REBELS HOPING FOR HOME FIELD ADVANTAGE

UNLV is happy to finally be back at Peter Johann Memorial Field, as the Rebels played eight of their first 10 games of the season away from their home field. That changes this weekend with a pair of home conference games, starting with the WAC home opener against Cal Baptist Friday night, while CSU Bakersfield makes the trip to Las Vegas for a Sunday afternoon contest.

The Rebels are hoping to break a three-game losing streak in which they have scored just one goal. Defense has stayed strong for UNLV however, and of the team's five losses, three were by a 1-0 margin while the fourth was Monday night's 2-1 setback at San Diego State. UNLV played shorthanded for the majority of the match, yet still nearly pulled off a rally for a win.




This will be the first meeting between UNLV and Cal Baptist since 1976, as the Lancers are in their first year at the Division I level and first-year members of the WAC. CSU Bakersfield meanwhile holds an 8-3-2 lead in the all-time series, and the teams have split their last two contests following a pair of ties.

Both games this weekend will be live streamed, carried by the WAC Digital Network which will be available on UNLVRebels.com as well as through the Roku, Apple TV, Fire TV and Android streaming devices. Sunday's game will feature the call of Wyatt Tomcheck on play by play and Eric Rowling as color.

MEET THE REBELS

Sophomore forward **Marco Gonzalez** and junior midfielder **Timo Mehlich** have quickly shown they will be the leaders of this year's attack on offense, to the surprise of no one after finishing second and third on the team in scoring a year ago. Gonzalez is second in the WAC with 17 points off seven goals and three assists, along with his first career hat trick. Mehlich also ranks among the WAC leaders with seven points. Freshman **Nico Classen** has taken over the center mid role and leads the WAC with four assists.

Junior goalkeeper **Enrique Adame** has turned in a strong start in goal in the season, with two shut-outs in eight games while owning 1.11 GAA and a 73.0% save percentage.

RANKING THE REBELS

For the first time this season the Rebels are not ranked in the region, as they dropped out of the United Soccer Coaches Far West rankings after their 0-2 weekend on the road. The Rebels were getting votes in the national poll after the first two weeks thanks to a 3-1 start, before the 1-0 setback to Cal State Fullerton on Sept. 9.

Two Rebel opponents are ranked in this week's poll, Air Force, who is also ranked in all four major national rankings, holds the top spot while UTRGV jumped to 10th after its win over UNLV.

CLOSING IN ON WIN #400

The Rebels are close to a team milestone, as in their 45th season of men's soccer at UNLV, they have 399 total wins, just one away from reaching the 400 win plateau. Over their 45 years they are 399-383-64 overall with a .509 winning percentage.

MEHLICH CLAIMS TEAM OF THE WEEK HONORS

Junior midfielder **Timo Mehlich** made an impact in both of UNLV's opening games, with a penalty kick goal to start off the Rebels' 3-0 win over FAU and a goal and an assist in the win over Evansville on Aug. 28. Those performances were good enough to earn him a spot on the Top Drawer Soccer National Men's Team of the Week, his first career weekly honor.



HAT TRICK GONZALEZ

Sophomore forward **Marco Gonzalez** was named WAC Offensive Player of the Week on Aug. 27 after posting the first hat trick of his career in UNLV's 4-1 win over Evansville. He also added an assist in the season-opening win over Florida Atlantic, giving him a league-high seven points through the first two games.



MEHLICH NAMED TO TOP 100 LIST

Top Drawer Soccer released its Nation's Top 100 Players list on Aug. 21, and the Rebels are represented as junior midfielder Timo Mehlich is ranked #76 in the initial set of rankings. Mehlich was an all-region and first-team all-conference selection in 2017.

REBELS PICKED TO FINISH SECOND IN THE WAC

For the third time in the past five years, UNLV has been picked to finish second in the WAC as it received 105 points in the preseason poll, one vote over third place Air Force (104), while Seattle is the preseason favorite with 119 total points.

In addition, three Rebels were named to the Preseason All-WAC squad, the second-highest number in the conference behind first-place Seattle. Named to the team was **Timo Mehlich**, **Adam Musovski** and **Marco Gonzalez**.

REBEL NEWCOMERS

Here are a couple of notes about the 10-member newcomer class for the Rebels

- Freshman **Nico Clasen**, a potential starter in the midfield, comes from **Timo Mehlich's** hometown of Mönchengladbach, Germany. Clasen has a total of 25 caps with the Germany National U-18 and U-16 teams, and is the first Rebel recruit to have played for his country's national youth team since Danny Cruz with the US U-17 team in 2007 and the U-20 squad in 2008-09
- UNLV's freshmen class includes a pair of state Gatorade Player of the Years, **John Lynam** (Nevada) and **Angelo Deloso-Flocco** (Hawaii)
- **Bay Kurtz**, a senior midfielder, is the first-ever transfer into Coach Ryerson's program from an ACC school (Virginia), and the first to transfer directly into UNLV's graduate school
