The UNLV men's basketball team (4-3) will head out on the road for the first time this season as it travels to Champaign, Illinois, to face Illinois (2-7) on Saturday, Dec. 8 at 11 a.m. PT/1 p.m. CT.

The Runnin' Rebels had won four straight games from Nov. 13-23, but have lost their last two. UNLV is coming off a 65-61 loss last Saturday to Cincinnati, which closed its season-opening seven-game homestand.

UNLV is led in scoring by senior guard Kris Clyburn's 11.7 ppg, while senior forward Shakur Juiston is averaging just shy of a double-double with 11.0 ppg and a team-leading 9.6 rpg. Juiston is fourth in the Mountain West in rebounding and ranks 33rd in the country. Sophomore guard Amauri Hardy is also averaging double figures in scoring at 10.3 ppg. Sophomore forward Mbacke Diong leads the team and league in blocks (2.3 bpg, 31st in the nation), while senior guard Noah Robotham is the team's assists leader (3.9 apg).

Illinois has lost three straight games, including two in conference play: at Notre Dame (76-74), at Nebraska (75-60) and vs. Ohio State (77-67). The Fighting Illini have three players averaging double figures in scoring: Trent Frazier (15.2 ppg), Ayo Dosunmu (12.3 ppg) and Aaron Jordan (10.6 ppg). Giorgi Bezhanishvili is the team's leading rebounder (4.9 rpg), while Frazier also leads in assists (3.4 apg). Illinois is 2-1 at home with wins over Evansville (99-60) and Mississippi Valley State (86-67) and a loss to Georgetown (88-80).

Saturday's game will be televised by the Big Ten Network with Jeff Levering and Deon Thomas calling the action. Jon Sandler, former Runnin' Rebel Robert Smith, and Steve Cofield (sideline reporter) will handle the UNLV radio call, which may be heard live on ESPN Radio 1100 AM and online via the UNLV Gameday App and TuneIn (link at UNLVRebels.com).

THE UNLY RUNNIN' REBELS (4-3, 0-0 MOUNTAIN WEST)

- The 2018-19 season marks the third at UNLV for head coach Marvin Menzies. Prior to coming to UNLV, he spent the previous nine years as head coach at New Mexico State where he compiled a 198-111 (.641) record. His current career record is 233-148 (.612) and he is 35-37 (.486) at UNLV.
- Coming to UNLV was actually a return to Las Vegas for Coach Menzies. He spent a year with the Runnin' Rebels on Lon Kruger's staff in 2004-05 as an assistant coach.
- The Runnin' Rebels opened the season with seven straight games at the Thomas & Mack Center and will now travel for the first time for the game at Illinois.
- Senior forward Shakur Juiston is UNLVs leading returning scorer. He averaged a double-double with 14.6 points and 10.0 rebounds per game last season. He shot 63.9 percent from the field, which ranked seventh in the country and No. 5 on the all-time UNLV seasonal chart. He also tallied 15 double-doubles last year, which ranked 20th in the nation. Juiston was named second-team All-Mountain West and second-team All-District 17 (NABC) last year.
- UNLV has two other seniors this season: point guard Noah Robotham, a transfer from Akron, who is from Las Vegas, and guard Kris Clyburn, who is in his third season at UNLV.
- Last year's team won 20 games, which was its highest win total in four years. It also marked a ninegame improvement in the win column from the previous season. Key losses from last year include Mountain West Freshman of the Year Brandon McCoy and seniors Jovan Mooring and Jordan Johnson. All three averaged double figures in scoring.
- This year's team returns seven student-athletes who played last season, which is the most for the program from the previous season in seven years.
- This year's roster has a total of 11 freshmen and sophomores.
- UNLV was picked to finish sixth in this year's Mountain West race by the media in October.
- The Runnin' Rebels are led this season in scoring by senior guard Kris Clyburn's 11.7 ppg, while senior forward Shakur Juiston is averaging just shy of a double-double with 11.0 ppg and a team-leading 9.6 rpg. Juiston is fourth in the Mountain West in rebounding and ranks 3rd in the country. Sophomore guard Amauri Hardy is also averaging double figures in scoring at 10.3 ppg. Sophomore forward Mbacke Diong leads the team and league in blocks (2.3 bpg, 31st in the nation), while senior guard Noah Robotham is the team's assists leader (3.9 apg).
- So far this season, UNLV leads the MW in scoring defense, allowing just 64.4 ppg. UNLV is also first in offensive rebounding (14.7 rpg, 12th in the country) and blocks (5.0 bpg, 39th in the country). The Runnin' Rebels rank second in the league in rebound margin (+11.0, 11th in the country), rebounds per game (41.0 rpg, 36th in the country) and limiting their opponents rebounds (30.0 rpg).

