons before returning to the West Gym. The Panthers have hosted some duals in McLeod, this will be the first season since 2010 that the entire schedule has been moved.
- The change of venue opens up the opportunity to move up the national attendance ranking. The Panthers' former venue, the West Gym was built in 1925 and held 2,100. While McLeod seats 6,500. UNI finished 14th in the nation for annual attendance among Division I wrestling programs a year ago. Since head coach Doug

Schwab took over in 2011, UNI has cracked the top 10 in attendance four times (2014-17).

- UNI joined the Big 12 ahead of the 2017-18 season.
- UNI's 19-13 win over No. 3 Ohio State was the second time UNI has beaten the third-ranked team in the nation in as many years. The Panthers knocked off then-ranked No. 3 Oklahoma State in a dual at OSU in the 2022 season. UNI took the lead in the Ohio State series with an 8-7 overall record against the Buckeyes. Coach Schwab remains undefeated against OSU at 2-0.

PARKER KECKEISEN RESUME

- Keckeisen has never given up bonus points.
- Parker Keckeisen is just the third Panther to earn two Big 12 titles. His second title at 184 pounds, extended UNI's streak at the weight class. A Panther has won a title at 184 pounds every year since joining the league in 2018. It's the second longest active streak of any Big 12 school at a weight class. Oklahoma State has had a champion at 149 pounds since 2015.
- Keckeisen has just four career losses that have come to three different opponents. He has lost to two-time reigning national champion Aaron Brooks (Penn State) twice. Keckeisen fell to

Bernie Truax in 2022. He avenged the loss to Truax in the same NCAA championship to take his second bronze medal at the championships. After beating the third-seeded Trent Hidlay at the 2022 NCAA championships, Hidlay avenged the loss at the 2022 Cliff Keen Invite. In the duo's third meeting, Keckeisen pinned Hidlay at the Collegiate Duals. So Brooks remains the only wrestler Keckeisen hasn't avenged a loss.

- Keckeisen is just the 15th Panther to compete in the NWCA All-Star Classic. He faced No. 1 Aaron Brooks of Penn State to open the 2023 season. Brooks won the decision, 12-8.
- He has cracked UNI's all-time list for season best winning percentage at No. 3 in 2021 and No. 5 in 2002. Complete list (at least 19 wins):

BUILDING ON THE 2022 SEASON

- The Panthers have finished in the top 20 at the Division I NCAA Championships since the 2008 season.
- Two-time All-American Parker Keckeisen led UNI last year with his second bronze at 184 pounds.
- The Panthers are on a five-tournament streak of having at least one all-America selection, which is the 14th longest streak in the nation.
- The Panthers qualified eight for the 2022 NAAs, the most since UNI sent nine in 2008. The team finished tied for 20th place, the eighth top-25 finish under head coach Doug Schwab. Four earned top-15 seeds. Three return: Keckeisen was seeded 4th; Kyle Biscoglia, 14th; and Austin Yant, 15th.
- The team earned NWCA Scholar All-America honors. Keckeisen, Biscoglia, Lance Runyon and Tyrell Gordon earned individual NWCA Scholar All-America honors.
- A ninth Panther, Cael Happel qualified for the 2022 NCAA Division I Championships as an alternate under the first time for the new rules.
- Three Panthers were in the Big 12 finals, the most since UNI joined the league in 2018. Two finalists return. Parker Keckeisen won at 184 pounds. Kyle Biscoglia took second at 133.

UNI VS. ISU MATCHUP NOTES

UNI's head coach Doug Schwab is 4-8 against Iowa State. His longest win streak against the Cyclones was from 2017 to 2019 with three consecutive wins. The win in the 2017-18 season was the largest margin of victory for UNI over ISU: 31-7 (24 points).

UNI's longest win streak against ISU was from 1940-1952 when the Panthers won 11 in a row.

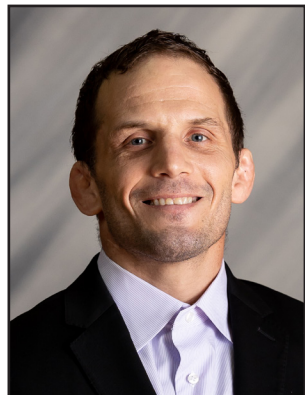

HEAD COACH DOUG SCHWAB - 13th season

Doug Schwab is the Panthers' ninth head coach in the program's illustrious history. He enters his 13th season at UNI in 2022-23 season. Thirteen UNI student-athletes have earned 18 all-America honors under his leadership, including 184-pounder Parker Keckeisen, a two-time all-American. Keckeisen earned the highest all-America honors of a redshirt freshman since the 1950s with a third-place finish in 2021. Schwab has coached eight teams to a top-20 NCAA championship finish. The Panthers are on a five-tournament streak of having at least one all-America selection.