THE ILLINOIS FIGHTING ILLINI (2-7, 0-2 BIG TEN)

- Illinois has lost three straight games, including two in conference play: at Notre Dame (76-74), at No. 24/25 Nebraska (75-60) and vs. No. 19/17 Ohio State (77-67).
- The Fighting Illini have three players averaging double figures in scoring: Trent Frazier (15.2 ppg), Ayo Dosunmu (12.3 ppg) and Aaron Jordan (10.6 ppg). Giorgi Bezhanishvili is the team's leading rebounder (4.9 rpg), while Frazier also leads in assists (3.4 apg).
- Illinois is 2-1 at home with wins over Evansville (99-60) and Mississippi Valley State (86-67) and a loss to Georgetown (88-80).
- The team is scoring 76.3 ppg, while its opponents are averaging 77.2 ppg.
- On Wednesday vs. Ohio State at the United Center in Chicago, Frazier and Kipper Nichols each scored 18 points and Illinois led at the half (38-34). The Illini outscored the Buckeyes 16-4 in the last six minutes of the first half, turning a 30-22 deficit into a four-point lead. However, Illinois shot just 27.3 percent in the second half (9 for 33).
- Illinois was 14-18 overall last season, finishing tied for 11th in the Big Ten with a 4-14 league mark.
- Head coach Brad Underwood is in his second year at Illinois with a record of 16-25 (.390) and in his sixth year overall with a career mark of 125-52 (.706).
- Illinois returns six letterwinners, including two starters from last year's team.

SERIES HISTORY

- This will mark the seventh meeting between Illinois and UNLV in men's basketball.
- Illinois leads the all-time series 4-2.
- UNLV is 1-0 on the road vs. Illinois (game was played in Chicago in 2011), but has never played in Champaign.
- UNLV won the last meeting (89-82), which was last season (Dec. 9) at the MGM Grand Garden Arena in Las Vegas.
- This will mark the fifth meeting between UNLV and Illinois over the last nine seasons.
- UNLV is 23-13 all-time against teams that currently make up the Big Ten Conference.

UP NEXT

After playing at Illinois, UNLV will return home and face BYU at T-Mobile Arena on the Las Vegas Strip. The National Finals Rodeo is currently being held at the Runnin' Rebels' home arena.

THE MARVIN MENZIES ERA AT UNLV

The 2018-19 season marks the third for UNLV under head coach Marvin Menzies. He officially became the 13th full-time head coach in the history of Runnin' Rebel basketball in April of 2016 after returning to Las Vegas after nine years as the head coach at New Mexico State, going 198-111 (.641) with the Aggies. Now in his 12th year overall as a head coach, his career record is 233-148 (.612) and he is 35-37 (.486) leading the Rebels. He led his team to the postseason in each of his last five seasons at NMSU and six of the last seven. He was an assistant coach on Lon Kruger's staff at UNLV in 2004-05.

ROSTER MAKEUP

UNLV returns seven student-athletes who played last season, which is the most for the program from the previous season in seven years. The Runnin' Rebels are led this year by seniors Shakur Juiston, a second-team All-Mountain West honoree in 2017-18, Noah Robotham, a Las Vegan who transferred from Akron, and Kris Clyburn, who is in his third year at UNLV. The team has welcomed six freshmen this season. In all, the young team has a total of 11 freshmen and sophomores on this year's roster.

"3-POINT GOAL..." - UNLV HOLDS NCAA RECORD

UNLV holds the NCAA record for most consecutive games scoring at least one 3-pointer. Since the 3-point field goal was adopted by the NCAA in 1986-87, UNLV has converted at least one 3-pointer in all 1,046 games played.

AT THE THOMAS & MACK CENTER

The 2018-19 season marks the 36th year of Runnin' Rebel basketball in the Thomas & Mack Center. UNLV has posted an all-time record of 482-121 (.799) in the arena since it opened in 1983.

AFTER SEVEN GAMES, UNLY HOLDING OPPONENTS TO JUST 64.4 PPG

UNLV is holding its opponents to just 64.4 points per game so far this season, which ranks No. 1 in the Mountain West. The Runnin' Rebels are also first in the conference in offensive rebounding (14.7 rpg, 12th in the country) and blocks (5.0 bpg, 39th in the country). The Runnin' Rebels rank second in the league in rebound margin (+11.0, 11th in the country), rebounds per game (41.0 rpg, 36th in the country) and limiting their opponents rebounds (30.0 rpg).

FRESHMAN LEADS WAY IN SEASON'S FIRST WIN

After going scoreless in six minutes of action in the loss vs. LMU, freshman guard Bryce Hamilton led the Runnin' Rebels in scoring in the win over UC Riverside. Hamilton poured in 16 points on a perfect 5 for 5 shooting night. He was also perfect on 3-pointers, making all three of his attempts. He had four rebounds, an assist and was 3 for 5 from the free-throw line in 23 minutes of action on Nov. 13.

JUISTON LEADS RUNNIN' REBELS TO SECOND STRAIGHT WIN

In UNLV's 74-61 win over Oakland on Nov. 16, senior forward Shakur Juiston resembled last year's version of himself as he led the team with 18 points and had a game-high 10 rebounds for his first double-double of the year. It was the 16th of his career. He was 8 of 13 from the field, adding two assists and a steal in 29 minutes of action.

MANY HIGHLIGHTS IN THIRD STRAIGHT WIN

In UNLV's third straight win, 96-70 over Pacific on Nov. 20, five Runnin' Rebels scored in double figures. Senior guard Kris Clyburn led the way with 17 points on 6 of 9 from the field, including three 3-pointers, sophomore forward Mbacke Diong scored a career-high 16 points on a perfect 7 of 7 shooting, senior forward Shakur Juiston and sophomore guard Amauri Hardy both scored 13 (then-career high for Hardy), and senior guard Noah Robotham pitched in a season-high 11 points. UNLV shot season-high percentages of 62.1 from the field (36 of 58) and 40.7 on 3-pointers (11 of 27). The 11 made 3-pointers is also a season high for the Runnin' Rebels and the most for the squad since draining 13 vs. Air Force during the 2016-17 season. UNLV also recorded a season-high 22 assists and a season-low 11 turnovers.

JUISTON'S SECOND DOUBLE-DOUBLE LEADS TO FOURTH STRAIGHT WIN

Senior forward Shakur Juiston had his second double-double of the season in the win on Nov. 23 vs. Southern Utah (11 points, 16 rebounds). Senior guard Kris Clyburn added a game-high 14 points. Juiston's rebound total was his most in a game since last year against SUU (Nov. 25, 2017) when he also had 16. His career high is 19 vs. Rice last year, which he matched this season vs. Valparaiso.

RUNNIN' REBELS' FOUR-GAME WIN STREAK SNAPPED VS. VALPARAISO

In UNLV's Mountain West-Missouri Valley Conference Challenge game, the team committed a season-high 25 turnovers. The Runnin' Rebels were led by senior forward Shakur Juiston's third double-double of the season with a team-high 14 points and a career-high-tying 19 rebounds. Valpo used a 21-2 run which spanned both halves and scored 31 points off turnovers and added 18 second-chance points.

UNLV DROPS HARD-FOUGHT GAME VS. CINCINNATI

The Runnin' Rebels rallied to get within a single possession three times over the final 3:30, but fell short in a 66-61 loss to Cincinnati last Saturday. Sophomore guard Amauri Hardy sscored a career-high 22 points. The Bearcats led from the start and increased their advantage to 12 points on three different occasions in the first half. UNLV missed 11 free throws, going 18 of 29 for the game.