2021-22: UNI qualified eight wrestlers for the NCAA championships while a ninth was named an alternate. It was the most since UNI also sent nine in 2008. Keckeisen led the Panthers last year, as UNI earned four top-15 seeds at the Division I NCAA Wrestling Championships. Keckeisen became a two-time all-American, taking bronze at 184 pounds.



2020-21: The Panthers wrestled an abbreviated schedule, finishing 4-4 on the year. Six Panthers qualified for the NCAA championship, but Lance Runyon had to withdraw due to injury. Keckeisen led UNI with a third-place finish. The Panthers finished 20th overall.

2019-20: Lujan and Steiert capped dominant seasons with Big 12 titles. Lujan won the final 19 bouts of his career and Steiert earned the only fall in the Big 12 Championship round. Seven wrestlers qualified for the NCAA field before the tournament was canceled. Jay Schwarm earned the NCAA DI Fall title, recording 16 on the year. The Panthers also took

care of things in the classroom. Schwarm, Steiert and Max Thomsen earned NWCA Scholar All-American honors. The Panthers also went 8-4 in duals, including a 6-2 record in Big 12 action.

2018-19: Drew Foster's national championship, the first individual title for UNI since Tony Davis in 2000, paced the Panthers to a 13th-place finish at the NCAA National Championship. Bryce Steiert earned All-American honors after finishing eighth at 164. Six Panthers qualified for the NCAA Championship. Foster repeated as the Big-12 champion and was named the Big-12 Wrestler of the Year. Taylor Lujan wrestled in the Big-12 championship and Josh Alber finished third to lead the Panther Train to a third-place finish.

2017-18: Jacob Holschlag earned his first All-America honor at 197 pounds. He was one of six Panthers to compete at the NCAA tournament. The team tied for 24th at the national championships. The Panthers joined the Big 12 and took second at the conference meet. Taylor Lujan (174 pounds) was the first Panther to earn Wrestler of the Week honors and a Big 12 title. Drew Foster also won a conference title at 184 pounds. Max Thomsen earned a spot in the Big 12 championship round, taking second at 149 pounds.

2016-17: UNI won the regular season Mid-American Conference title with an undefeated conference record. Taylor Lujan earned a MAC title at 174 pounds. The Panthers qualified seven for the NCAA tournament and finished 18th at the national tournament. It was the highest finish since 2014. Redshirt freshman Max Thomsen was fifth at 149 pounds, and sophomore Drew Foster was seventh at 184 pounds. UNI was 10th among all Division I schools for attendance.

2015-16: Dylan Peters earned his second All-America honor, taking sixth at 125 pounds. Blaize Cabell became the eighth Panther to win a MAC title, and the first Panther to win a conference title at heavyweight since UNI joined the MAC championship in the 2012-13 season. Five Panthers qualified, but only four competed at the NCAA tournament. Illness prevented Cabell from competing at his third NCAA championship. The team tied for 25th overall.

Schwab started a true freshman for the first time since taking over at UNI. The last freshman to start was Joey Lazor in 2009-10. Bryce Steiert was among the five NCAA qualifiers at 157 pounds. He was the first freshman Panther since 2003 to qualify for the NCAAs. The Panthers

were 10th in the nation among all Division I schools for attendance.

2014-15: Tough scheduling and Schwab's energy boosted attendance numbers for UNI wrestling in 2014-15. The Panthers posted the eighth-highest attendance numbers in the nation, up from ninth the year before. Schwab sent four wrestlers to the NCAA tourney, including two-time MAC champion Cooper Moore at 165 pounds. The team finished 34th at the national championships.

2013-14: Schwab crowned three All-Americans and qualified seven wrestlers, the most UNI had sent to nationals since 2007-08 when nine qualified.

Joe Colon took third at 133 pounds, the highest finish of any Panther since 2005. Dylan Peters (125 pounds) and Joey Lazor (141 pounds) placed sixth.

UNI was the only Division I school to finish its dual season undefeated. It was the first time in history UNI won 13 consecutive duals in a single season to finish undefeated. The Panthers went 10-0 in 1956 and 11-0 in 1950.

UNI's opponents only scored 163 points in duals, the fewest allowed since 1974. The program saw its biggest jump in attendance in at least 14 seasons, posting the ninth highest numbers in the nation. Four home duals in the West Gym were sell-outs.

2012-13: Schwab crowned his first two All-Americans and led the Panthers to their highest finish at the NCAA national tournament since 2005. Four wrestlers accounted for the team's 15th-place finish. David Bonin took fourth at 157 pounds, and Ryan Loder was seventh at 184 pounds. Two more Panthers made the Round of 12, just missing out on the All-America spot.