OUT-REBOUNDERS

UNLV has out-rebounded each of its first seven opponents this season. UNLV ranks 11th in the country in rebound margin at +11.0 per game.

CLYBURN EXCELLING FROM THE FREE-THROW LINE

Senior guard Kris Clyburn has excelled from the free-throw line this season, making 20 of his 21 attempts. His percentage of 95.2 currently ranks sixth in the country.

20 WINS LAST SEASON

In Coach Menzies' second year at the helm of the UNLV program (2017-18), the Runnin' Rebels recorded 20 wins, which was their highest win total in four years. It also marked a nine-game improvement in the win column from the previous season.

MORE ON LAST SEASON

The Runnin' Rebels finished the 2017-18 season with an overall record of 20-13 ... UNLV had four players average double figures in scoring and was led by freshman forward Brandon McCoy's 16.9 points per game ... He also led the team in rebounding at 10.3 rebounds per contest ... Shakur Juiston also averaged a double-double with 14.6 ppg and 10.0 rpg ... Jordan Johnson was the team's assist leader with 6.0 per game ... McCoy was named the Mountain West Freshman of the Year and declared for the NBA Draft ... UNLV led the MW in scoring (83.4 ppg) and rebounding (40.5 rpg), ranking 13th and 10th in the nation, respectively.

GETTING IT DONE IN THE CLASSROOM

The Runnin' Rebels are coming off back-to-back semesters with a collective grade point average of at least 3.0 for the first time. The team also set a GPA record with a 3.17 in the spring of 2018.

MOUNTAIN WEST'S SECOND-BEST RECRUITING CLASS

This year's UNLV men's basketball recruiting class has been ranked as high as No. 2 in the Mountain West.

61ST YEAR OF RUNNIN' REBEL BASKETBALL

The 2018-19 year marks the 61st season of Runnin' Rebel basketball at UNLV. Since the program's inception in 1958-59, the Runnin' Rebels have posted an all-time record of 1,275-556 (.696).

FIFTH-WINNINGEST PROGRAM EVER

With an all-time record of 1,245-543 (.696) against four-year American institutions (entering the 2018-19 season), UNLV ranks as the fifth-winningest program by percentage in NCAA Division I history (min. 25 years in Div. I). The only schools ahead of UNLV are Kentucky, North Carolina, Kansas and Duke.

A WINNING PROGRAM

UNLV has finished the season with a winning percentage above .500, 55 times in its 60-year history.

NBA DRAFT PICKS

UNLV had a total of four NBA Draft picks over a four-year span from 2013-16: Anthony Bennett (No. 1 overall in 2013 by the Cleveland Cavaliers), Rashad Vaughn (No. 17 overall in 2015 by the Milwaukee Bucks), Patrick McCaw (No. 38 overall in 2016 by the Golden State Warriors) and Stephen Zimmerman Jr. (No. 41 overall in 2016 by the Orlando Magic).

RUNNIN' REBELS IN THE NBA

As of October, there were six former Runnin' Rebels on NBA rosters. They were Khem Birch (Orlando Magic), Derrick Jones Jr. (Miami Heat), Patrick McCaw (Golden State Warriors), Brandon McCoy (New Orleans Pelicans), Rashad Vaughn (Dallas Mavericks) and Christian Wood (Milwaukee Bucks). Birch, Jones Jr., McCoy and Wood all went undrafted, while McCaw was a second-round selection in 2016 and Vaughn was picked in the first round in 2015.

NEW VIDEO BOARD IN THE THOMAS & MACK CENTER

As part of a \$5 million, multi-year commitment from Boyd Gaming Corporation – the largest corporate commitment in the history of UNLV Athletics - the Thomas & Mack Center has a brand new larger state-of-the-art center-hung video board. But we got the win and now we have to prepare for two really tough teams next week." UNLV Head Coach Marvin Menzies

- UNLV got to the free throw line 27 more times than SUU (43-16).
- UNLV's biggest lead of the game was 12 points (44-32) with 18:36 to go in the game.

- Eight Runnin' Rebel players scored at least seven points in the game.
- Tervell Beck pulled down a career-high eight rebounds.
- UNLV has made at least one 3-pointer in a NCAA-record 1,044 straight games.