2011-12: He was among 45 coaches who received full scholarships to join the fourth annual National Wrestling Coaches Association Leadership Academy in Fort Lauderdale, Florida, in August 2012. Five Panthers qualified for the NCAA tournament, and the team finished 34th.

2010-11: In his first season as head coach, Schwab led the Panthers to their first 12-win season since 2003 and helped UNI earn its fourth Western Wrestling Conference dual championship. Three Panthers qualified for the NCAA tournament, and the team tied for 46th place.

"My main job is to get the guys to buy into the lifestyle — that includes on the mat and in the classroom. I'm looking forward to putting an exciting product on the mat that fans in the Cedar Valley can rally behind and come out and watch," Schwab said.

Schwab of Osage, Iowa, served as an assistant wrestling coach with University of Iowa. Prior to joining the Iowa staff, Schwab served two seasons (2005-07) as an assistant coach at Virginia Tech University under Tom Brands. During his tenure with the Hokies, the team won the 2005 regular season Atlantic Coast Conference title, set a school record for dual meet wins (16) and had a school-record five wrestlers qualify for the NCAA Championships. Virginia Tech also crowned five conference champions and two All-Americans, and senior heavyweight Mike Faust was named 2006 ACC Wrestler of the Year.

Schwab was a three-time All-American and Big Ten champion for the Hawkeyes from 1998-2001. He won the 1999 NCAA title at 141 pounds and finished his collegiate career with 130 wins, which still ranks 10th-best in school history.

UNI FILLS HALL OF FAMES

GLEN BRAND HALL OF FAME

The 1974-75 University of Northern Iowa wrestling team will be inducted into the 2023 Glen Brand Wrestling Hall of Fame of Iowa. The Hirschberger / Shedenhelm Family will be presented with the Bowlsby Family Legacy Award.

The 1974-75 UNI wrestling team compiled a 15-4 record and winning the state of Iowa's first NCAA Division II national championship. Led by Chuck Patten, the Panthers advanced five wrestlers to the finals: Dave Cunningham at 118 pounds, Jim Miller at 134 pounds, Ken Snyder at 142 pounds, Dick Erickson at 177 pounds, and heavyweight Randy Omvig. Miller and Snyder both won their second consecutive national titles while Omvig won his first. Members of the team were Stanley Allen, Michael Asche, Jon Bagenstos, Gary Bentrim, Jeffrey Billerbeck, James Blasingame, Richard Briggs, Russell Clark, Stephen Coon, Thomas Cornally, David Coulter, David Cunningham, Larry Dawson, Dallas Deike, Joseph Deutsch, Randy Dodd, Michael Eremieff, Richard Erickson, Lowell Ewalt, Kevin Finn, Thomas Garcia, Al Garrison, Ron Gomis, Alan Halferty, Paul Herder, Thomas Hirschberger, Cassim Igram, Dan Keller, Dick Kennedy, Kurt Mattison, Bruce McClure, Nolan Meggers, Jeffrey Melvin, Gary Meyers, James Miller, Randall Omvig, Ronald Ott, Chuck Parsons, Stephen Pate, Kenneth Peterson, Lars Sacquitne, Lonny Silber, Michael Skopec, Kenneth Snyder, Lawrence Soderberg, Dana Sutherland, Randall Terpstra, Hal Turner, Russell Vermie, Paul Viktora, Paul Vornbrock, Mark Wakeland, John Wistey, and Michael Woodall.

The Hirschberger / Shedenhelm family comprises 14 wrestlers who will receive the Bowlsby Family Legacy Award. Since 1971, a Hirschberger / Shedenhelm family member has wrestled or coached. The Hirschberger / Shedenhelm legacy began at Belle Plaine High School with the Hirschberger brothers: Tom, Jim, Dean, Kurt, and Bruce. Tom, the eldest, finished fourth at the Iowa high school championships in 1972 and wrestled for UNI before sustaining a career-ending injury in 1975. Kurt was a two-time Iowa state champion in 1978 and 1979 while Jim, Dean and Bruce all wrestled. Kurt married Terri Jo Shedenhelm, a native of Belle Plaine, Iowa, and they had two sons, Dustin and Drew. Dustin was a three-time NCAA Division III national champion for Wartburg College after placing fourth (2000), third (2001) and first (2002) at the Iowa state tournament. Drew finished sixth (2006), third (2008) and first (2009) at the Iowa state tournament and was a national qualifier for Coe College. Dean's two sons, Erich and Lance, also wrestled. Erich placed fourth at the Iowa state tournament in 1998. Lance finished sixth (2012) and third (2013) at state before wrestling at Upper Iowa. Terri Jo's brothers, Kurt and Kevin Shedenhelm, also wrestled for Belle Plaine. Kurt finished fifth in 1981 and third in 1982 and 1983 at the Iowa state meet and was a Freestyle Junior Nationals runner-up before becoming a three-time NCAA qualifier for UNI. Kevin placed third (1983) and second (1984) at the Iowa state tournament and also wrestled for UNI. Kevin became the head wrestling coach at Denver (Iowa) High School and

coached his three sons, Blaze, Chase, and Izaak. Blaze was a state qualifier in 2010 while Chase was state runner-up in 2012 and state champion in 2013 and Izaak finished third in 2015 and first in 2016. Chase and Izaak both wrestled for UNI.

All-American Joe Colon is the latest Panther to earn a spot in the 2022 Glen Brand Hall of Fame. Colon compiled a perfect 24-0 dual record at UNI. He was a junior national college champion for Iowa Central Community College and was named Outstanding Wrestler in 2010.

As a Panther, he took third at the NCAA Division I NAAs as a senior in 2014. Colon allowed bonus points only once in 68 career matches for UNI. He won the Bill Farrell International championship in 2014 while finishing fourth at the World Team Trials and fifth at the U.S. Open. The following year, he finished second at the World Team Trials, third at the Cerro Pelado International and fourth at the U.S. Open. Colon won a bronze medal at the World Championships in 2018 and is currently an assistant wrestling coach at Northwestern. Both head coach Doug Schwab and Panther wrestler Cael Happel have been recognized with Glen Brand Hall of Fame's Bowlsby Family Legacy Award. Schwab was also inducted as an individual in 2011. Happel has an individual Glen Brand Hall of Fame Award as the 2020 Bob Steenlage Iowa High School Wrestler of the Year.

Located inside the National Wrestling Hall of Fame Dan Gable Museum in Waterloo, Iowa, the Glen Brand Hall of Fame was established in 2002 to honor native-born Iowans and those who wrestled or coached for an Iowa school who have made an impact on wrestling on a national level or who have done extraordinary work in Iowa.

NATIONAL WRESTLING HALL OF FAME

Bob Bowlsby, former UNI director of athletics and Big 12 commissioner will be inducted into the National Wrestling Hall of Fame's Class of 2023. On June 2-3 in Stillwater, Oklahoma, he will be honored as the Outstanding American inductee.

A native of Waterloo, Iowa, Bowlsby served as UNI's director of athletics from 1984 until 1991 before taking over leadership of the athletic department at Iowa and later at Stanford University. He was named the fourth commissioner of the Big 12 Conference in 2012, where he helped guide the league through growth and financial success until his retirement in 2022.

UNI INTERCOLLEGIATE HALL OF FAME

Former Panther wrestler and coach Mark Schwab, the brother of head coach Doug Schwab, was part of the most recent class inducted UNI's Hall of Fame. A two-time all-American, he took fifth place at the NCAA championships after a 49-9 his true freshman season at 118 pounds, the most wins ever in a single season at UNI and the most in NCAA history by a true freshman.

He went 30-0 in open competition during the 1986-87 season and a bronze medalist in Tblissi, Russia, which was deemed the world's toughest tournament

as a redshirt sophomore.

He held the nation's top ranking in his weight class after a 17-1-2 record before his season-ending injury. After nine knee operations and missing an entire season, Schwab reached the NCAA championships in 1989 with a 14-4 record and 34-4 senior campaign earning his second all-American status.

IOWA CHAPTER OF NWHOF

Former UNI head wrestling coach Don Briggs received special recognition in fall of 2022 from the Iowa Chapter of the National Wrestling Hall of Fame as a Lifetime Service to Wrestling Award recipient. The honor is awarded to individuals in recognition of years of dedication to the development of leadership and citizenship in young people through the sport. Briggs spent nine years as a graduate assistant and assistant coach at UNI, helping develop 14 NCAA Division II national champions. He was named UNI's head coach in 1982.

During his 15 years as UNI's head coach, Briggs amassed a dual meet record of 164-98 and coached 15 all-Americans. He led the Panthers to 12 consecutive NCAA regional championships from 1986 to 1997, Briggs was named the NCAA West Regional Coach of the Year 10 times.

DAVE SCHULTZ STREAK

Eight Panthers have earned the Dave Schultz High School Excellence Award in the last nine years. Current freshman Cory Land is the first Panther to have earned the national honor, the top award possible while also being the regional winner for the Southeast and the state honoree for Alabama. 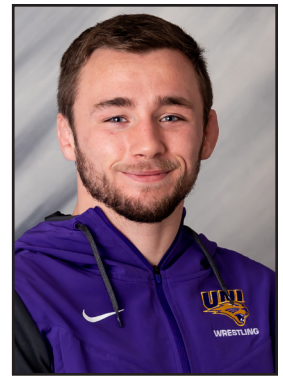
